- The Great Danes enter Saturday alone in second place in the CAA with a 5-2 conference mark.
- UAlbany is hoping for its second FCS playoff berth. The Great Danes' other playoff appearance came in 2011.

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC), and football, a Division I Football Championship Subdivision program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the America East's top-performing athletics department, seven times.

UAlbany has won 115 conference championships and has made 55 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past nine years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. Entering the 2018-19 school year, UAlbany has 99 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football, and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2018-19, UAlbany added eight conference championships to its total. Field hockey, women's soccer, women's cross country, men's and women's indoor track, men's & women's outdoor track as well as women's golf all won titles. Notably, women's cross country and track & field won the "Triple Crown," sweeping the cross country, indoor and outdoor championships.

Throughout its Division I history, UAlbany has had 19 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine drafted by Major League Baseball, and 15 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions, and Great Danes.

TEAM NOTES

Broken records

UAlbany has set a number of individual single-season program records this season.

- Eli Mencer has 11.5 sacks. That breaks the previous mark of 9.0 sacks, set by Eddie Delaney (2011).
- Jeff Undercuffler has 32 TD passes, surpassing the previous record of 25 set by Dan DiLella (2011). He also has thrown for 2,783 yards, breaking the old mark of 2,636 that had been held by Will Fiacchi (2014), now the Great Danes' WR coach.
- Juwan Green has 13 TD catches, eclipsing the previous record of 11 shared by Dan Gmelin (1997) and Ryan Kirchner (2011).
- Green also has 1,097 yards, more than the record of 1,070 set by Dan Gmelin in 1997. His 67 catches matches the record set by Tim Bush (2008).

Leading the way

Great Danes are atop the CAA statistical leaderboard in several categories.

- Karl Mofor leads the league with 93.5 rushing yards per game and 1,028 total rushing yards.
- Eli Mencer leads the league with 11.5 sacks. He also is the league leader with 20.0 tackles for a loss.
- Mencer and Nick Griffin are tied for the conference lead with three fumble recoveries.

Watch list

Jeff Undercuffler has been named to the watch list for the STATS Jerry Rice Award, which is given annually to the top freshman in all of FCS. The award will be voted upon after the season by a panel of more than 150 sports information directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries.

On the offensive

UAlbany averages 32.4 points per game, the third most in the CAA. The Great Danes have scored more than 30 points in seven of 11 games this season. They're 5-2 in those games.

UAlbany 24, New Hampshire 17

Nov. 16, 2019

Albany, N.Y.— Tyler Oedekoven's fourth-quarter touchdown pass gave the University at Albany football team the lead, and Hayden Specht's first career interception helped the Great Danes hold onto a pivotal 24-17 win over New Hampshire.

The victory sends UAlbany into next week's regular-season finale with at least a share of second place in the CAA and bolsters its FCS playoff case.

On a sunny but cold afternoon at Casey Stadium, the Great Danes honored 17 seniors in a ceremony prior to kickoff. Then, Karl Mofor ran for two touchdowns and the defense came up with a pair of interceptions to help deliver the outgoing class a victory.

The game was tied at 17 in the fourth quarter when Jeff Undercuffler found Oedekoven wide open down the left sideline for a 32-yard touchdown. The play put UAlbany ahead, 24-17, with 8:01 left.

Four minutes later, New Hampshire was deep in UAlbany territory, threatening to tie the game. But on a 4th and 10 from the Great Danes' 23, Specht stepped in front of a pass and ran it back 30 yards.

New Hampshire had one more chance, but Anthony Lang sacked the Wildcats' QB on a 4th and 6 and with 1:33 to go, allowing UAlbany's offense to end the game in the victory formation.

In the first half, Mofor propelled the offense, opening the scoring with a 6-yard TD run and then adding a 16-yard touchdown in the second quarter that tied the game at 14.

Dylan Burns also kicked a 24-yard field goal that put the Great Danes ahead at halftime, 17-14.

