BATTLE FOR FIRST AS UALBANY HOSTS RIVAL STONY BROOK

On Saturday, March 31st at 4 p.m., UAlbany takes on rival Stony Brook at Casey Stadium, with the victor holding lone possession of first place in the America East.

UAlbany stands as the unanimous #1 in each the USILA Coaches Poll and the Inside Lacrosse Maverik Media Poll, being #1 for the fifth consecutive week. Stony Brook is not ranked in either poll.

UAlbany remains as the lone undefeated team in Division I, defeating Harvard 14-6 during the midweek for a 9-0 record, including 2-0 in the America East. Stony Brook is playing its third conference game in a row, last defeating Hartford 10-8 at home on March 24th. The Seawolves have won two straight to be 3-5 overall and 2-0 in the league.

UAlbany won both meetings last season, knocking Stony Brook out of the America East Tournament semifinal round with a 19-6 victory on May 4th, 2017. Winning the last nine games, UAlbany leads the all-time series 20-10.

UALBANY UNANIMOUS #1 IN COACHES POLL, MEDIA POLL

For the fifth straight week, UAlbany stands at #1 in the USILA Coaches Poll and the *Inside Lacrosse* Maverik Media Poll. After the win over #2 Maryland on March 10th, UAlbany earned every first place vote in each poll.

The Great Danes have been ranked in the top-16 of both polls each week since May 2, 2014. In the preseason, UAlbany was #3 in each the coaches poll and the media poll.

THREE GREAT DANES ON TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

Connor Fields and **TD Ierlan** were each named to the 2018 Tewaaraton Trophy Watch List, released on March 1st, with **Tehoka Nanticoke** being added on March 20th.

UAlbany has had at least one Tewaaraton watch list player each of the last 11 years.

The Tewaaraton Trophy is given to the top player in college lacrosse. On the men's side, UAlbany's Miles and Lyle Thompson shared the 2014 Tewaaraton Trophy, with Lyle winning it outright in 2015.

FIELDS - GOING FOR NCAA SCORING RECORDS

Connor Fields has a chance to set numerous NCAA scoring records this season.

He is currently fifth all-time in Division I with 336 career points off 191 goals and 145 assists. He is even away from fourth by Joe Vasta, who had 343 points at Air Force from 1983-86. The record is 400 by UAlbany's own Lyle Thompson from 2012-15.

He is also tied for 6th all-time in DI with 191 goals in his career. He is one away from fifth, held by Gary Gait at Syracuse with 192 from 1987-90. The record is 206 by Duke's Zack Greer from 2005-08.

With 145 assists, he is 23rd in DI, one away from 22nd. The record is 225 by Lyle Thompson from 2012-15.

UALBANY - LONGEST CONFERENCE WINNING STREAK IN DI

With five consecutive undefeated regular seasons, UAlbany has the longest active winning streak in conference games with 30, dating back to 2013.

UAlbany is the only DI team to go undefeated in league play in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. Two schools, UAlbany and Denver, had undefeated conference regular seasons the past four years.

UAlbany formerly had a streak of 28 victories against America East opponents until May 5, 2016 after a 11-10 overtime defeat to Hartford in the America East Tournament semifinal round.

FIELDS RISING UP THE UALBANY RECORD BOOKS

Connor Fields, now the program's all-time goal scorer, is continuing to rise in the UAlbany record books in goals, assists and points.

His 66 goals in 2015 were second-most in UAlbany history and a freshman NCAA Division I record. His 117 points in 2017 is the fourth-highest single season scoring total in Division I history. The 2017 Tewaaron finalist and three-time All-American has three of the top-15 point-scoring seasons in UAlbany history.

FIVE GREAT DANES NAMED IL MEDIA PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Five UAlbany players were named to the Inside Lacrosse Pre-season Media All-America Team. This was the first year of this team selected by media members across the country.

Attack **Connor Fields** was named to the All-America First Team, faceoff specialist **TD Ierlan** was placed on the Second Team, midfielder **Kyle McClancy** is on the Third Team while goalkeeper **JD Colarusso** and attack **Tehoka Nanticoke** are Honorable Mention All-America.

IERLAN EARNS UALBANY DI GROUND BALL RECORD

As UAlbany's primary faceoff player, **TD Ierlan** has earned the program's DI ground ball record. The sophomore stands with 332 career ground balls, passing the DI record set by Jordan Levine, who had 321 ground balls from 2005-08, on March 28th.

Ierlan currently stands #1 in Division I with an 82% faceoff rate, almost 7% more than second place Trevor Baptiste of Denver, and first with 14.44 ground balls per game, over two more than any other player in DI.

