AGGIE STORYLINES...

- UC Davis returns 11 letter winners and four starters off of last season's squad that finished 13-3 overall -- it's sixth consecutive winning season -- and 9-1 in Big West Conference play during a pandemic-shortened 2020-21 campaign that featured a two-month layoff due to Yolo County health restrictions.
- The Aggies have won the last five consecutive Big West regular season titles, making them one of only two schools in league history to accomplish such a feat (UC Santa Barbara from 1996-2005).
- Last year marked the first time in school history that UC Davis won five consecutive OUTRIGHT league titles. The Aggies did win five straight league crowns during their Division II days -- four in the Northern California Athletic Conference and one in the California Collegiate Athletic Association -- from 1994-99, but shared the 1997-98 NCAC title.
- UC Davis is one of four active schools to have won at least five straight conference regular season titles: UConn (7 in the American Athletic Conference, 1 in the BIG EAST), Baylor (11 in the Big 12), and Gonzaga (5 in the West Coast Conference).
- UC Davis is a combined 64-10 in Big West play over the last five years entering the 2021-22 season, with the next-closest school, in terms of wins, being Long Beach State at 42-40 in conference play.
- UC Davis became the sixth program in conference history to win at least three Big West Tournament titles and the first repeat champion since 2014-15.
- Head Coach **JENNIFER GROSS** has won the last five consecutive Big West Coach of the Year awards -- the first time in conference history that has happened -- and stands behind only Mark French of UCSB (7) for the most in league history.
- Together for 11 years, Gross, Associate Head Coaches **JOE TERAMOTO** and **DES ABEYTA**, and Assistant Coach **MATT KLEMIN** make up the longest-tenured Division I coaching staff in the nation.
- With her 11 years at the helm, Gross is the third-longest tenured head coach in school history behind only Sandy Simpson (14 years) and Pam Gill-Fisher (12 years).
- Gross stands eight wins shy of 200 overall for her career, and clinched her 100th career Big West win on Jan. 23 at home against UC San Diego.
- Gross' 192 wins ranks third in school history and fifth in league history, while her 107 league wins stand seventh in the Big West annals. She trails only Simpson (251) and Jorja Hoehn (205) in school lore.
- UC Davis' trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2021 marked the program's eighth postseason appearance in 14 years as a Division I program.
- The team's No. 12 seed in the tournament was the highest in program history and the highest for any Big West school since 2004 (UC Santa Barbara - No. 11).

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Even though the institution's official name is the University of California, Davis, please use the moniker UC Davis when referring to its athletics programs. Please do not use: Cal State Davis, Cal-Davis, CS Davis, Davis State, University of Davis, U.C. Davis, UC-Davis or any combination thereof.

THIS WEEK: Having not played since a victory over Gonzaga back on Dec. 19 due to various COVID health and safety protocols, the UC Davis women's basketball team has been given the green light to return to competition this week, FINALLY opening defense of its Big West Conference title on the road at UC Irvine and UC San Diego this week. The Aggies and Anteaters tip-off in a rematch of last year's Big West Tournament championship game at the Bren Events Center in Orange County on Thursday (Jan. 6) at 7 p.m., before tussling with the Toreros on Saturday (Jan. 8) at 4 p.m. at the RIMAC Arena in La Jolla, Calif.

No fans will be allowed to attend Saturday's game at UCSD, while fans must produce either proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test within 1 day for an antigen test and 2 days for a PCR test prior to entry into an event for Thursday's game in Irvine.

IN THE RANKINGS: After nearly three weeks without a contest, UC Davis dropped one spot to No. 11 in the College Insider mid-major poll (as of Dec. 28) after breaking into the top following its win over Gonzaga on Dec. 19. New rankings are scheduled to be released on Jan. 4. The Aggies opened the year at No. 9 in the preseason rankings -- marking the highest for the program in that poll since the Aggies stood at No. 8 in the Feb. 27, 2018, poll. UC Davis has been ranked every week dating back to the final poll of the 2019-20 season.