TEAM NOTES CON'T

TE power

UAlbany's tight ends have been a big part of the offense in the red zone this season. They have a combined 10 touchdown catches, led by LJ Wesneski's six. Against Maine, Thomas Greaney caught the first two touchdowns of his career, the first of which came on his first career catch.

Spreading the wealth

UAlbany has five players with at least 12 catches this season: Juwan Green (67), Jerah Reeves (63), Karl Mofor (25), Donovan McDonald (15), and LJ Wesneski (12). Also, Jeff Undercuffler has thrown touchdown passes to eight different players: Green (13), Wesneski (six), Reeves (five), Tyler Oedekoven (two), Murad Hussain (two), Thomas Greaney (two), Mofor (one) and McDonald (one).

Dynamic defense

UAlbany's defense has forced 24 turnovers (15 fumble recoveries, nine interceptions) and scored four times. In the opener at Central Michigan, Eli Mencer had a strip sack, fumble return for touchdown, and against Bryant, Jarren Williams hauled in a deflected pass and ran 63 yards for a Pick 6. Dante Mount also scored on a 26-yard fumble return at Towson, and Nick Griffin took back a fumble against Rhode Island.

Receiving votes

For the fourth time this season, UAlbany received votes in this past week's STATS FCS Top 25 poll. UAlbany last was ranked in the Top 25 in September 2017, when it was No. 19 after starting the season 3-1.

When it counts

UAlbany has been at its best late in games this season, outscoring opponents 97-34 in the fourth quarter.

Top 10 wins

With an Oct. 12 victory over No. 9 Towson, UAlbany now has three straight victories when facing a Top 10 team.

2017: 19-10 (OT) vs. No. 7 Villanova

2018: 25-23 vs. No. 10 Stony Brook

2019: 38-21 at No. 9 Towson.

Put them in the books

Senior wide receiver Juwan Green and redshirt freshman QB Jeff Undercuffler earned several mentions in the record book with their performances in Week 3's 38-35 loss to Monmouth in overtime.

- Green's 15 catches established a new program record. The previous record was 13, set by Andy Shein against Brockport in 1994.
- Green's 245 yards are the second most in a single game behind Chris Phillis' 251 against Robert Morris in 2000.
- Green is one of five Great Danes to have three TD catches in a game.
- Undercuffler's 398 yards passing ties Joe Savino for the program record. Savino had set the mark in 1997 against Southern Connecticut State.
- Undercuffler set the record for both attempts (53) and completions (31). The previous records (49, 28) were set by Will Fiacchi against Richmond in 2014.

What a rush

UAlbany posted 362 yards rushing in a Week 2 win over Bryant. Alex James ran 12 times for 229 yards and a TD, while Karl Mofor carried 18 times for 123 yards. James ran

for an 80-yard TD in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter, he nearly had an 85 yard score, but it was called back when replay showed his foot touched the boundary at the 2-yard line.

Schedule strength

Once again, the Great Danes play a formidable schedule. The nonconference slate included an FBS opponent (Central Michigan) and No. 15 Monmouth, picked to finish second in the Big South Preseason Poll. In the CAA, Towson (No. 20) is currently ranked, while New Hampshire and Maine are receiving votes.

Last meeting with Stony Brook (Nov. 10, 2018, Wildcat Stadium)

Ethan Stark's 48-yard field goal that hit the cross bar and skipped through the uprights as time expired lifted the Great Danes to a wild 25-23 victory over No. 10-ranked Stony Brook at Casey Stadium. UAlbany piled on the senior placekicker in the stadium's south end zone. The win returned the Golden Apple Trophy to UAlbany, who beat a Top 10 opponent for the second time in as many seasons. Juwan Green (49 yards) and Donovan McDonald (81) also caught long touchdown passes from quarterback Jeff Undercuffler in a rivalry contest that went to halftime tied at 10.

