QUICK SLANTS

- UAlbany has won its past two games against Top 10 opponents, both at Casey Stadium. The Great Danes defeated No. 7 Villanova, 19-10 (OT) in 2017, and No. 10 Stony Brook, 25-23, in the 2018 season finale.
- Jeff Undercuffler threw three more touchdown passes against Richmond, bringing his season total to 18. He ranks second nationally and first in the CAA in that statistical category. He also has thrown for at least 200 yards in each of the past four games.
- Receivers Jerah Reeves (115 yards) and Juwan Green (109) both are coming off 100-yard performances.
- The UAlbany defense had a season-high 11.0 TFLs against Richmond.
- The Great Danes have not played at Towson since Nov. 15, 2003. The Tigers won, 35-16.

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East
Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's
golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic
Athletic Conference (MAAC), and football, a Division
I Football Championship Subdivision program,
is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic
Association (CAA). UAlbany has eared the Stuart P.
Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the
America East's top-performing athletics department,
seven times.

UAlbany has won 115 conference championships and has made 55 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past nine years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. Entering the 2018-19 school year, UAlbany has 99 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football, and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2018-19, UAlbany added eight conference championships to its total. Field hockey, women's soccer, women's cross country, men's and women's indoor track, men's & women's outdoor track as well as women's golf all won titles. Notably, women's cross country and track & field won the "Triple Crown," sweeping the cross country, indoor and outdoor championships.

Throughout its Division I history, UAlbany has had 19 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine drafted by Major League Baseball, and 15 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions, and Great Danes.

TEAM NOTES

Last meeting with Towson (Oct. 20, 2018, Casey Stadium)

Towson quarterback Tom Flacco threw for 306 yards and a pair of touchdowns to lead the No. 13-ranked Tigers to a 56-28 victory. Playing in front of homecoming crowd of 7,029 fans, the Great Danes got a big game from junior wide receiver Juwan Green, who caught touchdown passes of 50 and 60 yards. But the Tigers scored 28 points in the second guarter in dealing UAlbany its third consecutive defeat.

Top 10 wins

UAlbany has two wins against Top 10 opponents — and they've come in the Great Danes' two most recent tries. UAlbany beat No. 7 Villanova, 19-10, in overtime in 2017 and defeated No. 10 Stony Brook, 25-23, at Casey Stadium in 2018. In its program history, UAlbany has nine wins over Top 25 teams. The Great Danes were 1-3 against ranked teams in 2018.

On the offensive

UAlbany averages 32.7 points per game, the third most in the CAA. The offense has been led by QB Jeff Undercuffler, whose 18 TD passes rank second nationally and first in the league; Karl Mofor, who averages 89.2 yards per game, the second most in the CAA; and Juwan Green, who averages 91.4 receiving yards per game and has eight TD catches.

Go for it!

UAlbany has converted 10 of its 15 fourth-down attempts this season.

Spreading the wealth

UAlbany has four players with at least 12 catches this season: Juwan Green (38), Jerah Reeves (36), Karl Mofor (18) and Donovan McDonald (12).

Dvnamic defense

UAlbany's defense has forced 14 turnovers (eight fumble recoveries, six interceptions) and scored twice. In the opener at Central Michigan, Eli Mencer had a strip sack, fumble

LAST TIME OUT

Richmond 23, UAlbany 20 Oct. 5, 2019 Robins Stadium

RICHMOND, Va. — Jerah Reeves, Juwan Green and Murad Hussain all caught touchdown passes from Jeff Undercuffler, but the University at Albany football team fell at Richmond, 23-20, on Saturday in a CAA game.

Undercuffler hit Reeves on a 20-yard touchdown pass with 2:47 to play that brought the Great Danes within three points. But Richmond was able to hold the ball the rest of the way.

UAlbany's redshirt freshman quarterback completed 15-of-31 passes for 288 yards with three touchdowns, but UAlbany played from behind throughout the entire second half.

Hussain's TD was a spectacular one-handed grab in the first quarter that put UAlbany up, 7-3, and Green caught a 27-yard touchdown in the second quarter.

But UAlbany was bogged down by 16 penalties for 118 yards and an untimely turnover.

Leading 16-13, the Spiders intercepted a pass in Great Danes' territory with less than two minutes before halftime and returned it to the 6-yard line, setting up a touchdown run that made the score 23-13 at the intermission.

The teams remained scoreless in the second half until Reeves' touchdown catch.

