## NEWS AND NOTES

## Scouting Boston College

The Eagles arrive at Tuesday's game with a record of 5-5, having just won 73-72 on the road at Notre Dame on Saturday. It was the Eagles' first victory over the Fighting Irish in 13 ACC meetings. The Eagles were picked 13th in the ACC Preseason Coaches' Poll, and are led by graduate transfer Derryck Thornton, who returns to the ACC after departing Duke for Southern Cal. Thornton averages 15.2 points per game, good for 10th in the ACC.

## Last Time vs. Boston College

This is the first-ever meeting between the teams. The last ACC opponent UAlbany played was Louisville on December 21, 2017, falling on the road to the Cardinals 70-68.

## Last Time Out

The Great Danes visited Lewisburg, Pa. to play at Bucknell on Saturday, their third and final Patriot League opponent of the 2019-20 regular season. UAlbany jumped out to a big lead in the first half, 21-6, only to see the Bison come back within eight by the half. UAlbany led by as 12 in the second

before Bucknell stormed back to take the lead late. The Bison used clutch free-throw shooting to pull away just enough to weather UAlbany's final possession, and held on to defeat the Great Danes 65-64 to hand UAlbany its second-straight defeat.

## Around the America East

UAlbany currently sits in a four-way tie for third place with UMBC, New Hampshire, and Binghamton, each of whom sport matching 5-5 overall records. Just behind the four is UMass Lowell, who climbed to 5-6 after defeating St. Francis Brooklyn over the weekend. Stony Brook maintains its half-game lead over Vermont for the top spot in the conference, with the Seawolves riding a two-game winning streak with victories over Manhattan and Brown. Vermont snapped a two-game skid, at Yale and at Cincinnati, bouncing back to defeat Towson by 17 points to keep pace with the Seawolves' seven victories

### Down but Not Out

The Great Danes won their season-high third-straight game, defeating American University at SEFCU Arena 68-64. UAlbany trailed by as many as 19 in the first half, before storming back to take the lead in the second. The Danes fell behind again by as many as nine, before rallying a second time to claim a four-point victory. Cameron Healy and Antonio Rizzuto scored 18 and 17 points, respectively, with Rizzuto shooting 6-9 from the floor and 5-7 from three.

### Bobcats Invitational Wrapup

The UAlbany men's basketball team arrived at the Bobcats Invitational, where they would play three games in three days at Quinnipiac University, with a 2-2 record. Leaving the tournament, the Danes were 4-3, holding a winning record for the first time all season after posting consecutive wins, also for the first time this season, to close out their three games. After falling to tournament host Quinnipiac, the Great Danes received career nights from Kendall Lauderdale and Antonio Rizzuto to defeat Sacred Heart, and then held off a stingy Presbyterian squad to finish the tournament 2-1.

### Streaking

Sophomore guard Cameron Healy started all 32 games for the Great Danes last season, and connected on a three-pointer in each of those 32 games. Through 10 games this season, Healy has extended his made three-pointer streak to 42 games, the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. The national leader is junior Mack Smith from Eastern Illinois, who has made a three-pointer in 58-consecutive games.

### Approaching 300

At 5-5 in 2019-20, head coach Will Brown has won 299 games at UAlbany, leaving him just two wins away from hitting the 300-win milestone. Since taking over as the Great Danes' head coach during the 2001-02 season, Brown has won five America East titles, two America East regular-season titles, one NCAA Tournament victory, and guided his teams to seven 20-win seasons. Now entering his 19th season at the helm, Brown has averaged more than 16 wins per season, including high-water marks of 24 wins in three separate seasons.

### Double-Double

For the first time in his career, sophomore Malachi de Sousa recorded a double-double. de Sousa scored 10 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in the Great Danes' second game of the season, against Canisius. It was the first double-double for a UAlbany player since February 2019 when Cameron Healy went for 31 and 10 in his record-setting performance against Binghamton.

