UALBANY PLAYS FIRST AE ROAD GAME AT UNH

UAlbany looks to return to its winning ways on Saturday, January 6th, heading north to New Hampshire for a 1 p.m. game in Durham.

UAlbany is playing in its first America East road game while New Hampshire is playing its first conference home game of the season.

Each side fell in its conference opener on Wednesday. UAlbany, picked to finish second in the America East in the preseason coaches poll, fell vs. Hartford 72-64 at home to go to 12-4 overall and 0-1 in the league. New Hampshire, placed fifth in the preseason coaches poll, was defeated in a 71-67 game at UMBC on Wednesday, entering at 4-11 overall and 0-1 in the conference.

Last season, each team won on its opponent's home floor, with UAlbany taking the last meeting 69-55 in Durham on February 8, 2017 and UNH winning at SEFCU 75-67 on January 11, 2017. UAlbany leads the all-time series 22-15, including taking nine of the last 12 meetings.

HOT SHOOTING TEAM

Through 16 games in the season, UAlbany stands with the third highest scoring offense in the America East, earning 77.3 points per game, including six 80+ point games, with a 47.2% field goal rate.

Currently, Joe Cremo (17.9 ppg), David Nichols (15.9 ppg) and Travis Charles (14.9 ppg) are all in the top-12 in the America East in scoring.

UALBANY RANKED #4 MID-MAJOR IN NATION

UAlbany is ranked #4 in the CollegenInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 on January 2nd, released every Monday. UAlbany is also the top-ranked mid-major team in the state of New York and in the America East. UAlbany has stood in the top-10 each of the past three weeks.

CREMO JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

With a 30-point performance vs. Holy Cross on November 25th, Joe Cremo surpassed the career 1,000-point mark. Cremo now stands with 1,184 career points, having averaged 14.1 points per game in his career. Cremo earned the 1,000-point mark in 74 games played.

David Nichols currently has 919 points, including 625 in the 2016-17 year, the second-highest single season in UAlbany history. Nichols is 81 points away from 1,000.

Along with Cremo, ten UAlbany players have scored over 1,000 points in the DI era.

NICHOLS NAMED TO LOU HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST

UAlbany junior guard David Nichols has been named to the 2017-18 Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List. The Lou Henson Award is given each year to the top Division I mid-major player.

UALBANY PREDICTED TO FINISH 2ND IN AMERICA EAST PRESEASON POLL

UAlbany has been predicted to finish second in the America East Conference in the 2017-18 season in the preseason coaches poll.

UAlbany finished tied for third place last year with a 10-6 record. Finishing 21-14 overall, the Great Danes defeated Hartford and Stony Brook in the AE Tournament to earn a berth in the title game, falling to Vermont. Vermont was unanimously picked to finish first in the league with eight first-place votes and 64 points.

BOX OUT!

Through 16 games, UAlbany has outrebounded its opponents in all but two games, standing with the second-best rebounding margin in the America East at +8.4, and 19th in all of Division I. Auburn is the only team to out-rebound their opponents in all games to begin the year. First in the league is New Hampshire at +8.6. Greig Stire (8.2) and Travis Charles (5.6) stand in the top-10 in the America East in rebounding.

FIRST 6-0 START IN DIVISION I, SINCE 1985-86

This season, UAlbany earned its first-ever 6-0 start in its Division I history, the first three wins against opponents picked to finish top three in their respective leagues in the preseason: Iona, Boston University and Yale. UAlbany's 12 pre-America East play victory count is the best in its history, surpassing 11 in 2015-16 and 2012-13.

The last 6-0 start for UAlbany came in the DII era in 1985-86, being achieved in two seasons since 1956-57.

SEVEN WINNING LEAGUE SEASONS IN A ROW

UAlbany has earned a winning record in America East play each of the past seven seasons starting in the 2010-11 year, including a combined 28-4 tally from 2015-16. UAlbany has earned 10 winning seasons in America East play in the last 12 years under Will Brown.

NICHOLS, CREMO NAMED TO AE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

Two UAlbany players, David Nichols and Joe Cremo, have been selected to the 2017-18 America East Pre-season All-Conference Team. Nichols earned America East All-Conference First Team honors last season while Joe Cremo was placed on the Second Team.

THE WALKING BUCKET

Nicknamed the "Walking Bucket" by head coach Will Brown after the win over Colgate, Travis Charles has earned double digit points in 13 of 16 games this season, averaging 14.6 points per contest and shooting 60.0% from the field. He is also averaging 5.6 boards a contest.

STREAKS

Greig Stire has earned at least one board in each of the past 87 games, including a single game record 15 rebounds at Hartford on January 22nd, 2017.