Defensively, UAlbany was led by Levi Metheny's nine tackles. Mazon Walker had 3.5 tackles for loss, and Eli Mencer posted 3.0. Nick Dillon added a sack.

return for touchdown, and against Bryant, Jarren Williams hauled in a deflected pass and ran 63 yards for a Pick 6. UAlbany already has forced 13 fumbles.

When it counts

UAlbany has been at its best late in games this season, outscoring opponents 62-24 in the fourth quarter.

Home cookin'

UAlbany has won four straight at Casey Stadium, dating back to last season's 25-23 win over No. 10 Stony Brook in the season finale and followed by this year's wins over Bryant, Lafayette and William & Mary. The win over Bryant marked UAlbany's sixth straight win in a home opener.

Broken records

Senior wide receiver Juwan Green and redshirt freshman QB Jeff Undercuffler earned several mentions in the record book with their performances in Week 3's 38-35 loss to Monmouth in overtime.

- Green's 15 catches established a new program record. The previous record was 13, set by Andy Shein against Brockport in 1994.
- Green's 245 yards are the second most in a single game behind Chris Phillis' 251 against Robert Morris in 2000.
- Green is one of five Great Danes to have three TD catches in a game.
- Undercuffler's 398 yards passing ties Joe Savino for the program record. Savino had set the mark in 1997 against Southern Connecticut State.
- Undercuffler set the record for both attempts (53) and completions (31). The previous records (49, 28) were set by Will Fiacchi against Richmond in 2014.

What a rush

UAlbany posted 362 yards rushing in a Week 2 win over Bryant. Alex James ran 12 times for 229 yards and a TD, while Karl Mofor carried 18 times for 123 yards. James ran for an 80-yard TD in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter, he nearly had an 85 yard score, but it was called back when replay showed his foot touched the boundary at the 2-yard line. Through four games, UAlbany backs are averaging 5.8 yards per carry.

Schedule strength

Once again, the Great Danes play a formidable schedule. The nonconference slate included an FBS opponent (Central Michigan) and Monmouth, picked to finish second in the Big South Preseason Poll. CAA opponents Towson (No. 9), Delaware (15), Maine (18), and Stony Brook (22) are ranked in the STATS Top 25 poll. New Hampshire is receiving votes.

Scouting Towson

Towson (3-2, 1-1 CAA) is coming off a bye week. The Tigers last played Sept. 28 at Florida, of the SEC, and lost 38-0. In its two CAA contests, Towson has beaten Maine (45-23) and lost to Villanova (52-45, OT). The Tigers are led by CAA Preseason Offensive Player of the Year Tom Flacco, who averages 249.8 yards per game through the air. His favorite target is receiver Shane Leatherbury, who's averaging 72.8 receiving yards and has three touchdown catches. Towson was picked to finish second in the league in the preseason poll.

#18 QB Jeff Undercuffler: Ranks second nationally and first in the CAA with 18 TD passes this season. ... Has eclipsed 200 yards in each of the past four games. ... Has thrown 14 touchdown passes over his past four games. ... Tied a program record with 398 passing yards at Monmouth. Also set records for attempts (53) and completions (31). ... Threw for 199 yards and two TDs in season opener against Central Michigan. ... Made four appearances, including three starts, as a true freshman, throwing for 526 yards and four touchdowns. ... In first career start, vs. Delaware (11/3), completed 15-of-28 passes for 171 yards. ... Threw for 170 yards and two touchdowns in a season-ending win over No. 10 Stony Brook (11/17).

#21 RB Karl Mofor: Averaging 89.2 rushing yards per game. ... Two straight games with 100 yards rushing and 50 yards passing against Lafayette and William & Mary. ... Had three-straight 100-yard games, including a career-high 25 carries for a career-high 135 yards vs. Lafayette. ... UAlbany's second-leading rusher in 2018 with 596 yards and five TDs on 105 carries. ... Also caught 23 passes for 198 yards and two touchdowns. ... Had three games with 100-plus all-purpose yards. ... Rushed for 100 yards and a TD vs. Stony Brook (11/17). ... As a true freshman, appeared in all 11 games, starting eight. ... UAlbany's leading rusher as a freshman with 555 yards on 153 carries with six touchdowns. ... Had first career 100-yard game against Maine (Oct. 21), running for 105. ... #4 WR Juwan Green: Coming off a 109-yard, one-TD performance at Richmond. ...
Has three 100-yard games this season. ... Team's leading receiver with 38 catches for 546 yards and eight TDs ... Has a TD catch in five of six games this season. ... Program record-setting day at Monmouth. Caught record 15 passes (new record) for 245 yards (second most all-time) and three TDs (tied for most all-time). ... Transferred prior to junior season from Lackawanna CC. ... Appeared in nine games after becoming eligible, with five starts. ... Caught 23 passes for 429 yards and four touchdowns. ... Averaged 18.7 yards per catch. ... Also returned seven kickoffs for 163 yards. ... Had two games of 100-plus yards receiving. Caught seven passes for 130 yards and a touchdown vs. Richmond (10/13). Had four catches for 135 yards with two touchdowns against Towson a week later (10/20). ... Caught three passes for 60 yards and a TD vs. Stony Brook (11/17).

