TODAY'S MATCHUP

UAlbany

- Will be facing its first of three consecutive STATS Top 25 opponents. In fact, four of the Great Danes' final five games are against ranked teams. After No. 13 Towson, UAlbany will play No. 16 Maine and No. 24 Delaware. UAlbany also hosts No. 18 Stony Brook in the regular-season finale.
- Is playing Towson for the first time since 2013, the Great Danes' first year in the CAA. The Tigers, then ranked No. 7 in the country, won 44-17 at Casey Stadium. Prior to that, the teams had not met since 1978.
- Has had a wide receiver post 100 yards six times this season. Juwan Green was the latest, racking up 130 yards and a touchdown this past weekend against Richmond.
- Has seen each of its past four games decided by a touchdown or less. The Great Danes are 2-2 in those games.

Towson

- Is led by starting quarterback Tom Flacco, the younger brother of Baltimore Ravens quarterback Joe Flacco. He has completed 68.5 percent of his passes while throwing for 1,670 yards and 15 touchdowns against five interceptions.
- Has been ranked in the STATS Poll for four consecutive weeks. This week's No. 13 ranking marks the Tigers' highest ranking of the season.
- Carries a four-game win streak into Saturday's game. The Tigers' only loss this season was a 51-20 setback at Wake Forest on Sept. 8.
- Is playing its first road game since Sept. 15. The Tigers had played three straight home games following a bye.

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) and football, a Division I Football Championship Subdivision program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the America East's top performing athletics department, for six consecutive years and seven times overall.

UAlbany has won 107 conference championships and has made 52 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past eight years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. Entering the 2018-19 school year, UAlbany has 99 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2017-2018, UAlbany earned seven conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances. Men's lacrosse, ranked No. 1 nationally for six weeks during the regular season, reached the Final Four, and men's soccer advanced to the NCAA Tournament's second round. Softball, men's and women's outdoor track, women's indoor track and golf also won league titles. In the classroom, 11 teams carried a GPA of 3.2 or higher.

In its Division I history, UAlbany has had 18 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine players drafted by Major League Baseball and 14 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions and Great Danes.

Schedule strength

- The Great Danes will face Top 25 opponents in four of their final five games, including in each of the next three, beginning with No. 13 Towson. No. 16 Maine and No. 24 Delaware follow, and UAlbany hosts No. 18 Stony Brook in the regular-season finale.
- UAlbany was 2-3 against ranked opponents in 2017.

- In its first two games of the season, UAlbany faced Pittsburgh, a "Power 5" school from the Atlantic Coast Conference, and Rhode Island, which is 2-0 in the CAA, 4-1 overall and ranked No. 22 in this week's STATS poll.

Injury bug

- The Great Danes lost several starters and key players to injury before the season: S **Mason Gray** (lower body), WR **Austin Ellis** (lower body), TE **Murad Hussain** (lower body) and S **Damon Burton** (lower body) are all out for the season.
- Starting safety **Josh Wynn** (lower body) also has missed the past five games.
- The Great Danes' secondary has been especially affected by injuries. Gray and Wynn were the projected starters at safety.
- Tyler Carswell** has started in Gray's place, but he left the William & Mary game early in the first quarter with an injury and missed the Richmond game. Cornerback **Kareem Brown** moved to safety against Richmond.
- Reserve safety **Hayden Specht**, who had started in place of Wynn, also missed the past two games due to injury. AJ Mistler has started in his place.

ALBANY, N.Y. -- Richmond kicker Griffin Trau booted a 25-yard field goal in the final seconds, and for the third straight year, the University at Albany football team fell just short against the Spiders, losing 27-24.

After playing to multiple overtimes in each of the past two meetings, the teams traded the lead four times Saturday in another back-and-forth game.

Elijah Ibitokun-Hanks, Dev Holmes and Juwan Green all scored touchdowns and Ethan Stark kicked a 27-yard field for the Great Danes during their annual "Pink Game" in support of the American Cancer Society. UAlbany student-athletes wore the names of men and women affected by cancer on the backs of their uniforms in front of 4,085 fans at Casey Stadium.

Green, in a breakout game, caught seven passes for 130 yards, including a spectacular 54-yard touchdown catch on a pass thrown by Holmes that tied the game at 7 in the first quarter. On the play, Vincent Testaverde threw a swing pass to Holmes, who then heaved down the sideline for a wide-open Green.

Holmes then gave the Great Danes the lead, 14-7, in the second quarter when he caught a 13-yard touchdown from Testaverde.

But Richmond went to halftime ahead, 17-14, after quarterback Joe Mancuso scored on a 28-yard scramble and Trau kicked his first of two field goals.