NO CONTEST: The games against UC Riverside and Hawai'i that were canceled due to COVID health and safety protocols will not be made up and will be declared "no contests."

ABOUT THE ANTEATERS: UC Irvine enters the week with a 5-6 overall record and, like UC Davis, has yet to play a Big West game after having its openers at CSUN and UC Santa Barbara canceled due to COVID protocols... The Anteaters haven't played since a 58-53 road defeat at Grand Canyon on Dec. 23, and have lost four of their last five with a win over San Jose State on Dec. 15 in the middle of that run... Guard Kayla Williams, last year's Big West Freshman of the Year, is the lone UCI player in double figures, averaging 13.0 ppg and shooting .381 from the field while leading the team in both assists (45) and steals (26)... As a team, Irvine is averaging 70.9 ppg and shooting .406 from the floor, while allowing 66.5 ppg and a .394 field goal percentage.

SERIES NOTES: UC Davis leads the all-time series with UC Irvine, 32-9, according to records that date back to the 1973-74 season... The Aggies have won two straight -- and 12 of the last 13 -- in the series with the Anteaters after UCI snapped a 10-game skid against the Aggies with a 73-68 win in Irvine back in the 2019-20 season... The two teams had their two regular season meetings in 2020-21 cancelled due to a Yolo County health order that kept UC Davis sidelined for nearly two months... The Aggies are 13-4 on the road against the 'Eaters (with the locations of two games unknown), having won five straight until that loss in 2020.

ABOUT THE TRITONS: UC San Diego enters the week with a 3-6 overall record heading into Thursday's home game against UC Riverside... The Tritons have had their last three games canceled due to COVID protocols, last taking the court in a

WELCOME BACK FANS!

For the first time since the end of the 2019-20 regular season, fans will be welcomed back into the seats at the newly renamed University Credit Union Center for both men's and women's basketball in 2021-22. In order to provide a healthy and safe event for fans, student-athletes, coaches, and staff, UC Davis will require either proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test within 72 hours of the event upon entry to the UCU Center for all fans over the age of 12. A valid CDC vaccination card, a State of California digital COVID-19 record, or proof of a negative test, will be required, as well as a photo ID matching the name on the vaccine record or negative test. CDC approved face coverings that cover both the nose and mouth must be worn at all times while inside the arena unless actively eating or drinking in your seat. 65-57 loss at San Diego State on Dec. 17, and have lost five of their last six save for an 81-61 win over San Jose State on Dec. 3... Senior Sydney Brown leads the team in scoring (11.2 ppg) and is second in rebounding (7.9 rpg) while shooting .381 from the field... UCSD is averaging 62.6 ppg and is shooting .376 from the field, while holding opponents to just 60.2 ppg and a .336 field goal percentage.

SERIES NOTES: UC Davis leads the all-time series with its former CCAA Division II rival UC San Diego by a 14-3 count, having won the last seven straight dating back to 2002... The Aggies won both regular season meetings with the Tritons during their first year in the Big West last season, posting an 80-62 win in the opener before closing out the weekend with a 58-46 win at the University Credit Union Center... Saturday marks the first meeting between the two in La Jolla since the 2003-04 season (a 73-68 UC Davis win on Jan. 16, 2004), and the Aggies have won the last three meetings on UCSD's home floor dating back to an overtime

win in 2002... UC Davis is 3-1 in games played in La Jolla with the location of three games in the series unknown.

FOR OPENERS, BIG WEST STYLE (FINALLY!):

Since officially joining the league in 2007-08, UC Davis is 7-7 in Big West Conference openers, winning six of its last seven with the only hiccup in that streak a 75-70 defeat at UC Riverside in 2019-20... Thanks to the cancellation against the Highlanders, Saturday's game against Hawai'i marks only the sixth time in 15 conference openers that the Aggies will start league action at home, posting a 2-3 record in the previous nine contests... This year marks the first time that UC Davis and Hawai'i will tip-off league play against one another... The Aggies have opened against UC Riverside (1-2), CSUN (3-1), Cal State Fullerton (0-3), UC Irvine (2-0), and UC San Diego (1-0), as well as former conference rival Pacific (0-1).