Joe Cremo has scored points in each of his last 82 games going back to Nov. 19, 2015. Cremo has also dished out at least one assist in each of the past 46 games. David Nichols, scoring in each game all of 2016-17, is on a 53-game scoring streak. Stire has scored in 41 consecutive games while Travis Charles has a 36-game scoring streak.

UALBANY PLAYERS IN THE RECORD BOOK

A couple of UAlbany players are approaching adding their names to the UAlbany record book.

Alex Foster added his name on December 20th, tying a UAlbany single game record 15 rebounds at Louisville. Greig Stire earlier had 15 rebounds in a January 28th, 2017 win at Hartford.

Joe Cremo stands with 1,184 career points. He is 230 points away from being in the top-10 in UAlbany history, and currently is 8th in the program's DI history in points. He is also first in career free throw % at 87%.

Travis Charles has a chance to set a career record. He currently stands with a 60.4% field goal rate; the UAlbany record is 56.6% by Dick Crossett from 1962-65.

CAPITAL DISTRICT LOCALS

Three players local to the Capital District have remained home to suit up for the Great Danes this season.

From nearby Scotia comes junior Joe Cremo, a three-time Section II Class A champion at Scotia-Glenville, who earned 2015-16 America East Rookie of the Year. Senior forward Greig Stire has started the last three years in the frontcourt, taking Christian Brothers Academy in Albany to the 2012 Section II title. At Albany Academy, sophomore Nick Fruscio took his team to a pair of Federation state titles, including as a senior team captain.

WILL BROWN SIGNS FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION

On September 29, 2016, UAlbany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced that Will Brown signed a new five-year contract through the 2020-21 season. Brown enters his 17th season as UAlbany head coach this year.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK

UAlbany will play ten regular season games against teams from the Empire State, including seven at home. UAlbany will take on Iona, Oneonta, Colgate, Columbia, Siena, Canisius, Stony Brook (twice) and Binghamton (twice). This season, UAlbany is 6-0 against in-state opponents.

BASKETBALL IN ONE HAND, DEGREE IN THE OTHER

Two UAlbany players have earned their undergraduate degree and suit up as graduate students this year. Travis Charles graduated from UAlbany in 2017 with a B.A. in African Studies, while Alex Foster graduated from Bradley in 2017 with a degree in sports communication.

SCOUTING NEW HAMPSHIRE:

Ranked second all-time at UNH in career scoring with 1,676 points, senior forward Taylor Leissner shoots 46.1% for 19.7 points and 8.2 boards a game. The next leading scorer is senior forward Iba Camara, the league's top rebounder with 10.3 boards and 9.9 points a contest. Freshman Elijah Jordan runs the floor at 6.7 points and four assists per game.

UALBANY GRADS RETURN TO ASSIST THE GREAT DANES

Most of UAlbany's support staff are graduates of UAlbany. Associate head coach Jon Iati and assistant coach Jerrad Knotts played for Will Brown, graduating in 2006 and 2007 respectively, while Ty Conyers, hired as video coordinator this season, was a team manager for UAlbany, graduating in 2014. In addition, assistant coach Josh Pelletier earned a graduate degree from UAlbany in 2012.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE!

Three players native to Australia, Brent Hank, Cameron Healy and Adam Lulka, have joined UAlbany as freshmen for the 2017-18 season.

UAlbany has four former players from Australia: Mike Rowley (2013-17), Sam Rowley (2011-15), Peter Hooley (2011-16) and Luke Devlin (2010-14).

FOUR PLAYERS NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

For only the third time in Will Brown's tenure, and first time since 2013-14, UAlbany will have four team captains for this season. Travis Charles, Joe Cremo, David Nichols and Greig Stire will serve as captains for the Great Danes. Cremo is a captain for the second straight season while the other three are captains for the first time.

JAMAR WILSON, 2005-06 UALBANY TEAM INDUCTED INTO UALBANY ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME

Jamar Wilson, the all-time leading scorer in UAlbany men's basketball history, and the 2005-06 men's basketball team, the first team in program history to win the America East Tournament and regular season titles, were inducted into the UAlbany Athletics Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2017.

Wilson, a two-time America East Player of the Year and a two-time Associated Press All-American, finished his career with 2,164 points, top-10 in America East history, off 699 field goals and 601 free throws, each Division I UAlbany records.

The 2005-06 UAlbany team went 21-11 and 13-3 in the America East, defeating all three America East Tournament opponents by double digits, capped by an 80-67 victory over Vermont in the title game at home, earning the program's first NCAA Tournament automatic berth.

