TODAY'S MATCHUP

UAlbany

- Will be facing a Top 10 opponent for the time since last season, when the Great Danes defeated No. 7 Villanova, 19-10, in overtime at Casey Stadium for the first top 10 victory in program history. UAlbany also will be facing a ranked team for the fourth time in five weeks.
- Will be honoring its senior class in a pregame ceremony.
- Leads the all-time series with Stony Brook, 11-8, though the Seawolves won the 2017 matchup, 28-21, in overtime on Long Island.
- Has limited its opponent to less than 300 yards of offense in each of the past two games. The Great Danes held New Hampshire to just 70 yards of passing offense this past weekend.

Stony Brook

- Moved up to No. 10 in the rankings, its highest spot this season, after beating then-No. 11 Delaware, 17-3, this past Saturday.
- Is coached by Chuck Priore, who played four seasons at UAlbany under coach Bob Ford, starting at fullback for three seasons and serving as the team captain as a senior in 1982. Priore then spent three seasons at his alma mater as the running backs coach from 1983 to 1986.
- Has the league's second-ranked scoring defense, allowing just 19.1 yards per game.

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) and football, a Division I Football Championship Subdivision program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the America East's top performing athletics department, for six consecutive years and seven times overall.

UAlbany has won 107 conference championships and has made 52 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past eight years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. Entering the 2018-19 school year, UAlbany has 99 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2017-2018, UAlbany earned seven conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances. Men's lacrosse, ranked No. 1 nationally for six weeks during the regular season, reached the Final Four, and men's soccer advanced to the NCAA Tournament's second round. Softball, men's and women's outdoor track, women's indoor track and golf also won league titles. In the classroom, 11 teams carried a GPA of 3.2 or higher.

In its Division I history, UAlbany has had 18 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine players drafted by Major League Baseball and 14 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions and Great Danes.

Senior sendoff

UAlbany will be honoring 16 seniors before Saturday's game.

- Neven Sussman: Has played in 41 career games and worked at quarterback, linebacker, punter and on special teams during his career. At QB, he threw for 1,618 yards with eight touchdowns.
- **Vincent Testaverde:** Spent just this past season with the Great Danes as a redshirt senior. Threw for 1,714 yards and 11 TDs in eight starts.
- **Kareem Brown:** Played in 32 career games in three seasons at UAlbany. Has been a starter in the secondary every game in 2017 and 2018.
- Greig Stire: Four-year basketball player who joined the football team this season, working as a reserve tight end.
- Ethan Stark: Has made 12 of 13 field goals this season, including a career-long 51 yarder against Morgan State. Made 36 of 51 field goals for his career.
- **Sam Davis:** Reserve offensive lineman from nearby Johnstown, N.Y., has contributed on special teams.
- Luke Ritter: Two-year starter on the offensive line.
- Lukas Repetti: Has appeared in 38 career games at tight end and caught four passes for 35 yards.
- Brian Dolce: Three-year starter on the defensive line has 118 career tackles and 8.0 career sacks.
- Jack Dudzinski: Appeared in 21 career games on the offensive line. Son of defensive coordinator Keith Dudzinski.
- Nick Dillon: Mainstay on the defensive line in three seasons with the program
 after transferring from Eastern Michigan. Has 20 tackles (10 solo), 3.0 tackles for
 loss and 1.5 sacks.
- Antoine White: Has played in 21 games on the defensive line for UAlbany after transferring from Penn State. Has 35 tackles and 3.5 sacks this season.

NEW HAMPSHIRE 24, UALBANY 10 Nov. 10, 2018 Wildcat Stadium

DURHAM, N.H. — Karl Mofor opened the fourth quarter with a 28-yard touchdown catch and Ethan Stark kicked a 49-yard field goal, but the University at Albany football team lost to New Hampshire, 24-10, on Saturday in a CAA game in Durham, N.H.

New Hampshire, which was coming off last week's upset win over No. 3-ranked James Madison, scored on a 93-yard touchdown run and an interception returned for a touchdown in the second half to emerge with the victory.

With UAlbany trailing 17-3, Undercuffler and Mofor connected for their TD on the first play of the fourth quarter. On a first and 10 from the UNH 28-yard line, Undercuffler found Mofor open over the middle. The sophomore then churned through a few tacklers on his way to the end zone for his fourth TD of the season, cutting the Wildcats' lead to 17-10.

But New Hampshire took back a two-touchdown lead seven minutes later, when Evan Horn intercepted a pass in the end zone.