ICYMI - HALL EARNS BIG WEST WEEKLY HONORS:

A career milestone as part of a record-tying performance along with a clutch outing against one of the nation's top teams helped net UC Davis senior Cierra Hall Big West Conference Player of the Week laurels for the fourth time in her career back on Dec. 20. The cell biology major from Cypress, Calif., averaged 13.8 points and 8.3 rebounds per game in helping UC Davis win two of three games last week, shooting .467 (14-for-30) from the field overall against Stanislaus State, No. 3 Stanford, and a Gonzaga team that was receiving votes in the USA Today coaches poll and ranked No. 4 in the College Insider mid-major poll.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:

Okay, go ahead. Trailing by as many as 17 points with 9:16 remaining in the third quarter, the Aggies put together a comeback for the ages, shooting 64 percent from the field while holding Gonzaga to just 1-for-14 in the fourth quarter en route to the 69-66 win. The 17-point comeback is tied for the largest in the program's Division I history, matching the 17 point comeback against Hawai'i in 2011 and, again, against the Rainbow Wahine in the 2019 Big West Tournament championship game.

COMEBACK, PART II: UC Davis' double-digit comeback against the Bulldogs marked the Aggies' first come-from-behind win from down 10 points or more since they erased a 14-point deficit for a 67-65 win at UC Santa Barbara on Jan. 29 of last season.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE: The Aggies are 62-9 on their home floor over the past five-plus years, winning 18 of their last 21 and posting a winning record at home in each of the last eight campaigns.

20-20 VISION: Cierra Hall (22 points) and Evanne Turner (20) become the first Aggie teammates to finish with 20 points in the same game since the same dynamic duo accomplished the feat in last year's Big West Tournament Championship against UC Irvine, when Hall finished with 23 and Turner added 22 in the title-clinching win. It was Hall's seventh career 20-point game, while Turner collected her third 20-point performance of her career.

GIVING NO QUARTER: The Aggies' 25 points in the third quarter against Gonzaga are tied for the

most in a single period this year, matching the 25-point first quarter against Stanislaus State earlier in the week. That 25-point quarter was powered by Evanne Turner, who scored 13 points by herself in that quarter -- the most by a UC Davis player in a single quarter this season and the second double-digit quarter by an Aggie this season, besting Sage Stobbart's 12-point third quarter against Weber State. Turner's 13 points were the most since Cierra Hall finished with 13 at Hawai'i in the third period last season on March 5.

NOT HALF BAD: You can't make 'em all, but the Aggies did their best against Gonzaga. Powered by a huge second-half shooting display, UC Davis shot .521 from the field in the win over the Bulldogs -- the second time in its last three games that the Aggies have shot better than 50 percent from the field and the third time overall this season. Holding Gonzaga to 40 percent from the field, UC Davis outshot the opposition for the seventh time this year and won for the sixth time in those contests.

MILLENNIUM MILESTONE: The Aggies did more than celebrate the end of final exams with a win over Stanislaus State on Dec. 13, taking time to honor one of their own reaching a milestone against Stanislaus State. With a free throw late in the third quarter, senior Cierra Hall became the 21st player in school history to reach the 1,000 career point mark, hitting the milestone on the nose after finishing with 11 points. She is the first player to hit the mark since Morgan Bertsch accomplished the feat during Hall's freshman year in 2017. Thanks to her 22 points against Gonzaga, Hall enters Big West play with 1,030 career points, passing Kendall Greene, who scored 1,027 career points from 1992-96, for 20th on the all-time list and standing just 41 back of Kasey Riecks (1,071 points from 2008-12) for 19th on the career list.

