AGGIE STORYLINES...

- UC Davis returns eight letter winners and three starters off of last season's squad that finished 17-12 overall -- it's fifth consecutive winning season -- and 12-4 in Big West Conference play.
- The Aggies have won the last four consecutive outright Big West regular season titles, making them one of three schools in the history of the league to accomplish such a feat (UC Santa Barbara from 1996-2005 and Long Beach State from 1985-89).
- It marks the first time in school history that UC Davis has won four consecutive OUTRIGHT league titles. However, the Aggies did win five straight league titles during their Division II days -- four in the Northern California Athletic Conference and one in the California Collegiate Athletic Association -- from 1994-99, but shared the 1997-98 NCAC title.
- UC Davis is one of seven schools to have won at least 4 straight conference regular season titles: UConn (7 in the American Athletic Conference), Baylor (10 in the Big 12), Central Michigan (5 divisional titles in the Mid-American Conference), Robert Morris (4 in the Northeast Conference), Ohio Valley - Belmont (4 in the Ohio Valley Conference), Gonzaga (4 in the West Coast Conference).
- UC Davis is a combined 55-9 in Big West play over the last four years entering the 2020-21 season, with the next-closest school being CSUN at 35-29 in conference play (the only two programs with a winning record in that span).
- Head Coach **JENNIFER GROSS** has won the last four consecutive Big West Coach of the Year awards -- the first time in conference history that has happened -- and stands behind only Mark French of UCSB (7) for the most in league history.
- Together for the last 10 years, Gross, Associate Head Coaches **JOE TERAMOTO** and **DES ABEYTA**, and Assistant Coach **MATT KLEMIN** make up the longest-tenured Division I coaching staff in the nation.
- With her 10 years at the helm, Gross is the third-longest tenured head coach in school history behind only Sandy Simpson (14 years) and Pam Gill-Fisher (12 years).
- Gross stands 22 wins shy of 200 overall for her career, and clinched her 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23 at home against UC San Diego.
- Gross' 178 wins ranks third in school history and sixth in league history, with her 102 league wins standing seventh in the Big West annals. She trails only Simpson (251) and Jorja Hoehn (205) in school lore.
- UC Davis won its 250th game as a Division I program on Jan. 22 at home against UC San Diego.
- Entering the year, the Aggies' 248 wins since joining the Big West in 2007-08 are the most of any active member, followed by Cal Poly (201), UC Santa Barbara (184), and Long Beach State (184).
- Five Aggies entered the 2020-21 season on professional rosters in Europe: **MORGAN BERTSCH** (Pszczolka AZS-UMCS Lublin in Poland), **PELE GIANOTTI** (T71 Basket Dudelange in Luxembourg), **KATIE TOOLE** (RACA Granada in Spain), **NINA BESSOLO** (AS Niki Lefkadas in Greece) and **SOPHIA SONG** (Manchester Met Mystics in England).

NEWS & NOTABLES...

