KICK OFF

- Little Rock picked up a pair of wins over the weekend, defeating Mississippi Valley State 2-0 on Friday and Kansas State 2-1 on Sunday.
- Kayla Turner scored the game-winner for Little Rock on Friday and Harrison Hayworth got the game-winner for Little Rock on Sunday.
- Hayworth is tied for 29th in the nation in game-winning goals (2) as of Monday morning.
- The Trojans are 27th in the nation in shots per game and 26th in shots on goal per game as of Monday morning.
- Little Rock's Jaclyn Purvine has the team lead in points with three goals and two assists for eight total points.
- The Trojans are second in the Sun Belt in shots and goals and third in goals allowed.
- Little Rock will be seeking its first win against Louisiana since 2011 and its first ever against Texas State this weekend.

THE SERIES AGAINST TEXAS STATE

Little Rock and Texas State have squared off just three times – all since the Bobcats joined the Sun Belt three years ago – and Texas State won all three contests. The Bobcats won in 2013 by a 4-0 score and claimed a 2-1 win in Little Rock in 2014. Last season, the Bobcats escaped with a 2-1 victory in double overtime after a Trojan own goal gave Texas State the sudden death win.

A WIN AGAINST TEXAS STATE WOULD...

...be the Trojans' third straight win overall and the team's second three-game winning streak this year...be the first ever against Texas State...begin Sun Belt play with a win for the first time since 2008.

THE SERIES AGAINST LOUISIANA

The Cajuns have a large lifetime advantage against the Trojans, winning 11 of 16 total contests in the series. Louisiana had won three consecutive games in the series including a close 2-1 contest in Lafayette in 2014 before the teams tied in 2015. The tie was one of the Trojans' four in league play last year.

LITTLE ROCK VS. THE SUN BELT

Since the Trojans joined the Sun Belt Conference in 2000, the team has compiled a record of 37-103-9 in conference games. Little Rock's best conference season came last year when it went 3-2-4 in the league and finished fifth for its best-ever seed in the Sun Belt Tournament. That also marked the first year Little Rock was above .500 in league play.

PURVINE GETS MORE POINTS

Sophomore Jaclyn Purvine continues to lead the Trojans in scoring this season, adding three points to her year total over the weekend with a goal against Kansas State and an assist against Mississippi Valley State. Purvine has three goals and two assists for eight points, already surpassing the seven points she racked up as a freshman. She is currently third in points and third in goals scored in the Sun Belt.

PUTTING UP SHOTS

Little Rock outshot Mississippi Valley State by an incredible 38-0 on Friday night, keeping the Devilettes off the board completely while peppering the MVSU goal with shots on the other end. On the year, the Trojans rank 27th in the nation in total shots per game and 26th in shots on goal per game. Little Rock's 146 total shots taken is second in the Sun Belt this year, just one behind Louisiana.

HAYWORTH STRIKES AGAIN

Harrison Hayworth got the Trojans' game-winning goal against Kansas State on Sunday, her second career game-winning goal and second in five games. Hayworth is now tied for 29th in the country with her two game-winning goals.

CAREER FIRSTS FOR ROBBINS

Against Mississippi Valley State on Friday, Shara Robbins picked up her first career start and also came away with her first career win. The Trojan senior had played in three games in her career to that point for a total of just 105 minutes. She has played in 90 minutes this season, also playing the entire second half against UAPB on August 30.

TURNER SCORES ON SENIOR NIGHT

Getting the start on Senior Night on Friday, Kayla Turner scored a goal for the first time since her first career game more than three years ago. In that first career game in August 2013, Turner scored twice. Her first-half goal against MVSU on Friday was just the third time she scored a goal in a Trojan uniform.

DEFENDING WELL

Despite taking a 1-0 loss, the Trojans played stellar defense against No. 14 Texas A&M on Friday night. Little Rock only allowed the Aggies to take 12 total shots, and only six of those shots were on goal. Sara Small made five of the six saves asked of her in the loss. Small has come up huge against Power 5 competition in her career, shutting out Texas last season and giving up just one goal while making 13 saves against Ole Miss in 2015.

