AGGIE SOCCER FIELD

Aggie Soccer Field has been the home to the UC Davis men's and women's soccer teams since 1985. Built with primarily volunteer time and materials, Aggie Soccer Field is a product of the community's dedication to the sport of soccer.

The stadium bleachers, which have a capacity of 1,000 spectators, are the result of a 10-year project that reached completion in 1997. There are 65 nameplates affixed to the seat backs to recognize major stadium contributors. Additionally, an electronic scoreboard and high-fidelity sound system has been added to the facility.

Furthermore, new restrooms and concessions were added to the baseball/soccer complex during the 2001-02 year. In the summer of 2005, the field was resurfaced with a Bermuda hybrid and a new irrigation system was installed. Mark Lucas, who had previously worked at California, returned to UC Davis to supervise this project.

In 1994, Aggie Soccer Field was among those facilities invited to submit a bid to become a training facilities for the World Cup.

COACHING STAFF



TWILA KAUFMAN

Head Coach
5th Season
Arizona '03

Bringing with her high-level experiences as both a player and a coach, Head Coach Twila Kaufman enters her fifth season at the helm of the UC Davis women's soccer program in 2018.

Appointed to the post in January of 2014 after spending the previous 10 seasons as an assistant and associate head coach at Pepperdine, Kaufman has continued to build the Aggie program since taking over as only the second head coach in the program's Division I history, guiding UC Davis steadily up the table in the Big West Conference.

During her tenure, 12 different student-athletes have combined for a total of 14 All-Big West awards, while the Aggies have also had five student-athletes named to the league's all-freshman team -- including one in each of her four previous seasons.

Off the field, her charges have also excelled, earning a total of 32 Big West All-Academic Team awards. Former standout Ana Marija Sola was named to the CoSIDA All-District VIII squad in 2015, and was named the recipient of a prestigious NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship later that school year along with Big West Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year accolades.

In addition, former standout Mari Pastor was one of 200 student-athletes nationwide invited to participate in the 2015 NCAA Career in Sports Forum.

After winning just five matches and finishing seventh in the league in her first year, the long-time coach bounced back in the second season of the Kaufman era, finishing 10-7-2 overall -- the second-highest win total in the program's Division I history -- and moving up one spot in the conference standings to sixth.

The seven non-conference wins that year -- including triumphs over three-time Mountain West Conference champion San Diego State, Saint Mary's, Eastern Washington, and Causeway Cup rival Sacramento State -- were the most in the program's Division I history and matched the team's non-conference win total for the previous two seasons combined.

Out of the 328 Div. I teams across the country, the 2015 team also recorded its highest Ratings Percentage Index in school history. Commonly known as the RPI, this figure is a quantity used to rank sports teams based upon its wins, losses, and strength of schedule.

In both 2016 and 2017, Kaufman had the Aggies in contention for one of four coveted Big West Tournament berths right up until the final weekend of the regular season, and had UC Davis atop the league standings with its best conference start at the Division I level at 3-0-1 before becoming the final Big West team to suffer a defeat in league play.

Prior to taking over the program at UC Davis, Kaufman helped lead the Waves to four NCAA Tournament berths from 2004-13, including a "Sweet 16" appearance thanks to wins over Mississippi and Samford and a final No. 15 national ranking in 2005.

Elevated to associate head coach in 2008, she then helped lead Pepperdine to a West Coast Conference title, NCAA first-round appearance, and No. 10 national ranking in 2011, finishing the year 15-2-4 overall and 7-1 in the WCC.

During her tenure in Malibu, the Waves were one of the West Coast's most accomplished programs in that span, posting a 108-63-29 (.613) record.

Kaufman was integral in all areas of the Waves' program, including practice planning, academics, conditioning, and game management. She also served as the program's recruiting coordinator, annually bringing freshman classes that were nationally ranked by Soccer Buzz magazine. Kaufman is known for recruiting balanced classes that feature highly touted players as well as hidden gems.