### Preseason Recognition

Sophomore guard Cameron Healy earned a spot on the America East Preseason All-Conference team. After averaging 16.0 points per game last season and setting program records for three-point shooting, Healy earned a spot on the America East All-Conference Third and All-Rookie Teams a year ago, while finishing as runner-up for America East Rookie of the Year. Additionally, senior guard Ahmad Clark was one of 50 players named to the Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List, which recognizes the top mid-major player in the country.

### Picked Fourth

For the second-consecutive season, the UAlbany men's basketball team was picked fourth in the America East Preseason Coaches' Poll, drawing 47 points to fall just behind Stony Brook's 48 in third. Vermont was selected unanimously as the league favorite, marking the fourth-straight year the Catamounts have landed atop the preseason poll. UMBC received the lone remaining first-place vote in second place with 53 points.

### Record-Setting

Great Danes players set a handful of program records during the 2018-19 season. Freshman Cameron Healy set or tied single-game and single-season marks for three-pointers made and attempted, and broke Jamar Wilson's freshman record for total points scored in a season with 512. Additionally, Ahmad Clark tied the program record for single game assists with 10 at Niagara, and set a Division-I era single-season program record with 63 total steals.

### From Deep

The Great Danes embraced the three-pointer last season, setting single-season program records for threes attempted (790) and made (274) in 32 games. Sophomore Cameron Healy led the charge, taking 251 threes and making 104, including 55 in conference play, all of which were individual single-season program records.

### Freshmen become Sophomores

For four of the last five games last season, starting February 21 against Stony Brook and excluding Senior Night on February 27, the Great Danes started freshman at all five positions. The team started the season with freshmen at three starting spots, Cameron Healy, Adam Lulka, and Brent Hank, and moved to start four freshmen for the first time on December 20 against Manhattan when Antonio Rizzuto made his second career start. All five freshmen who played starting roles at some point last season return to the squad this year, including Healy and Lulka who each started every game last season.

### Returning Depth

The Great Danes return nine players from the 2018-19 squad, including all five

players who started at the end of the year. The most prominent departure was Devonte Campbell, who averaged 7.8 points and 4.8 rebounds last year, while earning America East All-Defensive Team accolades for the third time in his career. UAlbany returns each of its top five scorers, as well as two of its three most prominent bench players.

### The North

In August, UAlbany took a week-long trip to play exhibition games against five Canadian universities. The team played twice in Ottawa and three times in Montréal, ending the trip on a three-game winning streak against McGill University, Université du Québec à Montréal, and Concordia.

### Fighting Fires

During the offseason, sophomore guard Antonio Rizzuto signed up to be a volunteer firefighter with the McKownville Fire Department. When he's not otherwise occupied with basketball or school work, Rizzuto answers calls when a situation requires respondents. Rizzuto is an exterior firefighter, where he retrieves items from the trucks and hooks up the hoses to fire hydrants.

### In-House

A point of pride for head coach Will Brown, each of his staff members holds a degree from the University at Albany. Each of his assistant coaches, Jon Iati, Josh Pelletier, and Jerrad Knotts, hold UAlbany degrees, as do his director of basketball operations Greig Stire and video coordinator Shane Hammill. Brown's is the only staff in the country that can boast holding degrees from their coaching institution across the board. Iati, Knotts, and Stire all played for Brown during their collegiate careers. Further, entering their eighth season together, the Great Danes staff is tied for the second-longest tenured staff in the country. West Virginia coach Bob Huggins' staff enters their eighth year together, while Tom Izzo's staff at Michigan State enters their 10th.

### Captains

The Great Danes announced three players, Ahmad Clark, Adam Lulka, and Nick Fruscio, to serve as team captains for the 2019-20 season. Clark and Lulka each enter their second-straight season as team captains, while senior Nick Fruscio was selected by his teammates to serve in his final year.