In the second half, the teams traded third-quarter touchdowns, with Ibitokun-Hanks bouncing off several tacklers on his way to a 13-yard TD, and Richmond answering when it recovered a fumble in the end zone, a play that put the Spiders ahead, 24-21.

Stark tied the game at 24 with 4:02 to go, but on the ensuing possession, Richmond drove 57 yards on 11 plays to set up the game-winning kick.

Levi Metheny led the Great Danes' defense with 14 tackles, including 10 solo. Dante Mount finished with 13 (eight solo) and came up with two turnovers, intercepting a pass in the end zone and recovering a fumble.

Series history

- UAlbany and Towson have met once while the Great Danes have been a member of the CAA. That came Oct. 19, 2013, when the No. 7 Tigers won, 44-17, at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium.

Welcome Holmes

- Freshman **Dev Holmes** is the Great Danes' leading receiver this season, having caught 32 passes for 605 yards, with five touchdowns. He's averaging 100.8 yards per game, the most in the CAA.
- Against Richmond, Holmes also threw a 54-yard touchdown pass to **Juwan Green** for his first collegiate passing touchdown. On the play, Holmes took a swing pass from **Vincent Testaverde**, then threw a long ball down the right sideline to Green, who was wide open.
- Holmes has three 100-yard receiving games this season. His 605 yards already are more receiving yards than any UAlbany player has had in an entire season since 2014.
- Holmes won his third CAA Rookie of the Week Award on Sept. 24 after catching seven passes for 128 yards and two touchdowns against St. Francis (Pa.). His 24-yard touchdown catch with 7:50 left in the fourth quarter was the deciding score. It marked the second straight week Holmes caught the winning TD.

- A week earlier, against Morgan State, Holmes caught eight passes for 238 yards, including an 88-yard touchdown. He fell just 13 yards shy of UAlbany's single-game receiving yardage record, set by Chris Phillis against Robert Morris on Nov. 11, 2000.
- Holmes had a spectacular debut at Pittsburgh, catching nine passes for 148 yards and a TD to earn CAA Rookie of the Week honors.
- Holmes was part of back-to-back state championship teams while playing at Troy High, located just 20 minutes from Albany.

Century mark for Reeves

- Junior wide receiver **Jerah Reeves** had the first two 100-yard performances of his career in back-to-back games against St. Francis (Pa.) and William & Mary.
- Against William & Mary, Reeves caught six passes for 111 yards, including a 40-yard reception.
- A week earlier against St. Francis (Pa.), Reeves hauled in six passes for 104 yards, including a 65-yard touchdown.
- Reeves, from Williamsport, Pa., is the Great Danes' second-leading receiver with 28 catches for 435 yards and two touchdowns. He's averaging 72.5 yards receiving per game.

Green breaks out

- Junior receiver **Juwan Green**, a transfer from Lackawanna Community College, had a breakout game against Richmond, catching seven passes for 130 yards and a touchdown.
- Green became eligible after the second game of the season and made his debut against Morgan State.

Dynamic duo

- Redshirt junior **Elijah Ibitokun-Hanks** and sophomore **Karl Mofor** give the Great Danes a formidable one-two punch in the backfield. Through the first five games, both backs are averaging more than five yards per carry – Mofor at 5.9 and Ibitokun-Hanks at 5.6.
- Ibitokun-Hanks leads UAlbany with 548 yards and three touchdowns, while Mofor has 272 and a pair of TDs.
- Both Mofor and Ibitokun-Hanks nearly eclipsed 100 yards against St. Francis (Pa.). Each finished with 92. Ibitokun-Hanks scored his first TD of the season, and Mofor's total was boosted by a 74-yard run.
- While Ibitokun-Hanks was injured last season, Mofor filled in and was the Great Danes' leading rusher with 555 yards.
- Ibitokun-Hanks was a STATS FCS Third-Team All-American and member of the All-CAA First Team in 2016 after rushing for 1,401 yards and 16 touchdowns. But he suffered a knee injury in the season finale.
- Ibitokun-Hanks also had led the team in rushing in 2015 as a true freshman, when he ran for 609 yards and two touchdowns.

Like father, like son

- The son of longtime NFL quarterback and Heisman Trophy winner Vinny Testaverde, redshirt senior quarterback **Vincent Testaverde** is averaging 243.2 passing yards per game, second-most in the CAA. He's thrown for 1,459 yards, also second most in the league, and eight touchdowns.
- Testaverde threw for 300 yards in back-to-back games in Weeks 3 and 4, totaling 310 against Morgan State and 331 against St. Francis (Pa.). The latter tied for the sixth-highest single-game total in program history.
- In the season-opener at Pitt, Testaverde was seeing game action for the first time since 2014, when as a true freshman at Texas Tech he came off the bench to complete 15-of-26 passes for 116 yards against Texas.
- Testaverde left Texas Tech after his freshman year to transfer to Miami (Fla.), the

alma mater of his father. The younger Testaverde spent two years at Miami before transferring to UAlbany.

