#### **AGGIE OUTLOOK**

Coming off their second FCS Playoff appearance in school history the Aggies look to build on an encouraging 8-4 campaign in 2022. UC Davis returns a plethora of talent, headlined by Big Sky Preseason Offensive MVP and Walter Payton Watch List senior running back Ulonzo Gilliam, Jr. Gilliam, Jr. is on the verge of breaking the all-time rushing record and was listed on nearly every preseason All-American squad. Also earning preseason recognition by multiple outlets were offensive linemen Jake Parks and Connor Pettek. The duo was joined by tight end McCallan Castles, and RB/KR Lan Larison. The Aggies checked in at No. 25 in both the Stats Perform and Hero Sports preseason polls and No. 22 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

The two teams will be meeting for the ninth time on Saturday, with SDSU holding a 6-2 advantage. The two foes are familiar with each other as they met in the first round of the FCS Playoffs last season. The Jackrabbits won that game, 56-24, in Brookings. South Dakota State has won five straight over UC Davis, with the last Aggie win coming in a 52-0 drubbing in 2004.

#### **CHASING HISTORY**

Senior running back Ulonzo Gilliam, Jr., is on the verge of etching his name atop the Aggie record books in several categories. He enters week two ranked 2nd in career rushing (3,550), needing 40 yards on the ground to surpass G.P. Muhammad's (1995-98) mark of 3,589. Gilliam, Jr. broke the all-purpose yards (4,630) record at Cal, surpassing Muhammad's record of (4,629) by one yard in week one. The running back has 171 career receptions to rank seventh all-time. He also ranks sixth in scoring with 237 points - third all-time among UC Davis non-kickers. Brady Stuart (2012-15) holds the Aggie record with 274 career points.

#### **SCHEDULE GAZING**

On top of opening the season on the road against FBS foe Cal, UC Davis enters the 2022 campaign slated to play four FCS squads that are ranked in the top-25, including three in the Big Sky. Of the four teams, three were tabbed in the top-10 in the preseason polls. In the AFCA Coaches Preseason Poll, UCD will face No. 3 South Dakota State,

No. 4 Montana State, No. 7 Sacramento State and No. 20 Weber State. The three top-10 contests will all be on the road.

#### **COACHING MATCHUP**

John Stiegelmeier is in his 26th season at South Dakota State, sporting a 185-112 record, having led the Jackrabbits to 10-straight FCS Playoff appearances. UC Davis head coach Dan Hawkins has led the Aggies to their first two FCS Playoff appearances in school history and boasts a 31-23 mark in now his sixth season in Davis.



#### **TEAM CAPTAINS**

Senior running back Ulonzo Gilliam, Jr. and sophomore linebacker Teddye Buchanan were voted team captains for the upcoming season. The selection of Gilliam, Jr. marks the third-straight season the Merced, Calif., native has been named a captain, which is a program record. The appointment eclipses the likes of two-time captains Ken O'Brien, Bo Eason, Mike Moroski, and J.T. O'Sullivan, to name a few. Buchanan, only a sophomore is entering his first season with the distinguished title.

#### **NEW COACHES JOIN THE AGGIES IN 22**

Three new coaches join the Aggies for the 2022 season. Veteran coach Andre Allen joins the staff from Washington State and will oversee the wide receivers. Allen brings over 30 years of coaching experience to the Aggies, including 27 in California. In his two seasons in Pullman, the WSU receiver room was one of the most heralded in the Pac-12. Taylor Chapatte will be in his first season coaching the Aggie tight ends. Chapatte comes to Davis from the University of San Diego, where he spent four seasons as an assistant coach. Chapatte was the pass game coordinator/quarterbacks coach for two seasons with the Toreros and was the wide receivers coach the previous two seasons. With the departure of Mark Speckman right before camp, former UC Davis offensive quality control coach Kevin Burke was elevated to work with the talented running backs room. Burke came to Davis after two different stints as an assistant coach at his alma mater Mount Union where he most recently served as the quarterbacks coach. Burke spent three seasons as an assistant football coach at Case Western Reserve University after his first

two-year stint as an assistant coach for the Purple Raiders.

#### HAWKINS EARNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

This offseason, UC Davis head football coach Dan Hawkins inked a contract extension through the 2027 season to continue to lead his alma mater. Coach Hawkins has led the Aggies to a 31-22 (.585) record over his five seasons. In just year two at the helm, Hawkins guided UC Davis to its first 10-win season since 2001 and its first FCS Playoff appearance in school history. The 23-16 victory over Northern lowa in 2018 marked the first postseason win for the Ags since 2002. After navigating the Aggies through the COVID-19 pandemic and on the heels of a shortened fivegame 2021 spring season, UC Davis again made an appearance in the FCS Playoffs last fall after an 8-4 campaign.

#### FIRST FULL OFFSEASON

For the first time since the 2019 season, the UC Davis football team got to enjoy a full offseason of preparation. The

Aggies participated in their first spring training schedule since leading up to that 2019 campaign. UC Davis did not play in 2020 and returned to action for five contests in the spring of 2021, before jumping right back into action for a full fall slate.