Pepperdine also sent several players to the international stage, including national teams for Iceland, Italy, Mexico, South Africa, and the United States Under-23 team.

Outside of her collegiate coaching duties, Kaufman brings with her a wealth of experience at various levels in the sport, including the Los Angeles Legends as the USL's W-League, which featured some of the top women's soccer players in North America.

She was also a volunteer assistant coach at Northern Arizona and was co-director at the Northern Arizona Training Academy. Kaufman has also been involved long term with Region IV Olympic Development Program and has been involved with the United States Soccer Federation national training centers, most recently as a director for the Los Angeles Training Center of Southern California.

Kaufman is a 2003 graduate of Arizona where she earned her undergraduate degree in secondary education. That followed an outstanding playing career as a four-year starter and ended her career having played more matches than any Wildcat in team history, Kaufman etched her name on several top-10 lists, was a two-time honoree on the Pacific-10 Conference All-Academic team, and was the team's Rookie of the Year in 1998.

She continued her playing career with the Arizona Heatwave of the W-1 League.

Kaufman added a master's degree in coaching and athletic administration from Concordia University in 2009 and earned her USSF National "A" license in 2010.

After enjoying an outstanding playing career at Pepperdine, Rachael Collins enters her second season as an assistant coach with the UC Davis women's soccer program in 2018.

"It is an absolute joy for us to welcome Rachael to UC Davis. She comes from a championship club environment, and a college program that is very near and dear to me," said Head Coach Twila Kaufman upon the announcement of Collins' hire. "I was involved in her recruitment to Pepperdine, coached her during her freshman year, and have enjoyed watching her from afar ever since. It is a dream come true to work with her now; we are excited to be part of her first step as a coach, and are thrilled that she will mentor our players."

Added Collins, "I am honored and unbelievably excited to work with UC Davis' women's soccer program, and for an incredible head coach in Twila Kaufman. This team has a plan and a vision, I am eager to contribute to its growth and development. There is something special about creating positive, joyful and competitive culture on a team, and I look forward to helping everyone continue building this on and off the field."

Collins played a key role in the Waves' on-field success after immediately earning a spot in the starting lineup during her freshman season. It was her two-way play as a midfielder that led Pepperdine to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 berth during the 2014 season.

The Littleton, Colo., native truly led by example on and off the field, which is why Pepperdine selected her as a Maurice Hilliard Award recipient. Named after the school's late athletic chaplain, this prestigious honor is received annually by a student-athlete that exemplifies the attributes of Christian faith, character and leadership.

Collins also earned West Coast Conference Commissioner's Honor Roll, WCC All-Academic Honorable Mention and Scholar-Athlete accolades throughout her undergraduate career.

Shortly after the 2016 season concluded, Collins joined Pepperdine's Sports Medicine unit as an undergraduate athletic medical intern, which provided valuable hands-on experience for her since she holds a bachelor's degree in sports medicine.

Added Kaufman, "A colleague once told me after playing us during Rachael's freshmen year that they imagined she was the spitting image of me as a player. I told them that I took that as a huge compliment because she was a significantly better midfielder than I ever was. One of Rachael's roles here is to paint the picture of what a complete midfielder looks like, through coaching and personal demonstration."

The Aggies' assistant also possesses five years of playing experience with the Colorado Rush Soccer Club, an organization based in Littleton. Throughout that timespan, Collins started for the Rush Women's W-League team, trained, competed alongside, and against a field of players that continued their careers at the Division I level.

"Rachael was on one of the best teams in the country as a youth player and will no doubt be able to recruit elite players for us. Most importantly, she will help this program's culture evolve by finding student-athletes who possess similar core values. She has all the makings of an awesome recruiter," said Kaufman.



ALYSSA WHITEHEAD

Assistant Coach
1st Season
Samford '12

After helping Samford to at least a share of the last three Southern Conference titles and helping guide her alma mater to a 2016 NCAA Tournament berth, former Bulldogs' standout goalkeeper and coach Alyssa Whitehead joins the UC Davis staff for her first season as an assistant coach in 2018.