Played the William & Mary game wearing the name of his cousin, Charon Melvin-Williams, on the back of his jersey as part of the program's "Pink Game." Melvin-Willians died of cancer in 2010. ... Eight catches for 79 yards at Monmouth. Caught a 21-yard TD pass that tied the game with four seconds left in regulation. ... Second on the team as a junior with 36 catches and 581 receiving yards. ... Scored three touchdowns. ... Recorded 111 receiving yards vs. William and Mary (Oct. 6). ... Also caught for 104 yards and a touchdown vs. Saint Francis (Sept. 22).

#37 P Joey Mitchell: As a true freshman, averaging 36.6 yards per punt. ... Season-long punt of 51 yards at Richmond. ... Placed three kicks inside the 20 against Bryant.

#19 K Dylan Burns: Set a program record with four made field goals against William & Mary. ... Because of a penalty, made a 35-yard extra point to tie the game at Monmouth with four seconds left in regulation. ... Made first career FG, a 24-yarder, against Bryant. ... Won the starting kicking job, while also earning a scholarship, during the preseason.

DEFENSIVE PLAYERS TO WATCH

#54 DT Nick Dillon: Has played in all 34 games since transferring from Eastern Michigan in 2016. ... In 2018 recorded 22 tackles (11 solo), 1.5 sacks and six quarterback hurries. ... As a junior, appeared in nine games, recording 16 tackles (three solo). ... Played in four games for Eastern Michigan in 2015.

#12 DOG Eli Mencer: Has 4.5 sacks, 9.5 TFLs, three forced fumbles and three fumble recoveries. ... Had a spectacular strip sack/fumble-returned-for-touchdown at Central Michigan. ... Now has three career defensive TDs, including an overtime winner against Villanova in 2017. ... Playing a new position that the coaching staff has dubbed "DOG." It's a hybrid defensive end/linebacker role. ... Had played linebacker after initially being recruited as a running back. Rushed for 1,280 yards and 23 TDs as a senior at Altoona High School. ... Consistent big playmaker. Had 8.5 TFLs, 4.5 sacks and an interception as a junior. ... Led CAA with five forced fumbles as a sophomore. Also returned two fumbles for a touchdown, including one for 80 yards against Villanova (Sept. 23) that finished off a 19-10 overtime victory.

#45 LB Levi Metheny: Team leader with 56 tackles. ... Has two interceptions. ... After winning job as a starting middle linebacker in training camp, led team in 2018 with 92 tackles (48 solo). ... Appeared in all 11 games, mostly on special teams, as a redshirt freshman.

#44 LB Danny Damico: Third on team with 44 tackles. ... Appeared in 10 games as a redshirt freshman, recording 81 tackles (32 solo).

#6 LB Joe Casale: Career-high nine tackles at Monmouth. ... Recruited as a safety from Troy High School, just 10 miles from campus. Later moved to linebacker. ... Nicknamed "Joe Buck" by the coaching staff, because plays the "Buck" linebacker position. ... Appeared in four games as a true freshman.

#7 CB Jarren Williams: Caught a pass off a deflection and raced 63 yards down the sideline for a touchdown against Bryant. ... Joined the program as a graduate transfer from St. Francis (Pa.). ... - UAlbany also has several NFL connections on its coaching staff:
- Offensive line coach **Jim Sweeney** was second round pick in the 1984 draft. He was named to the All-NFL Rookie Team after his first season with the New York Jets; he played 11 seasons with the Jets, with 158 consecutive starts.
- Tight ends coach and run-game coordinator **Nate Byham** was a sixth-round pick in the 2010 Draft by the San Francisco 49ers. He played in 29 NFL games, playing 14 games, including three starts, with the 49ers before signing with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers for 2012 and 2013.
- Cornerbacks coach **Curome Cox** played 43 NFL games over three seasons with the Denver Broncos and Houston Texans. First signed by the Atlanta Falcons as an undrafted free agent in 2004, he was part of Broncos teams that won the 2005 AFC West Title and reached the 2006 AFC Championship Game. He started five games for the Broncos over those two seasons, recording two interceptions along with 46 tackles and five passes defended.
- Offensive assistant **Jacob Alsadek** appeared in camps with both the Green Bay Packers and Dallas Cowboys after graduating from Arizona in 2017.

