- UAlbany has set a number of individual single-season records this season. Among them: QB Jeff Undercuffler (39 passing TDs; 3,27- passing yards), WR Juwan Green (16 receiving TDs; 1,263 receiving yards), Eli Mencer (14.5 sacks).
- The Great Danes finished second in the CAA with a 6-2 mark.
- UAlbany won its first-ever FCS Playoff game last weekend with a dominating 42-14 victory against Central Connecticut State. Redshirt-freshman Jeff Undercuffler tossed a program-record six touchdowns in the rout.
- Saturday marks the first meeting between UAlbany and Montana State in the sport of football.

ABOUT UALBANY ATHLETICS

UAlbany is a member of the America East Conference in 16 of 18 varsity sports, while women's golf is an associate member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC), and football, a Division I Football Championship Subdivision program, is an associate member of the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA). UAlbany has earned the Stuart P. Haskell Jr. Commissioner's Cup, which honors the America East's top-performing athletics department, seven times.

UAlbany has won 115 conference championships and has made 55 NCAA Tournament appearances since moving to Division I in 1999. Proving to be a perennial power, the Great Danes have won seven or more conference titles in each of the past nine years. UAlbany claimed its 100th conference title on May 14, 2017, when softball won the America East Tournament. Entering the 2018-19 school year, UAlbany has 99 America East Tournament titles, six Northeast Conference (NEC) season titles in football, and two MAAC titles in women's golf.

In 2018-19, UAlbany added eight conference championships to its total. Field hockey, women's soccer, women's cross country, men's and women's indoor track, men's & women's outdoor track as well as women's golf all won titles. Notably, women's cross country and track & field won the "Triple Crown," sweeping the cross country, indoor and outdoor championships.

Throughout its Division I history, UAlbany has had 19 players selected in the Major League Lacrosse Draft, nine drafted by Major League Baseball, and 15 sign NFL contracts.

UAlbany's more than 400 student-athletes strive every day to be Great Leaders, Great Champions, and Great Danes.

TEAM NOTES

Broken records

UAlbany has set a number of individual single-season program records this season.

- Eli Mencer has 14.5 sacks. That breaks the previous mark of 9.0 sacks, set by Eddie Delaney (2011).
- Jeff Undercuffler has 39 TD passes, surpassing the previous record of 25 set by Dan DiLella (2011). He also has thrown for 3,270 yards, breaking the old mark of 2,636 that had been held by Will Fiacchi (2014), now the Great Danes' WR coach.
- Juwan Green has 16 TD catches, eclipsing the previous record of 11 shared by Dan Gmelin (1997) and Ryan Kirchner (2011).
- Green also has 1,263 yards, more than the record of 1,070 set by Dan Gmelin in 1997. His 80 catches breaks the record set by Tim Bush (2008).

Leading the way

Great Danes are atop the CAA statistical leaderboard in several categories.

- Karl Mofor leads the league with 95.3 rushing yards per game and 1,239 total rushing yards.
- Eli Mencer leads the league with 14.5 sacks. He also is the league leader with 23.0 tackles for a loss and five forced fumbles.
- Mencer and Nick Griffin are tied for the conference lead with three fumble recoveries.

UAlbany 42, Central Connecticut State 14
Nov. 30, 2019

Albany, N.Y.— Redshirt-freshman quarterback Jeff Undercuffler threw six TD passes and Juwan Green hauled in two TDs as the University at Albany football team rolled past Central Connecticut State, 42-12, in the program's first-ever FCS Playoff win.

In the opening round of the FCS Playoffs, the Great Danes outscored the Blue Devils 35-7 in the second half, behind five TD passes from Undercuffler.

Juwan Green produced 105 yards and two touchdowns. He has hauled in a program-record 16 touchdowns and 1,263 receiving yards through 13 games this season.

Eli Mencer finished the game with one sack for a program record 14.5 on the season. He posted an interception and five tackles on the day, including one for a loss of five yards.

LJ Wesneski caught his seventh touchdown pass this year. He finished the game with one reception for 11 yards.

Karl Mofor added to the stat sheet with three receptions for 26 yards and one touchdown. On the ground, he added 37 yards on 11 carries.

The Blue Devils broke open the scoring with a 31-yard TD pass on their second drive of the game.

In the second quarter, on a second and 10 from the CCSU 12-yard line, Undercuffler connected with Green in the back corner of the end zone. The Danes' wide receiver went up and over the CCSU safety to bring down the pass and knot the score at 7-all.

The Great Danes came out of the break hot, scoring 28 unanswered points in the third quarter. First, Undercuffler found Green for a 41-yard TD pass, before connecting with Jerah Reeves (33 yards), LJ Wesneski (11 yards) and Tyler Oedekoven (9 yards) for touchdowns.

Undercuffler later found Karl Mofor for a quick hit over the middle. The Danes' running back then broke three tackles before charging into the end zone to make the score 42-7.