### Decade Recap

The Great Danes finished the 2010's with a record of 188-148, the second-highest decade wins total in program history behind the 190 victories during the 1980's. UAlbany also won 93 America East games in the 2010's, and averaged nearly 19 wins per season in the last decade.

# LAST TIME OUT - at BUCKNELL

Score: Bucknell 65, UAlbany 64

Location: Sojka Pavilion in Lewisburg, Pa.

Records: UAlbany (5-5); Bucknell (4-7)

Short story: Men's basketball sees double-digit leads evaporate in a tough loss at Bucknell, 65-64.

**Coach Brown:** "We did a pretty good job in the first half, and then we started turning the ball over and allowed them to get back into the game. A lot of the first half was self-inflicted on our end, and then in the second half, we didn't play a lot of smart basketball. We're putting too much pressure on Ahmad and Cameron to create offense. This is a game that we should have closed out, but we didn't make plays when we need to, and we didn't play smart basketball."

### Recap

Kicking off a two-game road set, the University at Albany men's basketball team visited Bucknell Saturday night in search of their fourth victory in five games. After leading by double digits in both the first and the second halves, UAlbany saw Bucknell claw back to claim a 65-64 victory, outscoring the Great Danes by nine in the second half.

Following a scoreless minute, Ahmad Clark drove to the basket and drew a foul. He hit both free throws to give UAlbany the early 2-0 lead. Clark scored five of UAlbany's first seven points.

With 15:57 remaining in the first, UAlbany had built a 7-3 lead, with Antonio Rizzuto headed to the free-throw line. Rizzuto hit both free throws to push the Danes' lead to nine.

Clark hit a three to put UAlbany up 11 with just over 13 minutes left in the first half. Clark had scored 10 of UAlbany's first 17 points. A quick transition dunk from Clark to Kendall Lauderdale put UAlbany up 19-6, forcing Bucknell to take a timeout.

Lauderdale scored again to go up 21-6 following the timeout. Bucknell responded with a 6-0 run to cut the lead to 21-12. Lauderdale broke Bucknell's run with a layup with 8:24 remaining.

With 6:54 to go in the first, Cameron Healy drained a three from the top right corner, extending his made-threes streak to 42 games, putting UAlbany back up 10, 26-16.

Bucknell was able to close within eight by the end of the half, and trailed UAlbany heading into the locker room 32-24 after hitting a three with six seconds left in the first.

Clark led UAlbany at the break with 11 points, while the Great Danes shot 52.4% from the floor over the first 20 minutes. Healy had snagged eight rebounds, and also dished three assists. The Great Danes had committed 12 turnovers in the first half, hitting their full-game average on the season. UAlbany outscored Bucknell 9-0 off the bench and 14-2 in the paint.

Bucknell quickly closed to within five coming of the locker room before UAlbany went back up by seven.

With 14:31 left in the second, following two free throws from Clark, Trey Hutcheson hit a three from the top right corner to put UAlbany back up by 10, 41-31. The Danes' run extended to 7-0 when Healy hit two free throws to go up 43-31.

The Great Danes held the Bison scoreless for nearly three minutes before letting up another basket. Following their drought, the Bison went on a 10-0 run to close their deficit to just two with 10:35 left in the second half. Clark responded immediately with a jumper on the other end to break Bucknell's scoring streak.

Bucknell closed within one with 9:57 with a layup and-one, and took the lead on their next possession on a layup in transition, 46-45 with 9:31 remaining. Brent Hank tied the game at 46 with 9:02 to go after hitting one of two free throws.

Trailing by two, Healy drained another three to put UAlbany back up by one. Bucknell soon built a four-point lead, before Healy hit a contested three from the top of the arc to cut the Danes' deficit to 55-54 with 4:24 remaining.

By the final media timeout, Bucknell has grown its lead to 59-54. Out of the timeout, Lauderdale went to the line and hit one of two free throws, but saw the miss on the second put back with a dunk from Hutcheson to bring the lead down to two.