- Nicastro, a 2016 graduate, finished his career fifth on the Great Danes' all-time tackles list with 310. He was an All-CAA First-Team member in 2016, when he also received the program's Todd J. Clark Memorial Award, given annually to a student-athlete who embodies leadership, courage and selflessness.

Happy anniversary

The University at Albany football program will be honoring its 50th anniversary in 2019, celebrating a tradition of excellence that dates back to its founding in 1970. The Great Danes' milestone season coincides with the 150th anniversary of College Football. UAlbany will be celebrating both anniversaries during the Nov. 5 game against CAA-rival and 2018 national semifinalist Maine. UAlbany's football history includes six Division I conference championships and an FCS playoff appearance in 2011. The program has won 300 games and seen 15 student-athletes sign NFL contracts. It all began in 1970, when former coach Bob Ford, with a roster of about 50 players and four graduate assistant coaches, restarted a club team that had been inactive since 1924. Just three seasons later, UAlbany moved up to Division III and went 16-2 over its first two campaigns. The program later transitioned to Division II in 1995 and then Division I in 1999.

HEAD COACH GREG GATTUSO



reg Gattuso enters his sixth season at the helm of the UAlbany football program in 2019.

A former standout defensive lineman at Penn State who's worked at Duquesne, Pittsburgh and Maryland, Gattuso has led the Great Danes through five seasons in the Colonial Athletic Association, one of the top Football Championship Subdivision conferences in the nation.

The 2018 season included a win over No. 10 Stony Brook in the season finale. The Great Danes played one of the most difficult schedules in the nation, with four games against ranked teams and a season-opening game against Pitt, of the Atlantic Coast Conference.


In 2017, he led the Great Danes to their first

win over a Top 10 program -- a 19-10 overtime victory over No. 7 Villanova at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. UAlbany also shut out New Hampshire, an FCS playoff qualifier, 15-0 in the season finale. It was one of several superlative efforts from a defense that finished the season ranked No. 9 nationally. The Great Danes were 4-7 overall and 2-6 in the CAA against a rigorous schedule that featured games against an FBS opponent (Old Dominion) and five matchups with Top 25 teams.

Under Gattuso's leadership, UAlbany had its best season as a CAA member in 2016, finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in the league. The Great Danes were ranked for five weeks, including as high as No. 16. UAlbany also earned its first victory over an FBS opponent with a 22-16 road win over Buffalo.

Hallmarks of Gattuso's teams have included discipline and taking care of the football. In 2016, the Great Danes were second in the CAA with a plus-16 turnover margin.

In his first season, in 2014, Gattuso led the Great Danes to a six-win turnaround from the previous year. The Great Danes picked up votes in the national polls for 10 straight weeks and appeared in The Sports Network Top 25 four times on their way to a 7-5 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark.

A year later, the Danes earned CAA victories over Rhode Island and perennial power Delaware.

Gattuso was a defensive lineman at Penn State, where he helped lead the Nittany Lions to a national title in 1982. In his first collegiate head-coaching role, Gattuso piloted Duquesne to a 97-32 record during his 12-season tenure, and while making three bowl appearances at Pittsburgh, he turned the defensive line into one of the best in the nation as an assistant head coach.


Gattuso came to UAlbany after spending three seasons as a member Randy Edsall's staff at Maryland. There, he led the defensive line that ranked among the top in the ACC and was promoted to the position of assistant head coach in February 2012.

From 1989-1991, he served as head coach at his high school alma mater, Seton-La-Salle. Taking over a team that went 6-34 during the four seasons prior to his arrival, Gattuso led the Rebels to a 28-10-1 mark (.731), including three WPIAL playoff berths, a WPIAL championship and Parkway Conference title.

During his playing career, Gattuso was named the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's Class AA Player of the Year his senior season at Seton-LaSalle.