Defensively, Eli Mencer picked up his first interception of the season and recorded up the team's only sack of the game. Danny Damico led the Great Danes with 12 tackles.

have scored more than 30 points in nine of 13 games this season. They are 7-2 in those games.

TE power

UAlbany's tight ends have been a big part of the offense in the red zone this season. They have a combined 11 touchdown catches, led by LJ Wesneski's seven. Against Maine, Thomas Greaney caught the first two touchdowns of his career, the first of which came on his first career catch.

Spreading the wealth

UAlbany has six players with at least 12 catches this season: Juwan Green (80), Jerah Reeves (70), Karl Mofor (29), LJ Wesneski (18), Donovan McDonald (15) and Tyler Oedekoven (15).

Also, Jeff Undercuffler has thrown touchdown passes to eight different players: Green (16), Wesneski (seven), Reeves (six), Tyler Oedekoven (three), Murad Hussain (two), Thomas Greaney (two), Mofor (two) and McDonald (one).

Dynamic defense

UAlbany's defense has forced 27 turnovers (16 fumble recoveries, 11 interceptions) and scored four times. In the opener at Central Michigan, Eli Mencer had a strip sack, fumble return for a touchdown, and against Bryant, Jarren Williams hauled in a deflected pass and ran 63 yards for a Pick-6. Dante Mount also scored on a 26-yard fumble return at Towson, and Nick Griffin took back a fumble against Rhode Island.

Receiving votes

After receiving votes the last five weeks, UAlbany had cracked the STATS Top-25 rankings. The Great Danes are No. 25, breaking into the rankings for the first time since 2017. UAlbany last was ranked in the Top 25 in September 2017, when it was No. 19 after starting the season 3-1.

When it counts

UAlbany has been at its best late in games this season, outscoring opponents 111-53 in the fourth quarter.

Top 10 wins

With an Oct. 12 victory over No. 9 Towson, UAlbany now has four straight victories when facing a Top 10 team.

Put them in the books

Senior wide receiver Juwan Green and redshirt freshman QB Jeff Undercuffler earned several mentions in the record book with their performances in Week 3's 38-35 loss to Monmouth in overtime.

- Green's 15 catches established a new program record. The previous record was 13, set by Andy Shein against Brockport in 1994.
- Green's 245 yards are the second most in a single game behind Chris Phillis' 251 against Robert Morris in 2000.
- Green is one of five Great Danes to have three TD catches in a game.

- Undercuffler set the record for both attempts (53) and completions (31). The previous records (49, 28) were set by Will Fiacchi against Richmond in 2014.

What a rush

UAlbany posted 362 yards rushing in a Week 2 win over Bryant. Alex James ran 12 times for 229 yards and a TD, while Karl Mofor carried 18 times for 123 yards. James ran for an 80-yard TD in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter, he nearly had an 85 yard score, but it was called back when replay showed his foot touched the boundary at the 2-yard line.

Schedule strength

Once again, the Great Danes play a formidable schedule. The nonconference slate included an FBS opponent (Central Michigan) and No. 15 Monmouth, picked to finish second in the Big South Preseason Poll. In the CAA, Towson (No. 20) is currently ranked, while New Hampshire and Maine are receiving votes.

The series with Montana State

Saturday's meeting will be the first between UAlbany and Montana State in the sport of football. The Great Danes are 3-3 on the road this season while the Bobcats own a 5-1 clip at home.

Scouting Montana State

The Bobcats earned a first round bye after drawing the No. 5 seed with a 9-3 overall record. Montana State won its last four conference games of the season and finished tied for third in the Big Sky with a 6-2 record. The Bobcats' defense ranks third in the conference, holding their opponents to an average of 21.5 points per game. Bryce Sterk is boasting 16.5 tackle for loss while Amanda Williams adds 14.5 to rank fourth and fifth, respectively, in the league. Sterk is tied for first with 13.5 sacks on the year.

- UAlbany also has several NFL connections on its coaching staff:
 - Offensive line coach **Jim Sweeney** was second round pick in the 1984 draft. He was named to the All-NFL Rookie Team after his first season with the New York Jets; he played 11 seasons with the Jets, with 158 consecutive starts.

- Tight ends coach and run-game coordinator **Nate Byham** was a sixth-round pick in the 2010 Draft by the San Francisco 49ers. He played in 29 NFL games, playing 14 games, including three starts, with the 49ers before signing with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers for 2012 and 2013.