Bucknell managed to pull back ahead by four with 2:31 remaining, and again with 1:37 remaining. With 14 seconds to go, UAlbany came within one after a layup from Lauderdale, but Bucknell hit two free throws to go up by three with 10 seconds remaining. Rizzuto hit a layup at the buzzer, but only brought the Danes within one at the final horn, 65-64.

Clark finished the game with 18 points on 5-10 shooting and 6-8 from the line. Healy finished with a career-high 11 rebounds to go with 15 points, three assists, and two steals. UAlbany led by as many as 15 in the first half, and by as many as 12 in the second half, only to see the Bison pull off the comeback victory.

**Up next:** The Great Danes visit ACC opponent Boston College on Tuesday, December 10, before hosting the final home game of 2019 on Saturday, December 14 against Niagara.

## WILL BROWN - 19TH SEASON AT UALBANY



Will Brown begins his 19th season overall as the University at Albany's men's basketball head coach, after spending one season in an interim capacity. Brown, the longest tenured coach in the America East Conference, has led the program to five conference championships, five NCAA Tournament appearances, two CollegiateInsider.com Postseason Tournament appearances, one CBI Postseason appearance and an unparalleled success in the classroom.

UAlbany's streak of 20-win seasons came to an end in 2018-19, as the Great Danes finished 12-20 overall with a mark of 7-9 in the America East. UAlbany returned just one starter from the 2017-18 squad, two-time America East All-Defense selection Devonte Campbell, and began the season starting freshmen at three positions. Eventually, the Danes would start four, and then five freshmen, as the season continued. Following a 5-10 non-conference slate, UAlbany opened the America East schedule 0-5, before rebounding to win seven of their last 11 to clinch the six-seed in the 2019 America East Tournament. Redshirt-freshman Cameron Healy was named to the America East All-Rookie Team, and the All-Conference Third Team. Junior Ahmad Clark was also named to the All-Conference Third Team, and senior Devonte Campbell earned his third

All-Defensive selection. Cameron Healy finished the season holding both the freshman record for total points in a season, 512, and the overall program record for three-pointers made and attempted in a single season, with 104 and 251, respectively. Healy also led the America East in threes per game, 3.3, and free throw percentage, .884, while Clark finished with the conference lead in assists per game, 4.3.

Brown earned the program's first NCAA Division I Tournament win in 2013-14 when the Purple & Gold took down Mount St. Mary's in the First Four 71-64 in Dayton, Ohio. He led UAlbany to its second-straight America East title in 2013-14, as the No. 4 seed. The Great Danes repeated their feat as the lowest seed to ever win the tournament, once again knocking off the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds and taking the title on the road.

The 2012-13 Great Danes arguably ended their season as their most successful in league history with a 24-11 record, a NCAA Tournament Second Round appearance and won the America East Conference Tournament Championship. Following his third conference tournament championship, he became the fourth America East Conference head coach with at least three conference tournament titles. The 24 wins is a program-best for most wins in a season at UAlbany in Division I. The Great Danes set a record for most non-conference wins in school history with 12.

Brown guided the Great Danes to their second straight America East Conference championship after defeating top-seed Vermont in the 2007 tournament final. The Great Danes, who earned an automatic NCAA berth, were seeded No. 13 against Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season winner Virginia. Brown's team totaled 20 victories during the regular season for the first time at the Division I level. UAlbany tied the second-highest single-season win total (23) in school history and posted consecutive 20-win campaigns for the first time in 17 years. Jamar Wilson made his second appearance on the Associated Press All-America squad.

Brown led the Great Danes to their first-ever NCAA Division I Tournament berth in 2005-06 after winning both the America East Conference tournament and regular-season titles. UAlbany set the program's Division I record for single-season victories with a 21-11 record and produced its highest win total since 1993-94. His squad posted UAlbany's first postseason triumph in 11 years with three wins in America East tournament play. The Great Danes, who also established their top conference mark with 13 victories in the regular season, went on to put up a monumental fight against second-ranked Connecticut in a memorable NCAA first-round battle. Brown was named the New York State Coach of the Year.

