AGGIE STORYLINES...

- UC Davis returns eight letter winners and three starters off of last season's squad that finished 17-12 overall -- it's fifth consecutive winning season -- and 12-4 in Big West Conference play.
- The Aggies have won the last four consecutive outright Big West regular season titles, making them one of three schools in the history of the league to accomplish such a feat (UC Santa Barbara from 1996-2005 and Long Beach State from 1985-89).
- It marks the first time in school history that UC Davis has won four consecutive OUTRIGHT league titles. However, the Aggies did win five straight league titles during their Division II days -- four in the Northern California Athletic Conference and one in the California Collegiate Athletic Association -- from 1994-99, but shared the 1997-98 NCAC title.
- UC Davis is one of seven schools to have won at least 4 straight conference regular season titles: UConn (7 in the American Athletic Conference), Baylor (10 in the Big 12), Central Michigan (5 divisional titles in the Mid-American Conference), Robert Morris (4 in the Northeast Conference), Ohio Valley - Belmont (4 in the Ohio Valley Conference), Gonzaga (4 in the West Coast Conference).
- UC Davis is a combined 55-9 in Big West play over the last four years entering the 2020-21 season, with the next-closest school being CSUN at 35-29 in conference play (the only two programs with a winning record in that span).
- Head Coach **JENNIFER GROSS** has won the last four consecutive Big West Coach of the Year awards -- the first time in conference history that has happened -- and stands behind only Mark French of UCSB (7) for the most in league history.
- Together for the last 10 years, Gross, Associate Head Coaches **JOE TERAMOTO** and **DES ABEYTA**, and Assistant Coach **MATT KLEMIN** make up the longest-tenured Division I coaching staff in the nation.
- With her 10 years at the helm, Gross is the third-longest tenured head coach in school history behind only Sandy Simpson (14 years) and Pam Gill-Fisher (12 years).
- Gross stands 24 wins shy of 200 for her career, and clinched her 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23 against UC San Diego.
- Gross' 176 wins ranks third in school history and tied for sixth in league history, with her 100 league wins also seventh in the Big West annals. She trails only Simpson (251) and Jorja Hoehn (205).
- UC Davis won its 250th game as a Division I program on Jan. 22 at home against UC San Diego.
- Entering the year, the Aggies' 248 wins since joining the Big West in 2007-08 are the most of any active member, followed by Cal Poly (201), UC Santa Barbara (184), and Long Beach State (184).
- Five Aggies entered the 2020-21 season on professional rosters in Europe: **MORGAN BERTSCH** (Pszczolka AZS-UMCS Lublin in Poland), **PELE GIANOTTI** (T71 Basket Dudelange in Luxembourg), **KATIE TOOLE** (RACA Granada in Spain), **NINA BESSOLO** (AS Niki Lefkadas in Greece) and **SOPHIA SONG** (Manchester Met Mystics in England).

NEWS & NOTABLES...

- Both of this weekend's games will be streamed live on ESPN3.
- UC Davis makes its first ESPN3 regular season appearance since a win at CSUN on Jan. 24, 2019, and only the fifth and sixth all time appearances on the platform since 2014.
- The Aggies are 3-1 in their four previous ESPN3 appearances, winning each of their last three.
- UC Davis junior Sage Stobbart was one of 15 student-athletes from across the country named to the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year award on Tuesday.
- Stobbart, who tied a career high with 18 points in the opener against UC San Diego and added her sixth career double-double in game two, entered the week leading the nation at 4.00 blocks per game.
- Following its sweep of UC San Diego in its return to the court last weekend, UC Davis jumped five spots to No. 18 in the **COLLEGE INSIDER** Mid-Major poll as of Jan. 26, up from No. 23.
- The Aggies have been ranked as high as No. 15 in the mid-major poll back on Dec. 8 and have been among the top 20 every week this season, extending its run to 11 consecutive weeks dating back to the final 2019-20 poll.
- The No. 15 ranking is the highest standing for UC Davis in that poll since the Aggies finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 12 in the final mid-major rankings.
- Until the Aggies took the court against UC San Diego on Jan. 22, only one other Division I school had played fewer games this season. Merrimack College of the Northeast Conference officially opened its season against Fairleigh Dickinson on Jan. 23.
- After waiting 264 days between the final game of the halted 2019-20 campaign and the season opener against San Francisco, UC Davis waited 59 more days for the ball to be in the air again when it tipped off against league newcomer UC San Diego.
- All told, the Aggies have had 14 games cancelled, thus far, either due to COVID concerns with other programs or a December Yolo County health order that forced UC Davis to pause activity indefinitely.
- **#PROTECTTHEPAV:** The Aggies are a combined 52-7 at The Pavilion during their championship streak (dating back to 2016-17), having won 12 of their last 13 on their home floor. UC Davis has posted a winning record at home in each of the last seven seasons entering 2020-21.