#1 RECRUIT, TEHOKA NANTICOKE, COMES TO UALBANY

Tehoka Nanticoke comes to UAlbany, being ranked the #1 recruit by *Inside Lacrosse* in the Class of 2017. He was the team MVP of the U19 Iroquois Nationals in the 2016 World Games. In his collegiate debut, he scored five goals in the victory at #8/7 Syracuse.

He is the second #1 overall recruit ever to play for the Great Danes, the other being Lyle Thompson of the Class of 2011.

UALBANY PREDICTED TO FINISH FIRST IN AMERICA EAST IN 2018

For the sixth straight season, UAlbany has been predicted to finish first in the America East in the preseason coaches poll. It is the fifth consecutive season that UAlbany was a unanimous pick to finish first.

UAlbany is undefeated in America East regular season play since the start of 2013. The rest of the poll is filled out by Stony Brook, Vermont, UMBC, Hartford, Binghamton and UMass Lowell.

NATIVE AMERICANS WITH UALBANY

Seven Native Americans will compete with UAlbany this season, including some that have competed internationally with the Iroquois Nationals.

Five competed with the U19 Iroquois Nationals in 2016 in the World Lacrosse Championships in Canada. Juniors **Colyn Lyons** and **Chaunce Hill**, sophomores **Ron John** and **Mitch Laffin**, plus freshman **Tehoka Nanticoke**, helped the team earn a bronze medal finish.

Also competing with the Great Danes are **Jakob Patterson**, a member of the America East All-Rookie Team in 2017, and **Cougar Kirby**.

NEW YORK, NEW YORK

Home is where the heart is for UAlbany, drawing on the home state for most of its roster. Of its 50-man roster, 35 players hail from New York State.

From the USA, other states represented on UAlbany's roster include Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, New Jersey, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Vermont. The team also has four players from Canada.

The team's diversity is represented on its helmets. Each UAlbany helmet has three flags on the back, representing the United States, Canada and the Iroquois Six Nations.

#1 UAlbany Men's Lacrosse Grinds Out 14-6 Win vs. Harvard

ALBANY, N.Y. – The #1 UAlbany men's lacrosse team used a 10-goal second half to take down Harvard 14-6 and improve to 9-0 on the season.

"We had to overcome some adversity for sure; we had a slow start. We had to find some guys to step up, and our defense in general was great. Very proud of our team for regrouping in the second half to play solid defense and be better on the offensive end," said UAlbany head coach Scott Marr.

Tehoka Nanticoke earned a team-high six points off two goals and four assists, whereas Justin Reh and Kyle McClancy each had hat tricks. JD Colarusso notched the victory in goal with 11 saves and six goals allowed, with Stone Sims and Erik Dluhy each having two caused turnovers. TD Ierlan won 66.7% of faceoffs (16-for-24) with 15 ground balls and an assist.

Morgan Cheek finished with two goals and an assist for Harvard, while Kyle Anderson had two goals. Robert Shaw had the loss in goal with 13 saves and 14 goals allowed.

TD Ierlan became UAlbany's Division I all-time

ground balls leader, standing with 332 in his career and passing Jordan Levine's mark of 321.

Kyle McClancy surpassed the 100-point mark, standing with 101 in his career off 64 goals and 37 assists.

The first quarter saw UAlbany strike twice quickly as Jakob Patterson faked out two defenders and scored point blank on a run to the cage, then off a faceoff win, Tehoka Nanticoke passed off to Justin Reh for the shot and score. Harvard got its first goal while man-down from Kyle Anderson as both sides exchanges turnovers for the rest of the quarter until with 35 seconds left, Reh scored his second on a bouncing shot as UAlbany led 3-1 after one.

UAlbany scored early again as Connor Fields found Nanticoke on the doorstep for the point blank goal. The two sides went back and forth for many minutes as Harvard saved UAlbany shots while UAlbany forced turnovers the other way. Robert Mencke scored for Harvard in the final three minutes to make it 4-2 UAlbany at the half.

For the third straight quarter, UAlbany scored quickly as Kyle McClancy got around his defender and scored after a roll around the cage. Following a Harvard goal, UAlbany scored twice in a span of a minute, a roll dodge and score from McClancy and a shot from the hip on a run by Patterson. Harvard got a goal back, then UAlbany finished the quarter strongly with two more goals, another Reh goal from Nanticoke and a catch and shoot from Davis Diamond to Alex Burgmaster, to give UAlbany a 9-4 lead at the break.