- UC Davis makes its second appearance on the ESPN3 "airwaves" this weekend when it travels to Long Beach State for a pair at the Walter Pyramid.
- The Aggies swept two games at UC Santa Barbara in their previous ESPN3 games earlier this year, improving to 5-1 all-time in such games, winning their last five.
- The six-point margin at No. 12/11 Oregon was the smallest for UC Davis against a top-25 opponent in its Division I history (previous was 12 points at No. 22 South Dakota State in 2008, at #16 Stanford in 2014, and at #5 Stanford in 2019).
- UC Davis junior Sage Stobbart was one of 15 student-athletes from across the country named to the watch list for the **2021 NAISMITH WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD** on Jan. 26.
- Coming off a near road upset of nationally ranked Oregon in its last outing, UC Davis, the Aggies dropped two spots to No. 18 in the latest **COLLEGE INSIDER** mid-major poll released on Feb. 9.
- The Aggies have been ranked as high as No. 15 in the mid-major poll back on Dec. 8 and have been among the top 20 every week this season, extending its run to 13 consecutive weeks dating back to the final 2019-20 poll.
- The No. 15 ranking is the highest standing for UC Davis in that poll since the Aggies finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 12 in the final mid-major rankings.
- UC Davis posted a pair of milestones in its sweep of UC San Diego, clinching the program's 250th Division I victory on Jan. 22, and coach **JENNIFER GROSS'** 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23.
- Gross became only the seventh coach in league history to reach 100 conference wins and, with 102 victories entering the week, trails Hawaii's Vince Goo (108 league wins from 1987-96) by six for sixth.
- Gross' 178 overall career victories ranks her sixth in league, passing Cal State Fullerton's Dr. Maryalyce Jeremiah, and standing one win back of Goo (179) for fifth overall.
- UC Davis enters the week with a pair of top-five NCAA ranks as a team: standing No. 2 in the nation in free throw percentage at .836 (Milwaukee is first at .842) and No. 6 in the NCAA in three-point percentage at .400 (Fairfield is first at .449).
- The Aggies have also done well to keep their hands to themselves, ranking second in the NCAA in fewest fouls per game at 12.7 (Wyoming is first at 12.6).
- UC Davis has hit at least one three-pointer in 529 consecutive games dating back to Feb. 15, 2003, at Cal State San Bernardino. Since then, the Aggies have shot .351 (3,704-for-10,549) from beyond the arc.
- It is believed to be the fourth-longest active streak of its kind in the nation, trailing only Iowa State (824 games since 1995), Chattanooga (674 since 1999), and Milwaukee (575 since 2002), as of Feb. 8.
- Thanks to her 2-for-2 performance at the line at No. 12/11 Oregon on Saturday (Feb. 6), senior **CIERRA HALL** is now a perfect 21-for-21 at the charity stripe.
- Hall shares the NCAA lead with Niagara's Ally Haar (16-for-16) as of Feb. 8.
- The school record for consecutive free throws made is 27 by Colleen Turnbull from Jan. 4-25, 2003.
- Hall is the closest active Aggie to 1,000 career points points at 756, and needs 397 rebounds this year to hit 1,000. She only needs 106 more rebounds to break Doherty's program Division I career record (708), which would place her fourth on the all-time list at 709.
- Hall's 603 career boards has her sixth on the school's Division I career list, just three behind Paige Mintun (606 from 2007-11) for fifth and 13 back of Pele Gianotti (616 from 2014-18), and are just 33 shy of assistant coach Des Abeyta (636) for 10th on the all-time list.
- Carol Rische (1979-83) is the only Aggie to score 1,000 career points (1,711) and grab 1,000 career rebounds (1,028).
- Senior **MACKENZIE TRPCIC** finished with a career-high 13 assists at No. 12/11 Oregon on Saturday -- tied for the sixth-highest single-game total in the NCAA this year and one shy of the school single-game record (14 by Molly Greubel at UC Irvine in 2014).
- The 13 assists are tied for second on the school's single-game list along with Sara Lillevand, who had 13 helpers at Stanislaus State on March 10, 1990, and marked her third career double-digit assist game (10 vs. Sacramento State and CSUN last season).
- Trpcic enters the week ranked seventh in the NCAA in assists per game (7.0) and 12th in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.00).
- Trpcic also shared game-high honors against the Ducks with a career-high eight rebounds, adding six points and two steals.
- The 13 assists marked the 18th time she has finished with five-or-more helpers in a game in her Aggie career.
- With 175 career assists entering the week, Trpcic is 24 helpers shy of Morgan Bertsch (2015-19) for 10th on program's Division I career list.
- Sophomore **EVANNE TURNER** led all scorers with a game-high 19 points at No. 12/11 Oregon on Saturday, tying her season high and falling just two points short of her career high (21 at CSUN last year).
- Turner enters the week ranked No. 4 in the NCAA in three-point percentage (.517) and is shooting .500 overall from the floor for the year.
- Turner matched her career high's for field goals (seven) and three-pointers (five) made against the Ducks, adding five rebounds
- Junior **KAYLA KONRAD** became the second Aggie to play all 40 minutes in a game this season on Saturday at No. 12/11 Oregon along with Trpcic, who went the distance at UC Santa Barbara on Jan. 29.

- With 10 points against the Ducks, Konrad has now reached double figures in five of the team's six games this season, after reaching double figures only four times in her previous two years combined.
- The team's leading scorer through six games, **SAGE STOBART** is the only Aggie to post double-digit points in all six outings this season.
- With 69 blocks in her career, Stobart ranks ninth on the school's career list, passing the 66 posted by both Lauren Juric (2007-12) and Marly Anderson (2016-18). Ellen Porshneva (2003-06, 2007-08) is next on the list in eighth place with 80 swats.

RECYCLED NOTES...

