AGGIE STORYLINES...

- UC Davis returns 11 letter winners and four starters off of last season's squad that finished 13-3 overall it's sixth consecutive winning season and 9-1 in Big West Conference play during a pandemic-shortened 2020-21 campaign that featured a two-month layoff due to Yolo County health restrictions.
- The Aggies have won the last five consecutive Big West regular season titles, making them one of only two schools in league history to accomplish such a feat (UC Santa Barbara from 1996-2005).
- Last year marked the first time in school history that UC Davis won five consecutive OUTRIGHT league titles. The Aggies did win five straight league crowns during their Division II days -- four in the Northern California Athletic Conference and one in the California Collegiate Athletic Association -- from 1994-99, but shared the 1997-98 NCAC title.
- UC Davis is one of four active schools to have won at least five straight conference regular season titles: UConn (7 in the American Athletic Conference, 1 in the BIG EAST), Baylor (11 in the Big 12), and Gonzaga (5 in the West Coast Conference).
- UC Davis is a combined 64-10 in Big West play over the last five years entering the 2021-22 season, with the next-closest school, in terms of wins, being Long Beach State at 42-40 in conference play.
- UC Davis became the sixth program in conference history to win at least three Big West Tournament titles and the first repeat champion since 2014-15.
- Head Coach **JENNIFER GROSS** has won the last five consecutive Big West Coach of the Year awards -- the first time in conference history that has happened -- and stands behind only Mark French of UCSB (7) for the most in league history.
- Together for 11 years, Gross, Associate Head Coaches **JOE TERAMOTO** and **DES ABEYTA**, and Assistant Coach **MATT KLEMIN** make up the longest-tenured Division I coaching staff in the nation.
- With her 11 years at the helm, Gross is the third-longest tenured head coach in school history behind only Sandy Simpson (14 years) and Pam Gill-Fisher (12 years).
- Gross stands 10 wins shy of 200 overall for her career, and clinched her 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23 at home against UC San Diego.
- Gross' 190 wins ranks third in school history and fifth in league history, while her 107 league wins stand seventh in the Big West annals. She trails only Simpson (251) and Jorja Hoehn (205) in school lore.
- UC Davis' trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2021 marked the program's eighth postseason appearance in 14 years as a Division I program.
- The team's No. 12 seed in the tournament was the highest in program history and the highest for any Big West school since 2004 (UC Santa Barbara No. 11).

THIS WEEK: With finals week now behind it, the UC Davis women's basketball team returns its attention to the court for two games this week, beginning Monday afternoon (Dec. 13) at 4 p.m., against Stanislaus State at the University Credit Union Center.

IN THE RANKINGS: Thanks, in large part to their upset over nationally ranked Oregon, the Aggies jumped two spots to No. 16 in the Dec. 7 College Insider mid-major poll after hanging tough at No. 18 for two straight weeks. UC Davis opened the year at No. 9 in the preseason rankings -- marking the highest for the program in that poll since the Aggies stood at No. 8 in the Feb. 27, 2018, poll. UC Davis has been ranked every week dating back to the final poll of the 2019-20 season.

ABOUT THE WARRIORS: Stanislaus State enters the week with a 7-1 overall record and a 3-0 mark in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, having won seven straight after an one-point loss to Central Washington in its season opener... The Warriors face conference rivals Seattle Pacific (Dec. 9) and Humboldt State (Dec. 11) at home before taking on the Aggies... Stanislaus State has already played one exhibition against a Division I opponent this year, falling to Fresno State, 88-71, back on Nov. 17... Four Warriors are in double figures, led by forward Kyanna Davis, who is averaging a robust 20.1 ppg to go with 8.8 rpg and shooting 38 percent from the field -- including a team-high 19 three-pointers... Da'Myiah Lewis (12.0 ppg, .569 FG%), Kaleigh Taylor (10.6 ppg), and Liliana Marques (10.1 ppg) are also in double digits for Stanislaus State, which averages 66.8 ppg as a team while holding opponents to just 58.4 ppg.

SERIES NOTES: UC Davis leads the all-time series with its former Division II rival by a 43-20 count, winning the last two countable meetings back in 2004 -- and 22 of the last 25 -- including a run of 17 consecutive victories by the Aggies from 1993-2000... This will be the first meeting since a 91-76 UC Davis win in Turlock, Calif., on March 6, 2004... The Aggies are 24-8 all-time against the Warriors at home in the series, according to records that date back to the 1977-78 season.

11...10...9...8...: While there are milestones abound in the UC Davis career of senior forward Cierra Hall, the Cypress, Calif., native stands poised to add yet another in 2021-22. The countdown is on for Hall, who enters the game against Stanislaus State needing 11 more points to become the 21st player in school history to reach 1,000 for her career and the first since former teammate Morgan Bertsch did so during Hall's freshman year in 2017 against Pepperdine.