In the first half, Stark opened the scoring with 9:39 left in the first quarter when he connected on a 49-yard field goal that hit the crossbar and bounced through. It was the fifth-longest field goal in program history and the second longest of the season for Stark, who had a 51-yarder against Morgan State on Sept. 15.

New Hampshire answered about six minutes later on Trevor Knight's 1-yard run, and the Wildcats added a field goal with 16 seconds left before halftime to take a 10-3 lead to the intermission.

Carlos Washington's 93-yard touchdown run with 3:11 left in the third extended the lead to 17-3.

- Paul Casanzio: Has played in 27 career games as a long-snapper.
- Tadriek Johnson: Has played in six games this season on special teams, registering a tackle.
- Will Brunson: Has played in 20 games at quarterback, throwing for 2,334 yards and 10 touchdowns. Threw for 1,889 and nine TDs as UAlbany's starting QB in 2017
- Isiah Clark: Has provided depth at wide receiver in four seasons with the program.

Schedule strength

- UAlbany is playing one of the toughest schedules in the nation down the stretch.
 This will be the fourth time in five games the Great Danes have faced a Top 25 opponent.
- UAlbany's most recent win over a ranked team was in the 2017 season finale, when the Great Danes defeated No. 16 New Hampshire, 15-0, at Casey Stadium.
- This marks the first time the Great Danes are playing a top 10 team since Sept. 23, 2017, when they beat No. 7 Villanova, 19-10, in overtime at Casey Stadium. That was the program's first top 10 victory.

A familiar foe

- UAlbany and Stony Brook have met 19 times, with the Great Danes leading the all-time series 11-8.
- The teams faced each other as members of the Northeast Conference until 2007, when Stony Brook left the league to become an independent for one year before joining the Big South in 2008. Both programs joined the CAA in 2013.
- UAlbany lost to Stony Brook, 31-28, on Nov. 26, 2011, in the Great Danes' only FCS playoff appearance.

So close

- The Great Danes have lost three games by a touchdown or less all three in the final minute of the fourth quarter
 - Oct. 6 at William & Mary: Lost 25-22 on a touchdown with 50 seconds to go.
 - Oct. 13 vs. Richmond: Lost 27-24 on a FG with six seconds left.
 - Nov. 4 vs. Delaware: Lost 21-16 on a TD with 18 seconds remaining.
- UAlbany lost four games by a touchdown or less in 2017.

Injury bug

- The Great Danes lost several starters and key players to injury before the season: S Mason Gray (lower body), WR Austin Ellis (lower body), TE Murad Hussain (lower body) and S **Damon Burton** (lower body) were injured during training camp.
- During the season, the Great Danes lost LB Isaiah Watson (lower body) and DL Nick Griffin (upper body) to season-ending injuries.
- True freshman **Jeff Undercuffler** has started at quarterback each of the past two weeks after both starter Vincent Testaverde (lower body) and backup Will Brunson (upper body) were injured at Maine.

Offense notes

Undercuffler debuts

- Freshman quarterback Jeff Undercuffler made his second career start and third collegiate appearance against New Hampshire. He threw for 167 yards with a touchdown and an interception.
- Undercuffler had made his first start against Delaware. Facing the No. 13 team in the country on a day with sustained winds of 25 miles per hour, he completed 15of-28 passes for 171 yards with two interceptions.
- Undercuffler made his collegiate debut against Maine. After starter Vincent Testaverde and backup Will Brunson left the game with injuries, Undercuffler took over in the fourth quarter on a windy, snowy afternoon in Orono, Maine. On his first official pass attempt, Undercuffler found **Jerah Reeves** over the middle in the end zone for a 14-yard touchdown pass. Undercuffler finished the game 2-for-6 for 18 yards.

Dynamic duo

- Redshirt junior Elijah Ibitokun-Hanks and sophomore Karl Mofor combined for 76 yards on 19 carries against New Hampshire. Mofor also caught a 28-yard touchdown pass on the first play of the fourth quarter for his fifth TD of the season.
- Ibitokun-Hanks is averaging 4.9 yards per carry, and Mofor is at 5.7. Ibitokun-Hanks leads UAlbany with 716 yards to go with four TDs, while Mofor has 496 yards.
- Against Maine, the No. 1 rushing defense in the CAA, Mofor still managed 68 yards on 12 carries — an average of 5.7 yards per carry.
- Both Mofor and Ibitokun-Hanks nearly eclipsed 100 yards against St. Francis (Pa.). Each finished with 92. Ibitokun-Hanks scored his first TD of the season, and Mofor's total was boosted by a 74-yard run.
- While Ibitokun-Hanks was injured last season, Mofor filled in and was the Great Danes' leading rusher with 555 yards.
- Ibitokun-Hanks was a STATS FCS Third-Team All-American and member of the All-CAA First Team in 2016 after rushing for 1,401 yards and 16 touchdowns. But he suffered a knee injury in the season finale.
- Ibitokun-Hanks also had led the team in rushing in 2015 as a true freshman, when he ran for 609 yards and two touchdowns.