Wilson and the 2005-06 team are the first UAlbany men's basketball inductees into the UAlbany Athletics Hall of Fame since Todd Cetnar entered in 2013.

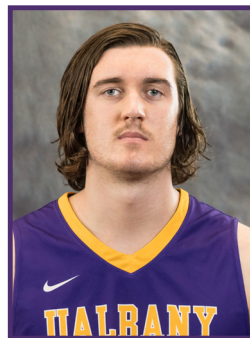

UAlbany Men's Basketball Falls in AE Opener vs. Hartford 72-64

ALBANY, N.Y. – The UAlbany men's basketball team rallied from down 20 for a tie game with two minutes left in the America East home opener, but fell to Hartford 72-64 on Wednesday night.

"To come back from 20 points takes a lot of energy, but we put ourselves in that position. We played smart to get back from down 20, but we needed to finish," said UAlbany head coach Will Brown.

Joe Cremo played all 40 minutes, notching 23 points and six assists, while David Nichols earned 20 points and a pair of steals. Greig Stire earned 14 rebounds, one shy of tying the single game program record. Stire shares in this single game record, previously having 15 in a game last season.

For Hartford, John Carroll finished with 17 points, eight rebounds and three assists. J.R. Lynch also had 17 points, adding four assists. Hartford shot 50% from three-point range and 100% (13-for-13) from the free throw line.

Action was high-flying in the first couple of minutes as both sides traded shots back and forth. Including a couple of scores from Hassen Attia for Hartford and a

layup and one from Joe Cremo, the two teams were tied at 9-9 at the first media timeout.

After Hartford went back up with a three, three different UAlbany players contributed to a 7-0 run, capped by a long jumper on a fast break by David Nichols, to take a 16-12 advantage seven minutes in.

Hartford used the perimeter and running into the paint to go on a 14-0 run, started by threes from John Carroll and J.R. Lynch, to take a 26-16 lead with 8:26 left in the 1st.

UAlbany started to fire away from three, chipping away with long range makes by Nichols and Cremo. With 6:37 to play in the 1st, Nichols hit another three to pull UAlbany within five, down 29-24.

Hartford rebuilt the lead to 12 after Travis Weatherington hit a corner three with 1:50 left in the 1st. UAlbany got to within single digits in the final minute, but a John Carroll jumper gave Hartford a 41-31 advantage at the break.

Hartford's strong shooting continued into the second half, beginning the period on an 11-4 run, fueled five points from Weatherington, to lead 52-35 by the half's first media.

UAlbany's defense held Hartford without points for over two-and-a-half minutes, adding a Greig Stire tip-in to start chipping away. The Hawks continued to score long range, pushing the lead to 20 with 11:44 left at 59-39 Hartford.

Attacking with the fast break, UAlbany looked to come back. UAlbany looked to its guards for jumpers and perimeter shooting against the Hartford zone. Cremo got the comeback going with a three, then Devonte Campbell added free throws. Going to the paint in the next couple of possessions, UAlbany chipped away to 10 with 7:12 left at 59-49.

Spurred on by the crowd, UAlbany continued to rally, adding threes from Cremo and Nichols to pull to six. The defense continued to hold off Hartford as Cremo hit a floater, then four consecutive free throws, completing a 22-2 run and tying the game at 61-61 with two minutes to play.

Hartford got fouled with 1:49 left, with Carroll hitting three straight free throws. Jason Dunne added two more, then after another change of possession, Lynch put two in. Nichols hit a three to bring UAlbany back within four, but that is as close as the Great Danes came. Four more free throws helped seal the game for Hartford 72-64.

Second Half Surge Sends UAlbany MBB to a 69-55 Road Victory over UNH

DURHAM, N.H. - Fueled by a combined 39 points and eight steals from Joe Cremo and David Nichols, the UAlbany men's basketball team ended the game on a 24-10 streak to grab a 69-55 victory at New Hampshire on Monday night.

With the score tied at 45-45 with 11:32 to play, UAlbany held UNH without points for five minutes, going on a 10-0 run in that span. UAlbany did not trail by less than seven the rest of the way to pick up the win.

"This was a good win for us; I have great respect for the UNH program with some great games over the years," said head coach Will Brown. "We got off to a slow start, but after the first six-seven minutes we had a nice half, and then the second half, except for a four-minute lull, we showed some maturity and poise."

Nichols had UAlbany-highs with seven rebounds, five assists and four steals, adding 16 points. Cremo had a game-best 21 points, including going 4-for-5 from three, plus had four steals and four assists.

For the Wildcats, Iba Camara got a double-double off 12 points and 14 rebounds. Daniel Dion led the team in scoring with 18 points, adding three assists.