SAGE HAS COMPANY: Reaching 1,000 career points wasn't the only milestone Hall reached against the Warriors, joining teammate Sage Stobbart atop another record list with her career high 16 rebounds against Stanislaus State. Hall's 16 boards matched Stobbart's 16 rebounds against Saint Mary's earlier this year for the most by an Aggie in a single game in the program's Division I history. The Cypress, Calif., native now has 747 career rebounds and moving her to within four of Staci Stevens (1984-88) for third on the school's all-time list. Already the program's Division I career record holder, Hall is only the fifth player to reach the 700-rebound plateau for a career in school history, joining Carol Rische (1,028), Colleen Turnbull (790), Stevens, and Alyson Doherty (708).

60 IS GREAT... 59 NOT SO MUCH: UC Davis is a perfect 6-0 this year when scoring 60-or-more points, but have yet to win a game when scoring 59 points or fewer, falling to 0-4 after Wednesday's contest at Stanford.

DOUBLE DIGIT DIVAS: Four more Aggies in double figures on Monday against Stanislaus State, adding to their career totals. Here's how they -- and the rest of the Aggies -- stack up over their careers.

THREE FOR ALL: Having led the Big West in three-point shooting in each of the last four years (and five of the last six), the Aggies carry a significant streak into the 2021-22 season thanks to their prowess beyond the arc. UC Davis has hit at least one three-pointer in 549 consecutive games dating back to Feb. 15, 2003, at Cal State San Bernardino, shooting .351 (3,857-for-10,995) during that span. It is believed to be the fourth-longest active streak of its kind in the nation, trailing only Iowa State (849 games since 1995), Chattanooga (697 games since 1999), and Milwaukee (596 games since 2002) as of Jan. 2, 2022.

SAGE STO-BLOCK: Senior Sage Stobbart added to her team-best total with two more swats against Gonzaga on Dec. 19, giving her 19 for the season and 117 for her career -- the latter moving her to within two of Kendall Greene (119 from 1992-96) for fourth on the school's career list.

KEEPING IT 100: Stobbart is one of only six players to ever eclipse the 100 block plateau along with Morgan Bertsch (193 from 2015-19), Paige Mintun (150

If you've ever wondered at how the Aggies are so good at executing at the buzzer, the answer is very simple... practice. In what has become a day before the game tradition, the Aggies -- players, coaches, and staff -- launch half-court heaves at the end of their final practice prior to gameday, celebrating often in what has been dubbed "Day Before Game Half Court Shots" or, as fans of the program have come to know the hashtag on social media #DBGHCS. This year has already seen a number of Aggies get on the board (as of Dec. 17):

from 2006-11), Alyson Doherty (147 from 2012-16), Greene, and Janae Henning (109 from 1998-2002).

FREEEEEE... FREEEEEE THROWIN': No Aggie has gotten to the line more than Hall this year, as the senior is shooting just under 72 percent from the stripe in 39 attempts from the stripe. Her 269 makes and 379 career attempts both rank fourth in the program's Division I history and stand just outside the all-time top 10 in both categories.

CHAIRWOMEN OF THE BOARD(S): The Aggies' 1-2 rebounding punch of Hall and Stobbart is one of the more dominant in the Big West entering the week-end as Hall's 79 rebounds (7.9 rpg) lead the league, while Stobbart's 69 (7.0 rpg) are tied for sixth. Aside from UC Davis, UC Riverside and UC San Diego are the only other teams in the league featuring two individuals among the top 10 in rebounding.

MINUTE WOMEN: Very few players in the Big West have seen more time on the floor than Hall this season as the senior has logged an average of 32.7 mpg through 10 contests, ranking fourth in the league. In fact, three Aggie starters are among the top 15 in the league in that category -- the only school to do so -- as Hall is joined by classmate Kayla Konrad (8th - 31.4 mpg) and sophomore Evanne Turner (12th - 30.6 mpg).