Green breaks out

- Junior receiver Juwan Green, a transfer from Lackawanna Community College, posted 100-yard performances in back-to-back games against Richmond and Towson.
- Green had a breakout game against Richmond, catching seven passes for 130 yards and a touchdown.
- He followed that with a 135-yard outing against Towson in which he caught touchdown passes of 50 and 60 yards from Vincent Testaverde.
- Green became eligible after the second game of the season and made his debut against Morgan State.

Welcome Holmes

- Freshman Dev Holmes is the Great Danes' leading receiver this season, having caught 48 passes for 729 yards, with five touchdowns. He's averaging 72.9 yards per game, the fourth most in the CAA.
- Against Richmond, Holmes also threw a 54-yard touchdown pass to Juwan Green for his first collegiate passing touchdown. On the play, Holmes took a swing pass from Vincent Testaverde, then threw a long ball down the right sideline to Green, who was wide open.
- Holmes won his third CAA Rookie of the Week Award on Sept. 24 after catching seven passes for 128 yards and two touchdowns against St. Francis (Pa.). His 24yard touchdown catch with 7:50 left in the fourth quarter was the deciding score. It marked the second straight week Holmes caught the winning TD.
- A week earlier, against Morgan State, Holmes caught eight passes for 238 yards, including an 88-yard touchdown. He fell just 13 yards shy of UAlbany's single-game receiving yardage record, set by Chris Phillis against Robert Morris on Nov. 11, 2000.
- Holmes had a spectacular debut at Pittsburgh, catching nine passes for 148 yards and a TD to earn CAA Rookie of the Week honors.
- Holmes was part of back-to-back state championship teams while playing at Troy High, located just 20 minutes from Albany.

Century mark for Reeves

- Junior wide receiver Jerah Reeves had the first two 100-yard performances of his career in back-to-back games against St. Francis (Pa.) and William & Mary.
- Against William & Mary, Reeves caught six passes for 111 yards, including a 40yard reception.
- A week earlier against St. Francis (Pa.), Reeves hauled in six passes for 104 yards, including a 65-yard touchdown.
- Reeves also threw his first collegiate pass against Towson. He took a reverse from Elijah Ibitokun-Hanks, rolled left and then hit Juwan Green for a 22-yard completion to the 1-yard line that set up a Vincent Testaverde TD run.
- Reeves, from Williamsport, Pa., is the Great Danes' second-leading receiver with 36 catches for 581 yards and two touchdowns. He's averaging 64.6 yards receiving per game.

Like father, like son

- The son of longtime NFL quarterback and Heisman Trophy winner Vinny
 Testaverde, redshirt senior quarterback Vincent Testaverde is averaging 214.2
 passing yards per game, third-most in the CAA. He's thrown for 1,714 yards,
 second most in the league, and 11 touchdowns.
- Testaverde left the game at Maine with a lower-body injury and didn't dress for this past week's game against Delaware.
- Testaverde threw for 300 yards in back-to-back games in Weeks 3 and 4, totaling 310 against Morgan State and 331 against St. Francis (Pa.). The latter tied for the

- In the season-opener at Pitt, Testaverde was seeing game action for the first time since 2014, when as a true freshman at Texas Tech he came off the bench to complete 15-of-26 passes for 116 yards against Texas.
- Testaverde left Texas Tech after his freshman year to transfer to Miami (Fla.), the alma mater of his father. The younger Testaverde spent two years at Miami before transferring to UAlbany.
- This season Testaverde is wearing No. 14 as a nod to his father. He had worn No.
 17 when he first arrived at UAlbany as a mid-year transfer.
- Testaverde emerged as the starter toward the end of training camp after winning a three-way battle with redshirt junior Will Brunson, last year's starter, and Nyc Burns, a redshirt sophomore and junior-college transfer from Northeast Oklahoma A&M.

No. 1

- Redshirt sophomore tight end LJ Wesneski caught his first career touchdown pass against Morgan State, bringing in a 15-yard pass from Vincent Testaverde in the first quarter.
- Wesneski has caught six passes for 95 yards this season after stepping in for Murad Hussain, who was injured during training camp, as the starting tight end.
- The Plymouth, Pa., native had two catches for 15 yards last season as a reserve.