LOOKING BACK...

- UC Davis posted a pair of milestones with its sweep of UC San Diego, clinching the program's 250th Division I victory in the opener on Jan. 22, and coach Jennifer Gross' 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23
- Gross becomes only the seventh coach to reach 100 conference wins, trailing Hawai'i's Vince Goo,

- who won 108 league games from 1987-96, for sixth
- Gross' 176 overall career victories ranks her tied for sixth in league with Cal State Fullerton's Dr. Maryalyce Jeremiah, and only three wins back of Goo for fifth
- Coupled with the 82 points scored in the season-opening win over San Francisco, the 80 points scored in the opener against UC San Diego gave the Aggies back-to-back 80-point performances for the first time since March 9 & 15, 2019, against UC Santa Barbara (W, 80-44) and UC Irvine (W, 82-50).
- UC Davis tied the school single-game record with 17 three-pointers made in the opener against the Tritons, matching the mark set in 2007 against Cal Poly and later tied against Long Beach State in 2015, and against Washington State in 2017.
- UC Davis has hit at least one three-pointer in 526 consecutive games dating back to Feb. 15, 2003, at Cal State San Bernardino. Since then, the Aggies have shot .351 (3,682-for-10,488) from beyond the arc.
- It is believed to be the fourth-longest active streak of its kind in the nation, trailing only Iowa State (820 games since 1995), Chattanooga (670 since 1999), and Milwaukee (571 since 2002), as of Jan. 23.
- The UC Davis defense limited UC San Diego to just .259 (14-for-54) shooting from the field in game two of their series -- including an 0-for-11 showing in the second quarter alone -- marking the lowest percentage by an Aggie opponent since Hawai'i shot just .246 (15-for-61) from the floor on Feb. 22, 2020.
- UC Davis also limited the Tritons to just .100 (2-for-20) shooting from beyond the arc -- the lowest since holding CSUN to just .063 (1-for-16) on Jan. 29, 2020.
- The four points surrendered in the second quarter of game two against UCSD are tied for the second fewest in a single quarter by an Aggie opponent since the NCAA returned to the quarter format for the 2015-16 season.
- The Aggies led wire-to-wire in game two against the Tritons -- the first time UC Davis has done that since Feb. 12, 2020, against Cal Poly in a 71-58 victory.
- Junior **KAYLA KONRAD** set a career high with 20 points in the opener against UCSD -- her first career 20-point game -- tying her career high with seven field goals made and setting a career high with four three-pointers in the contest.
- Senior **CIERRA HALL** posted her second straight double-double -- and the fifth of her career -- in the opener against UCSD, finishing with 11 points and 10 rebounds.
- The 10 rebounds marked the 15th double-digit rebounding performance of her career.
- Junior **SAGE STOBART** tied her career high with 18 points in the opener against UCSD, set a career high with five three-pointers made, and added three blocks.

- One day later, Stobbart added her sixth career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds in game two against the Tritons, adding four more swats.
- With seven blocks on the weekend, Stobbart moved into ninth on the school's career list with 67, breaking a tie with Lauren Juric (2007-12) and Marly Anderson (2016-18).
- After opening the year hitting her first seven shots en route to 19 points against San Francisco, sophomore **EVANNE TURNER** was a perfect 5-for-5 (including 4-for-4 from behind the arc) in the opener against UCSD.
- Senior **MACKENZIE TRPCIC** collected seven assists in the opener against UC San Diego – the 16th time she has finished with five-or-more helpers in a game in her Aggie career.
- Newcomers **MAZATLAN HARRIS** and **BRIA SHINE** made their collegiate debuts in the opener against the Tritons, each draining a three-pointer during the Aggies' record-tying performance.
- **KENEDY LILLY** also made her collegiate debut in the series against UCSD, grabbing her first career rebound in game two

RECYCLED NOTES...