UAlbany put another ball in the net in the opening minutes of the quarter again as Sean Eccles scored off a pass from Nanticoke. After a Harvard goal and a faceoff win for UAlbany, Matt Perla broke the Harvard 10-man ride with a goal from well behind the mid-line, resulting in the crowd roaring with appreciation. UAlbany sealed the game late with another longpole goal, this one from Troy Reh, adding one more from McClancy as UAlbany won 14-6.

#6/5 UAlbany Men's Lacrosse Buries Stony Brook 19-6 to Advance to AE Title Game

ALBANY, N.Y. – Paced by a 8-0 surge in the latter half of the second quarter, the 1-seed UAlbany men's lacrosse team crushed 4-seed Stony Brook 19-6 to return to the America East title game.

UAlbany (13-2), leading 4-1 in the middle of the second quarter, rolled off eight consecutive goals in 5:30 of play, all without losing possession, to build an 11-goal lead at the half vs. Stony Brook (7-7). UAlbany added another goal shortly into the third quarter to cap the 9-0 run. UAlbany did not give up back-to-back goals the rest of the way and cruised to the victory.

"We were mentally prepared for tonight's game, and we had a balanced effort from our team," said UAlbany head coach Scott Marr. "We shared the ball and were unselfish, and I am proud of our effort, but we are only half-done here."

UAlbany advances to the America East title game on Saturday, May 6th at noon at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. The Great Danes will take on 3-seed Binghamton, which defeated 2-seed UMBC 9-4 in the first game of the semifinals.

UAlbany dominated on the faceoff-X, setting an America East Tournament record by winning 86.2% (25-for-29). TD Ierlan dominated as UAlbany's primary faceoff man, winning 22-for-23 (95.7%) and grabbing 16 ground balls, more than Stony Brook as a team.

As a team, UAlbany outshot Stony Brook 46-23 and grabbed 39 ground balls compared to Stony Brook's 15.

Each Kyle McClancy and Justin Reh scored four goals, with the former adding an assist. Connor Fields had a team-high seven points off two goals and five assists, adding three ground balls, while Adam Osika notched a hat trick on four shots. In goal, JD Colarusso notched the victory with seven saves and five goals allowed.

"It is always great to get another chance at the America East Championship," said Fields. "Last year, we didn't play UAlbany lacrosse, and we are really excited for Saturday."

For Stony Brook, six different players had goals, with Tom Haun notching a goal and an assist. Michael Bollinger had the loss in goal with two saves and 11 goals allowed in the opening 27:36.

UAlbany had two quick goals in the opening 2:33, with a McClancy roll to the cage and Justin Reh shaking off a defender from behind the cage and scoring point blank. After UAlbany held on a long SBU possession by forcing a shot clock violation, Osika took a pass from a double-teamed Bennett Drake, ran to the cage and scored. A minute later, UAlbany passed around the horn man-up, leading to McClancy shooting a rocket under the crossbar to make it 4-0 after 8:30 of play.

SBU got its first goal in the closing minutes of the 1st quarter, pulling to 4-1 after one period.

With 6:50 left in the second, John Glancy hit his shot from straight away to start the UAlbany run. Ierlan kept winning faceoffs as UAlbany kept the ball, leading to a barrage of goals: Justin Reh scored from around the cage, Field hit a shot while jumping and throwing down a high to low fire, McClancy hit a laser off a dodge, Justin Reh hit a shot while falling backwards, Eli Lasda scoring off a won ground ball on the faceoff in the center of the field and scoring on his own (the last four goals occurring in a minute's time), Justin Reh adding a catch and shoot off a shot in the corner, then McClancy hitting a frozen rope inside the post. The quarter-ending 8-0 run sent UAlbany to a 12-1 lead at the half.

Facing a new keeper, UAlbany kept up the attack as Fields spun off his defender and scores on a shot past the torso. After SBU ended the UAlbany run with 12:26 left in the 3rd, Osika got the goal back, whipping a shot from the hip close range. The sides went back and forth the rest of the quarter, with a Mitch Laffin catch and shoot goal on the doorstep and an Osika rip off the dodge making it 16-4 UAlbany after three quarters.

Into the fourth, after a UAlbany barrage of shots ended in a turnover, the ride helped force an SBU turnover. UAlbany fired away again, leading to Lasda hitting a shot while jumping. SBU got the goal back as UAlbany's defense held down the stretch. Ron John added his first career goal off a clear from Troy Reh, then Davis Diamond set up Jake Cullen for a catch and shoot next to the crease. SBU added a late goal, with UAlbany taking the 19-6 victory.