Defense notes

Metheny in the middle

- Redshirt sophomore linebacker **Levi Metheny**, a first-year starter, leads the Great Danes with 87 tackles (44 solo).
- Metheny also has intercepted two passes: at Maine and William & Mary.
- Metheny totaled 23 tackles last season while playing mostly special teams and serving as a reserve at linebacker.

Sack attack

- The Great Danes have 20 sacks on the season. That total was boosted by a season-high four-sack game against William & Mary.
- Linebacker Eli Mencer leads the team with 4.5 sacks. Redshirt freshman Anthony Lang has 4.0, while redshirt senior Antoine White has 3.5.
- The 6-foot-1, 294-pound White transferred from Penn State prior to his redshirt junior season.
- Lang has been an impact player as part of the defensive line rotation. He also leads the team with six QB hurries and has a forced fumble.

Playmaker

- **Eli Mencer** has continued his propensity for making make big plays on defense. For the season, he has 7.5 tackles for loss, 4.5 sacks and a recovered fumble.
- Mencer led UAlbany in forced fumbles with five in 2017 and was tied for second on the team with eight tackles for loss. He returned a fumble 69 yards for a TD against Rhode Island and another for 80 yards to finish off an overtime victory over Villanova.
- A standout running back in high school, Mencer changed positions before his redshirt season in 2015. He rushed 1,280 yards and 23 touchdowns as a senior.

QB/P/LB

- Neven Sussman got his first career interception at Pittsburgh in his first career start at outside linebacker. He has 34 tackles this season (12 solo) while being used mostly as a reserve at linebacker and extensively on special teams.
- Last season, Sussman served as both the backup quarterback and punter. In his

Special Teams Notes

Stark on the mark

SIC)

- Senior placekicker Ethan Stark has made 12 of his 13 field-goal attempts.
- UAlbany's all-time record for most field goals made in a season is 15, set in 2007 by Jason Fralicker.
- Stark's 51-yard field goal against Morgan State was the third longest in program history and just two yards shy of UAlbany's all-time record. He also hit a 49-yarder against New Hampshire that ranks as the fifth-longest in program history.
- Stark also has made 19 of his 20 extra-point tries.

On the return

- Junior wide receiver Donovan McDonald's 67-yard punt return for a touchdown against Morgan State was the Great Danes' first since Nov. 13, 2010, when Ryan Kirchner took one back 80 yards against Wagner.
- McDonald has returned nine punts for an average of 7.8 yards.
- McDonald was named to the CAA Preseason All-Conference Team as a punt returner.
- McDonald ranked third in the league last season with an average of 10.1 yards per punt return.
- He also led the Great Danes with 1,015 all-purpose yards and became UAlbany's second-leading receiver with 29 catches for 339 yards and three touchdowns.
- McDonald joined the Great Danes prior to the 2017 season as a transfer from Nebraska, where he was a member of both the football and track programs.
- McDonald was a walk-on when he came to the program, but he earned a full scholarship after Week 3 of the 2017 season.

Did you know?

UAlbany and the NFL

- The Great Danes have seen 14 players sign NFL contracts. This year two former UAlbany players appeared in NFL training camps: Anthony Manzo-Lewis (Chargers) and Brian Parker (Broncos).
- UAlbany also has several NFL connections on its coaching staff:
- Offensive line coach **Jim Sweeney** was second round pick in the 1984 draft. He was named to the All-NFL Rookie Team after his first season with the New York Jets; he played 11 seasons with the Jets, with 158 consecutive starts.
- Defensive line coach **Delbert Cowsette** was drafted by the Washington Redskins and played for the New York Giants, Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Chicago Bears from 2000-2006.
- Tight ends coach and run-game coordinator **Nate Byham** was a sixth-round pick in the 2010 Draft by the San Francisco 49ers. He played in 29 NFL games, playing 14 games, including three starts, with the 49ers before signing with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers for 2012 and 2013.

- Stire has seen playing time as a reserve, blocking tight end.
- Stire was a two-year starter at power forward. He led the team with 6.0 rebounds per game as a senior and also averaged 7.1 points while shooting 56.3 percent.
- Stire began working with the football team during Spring Practice. He's expected to provide depth at tight end.

Welcome back Will and Michael

- UAlbany alums Michael Nicastro (defensive assistant) and Will Fiacchi (wide receivers coach and recruiting coordinator) both are on the coaching staff this season.
- Fiacchi, a 2014 graduate, is the Great Danes' all-time leading passer, having thrown for 7,150 yards. He made 35 consecutive starts at quarterback and holds team records in most completions in a game (28), season (207) and career (602). He's in his second year on the coaching staff after serving as the offensive assistant last season.