- This season Testaverde will wear No. 14 as a nod to his father. He had worn No. 17 when he first arrived at UAlbany as a mid-year transfer.
- Testaverde emerged as the starter toward the end of training camp after winning a three-way battle with redshirt junior Will Brunson, last year's starter, and Nyc Burns, a redshirt sophomore and junior-college transfer from Northeast Oklahoma A&M.

Getting offensive

- UAlbany has posted at least 300 yards of offense in every game this season, highlighted by a 503-yard performance against St. Francis (Pa.).
- The Great Danes are averaging 383.0 yards per game.
- The offense is led by first-year coordinator **Joe Davis**, who joined UAlbany from Fordham, where he had held the same position. Davis also is UAlbany's quarter-backs coach.

No. 1

- Redshirt sophomore tight end **LJ Wesneski** caught his first career touchdown pass against Morgan State, bringing in a 15-yard pass from Vincent Testaverde in the first quarter.
- Wesneski has caught four passes for 60 yards this season after stepping in for Murad Hussain, who was injured during training camp, as the starting tight end.
- The Plymouth, Pa., native had two catches for 15 yards last season as a reserve.

Defense notes

Metheny in the middle

- Redshirt sophomore linebacker **Levi Metheny**, a first-year starter, leads the Great Danes with 55 tackles (31 solo).
- Metheny also recorded his first career interception at William & Mary.
- Metheny totaled 23 tackles last season while playing mostly special teams and serving as a reserve at linebacker. This season, he's replacing Nate Hatalsky, who had 122 tackles last season, tying for the 12th most in program history.
- The Great Danes have a youthful linebacking corps: Redshirt freshman **Danny Damico** has started the past four games at outside linebacker, Metheny has started all five games in the middle, and **Isaiah Watson** has seen significant playing time (including one start) at the other outside position.
- Damico is second on the team with 50 tackles (20 solo).

Sack attack

- The Great Danes are tied for seventh in the CAA with 12 sacks on the season. That total was boosted by a four-sack game against William & Mary.
- Redshirt freshman defensive end **Anthony Lang** leads the Great Danes with 3.0 sacks, and redshirt senior interior lineman **Antoine White** has 2.5.
- The 6-foot-1, 294-pound White transferred from Penn State prior to his redshirt junior season.
- Lang has been an impact player as part of the defensive line rotation. He also leads the team with three QB hurries and has a forced fumble.

Mount makes his mark

- Reserve defensive back **Dante Mount**, a junior transfer from Erie Community College, had an eventful game against Richmond, intercepting a pass in the end zone and recovering a fumble.
- Mount has 25 tackles (16 solo) while having worked at both corner and safety.

Playmaker

- **Eli Mencer** has continued his propensity for making make big plays on defense. For the season, he has 5.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks and a recovered fumble.
- Mencer led UAlbany in forced fumbles with five in 2017 and was tied for second on the team with eight tackles for loss. He returned a fumble 69 yards for a TD against Rhode Island and another for 80 yards to finish off an overtime victory over Villanova.
- A standout running back in high school, Mencer changed positions before his redshirt season in 2015. He rushed 1,280 yards and 23 touchdowns as a senior.

QB/P/LB

- **Neven Sussman** got his first career interception at Pittsburgh in his first career start at outside linebacker. He has 21 tackles this season (nine solo).
- Last season, Sussman served as both the backup quarterback and punter. In his first season punting, he averaged 37.3 yards per kick, with a long of 59 yards. At quarterback, he completed 12-of-26 passes for 163 yards with one interception; he also carried the ball 43 times for 132 yards.
- Sussman had started 13 career games at quarterback, including nine as a sophomore in 2016, when he threw for 1,017 yards and seven touchdowns.

Special Teams Notes

Stark on the mark

- Senior placekicker **Ethan Stark** has made nine of his 10 field-goal attempts.
- His 51-yard field goal against Morgan State was the third longest in program history and just two yards shy of UAlbany's all-time record.
- Stark also has made 12 of his 13 extra-point tries.
- Serving as UAlbany's primary punter for the first time this season, Stark is averaging 35.4 yards per kick, with a long of 45. He's also placed seven punts inside the 20-yard line.