- **CIERRA HALL** was named the Big West Conference Player of the Week on Feb. 1 for the second time in her career after averaging 21.0 ppg, 5.5 rpg, and 3.0 apg, while shooting .591 overall, .625 from three-point range, and a perfect 9-for-9 from the line, in two games at UC Santa Barbara.
- Until the Aggies took the court against UC San Diego on Jan. 22, only one other Division I school had played fewer games this season. Merrimack College of the Northeast Conference officially opened its season against Fairleigh Dickinson on Jan. 23.
- After waiting 264 days between the final game of the halted 2019-20 campaign and the season opener against San Francisco, UC Davis waited 59 more days for the ball to be in the air again when it tipped off against league newcomer UC San Diego.
- All told, the Aggies have had 15 games cancelled, thus far, either due to COVID concerns with other programs, teams opting out, or a December Yolo County health order that forced UC Davis to pause activity indefinitely.
- Hall was one of five unanimous picks to both the coaches' and media's preseason all-conference teams after earning league defensive player of the year, all-defensive team, and All-Big West second team honors in 2019-20.
- UC Davis was a unanimous pick to claim its fifth consecutive Big West crown in 2020-21 by both the media and coaches. The Aggies picked up six of the 11 first-place votes (101 points overall) from the coaches and 13 of the 20 media first-place votes (207 points overall).
- The 2020-21 roster will be the tallest in school history thanks to the additions of a trio of towering 2019-20 redshirts in 6-6 Svanholm (Colorado State), 6-5 freshman **KENEDY LILLY**, and 6-3 freshman **MEGAN JONES**
- Four players on this year's roster measure taller than 6-foot-3 — tied for the most in the history of the program
- Svanholm is believed to be the second-tallest in the history of the program, trailing only 6-foot-8 Kelly Ditto, who was a three-year letter winner for the Aggies in 1999 and 2001-02.
- UC Davis adds three true freshmen to the roster for 2020-21 in **BRIA SHINE** (6-1, G, Sacramento, Calif. / Christian Brothers HS), Carreon (5-10, Wing, Chula Vista, Calif. / San Diego Christian HS), and **MAZATLAN HARRIS** (6-2, F, San Diego, Calif. / Cathedral Catholic HS).
- UC Davis reloaded its roster by signing three high school standouts during November's early signing period: **SYDNEY BURNS** (Wilsonville, Ore. / Wilsonville HS), **MARLEY LANGI** (Redwood City, Calif. / Archbishop Mitty HS), and **MEGAN NORRIS** (Atherton, Calif. / Sacred Heart Prep).
- The **BIG WEST CONFERENCE** has a new look for 2020-21, officially welcoming CSU Bakersfield and UC San Diego to the fold, bring the league's total number of teams to 11
- The Roadrunners join the Big West after seven years in the Western Athletic Conference, while the Tritons begin their NCAA-mandated four-year reclassification period to Division I.
- UCSD will be included in all Big West round-robin schedules, but will not be eligible for the conference tournament until it officially completes its reclassification in July, 2024.
- In order to minimize travel and emphasize the health and safety of the student-athletes, there will be a new Big West scheduling format for 2020-21, with teams facing the same opponent on back-to-back nights rather than the traditional home-and-home schedule.

It is this uncommon commitment towards student-athletes that led to the creation of the Aggie EVO System, a multi-faceted student-athlete outcomes program focused on preparing young men and women for a successful launch after graduating from the sixth-ranked public school in the nation.

We define launch as moving beyond graduation into a meaningful professional path that builds on the college experience, sets a graduate on a path of financial and social well-being and effectively replaces the sport as the primary piece of their identity.

The Aggie EVO System (“EVO” is shorthand for a student-athlete’s “evolution” during college) is an important part of the student-athlete experience at UC Davis – just like weights and conditioning, attending class or getting athletic medicine treatment. This unprecedented program was designed to focus on four key elements to help UC Davis student-athletes prepare for future success by helping them better “know and navigate the World of Work”:

- **SKILLS** that employers want and will make student-athletes even more effective in their sports: self awareness, emotional intelligence, social/cultural competence and leadership.
- **KNOWLEDGE** of what careers and paths are out there (we call this the “World of Work”), what fits one’s interests and abilities, who in our gigantic network can advise and guide them and each individual can navigate a path to get there.
- **OPPORTUNITIES** to enjoy internships, jobs and other learning opportunities through a powerful network of Aggie alums. Student-athletes hear from and meet alums in a wide variety of fields, attend recruiting events and visit members of the EVO Pro network at companies in San Francisco, Silicon Valley, and Sacramento.
- **TOOLS** that student-athletes need to secure these opportunities. We require a few more basic tools or updates each year they are on campus. This includes resumes and cover letters, LinkedIn profiles, interviewing skills, business cards, professional headshots, and anything else that helps student-athletes prepare for a more successful launch.