The series with Stony Brook

This marks the 21st meeting between the programs, with UAlbany leading the series 12-8. The teams had met annually as members of the Northeast Conference until 2007, when Stony Brook left to become an independent for one season before joining the Big South. In 2011, UAlbany lost to Stony Brook, 31-28, on the road in the program's only FCS playoff appearance. Two years later, both teams joined the CAA.

Scouting Stony Brook

Stony Brook has lost five of its past six games, including a 17-10 decision at Delaware last week. The Seawolves average 210.4 rushing yards per game, the second most in the CAA. Against Delaware, both running backs Isaiah White (188 yards) and Jadon Turner (101) rushed for more than 100 yards. Stony Brook has played well against some of the CAA's top teams. The Seawolves went to overtime with James Madison before falling, 45-38, and defeated Villanova, 36-35.

Against Towson, threw two touchdown passes and for 380 yards, the second-highest single-game total in program history. ... Tied a program record with 398 passing yards at Monmouth. and a TD vs. Stony Brook (11/17). ... As a true freshman, appeared in all 11 games, starting eight. ... UAlbany's leading rusher as a freshman with 555 yards on 153 carries with six touchdowns. ... Had first career 100-yard game against Maine (Oct. 21), running for 105. ... Ran for 99 yards and a touchdown in collegiate debut against Old Dominion (Sept. 2). ... Nearly rushed for 100 yards the following week, too, compiling 98 with two TDs at Morgan State (Sept. 9).

#4 WR Juwan Green: UAlbany's leading receiver with 67 catches for 1,097 yards and 13 TDs. ... Third in the nation TD catches. ... Has five 100-yard games for the season. ... Two TDS and 134 yards at Delaware. ... Caught two more TD passes against Maine to set a new program single-season record. ... At Towson, caught eight passes for 156 yards. ... Had a 109-yard, one-TD performance at Richmond. ... Has five or more catches in eight games. ... Program record-setting day at Monmouth. Caught record 15 passes (new record) for 245 yards (second most all-time) and three TDs (tied for most all-time). ... Transferred prior to junior season from Lackawanna CC. ... - UAlbany also has several NFL connections on its coaching staff:

- Offensive line coach **Jim Sweeney** was second round pick in the 1984 draft. He was named to the All-NFL Rookie Team after his first season with the New York Jets; he played 11 seasons with the Jets, with 158 consecutive starts.

- Tight ends coach and run-game coordinator **Nate Byham** was a sixth-round pick in the 2010 Draft by the San Francisco 49ers. He played in 29 NFL games, playing 14 games, including three starts, with the 49ers before signing with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers for 2012 and 2013.

- Cornerbacks coach **Curome Cox** played 43 NFL games over three seasons with the Denver Broncos and Houston Texans. Happy anniversary

The University at Albany football program will be honoring its 50th anniversary in 2019, celebrating a tradition of excellence that dates back to its founding in 1970. The Great Danes' milestone season coincides with the 150th anniversary of College Football. UAlbany will be celebrating both anniversaries during the Nov. 5 game against CAA-rival and 2018 national semifinalist Maine. UAlbany's football history includes six Division I conference championships and an FCS playoff appearance in 2011. The program has won 300 games and seen 15 student-athletes sign NFL contracts. It all began in 1970, when former coach Bob Ford, with a roster of about 50 players and four graduate assistant coaches, restarted a club team that had been inactive since 1924. Just three seasons later, UAlbany moved up to Division III and went 16-2 over its first two campaigns. The program later transitioned to Division II in 1995 and then Division I in 1999.

HEAD COACH GREG GATTUSO



Greg Gattuso enters his sixth season at the helm of the UAlbany football program in 2019.

A former standout defensive lineman at Penn State who's worked at Duquesne, Pittsburgh and Maryland, Gattuso has led the Great Danes through five seasons in the Colonial Athletic Association, one of the top Football Championship Subdivision conferences in the nation.