ALL HAIL HALL: A season-high 13 rebounds were more than just that for senior Cierra Hall in the team's win over Weber State as she became the all-time leading rebounder in the program's Division I history, finishing the win over the Wildcats on Nov. 26 with 713 rebounds to her name. Hall, who enters this week with 722 career boards, sprinted past the previous mark of 708 set by Alyson Doherty from 2012-16 and moved into fourth place on the school's all-time list, standing just 29 behind Staci Stevens' (1984-88) total of 751 for third. Hall is only the fifth player to reach the 700-rebound plateau for a career in school history, joining Carol Rische (1,028), Colleen Turnbull (790), Stevens, and Doherty.

BLOCK YOU VERY MUCH: Senior Sage Stobbart added to her team-best total with another swat against Washington State just before final exams,

giving her 13 for the season and 111 for her career -the latter moving her past Janae Henning (109 swats
from 1998-02) and into fifth place on the school's
career list.

KEEPING IT 100: Stobbart is one of only six players to ever eclipse the 100 block plateau along with Morgan Bertsch (193 from 2015-19), Paige Mintun (150 from 2006-11), Alyson Doherty (147 from 2012-16), Kendall Greene (119 from 1992-96), and Henning.

THREE FOR ALL: Having led the Big West in three-point shooting in each of the last four years (and five of the last six), the Aggies carry a significant streak into the 2021-22 season thanks to their prowess beyond the arc. UC Davis has hit at least one three-pointer in 546 consecutive games dating back to Feb. 15, 2003, at Cal State San Bernardino, shooting .351 (3,836-for-10,928) during that span. It is believed to be the fourth-longest active streak of its kind in the nation, trailing only lowa State (845 games since 1995), Chattanooga (691 games since 1999), and Milwaukee (593 games since 2002) as of Dec. 7, 2021.

SHE GIVETH AND DON'T GIVETH AWAY: Hall is one of the top players in the nation when it comes to assist-to-turnover ratio, entering the week with 24 assists on the year (3.43 apg) against only nine turnovers on the season (1.29 pg). Her 2.67 assist-to-turnover ratio ranks third among qualifiers in the Big West this week, while also standing 33rd in the NCAA.

SMOOTH LIKE SVANHOLM: Forward Lena Svanholm has provided the Aggies with quite a lift off the bench for UC Davis, averaging nearly seven points and four rebounds per game, while leading the team with 10 offensive rebounds. She is shooting nearly 60 percent from the floor overall, but averaging nearly nine points and hitting 7-of-13 (.538) from the field in her last two games against Pac-12 opponents.

MINUTE WOMEN: Not many have seen more court time this year that the Aggie trio of Hall, Kayla Konrad, and Evanne Turner, who all rank among the top 12 in the Big West in minutes per game in the first quarter of the season. Hall's 33.78 mpg rank third in the league -- and is one of only five in the Big West averaging more than 33 minutes per contest entering the week -- with Konrad (32.21) close behind in sixth, and Turner (30.75) in 12th.

DOUBLE DIGIT DIVAS: Four more Aggies in double figures at Oregon, helping UC Davis pull off the upset. Here's how they — and the rest of the Aggies — stack up over their careers.

EUPHORIA IN EUGENE: It was more than just the third straight victory for the Aggies... much more. UC Davis' victory over Oregon on Dec. 1 marked the program's first win in 23 tries over a nationally ranked opponent as a Division I program. The Aggies had come close, falling to the Ducks by only six points last season and coming to within 12 of both Stanford in 2019 and South Dakota State in 2008, but unable to clear that final hurdle.

"POWER" DOWN: Aside from it being the first-ever win over a nationally ranked program for the Aggies, Wednesday's win at Oregon marked UC Davis' 10th win over a "Power Five" school since joining the Division I ranks in 2007-08 with, now, eight of those 10 triumphs coming against the Pac-12 Conference thanks to wins over Washington (2007, 2011), Washington State (2010, 2017, 2018), USC (2012), and Utah (2017), along with the Ducks.

PUT A LID ON IT: The Aggies are up to their old tricks again. Despite an off night against a hot-shooting Washington State squad — the first this season to shoot at least 40 percent from the field against UC Davis this year — the Aggies enter this week's games ranked No. 36 in the NCAA in field goal percentage defense (.344) behind leader Coastal Carolina (.278). The Aggies have led the Big West in scoring defense in four of the last five years and in field goal percentage defense in each of the last five season. In fact, the 56.8 ppg allowed by the Aggies in 2020-21 was the lowest for a league leader since UC Santa

Barbara allowed just 52.9 ppg in 2012-13, while the .332 field goal percentage by the opposition was the lowest in league history.

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Aggies are 60-9 on their home floor over the past five-plus years, winning 16 of their last 19 and posting a winning record at home in each of the last eight campaigns.