TRIPLE THREAT: Sophomore Evanne Turner has not been shy at putting up the three ball this season, leading the team -- and ranking third in the Big West -- with 57 attempts, while standing third in the conference with 2.00 makes per game. Her 98 makes from beyond the arc -- four of those coming in the win over Gonzaga -- moved her into the program's Division I top 10, passing Sophia Song (97 from 2016-20) and putting Turner 53 makes behind Nina Bessolo (151 from 2016-20) for ninth.

DE-FENSE (CLAP, CLAP)... DE-FENSE (CLAP, CLAP): Only three UC Davis opponents -- all of whom were either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls -- have managed to shoot better than 40 percent from the floor overall against the Aggie defense this season, but UC Davis has displayed its ability to clamp down, holding opponents to under 30 percent in a quarter 11 times this season -- including five quarters of under 20 percent. The Aggies limited Gonzaga to just 1-of-14 (.071) from the floor in the fourth quarter on Dec. 19 for the second-lowest single-quarter showing by an opponent this year, trailing only the 1-for-18 (.056) fourth quarter by Stanislaus State on Dec. 13, which was the lowest since holding UC San Diego to an 0-for-11 second quarter in a 58-46 victory on Jan. 23, 2021.

MAY THE FOURTH BE WITH US: Along those lines, the Aggies defense has found a way to frustrate opposing offenses in the fourth quarter, holding opponents to under 30 percent shooting in the final 10 minutes five times, while limiting opponents to just .301 (47-for-156) combined from the field in that period through 10 games this season.

#AGGIESINTHEPROS: Morgan Bertsch is spending her second year in Poland in 2021-22, but her first with Arka Gdynia, where she is averaging 12.5 ppg and 4.0 rpg while shooting .593 (as of Jan. 3) in 11 contests -- including a 30-point game in a win over Bydgoszcz on Oct. 24, and a 26-point outing against Lublin (her former team from the 2020-21 season) on Nov. 28. In Euroleague games, Bertsch is averaging 12.4 ppg and 4.8 rpg in 10 games, shooting 50 percent overall. Meanwhile, in Germany, Pele Gianotti has helped the Rhineland Lions

to an 15-1 record and a spot atop the DBBL standings after spending last season in Luxembourg.

RECYCLED NOTES

EUPHORIA IN EUGENE: It was more than just the third straight victory for the Aggies... much more. UC Davis' victory over Oregon on Dec. 1 marked the program's first win in 24 tries over a nationally ranked opponent as a Division I program. The Aggies had come close, falling to the Ducks by only six points last season and coming to within 12 of both Stanford in 2019 and South Dakota State in 2008, but unable to clear that final hurdle.

"POWER" DOWN: Aside from it being the first-ever win over a nationally ranked program for the Aggies, Wednesday's win at Oregon marked UC Davis' 10th win over a "Power Five" school since joining the Division I ranks in 2007-08 with, now, eight of those 10 triumphs coming against the Pac-12 Conference thanks to wins over Washington (2007, 2011), Washington State (2010, 2017, 2018), USC (2012), and Utah (2017), along with the Ducks.

AGGIES INK EPPS: Nya Epps, a 5-foot-10 wing from El Cerrito, Calif., has signed a National Letter of Intent to continue her academic and athletic career at UC Davis beginning in 2022-23. Epps is entering her senior season at Carondelet HS, fresh off a 2020-21 campaign that saw her average 16 points, six rebounds, and six assists, for the Cougars as a junior, earning her a slew of awards for her performance. THIS SOUNDS FAMILIAR: The five-time defending Big West champions were picked to win their sixth consecutive league title in 2021-22, unanimous selections by both the head coaches and the media according to a vote released on Nov. 2 by the conference office. UC Davis received nine of the 11 first-place votes and 99 points overall from the coaches, while picking up six of the 11 first-place nods from the media and 104 points overall.