- Cornerbacks coach **Curome Cox** played 43 NFL games over three seasons with the Denver Broncos and Houston Texans. Happy anniversary

The University at Albany football program will be honoring its 50th anniversary in 2019, celebrating a tradition of excellence that dates back to its founding in 1970. The Great Danes' milestone season coincides with the 150th anniversary of College Football. UAlbany will be celebrating both anniversaries during the Nov. 5 game against CAA-rival and 2018 national semifinalist Maine. UAlbany's football history includes six Division I conference championships and an FCS playoff appearance in 2011. The program has won 300 games and seen 15 student-athletes sign NFL contracts. It all began in 1970, when former coach Bob Ford, with a roster of about 50 players and four graduate assistant coaches, restarted a club team that had been inactive since 1924. Just three seasons later, UAlbany moved up to Division III and went 16-2 over its first two campaigns. The program later transitioned to Division II in 1995 and then Division I in 1999.

HEAD COACH GREG GATTUSO



Greg Gattuso enters his sixth season at the helm of the UAlbany football program in 2019.

A former standout defensive lineman at Penn State who's worked at Duquesne, Pittsburgh and Maryland, Gattuso has led the Great Danes through five seasons in the Colonial Athletic Association, one of the top Football Championship Subdivision conferences in the nation.

The 2018 season included a win over No. 10 Stony Brook in the season finale. The Great Danes played one of the most difficult schedules in the nation, with four games against ranked teams and a season-opening game against Pitt, of the Atlantic Coast Conference.

In 2017, he led the Great Danes to their first win over a Top 10 program -- a 19-10 overtime victory over No. 7 Villanova at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium. UAlbany also shut out New Hampshire, an FCS playoff qualifier, 15-0 in the season finale. It was one of several superlative efforts from a defense that finished the season ranked No. 9 nationally. The Great Danes were 4-7 overall and 2-6 in the CAA against a rigorous schedule that featured games against an FBS opponent (Old Dominion) and five matchups with Top 25 teams.

Under Gattuso's leadership, UAlbany had its best season as a CAA member in 2016, finishing 7-4 overall and 4-4 in the league. The Great Danes were ranked for five weeks, including as high as No. 16. UAlbany also earned its first victory over an FBS opponent with a 22-16 road win over Buffalo.

Hallmarks of Gattuso's teams have included discipline and taking care of the football. In 2016, the Great Danes were second in the CAA with a plus-16 turnover margin.

In his first season, in 2014, Gattuso led the Great Danes to a six-win turnaround from the previous year. The Great Danes picked up votes in the national polls for 10 straight weeks and appeared in The Sports Network Top 25 four times on their way to a 7-5 overall record and 3-5 CAA mark.

A year later, the Danes earned CAA victories over Rhode Island and perennial power Delaware.

Gattuso was a defensive lineman at Penn State, where he helped lead the Nittany Lions to a national title in 1982. In his first collegiate head-coaching role, Gattuso piloted Duquesne to a 97-32 record during his 12-season tenure, and while making three bowl appearances at Pittsburgh, he turned the defensive line into one of the best in the nation as an assistant head coach.

Gattuso came to UAlbany after spending three seasons as a member Randy Edsall's staff at Maryland. There, he led the defensive line that ranked among the top in the ACC and was promoted to the position of assistant head coach in February 2012.

From 1989-1991, he served as head coach at his high school alma mater, Seton-LaSalle. Taking over a team that went 6-34 during the four seasons prior to his arrival, Gattuso led the Rebels to a 28-10-1 mark (.731), including three WPIAL playoff berths, a WPIAL championship and Parkway Conference title.

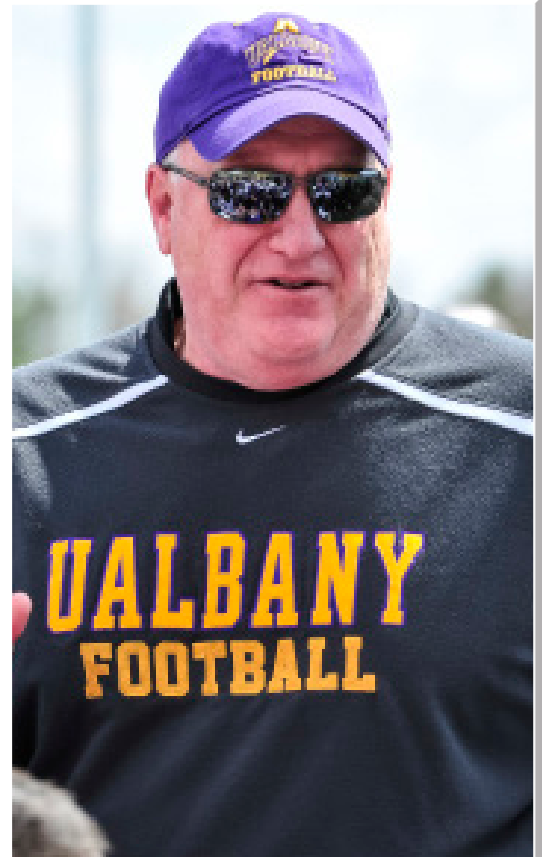
During his playing career, Gattuso was named the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's Class AA Player of the Year his senior season at Seton-LaSalle.