Brown was appointed as UAlbany's head coach on March 13, 2002, and has worked on the collegiate level since 1995. He became the 15th head coach in the history of the program. At age 40, Brown is still one of the youngest Division I head coaches in the nation.

Coach Brown and his wife, Jamie, work closely with many charitable organizations in the Capital District and surrounding areas. Jamie currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Big Brothers, Big Sisters Organization of the Capital Region. She also serves as the Associate Board of Directors for St. Peter's Hospital and co-chairs Coaches vs. Cancer to benefit the American Cancer Society. The Browns are also involved with the upstate Northeastern New York chapter of the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of America.

Brown, who joined the UAlbany staff as an assistant in Sept. 2001, was promoted to interim head coach on Dec. 20 of that year, and guided the Great Danes to a 7-13 record over the last 20 games. UAlbany was among the conference leaders in scoring defense. He coached the team to several impressive victories, including a win over Vermont, the America East Conference's regular-season champion.

Brown previously served as the head coach at Sullivan County Community College in Loch Sheldrake, N.Y., from 1998-2001. He led the Generals to a 90-10 record over a three-year period with two regional and two district titles. Sullivan County C.C. posted a 30-2 record and reached the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) championship game in 2000-01. Brown's first SCCC squad appeared in the NJCAA "Final Four" and finished 32-3 overall. The Generals were ranked second nationally in scoring at 92.9 points per game, and ninth in team defense with a 67.1 average.

Previous to his appointment at Sullivan County C.C., Brown spent three years at The College of Saint Rose as an assistant coach on Brian Beaur's staff. The Golden Knights made two NCAA Division II "Elite Eight" appearances in that span, and captured three New York Collegiate Athletic Conference (NYCAC) championships and two Northeast Regional crowns. Saint Rose compiled an 88-13 record from 1995-98.

As a collegiate player, Brown was a two-time NYCAC all-star and three-year starter at Dowling College, an NCAA Division II program on Long Island. He is the only player in school history to combine for more than 1,000 points and 500 assists. Brown completed his career as Dowling's all-time leader in assists (591), three-point field goals (181) and free throw percentage (.859). He also played second singles on the school's tennis team.

A native of Miller Place, N.Y., Brown earned first-team Class B all-state recognition as a high school senior, when he averaged more than 35 points per game. He was chosen All-Long Island and was a three-time All-Suffolk County selection. In May 2010, Brown was inducted into the Suffolk Sports Hall of Fame.

Brown resides in Latham with his wife, Jamie, and their two sons, Jackson and Landon. Brown has a master's degree in management and a B.A. in marketing from Dowling College. His father, William, Jr., has served as director of athletics at Miller Place High School, where he previously was head basketball coach for 17 years. His teams won three Suffolk County League VII scholastic titles.

### **Jon Iati - 8th Season (UAlbany '07, '09)**

Jon Iati, with the team since 2012, was promoted to associate head coach for the 2017-18 season. He has since helped UAlbany to six consecutive national postseason appearances, including three consecutive America East Championships from 2013-15. He previously served as the team's director of basketball operations.



### **Greig Stire - 2nd Season (UAlbany '18)**

After using his final semester of eligibility playing for the UAlbany football team following the conclusion of his basketball career, Stire returned to UAlbany men's basketball on the sidelines to take over as video coordinator mid-way through the 2018-19 season. Stire played four years for UAlbany, averaging 6.2 points and 5.6 rebounds per game in 132 appearances for the Great Danes. At the time of his graduation, Stire holds the program record for single season total rebounds with 266 and rebounding average with 8.3, and a share of the single-game program record for rebounds with 15. Stire's 132 games played rank second in program history, one game behind Blake Metcalf, and his 99 career starts rank in a tie for third.