- Hall was one of five unanimous picks to both the coaches' and media's preseason all-conference teams after earning league defensive player of the year, all-defensive team, and All-Big West second team honors in 2019-20.
- Hall is the closest active Aggie to 1,000 career points points at 689, and needs 429 rebounds this year to hit 1,000. She only needs 138 rebounds to break Doherty's program Division I career record (708), which would place her fourth on the all-time list at 709.
- UC Davis was a unanimous pick to claim its fifth consecutive Big West crown in 2020-21 by both the media and coaches. The Aggies picked up six of the 11 first-place votes (101 points overall) from the coaches and 13 of the 20 media first-place votes (207 points overall).
- The 2020-21 roster will be the tallest in school history thanks to the additions of a trio of towering 2019-20 redshirts in 6-6 Svanholm (Colorado State), 6-5 freshman **KENEDY LILLY**, and 6-3 freshman **MEGAN JONES**
- Four players on this year's roster measure taller than 6-foot-3 — tied for the most in the history of the program
- Svanholm is believed to be the second-tallest in the history of the program, trailing only 6-foot-8 Kelly Ditto, who was a three-year letter winner for the Aggies in 1999 and 2001-02.
- UC Davis adds three true freshmen to the roster for 2020-21 in **BRIA SHINE** (6-1, G, Sacramento, Calif. / Christian Brothers HS), Carreon (5-10, Wing, Chula Vista, Calif. / San Diego Christian HS), and **MAZATLAN HARRIS** (6-2, F, San Diego, Calif. / Cathedral Catholic HS).
- UC Davis reloaded its roster by signing three high school standouts during November's early signing period: **SYDNEY BURNS** (Wilsonville, Ore. / Wilsonville HS), **MARLEY LANGI** (Redwood City, Calif. / Archbishop Mitty HS), and **MEGAN NORRIS** (Atherton, Calif. / Sacred Heart Prep).
- The **BIG WEST CONFERENCE** has a new look for 2020-21, officially welcoming CSU Bakersfield and UC San Diego to the fold, bring the league's total number of teams to 11
- The Roadrunners join the Big West after seven years in the Western Athletic Conference, while the Tritons begin their NCAA-mandated four-year reclassification period to Division I.
- UCSD will be included in all Big West round-robin schedules, but will not be eligible for the conference tournament until it officially completes its reclassification in July, 2024.
- In order to minimize travel and emphasize the health and safety of the student-athletes, there will be a new Big West scheduling format for 2020-21, with teams facing the same opponent on back-to-back nights rather than the traditional home-and-home schedule.

“We are uncommonly committed to preparing student-athletes for successful lives after graduation. Our approach is based on the science of human development. You will not find another school more dedicated to helping you be positioned for a great job or grad school opportunity after sports end, whenever that may be.”

It is this uncommon commitment towards student-athletes that led to the creation of the Aggie EVO System, a multi-faceted student-athlete outcomes program focused on preparing young men and women for a successful launch after graduating from the sixth-ranked public school in the nation.

We define launch as moving beyond graduation into a meaningful professional path that builds on the college experience, sets a graduate on a path of financial and social well-being and effectively replaces the sport as the primary piece of their identity.

The Aggie EVO System (“EVO” is shorthand for a student-athlete’s “evolution” during college) is an important part of the student-athlete experience at UC Davis – just like weights and conditioning, attending class or getting athletic medicine treatment. This unprecedented program was designed to focus on four key elements to help UC Davis student-athletes prepare for future success by helping them better “know and navigate the World of Work”:

- **SKILLS** that employers want and will make student-athletes even more effective in their sports: self awareness, emotional intelligence, social/cultural competence and leadership.
- **KNOWLEDGE** of what careers and paths are out there (we call this the “World of Work”), what fits one’s interests and abilities, who in our gigantic network can advise and guide them and each individual can navigate a path to get there.
- **OPPORTUNITIES** to enjoy internships, jobs and other learning opportunities through a powerful network of Aggie alums. Student-athletes hear from and meet alums in a wide variety of fields, attend recruiting events and visit members of the EVO Pro network at companies in San Francisco, Silicon Valley, and Sacramento.
- **TOOLS** that student-athletes need to secure these opportunities. We require a few more basic tools or updates each year they are on campus. This includes resumes and cover letters, LinkedIn profiles, interviewing skills, business cards, professional headshots, and anything else that helps student-athletes prepare for a more successful launch.