HEAD COACH GREG GATTUSO



reg Gattuso enters his fifth season at the helm of the UAlbany football program in 2018. A former standout defensive lineman at Penn State who's worked at Duquesne, Pittsburgh and Maryland, Gattuso has helped the Great Danes steadily rise in the Colonial Athletic Association, one of the top Football Championship Subdivision conferences in the nation.

In 2017, he led the Great Danes to their first win over a Top 10 program -- a 19-10 overtime victory over No. 7 Villanova at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. UAlbany also shut out New Hampshire, an FCS playoff qualifier, 15-0 in the season finale. It was one of several superlative efforts from a defense that finished the season ranked No. 9 nationally. The Great Danes were 4-7 overall and 2-6 in the CAA against a rigorous schedule that featured games against an FBS opponent (Old Dominion) and five matchups with Top 25 teams.

Under Gattuso's leadership, UAlbany had its best season as a CAA member in 2016, finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in the league. The Great Danes were ranked for five weeks, including as high as No. 16. UAlbany also earned its first victory over an FBS opponent with a 22-16 road win over Buffalo.

Hallmarks of Gattuso's teams have included discipline and taking care of the football. In 2016, the Great Danes were second in the CAA with a plus-16 turnover margin.

In his first season, in 2014, Gattuso led the Great Danes to a six-win turnaround from the previous year. The Great Danes picked up votes in the national polls for 10 straight weeks and appeared in The Sports Network Top 25 four times on their way to a 7-5 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark.

A year later, the Danes earned CAA victories over Rhode Island and perennial power Delaware.

Gattuso was a defensive lineman at Penn State, where he helped lead the Nittany Lions to a national title in 1982.

In his first collegiate head-coaching role, Gattuso piloted Duquesne to a 97-32 record during his 12-season tenure, and while making three bowl appearances at Pittsburgh, he turned the defensive line into one of the best in the nation as an assistant head coach.

Gattuso came to UAlbany after spending three seasons as a member Randy Edsall's staff at Maryland. There, he led the defensive line that ranked among the top in the ACC and was promoted to the position of assistant head coach in February 2012.

From 1989-1991, he served as head coach at his high school alma mater, Seton-LaSalle. Taking over a team that went 6-34 during the four seasons prior to his arrival, Gattuso led the Rebels to a 28-10-1 mark (.731), including three WPIAL playoff berths, a WPIAL championship and Parkway Conference title.

During his playing career, Gattuso was named the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's Class AA Player of the Year his senior season at Seton-LaSalle.

Gattuso and his wife Colleen have two daughters, Jacqueline and Kaitlin.

STONY BROOK, N.Y. — The University at Albany football team rallied from a two-touchdown deficit to tie the score in the final two minutes of regulation, but Stony Brook scored the only points of overtime in its 28-21 win Saturday at LaValle Stadium.

Great Danes quarterback Will Brunson threw for 216 yards and two touchdowns, and freshman tailback Karl Mofor tied the game at 21 with a touchdown run with 1 minute, 34 seconds left in the fourth quarter.

But Stony Brook, ranked No. 14 in this week's STATS Top 25 poll, scored on the first drive of overtime on a 13-yard touchdown pass, and UAlbany's drive ended with an incompletion on fourth down on the 5-yard line.

Brad Harris and Donovan McDonald caught touchdown passes for the Great Danes.

Stony Brook led 21-14 at halftime after taking advantage of two UAlbany turnovers.

The Seawolves recovered a fumble on the opening kickoff at the 16-yard line and took a 7-0 lead four players later.

After Harris's 7-yard touchdown catch tied the game, Stony Brook recovered another Great Danes' fumble at the UAlbany 9, leading to Stacy Bedell's 4-yard touchdown run and a 14-7 lead.

Stony Brook added a touchdown on a 26-yard pass with 7:02 left in the second quarter, before McDonald's 15-yard TD catch cut the lead to 21-14.

The scored held until Brunson, who completed 23-of-35 passes in the game, led a 19-play, 96-yard drive that culminated with the tying touchdown at the end of regulation.

UAlbany converted five third downs on the drive, including Brunson's 18-yard scramble on 3rd and 16 and his 19-yard completion to Austin Ellis on 3rd and 17. Mofor's 3-yard run finished the drive.

Stony Brook had a chance to win in regulation, but its 48-yard field-goal try as time expired was no good.