HALL EARNS PRESEASON NOD: Back for a fifth season in an Aggie uniform after the NCAA granted 2020-21 winter sports student-athletes an additional year of eligibility due to the pandemic, senior forward Cierra Hall was one of five unanimous selections to both the coach's and media's preseason All-Big West teams for the second straight season. One of only three players in league history to win both the conference player and defensive player of the year awards in a career, Hall averaged 14.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game last season while shooting .463 from the field.

A WHOLE LOTTA WINNING: Hall has a chance to join a league of her own if UC Davis has the good fortune to repeat as conference champions in 2021-22, becoming the first Aggie to be on the floor for five consecutive conference titles in a career. Last year, Hall became the sixth UC Davis player to be a part of four straight conference titles on the floor, joining Nicole Dubriel (1994-98), Elizabeth Doud (1994-98), Karyn Castro (1995-98), Sophia Song (2016-20), and Nina Bessolo (2016-20). Teammates Kayla Konrad and Sage Stobbart have the chance to join that club in 2021-22, having been a part of all five titles during the team's run, but each taking a redshirt year in 2017-18.

ABEYTA GOES INTERNATIONAL: Entering her 14th year on the sidelines of her alma mater, Associate Head Coach Des Abeyta seized an opportunity to take her coaching talents to the international stage this past summer, serving as an assistant coach for the South Sudan Women's Senior National team for the FIBA AfroBasket Zone 5 qualifiers in July in Rwanda. A NUMBER OF THINGS: Same faces, new numbers for two Aggies in 2021-22. Third-year sophomore Megan Jones is now wearing No. 2 after spending the last two years as No. 24. Second-year freshman Mazatlan Harris now sports No. 33 after spending last year as No. 13 on the UC Davis roster.

A TALL ORDER: The UC Davis roster measures as one of the tallest in school history in 2021-22, with five players measuring at 6-foot-3 or taller -- the most in the history of the program. Lena Svanholm, who stands 6-foot-6, is believed to be the second-tallest in the history of the program, trailing only 6-foot-8 Kelly Ditto, who was a three-year letter winner for the Aggies in 1999 and 2001-02, while 6-foot-5 Kenedy Lilly is close behind.

You will not find another school more dedicated to helping you be positioned for a great job or grad school opportunity after sports end, whenever that may be.”

It is this uncommon commitment towards student-athletes that led to the creation of the Aggie EVO System, a multi-faceted student-athlete outcomes program focused on preparing young men and women for a successful launch after graduating from the sixth-ranked public school in the nation.

We define launch as moving beyond graduation into a meaningful professional path that builds on the college experience, sets a graduate on a path of financial and social well-being and effectively replaces the sport as the primary piece of their identity.

The Aggie EVO System (“EVO” is shorthand for a student-athlete’s “evolution” during college) is an important part of the student-athlete experience at UC Davis – just like weights and conditioning, attending class or getting athletic medicine treatment. This unprecedented program was designed to focus on four key elements to help UC Davis student-athletes prepare for future success by helping them better “know and navigate the World of Work”:

- **SKILLS** that employers want and will make student-athletes even more effective in their sports: self awareness, emotional intelligence, social/cultural competence and leadership.
- **KNOWLEDGE** of what careers and paths are out there (we call this the “World of Work”), what fits one’s interests and abilities, who in our gigantic network can advise and guide them and each individual can navigate a path to get there.
- **OPPORTUNITIES** to enjoy internships, jobs and other learning opportunities through a powerful network of Aggie alums. Student-athletes hear from and meet alums in a wide variety of fields, attend recruiting events and visit members of the EVO Pro network at companies in San Francisco, Silicon Valley, and Sacramento.
- **TOOLS** that student-athletes need to secure these opportunities. We require a few more basic tools or updates each year they are on campus. This includes resumes and cover letters, LinkedIn profiles, interviewing skills, business cards, professional headshots, and anything else that helps student-athletes prepare for a more successful launch.