The 2018 season included a win over No. 10 Stony Brook in the season finale. The Great Danes played one of the most difficult schedules in the nation, with four games against ranked teams and a season-opening game against Pitt, of the Atlantic Coast Conference.

In 2017, he led the Great Danes to their first win over a Top 10 program -- a 19-10 overtime victory over No. 7 Villanova at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. UAlbany also shut out New Hampshire, an FCS playoff qualifier, 15-0 in the season finale. It was one of several superlative efforts from a defense that finished the season ranked No. 9 nationally. The Great Danes were 4-7 overall and 2-6 in the CAA against a rigorous schedule that featured games against an FBS opponent (Old Dominion) and five matchups with Top 25 teams.

Under Gattuso's leadership, UAlbany had its best season as a CAA member in 2016, finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in the league. The Great Danes were ranked for five weeks, including as high as No. 16. UAlbany also earned its first victory over an FBS opponent with a 22-16 road win over Buffalo.

Hallmarks of Gattuso's teams have included discipline and taking care of the football. In 2016, the Great Danes were second in the CAA with a plus-16 turnover margin.

In his first season, in 2014, Gattuso led the Great Danes to a six-win turnaround from the previous year. The Great Danes picked up votes in the national polls for 10 straight weeks and appeared in The Sports Network Top 25 four times on their way to a 7-5 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark.

A year later, the Danes earned CAA victories over Rhode Island and perennial power Delaware.

Gattuso was a defensive lineman at Penn State, where he helped lead the Nittany Lions to a national title in 1982. In his first collegiate head-coaching role, Gattuso piloted Duquesne to a 97-32 record during his 12-season tenure, and while making three bowl appearances at Pittsburgh, he turned the defensive line into one of the best in the nation as an assistant head coach.

Gattuso came to UAlbany after spending three seasons as a member Randy Edsall's staff at Maryland. There, he led the defensive line that ranked among the top in the ACC and was promoted to the position of assistant head coach in February 2012.

From 1989-1991, he served as head coach at his high school alma mater, Seton-La-Salle. Taking over a team that went 6-34 during the four seasons prior to his arrival, Gattuso led the Rebels to a 28-10-1 mark (.731), including three WPIAL playoff berths, a WPIAL championship and Parkway Conference title.

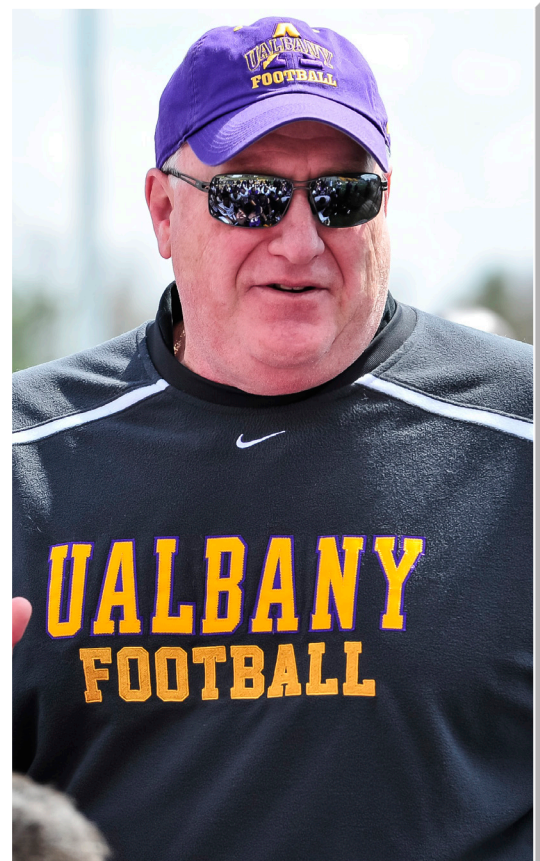
During his playing career, Gattuso was named the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's Class AA Player of the Year his senior season at Seton-LaSalle.