Following a record-setting four-year career as a goalkeeper at Samford from 2008-11, Whitehead joined the Bulldogs' coaching staff in the summer of 2015, where her responsibilities included planning and implementing training sessions for goalkeepers, handling team travel, academic oversight, and assisting in recruiting.

She made an immediate impact on the program, helping her alma mater to Southern Conference regular season titles in 2015-17, while claiming the conference tournament championship in 2016 to earn a berth into the NCAA Tournament where the Bulldogs faced Florida State in the first round. Whitehead coached Samford keeper Anna Maddox to three All-Southern Conference awards — including first team honors in 2015 and 2016 — while her goalkeepers allowed just a single goal in conference play during her first year on staff.

During her time in Birmingham, Ala., the Bulldogs finished a combined 42-15-5 overall during the last three seasons and lost only two SoCon games in that same span, finishing 24-2-1 in league play.

Outside of her work with the Bulldogs, Whitehead also served as a goalkeeper coach with the U.S. Olympic Development Program Region III as well as the Birmingham United Soccer Association, while also serving as a volunteer assistant at Oak Grove High School in her hometown of Hattiesburg, Miss.

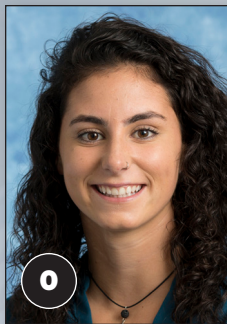
A four-year varsity starter and four-time All-SoCon selection at Samford, Whitehead finished her career as the school's all-time leader in shutouts (32) and finished with a career-high 120 saves as a senior in 2011, completing her career with 50 consecutive starts in net. She was a United Soccer Coaches All-Southeast Regional honoree as a sophomore, leading the nation with a 0.31 goals against average — including holding opponents to without a goal for 730 consecutive minutes at one point — and finishing third in the NCAA with a .910 save percentage.

Whitehead capped off her senior season with a SoCon regular season and tournament championship, advancing the Bulldogs to the NCAA Tournament. In 2018, she became the first soccer player inducted into the Samford Athletics Hall of Fame.

Following her decorated collegiate career, Whitehead competed for the W-League's Charlotte Lady Eagles from 2009-11, earning the league's Goalkeeper of the Year and a spot on the all-conference team in 2010, before taking her talents abroad to play three professional seasons in Sweden with Umea Sodra FF from 2012-13, and Mallbacken IF in 2014.

She finished with seven shutouts in 2012 with Umea Sodra FF, while helping Mallbacken IF to the Elitettan Division title in 2014, finishing with nine clean sheets and helping the club earn promotion to the Damallsvenskan — Sweden's top division.

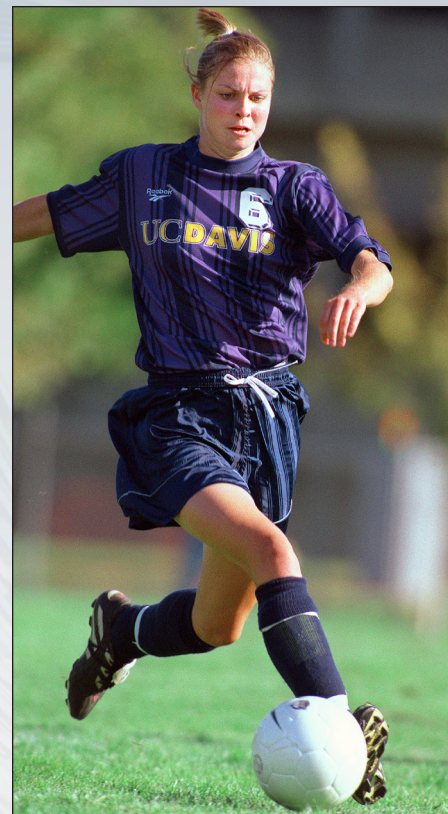