Each side had strong defense to begin, with UAlbany

having trouble getting inside and UNH being stopped on mid-range jumpers. Off a quick layup and high floater off the back of the rim for Taylor Lessner, UNH took an early 9-4 lead five minutes in.

After Nichols hit a jumper to pull UAlbany within three, UNH scored the next six to establish a nine-point advantage. Charles hit a 15-footer, then a turnaround jumper just outside the paint, to make it 15-10 UNH at the under-11 mark in the 1st.

Charles hit another jumper to start a UAlbany run. As the UAlbany defense held the other way, Dallas Ennema started to fire away, hitting a three and a long jumper just inside the arc to complete the 7-0 run and make it a 17-17 tie game with under seven in the 1st.

UAlbany's run continued as the Great Danes held UNH without a basket for almost five minutes. UAlbany found some success from three, with Nichols and Cremo hitting from behind the arc, as the Great Danes continued the run to 19-5 with a 27-20 lead in the final three minutes of the half. A final exchange of baskets gave UAlbany a 29-22 lead at the break.

Brown's team came out of the locker room and attacked the paint. This led to UAlbany starting the half on a 7-3 run, capped by a steal and score then a rebound and score from Nichols, for a 36-25 lead two minutes in. UAlbany escaped the UNH press and added a pair of threes to make it 42-30 with 15:54 left in the 2nd.

UNH started to run more with the press, leading to an 11-2 sprint. Cremo got a free throw to put UAlbany's lead back to two possessions at 45-41 with 12:19 left to play. UNH tied it up with a free throw and a kick-out three to make it 45-45.

After a Charles jumper, UAlbany twice stole a UNH possession and bolted down the floor for two points. The defense continued to hold UNH to the perimeter, with a Cremo corner three and a Campbell free throw completing a 10-run over a span of five minutes, putting the Great Danes up 55-45.

Breaking the UNH press, UAlbany had answers for Wildcat baskets; following a Leissner layup underneath, Cremo hit another three-pointer from the corner to send UAlbany up 64-54 with 3:45 left to play.

UAlbany played strong defense and used the shot clock the rest of the way. After Nichols rebounded a Jaleen Smith missed shot, UAlbany took a minute off the clock with an offensive rebound. Cremo finished the possession with a layup with 1:34 to go.

The UAlbany defense allowed one point in the final 4:10 of the game, taking the victory 69-55.

Coach Will Brown
17th Year at UAlbany
2014-15 America East Coach of the Year



Will Brown enters this year in his 17th season overall as the University at Albany's men's basketball head coach, after spending one season in an interim capacity. Brown, the longest tenured coach in the America East Conference, has led the program to five conference championships, five NCAA Tournament appearances, two CollegelInsider.com Postseason Tournament appearances, CBI Postseason appearance and an unparalleled success in the classroom.

UAlbany earned its third straight 20+ win season in 2016-17, making its sixth consecutive postseason with a bid in the CollegelInsider.com Tournament. Finishing third in the America East, UAlbany defeated Stony Brook on the road to pick up a berth in the America East title game, eventually finishing the year at 21-14 including the program's first-ever victory over a Big Ten team with an 87-81 win at Penn State. UAlbany led the America East in free throw percentage, rebounding margin and offensive rebounding with a team that saw three new starters in every lineup from the year before.

Brown earned his 250th career victory at UAlbany with a 84-65 win vs. Binghamton on Jan. 19, 2017.

David Nichols earned America East All-Conference First Team, setting a program record with 248 field goals made and finishing in the top-5 with 17.9 points per game. Joe Cremo earned a place on the All-Conference Second Team with he, Nichols and Mike Rowley all being honored on the America East All-Academic Team. Rowley also earned the America East Elite 17 Award for having the highest GPA among players of junior standing or higher in the America East title game. Devonte Campbell picked up an America East All-Defensive Team nod.

He was also named the top value coach among Division I head coaches in 2013-14 by HoopDirt.com.

Brown was appointed as UAlbany's head coach on March 13, 2002, and has worked on the collegiate level since 1995. He became the 15th head coach in the history of the program.

Brown previously served as the head coach at Sullivan County Community College in Loch Sheldrake, N.Y., from 1998-2001. He led the Generals to a 90-10 record over a three-year period with two regional and two district titles.

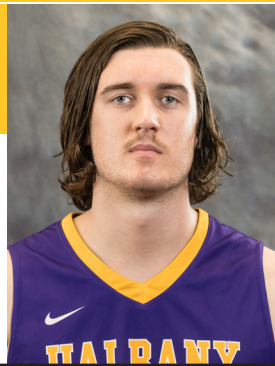