RECORD-SETTING SMALL

Trojan senior keeper Sara Small had a tremendous junior year in her first significant action of her college career. After transferring from Wake Forest where she played under 10 minutes in three years,

Small came to Little Rock and now holds the team's career goals against average record with a 0.98 and save percentage with .805. Small allowed just 21 goals in 1,849 minutes and set a new program record with 6.1 shutouts in a season in 2015.

TOP 10 SCORER

Thanks to her goal against UAPB on August 30, Little Rock forward Fali Garuba has moved into the top 10 all-time in program history in goals and points. Garuba's goal was the 15th of her career, tying her for 10th all-time with Georgeanne Elder and Ariel Galletti. She also reached 38 points, tying for ninth in program history with Lisa Stuart. Garuba is also sixth in school history with four GWGs.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Midfielder Harrison Hayworth and goalie Sara Small were named the Sun Belt Conference's Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week on August 30 after stellar performances the previous weekend. Hayworth had a goal and an assist against previously unbeaten Memphis, and Small posted two shutouts in wins over Missouri State and Memphis. Hayworth is the first Trojan to win the Sun Belt weekly award since 2012, and Small has now won her third Defensive Player of the Week award from the league. Little Rock has never won both awards in a single week until Tuesday.

MIXING MINUTES

Little Rock has used 21 different starters and 25 total players in its first eight games of the season, getting more than two-thirds of its roster some playing time.

SMALL REACHES 100 SAVES

Senior goalkeeper Sara Small reached 100 career saves when she picked up nine saves combined in wins against Memphis and Missouri State. Small also recorded shutouts in both of those games, bringing her career shutout number up to 8.1. Small ranks second in Trojan history now in shutouts and 13th in total saves. She is also second in team history in wins, first in career goals against average and first all-time in save percentage.

LONG GOES FAR

Senior defender Hali Long had an incredible summer, earning a spot on the Philippines National Team. Long became the first Trojan to ever play for a country's national team. As part of her duty with the Philippines, Long participated in the AFF Women's Championship tournament in Myanmar in late July, helping the Philippines to one win.

COACH ADRIAN BLEWITT

Adrian Blewitt was named Little Rock's head soccer coach in December 2012, and he was immediately tasked with turning around a struggling program. After three years with the Trojans, that turnaround is fully under way.



Little Rock doubled its win total from 2012 to 2013, reaching the Sun Belt Conference Tournament for the first time since 2009. Junior Ariel Galletti was named to the All-Sun Belt First Team, and the Trojans scored five more goals while allowing 41 fewer goals from their opposition.

The following year, Little Rock more than doubled its win total once again. The Trojans finished the 2014 season with an 11-8-1 record, the first winning record in school history. Little Rock also set a school record for wins in a year with 11 and had program-bests in goals scored, team goals against average and shutouts. The Trojans had an incredible start to the season, beginning with nine consecutive victories that set a Little Rock record in any sport for the most wins to open a season.

In 2015, more team records were broken. Little Rock finished the season in fifth place in the Sun Belt Conference, the team's highest-ever finish. The Trojans made the league tournament for the third consecutive year while setting the program record for goals against average (1.07). Little Rock tied Texas and took Ole Miss to overtime while goalkeeper Sara Small had the best GAA in team history (0.97).

Blewitt now has a career head coaching record of 98-60-16 with women's teams and 195-98-18 overall. With the Trojans, he is 28-32-6.

In 17 years as a head coach, Blewitt led his teams to appearances in the Sweet 16 and Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament and six conference championships, and he has won four conference or region Coach of the Year honors. On three separate occasions, Blewitt's teams have finished the year ranked in the top 10 nationally.

Blewitt compiled a 167-66-12 overall record as a head men's and women's soccer coach at NCAA Division II schools Lees-McRae College and Lenoir-Rhyne University, including a 36-5-3 mark in his final two seasons as head coach at Lenoir-Rhyne. After three years at Little Rock, his career record stands at 193-98-18.

Blewitt's coaching experience includes seven years at Lenoir-Rhyne University (2005-11), including the last five as the head women's soccer coach.

Over his career, Blewitt has coached five NCAA Division II All-Americans, four conference Players of the Year and four Freshmen of the Year winners.

Blewitt earned his bachelor's degree in health and physical education in 1994 and his master's degree in liberal arts in 1996, both from Lock Haven University.

A native of Grimsby, England, Blewitt and his wife Tamara have one daughter, JoElle.