University at Albany Head Coach Scott Marr

18th Year at UAlbany

2002, 2007, 2013, 2014 and 2016 America East Coach of the Year



Scott Marr begins his 18th season as UAlbany's head coach. The only coach hired in the Division I era at the University at Albany, Marr, a five-time America East Coach of the Year, has coached the Great Danes to eight America East Tournament titles, nine appearances in the NCAA Tournament and four NCAA Tournament victories. He has a 163-111 career record at UAlbany and has coached Tewaaraton winners in 2014 and 2015, 29 All-Americans, six Tewaaraton finalists, two Lt. Raymond J. Enners Award winners for Most Outstanding DI Player, three Lt. Col. J.L. Turnbull Award winners for the best Attackman in the nation, eight America East Players of the Year and 102 all-conference players.

In 2017, UAlbany was ranked as high as #4 in the nation for the second straight year, running the table in the America East regular season and tournament to finish 15-3 overall, defeating defending NCAA champion North Carolina in front of 6,472 at Casey Stadium to earn a spot in the NCAA Quarterfinals for the third time in four seasons. UAlbany earned victories over North Carolina, Yale, Binghamton and UMass, all top-20 in the RPI. 10 Great Danes earned America East All-Conference honors, led by Connor Fields, a 2017 Tewaaraton Trophy finalist and Turnbull Award winner for top attackman in Division I, earning 117 points on the year, the fourth-highest single scoring season in Division I history. Marr's squad was the top scoring team in the country with 277 goals, adding 171 assists for 448 points, averaging 15.39 goals per game as nine Great Danes scored double digit goals. Fields, TD Ierlan, Stone Sims, Troy Reh, Adam Osika and Kyle McClancy all earned All-America honors from the USILA or Inside Lacrosse. Fields was on the first team for each while Ierlan was second team by IL and third team in the USILA.

As an assistant on Dick Edell's Maryland staff for six years, Marr served as both assistant coach and offensive coordinator. Maryland made five NCAA Tournament appearances during that period and was the Division I national runner-up in 1995, 1997 and 1998. The Terrapins shattered the school's single-season scoring record with 236 goals when the program captured the '98 Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season and tournament titles. Maryland's attack averaged 12.5 goals under Marr's direction from 1995-2000. All-Americans Matt Hahn and Andrew Whipple became two of the most storied scorers in school history.

Marr served as one of three assistants for the 2006 U.S. Men's Lacrosse Team that won the silver medal. Syracuse's John Desko was the U.S. team's head coach. The 2006 International Lacrosse Federation World Championship was held in London, Ontario from July 13-22.

Marr began his coaching career as the University of Delaware's offensive coordinator, where he worked with the school's all-time leading scorer Anthony DiMarzo. From 1992-94, the Blue Hens captured three consecutive North Atlantic Conference championships and earned a top-20 national ranking in each season. Marr was also an assistant on the United States team that won the 1999 World Cup.

As a collegiate player at Johns Hopkins University, Marr was an attackman on the 1987 national championship squad and the '89 national runner-up team. The Blue Jays garnered four straight NCAA berths during his career. He received a B.S. in social and behavioral sciences in 1991.

A native of Yorktown, N.Y., Marr was a high school All-American who twice led his team to the state's semifinal round. He and his wife, Traci, a special education teacher, have three children, Kyle, Jordyn and Keeley.

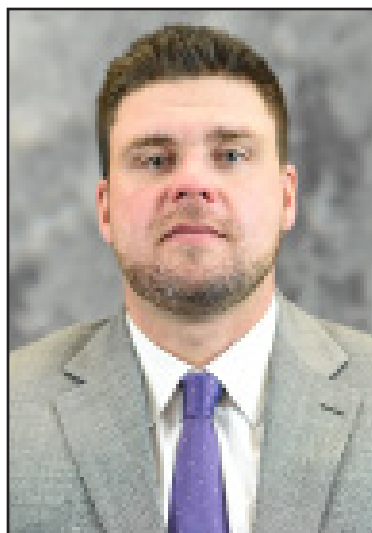

The 2007 UAlbany graduate comes back after serving as the head coach of the Hill Academy in his native Canada for six seasons, leading the school to a 68-13 record in the final five years.

Volunteer Assistant Coach

Former two-time UAlbany team captain Derrick Eccles enters his second season as a volunteer assistant coach for the 2017 season. Eccles finished his UAlbany in career in 2016, serving as the team's representative in the USILA North-South Game. The 2013 America East All-Rookie Team midfielder was a team captain in the 2015 and 2016 seasons, earning 45 points, off 29 goals and 16 assists, 62 ground balls and 10 caused turnovers in 61 career games.