#DBGHCS: If you've ever wondered at how the Aggies are so good at executing at the buzzer, the answer is very simple... practice. In what has become a day before the game tradition, the Aggies -- players, coaches, and staff -- launch half-court heaves at the end of their final practice prior to gameday, celebrating often in what has been dubbed "Day Before Game Half Court Shots" or, as fans of the program have come to know the hashtag on social media #DBGHCS. This year has already seen a number of Aggies get on the board:

AGGIES INK EPPS: Nya Epps, a 5-foot-10 wing from El Cerrito, Calif., has signed a National Letter of Intent to continue her academic and athletic career at UC Davis beginning in 2022-23. Epps is entering her senior season at Carondelet HS, fresh off a 2020-21 campaign that saw her average 16 points, six rebounds, and six assists, for the Cougars as a junior, earning her a slew of awards for her performance. THIS SOUNDS FAMILIAR: The five-time defending Big West champions were picked to win their sixth consecutive league title in 2021-22, unanimous selections by both the head coaches and the media according to a vote released on Nov. 2 by the conference office. UC Davis received nine of the 11 first-place votes and 99 points overall from the coaches, while picking up six of the 11 first-place nods from the media and 104 points overall.

HALL EARNS PRESEASON NOD: Back for a fifth season in an Aggie uniform after the NCAA granted 2020-21 winter sports student-athletes an additional year of eligibility due to the pandemic, senior forward Cierra Hall was one of five unanimous selections to both the coach's and media's preseason All-Big West teams for the second straight season. One of only three players in league history to win both the conference player and defensive player of the year awards in a career, Hall averaged 14.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game last season while shooting .463 from the field.

A WHOLE LOTTA WINNING: Hall has a chance to join a league of her own if UC Davis has the good fortune to repeat as conference champions in 2021-22, becoming the first Aggie to be on the floor for five consecutive conference titles in a career. Last year, Hall became the sixth UC Davis player to be a part of four straight conference titles on the floor, joining Nicole Dubriel (1994-98), Elizabeth Doud (1994-98), Karyn Castro (1995-98), Sophia Song (2016-20), and Nina Bessolo (2016-20). Teammates Kayla Konrad and Sage Stobbart have the chance to join that club in 2021-22, having been a part of all five titles during the team's run, but each taking a redshirt year in 2017-18.

ABEYTA GOES INTERNATIONAL: Entering her 14th year on the sidelines of her alma mater, Associate Head Coach Des Abeyta seized an opportunity to take her coaching talents to the international stage this past summer, serving as an assistant coach for the South Sudan Women's Senior National team for the FIBA AfroBasket Zone 5 qualifiers in July in Rwanda. A NUMBER OF THINGS: Same faces, new numbers for two Aggies in 2021-22. Third-year sophomore Megan Jones is now wearing No. 2 after spending the last two years as No. 24. Second-year freshman Mazatlan Harris now sports No. 33 after spending last year as No. 13 on the UC Davis roster.

A TALL ORDER: The UC Davis roster measures as one of the tallest in school history in 2021-22, with five players measuring at 6-foor-3 or taller -- the most in the history of the program. Lena Svanholm, who stands 6-foot-6, is believed to be the second-tallest in the history of the program, trailing only 6-foot-8 Kelly Ditto, who was a three-year letter winner for the Aggies in 1999 and 2001-02, while 6-foot-5 Kenedy Lilly is close behind.



It is this uncommon commitment towards student-athletes that led to the creation of the Aggie EVO System, a multi-faceted student-athlete outcomes program focused on preparing young men and women for a successful launch after graduating from the sixth-ranked public school in the nation

We define launch as moving beyond graduation into a meaningful professional path that builds on the college experience, sets a graduate on a path of financial and social well-being and effectively replaces the sport as the primary piece of their identity.

The Aggie EVO System ("EVO" is shorthand for a student-athlete's "evolution" during college) is an important part of the student-athlete experience at UC Davis – just like weights and conditioning, attending class or getting athletic medicine treatment. This unprecedented program was designed to focus on four key elements to help UC Davis student-athletes prepare for future success by helping them better "know and navigate the World of Work":

- **SKILLS** that employers want and will make student-athletes even more effective in their sports: self awareness, emotional intelligence, social/cultural competence and leadership.
- KNOWLEDGE of what careers and paths are out there (we call this the "World of Work"), what fits one's interests and abilities, who in our gigantic network can advise and guide them and each individual can navigate a path to get there.
- **OPPORTUNITIES** to enjoy internships, jobs and other learning opportunities through a powerful network of Aggie alums. Student-athletes hear from and meet alums in a wide variety of fields, attend recruiting events and visit members of the EVO Pro network at companies in San Francisco, Silicon Valley, and Sacramento.
- **TOOLS** that student-athletes need to secure these opportunities. We require a few more basic tools or updates each year they are on campus. This includes resumes and cover letters, LinkedIn profiles, interviewing skills, business cards, professional headshots, and anything else that helps student-athletes prepare for a more successful launch.