On the return

- Junior wide receiver **Donovan McDonald's** 67-yard punt return for a touchdown against Morgan State was the Great Danes' first since Nov. 13, 2010, when Ryan Kirchner took one back 80 yards against Wagner.
- McDonald has returned six punts for an average of 11.2 yards.
- McDonald was named to the CAA Preseason All-Conference Team as a punt returner.
- McDonald ranked third in the league last season with an average of 10.1 yards per punt return.
- He also led the Great Danes with 1,015 all-purpose yards and became UAlbany's second-leading receiver with 29 catches for 339 yards and three touchdowns.
- McDonald joined the Great Danes prior to the 2017 season as a transfer from Nebraska, where he was a member of both the football and track programs.
- McDonald was a walk-on when he came to the program, but he earned a full scholarship after Week 3 of the 2017 season.

UAlbany and the NFL

- The Great Danes have seen 14 players sign NFL contracts. This year two former UAlbany players appeared in NFL training camps: Anthony Manzo-Lewis (Chargers) and Brian Parker (Broncos).
- UAlbany also has several NFL connections on its coaching staff:
 - Offensive line coach **Jim Sweeney** was second round pick in the 1984 draft. He was named to the All-NFL Rookie Team after his first season with the New

- Stire was a two-year starter at power forward. He led the team with 6.0 rebounds per game as a senior and also averaged 7.1 points while shooting 56.3 percent.
- Stire began working with the football team during Spring Practice. He's expected to provide depth at tight end.

Welcome back Will and Michael

- UAlbany alums **Michael Nicastro** (defensive assistant) and **Will Fiacchi** (wide receivers coach and recruiting coordinator) both are on the coaching staff this season.

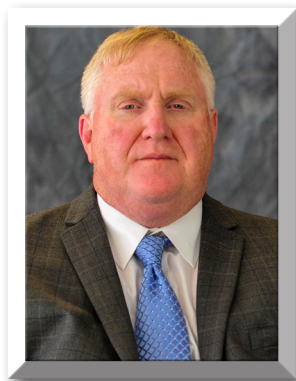

HEAD COACH GREG GATTUSO



Greg Gattuso enters his fifth season at the helm of the UAlbany football program in 2018. A former standout defensive lineman at Penn State who's worked at Duquesne, Pittsburgh and Maryland, Gattuso has helped the Great Danes steadily rise in the Colonial Athletic Association, one of the top Football Championship Subdivision conferences in the nation.

In 2017, he led the Great Danes to their first win over a Top 10 program -- a 19-10 overtime victory over No. 7 Villanova at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. UAlbany also shut out New Hampshire, an FCS playoff qualifier, 15-0 in the season finale. It was one of several superlative efforts from a defense that finished the season ranked No. 9 nationally. The Great Danes were 4-7 overall and 2-6 in the CAA against a rigorous schedule that featured games against an FBS opponent (Old Dominion) and five matchups with Top 25 teams.

Under Gattuso's leadership, UAlbany had its best season as a CAA member in 2016, finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in the league. The Great Danes were ranked for five weeks, including as high as No. 16. UAlbany also earned its first victory over an FBS opponent with a 22-16 road win over Buffalo.

Hallmarks of Gattuso's teams have included discipline and taking care of the football. In 2016, the Great Danes were second in the CAA with a plus-16 turnover margin.

In his first season, in 2014, Gattuso led the Great Danes to a six-win turnaround from the previous year. The Great Danes picked up votes in the national polls for 10 straight weeks and appeared in The Sports Network Top 25 four times on their way to a 7-5 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark.

A year later, the Danes earned CAA victories over Rhode Island and perennial power Delaware.

Gattuso was a defensive lineman at Penn State, where he helped lead the Nittany Lions to a national title in 1982.

In his first collegiate head-coaching role, Gattuso piloted Duquesne to a 97-32 record during his 12-season tenure, and while making three bowl appearances at Pittsburgh, he turned the defensive line into one of the best in the nation as an assistant head coach.

Gattuso came to UAlbany after spending three seasons as a member Randy Edsall's staff at Maryland. There, he led the defensive line that ranked among the top in the ACC and was promoted to the position of assistant head coach in February 2012.

From 1989-1991, he served as head coach at his high school alma mater, Seton-LaSalle. Taking over a team that went 6-34 during the four seasons prior to his arrival, Gattuso led the Rebels to a 28-10-1 mark (.731), including three WPIAL playoff berths, a WPIAL championship and Parkway Conference title.

During his playing career, Gattuso was named the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's Class AA Player of the Year his senior season at Seton-LaSalle.

Gattuso and his wife Colleen have two daughters, Jacqueline and Kaitlin.