#### **SMALLEY NOMINATED FOR CAMPBELL AWARD**

UC Davis graduate linebacker Jayce Smalley is taking full advantage of his extra eligibility seasons. The UCLA graduate transfer, who earned his degree in just three years in Westwood, already etched his name on an MBA degree in Davis and is starting another graduate program in professional accountancy. Smalley boasted a 3.82 in his MBA program. Smalley started the season-opener at Cal.

#### AGGIES SHATTERING ATTENDANCE MARKS

The consumption of Aggie sports grew across the board in 2021-22. Ticket sales increased by a department record 31-percent, highlighted by record-setting attendance numbers in football in both students and general fans. Two new UC Davis Health Stadium records were broken this

past football season, hitting a high of 12,315 against Sacramento State with an average of over 11,000 in attendance across the five home games. Ticket revenues experienced a six-figure increase from previous seasons. The student body set new game day records as well, with over 8,000 entering the gates for their first game back in over a year and a half.



#### THE VERSATILE TRENT TOMPKINS

In his short time in an Aggie uniform, Trent Tompkins has done a lot of everything for the Aggies. Listed as a wide receiver in 2022, the sophomore was all over the stat sheet in 2021. The All-Big Sky second team selection at the all-purpose spot tied for the team-lead with six rushing touchdowns and ranked second on the squad with 448 yards on the ground. The Fresno native caught 12 passes for 77 yards and threw 18 passes for 102 yards and one score. Tompkins also returned two punts for 86 yards, including an 85-yard touchdown. In his season debut at Cal, Tompkins returned three punts for 11 yards, a kickoff for 15 yards, rushed for eight yards and caught four passes for 31 yards.

#### **DISCIPLINED APPROACH**

In the season-opener at Cal, UC Davis committed only three penalties. In the last five contests the Aggies have committed five or less penalties in each outing. In 2021, the Aggies were penalized more than five times in only five of the 12 games.

#### LINEBACKER LEADERSHIP

The Aggies return a lot of experience and continuity from its linebackers. Of the group, the leading tackler and sack leader from a year ago return in 2022. Team captain Teddye Buchanan paced the team with 74 total tackles, including 40 solo stops in 12 games played. He also registered two sacks, two interceptions, a quarterback hurry and 5.5 tackles for loss. Sack-leader Cam Trimble also looks to wreak havoc in the backfield as the senior totaled 9.5 tackles for loss and five sacks to lead the team. He registered 47 tackles with 27 solo stops. The Ags also return Nick Eaton, who ranked seventh on the team with

41 total tackles, including 19 solo stops and five for a loss. Veteran Cole Hansen, Jackson Cloyd and Jayce Smalley return as well.



#### **RUSHING RETURN**

The UC Davis offense returns its top three rushers from a year ago. Ulonzo Gilliam, Jr., Trent Tompkins and Lan Larison accounted for 1,604 yards on the ground and 15 touchdowns. In all, the Aggies return eight players that carried the ball in 2021, accounting for 1,784 yards.

#### **ELITE SPECIAL TEAMS**

Behind Hawkins, the Aggies have enjoyed special teams success and 2021 was another year to showcase that, spotting one of the best top-to-bottom special teams units in the nation during the regular season. The Aggies were one of the tops in the nation in kickoff return yards behind All-Big Sky Second Team honoree Lan Larison at 29.91 per return. He set a single-game program record with 211 kick return yards against Eastern Washington. Punt returner Isaiah Thomas was named to the All-Big Sky Second Team at that spot. Thomas ranked 15th in the nation in punt return average at nine yards per during the regular season. Conversely, UC Davis allowed just 18.96 yards per return, though those are few and far between with Daniel Whelan averaging over three touchbacks per kickoff. Speaking of Whelan, as an All-Big Sky Second Team choice averaged a school record 44.01 yards per punt for his career and a single season record 46.25 in 2021.

#### **GOING FOR TWO**

In 2021, UC Davis attempted six two-point conversions, with QB Trent Tompkins involved in five of them. He sucessfully ran for three and passed for one (to Garren O'Keefe). While an official school record for such plays does not exist, records dating back to 1964 show the following program highs: the 1967 (3-for-8), 1991 (4-for-8) and 1993 (6-for-8) teams had the most attempted conversions, with that 1993 squad owning the benchmark for most successful tries. Shaun Ayers scored three in 1991 for the individual best. However, UC Davis archives are incomplete, with the number of attempts missing from final

#### **AGGIES ON THE AIRWAVES**

UC Davis football will once again join forces with Sports 1140 KHTK. Scott Marsh enters his 16th season as the Aggies' primary play-by-play voice, while Doug Kelly continues to his analyst roll that dates back to the 1990s. The 2022 football season also marks the second under the Big Sky Conference's deal with the streaming platform ESPN+. During home games, the Aggies welcome Scott Gordon on the call with Marsh on the ESPN+ streaming network and Greg Wong will join Kelly on the radio.

#### THE HERITAGE LOGO

The "heritage logo," which consists of a comet-tail C with a capital A enclosed inside the counter, has become the primary mark for UC Davis athletics. However, as its name suggests, it is hardly a new logo. That particular CA first appeared on the UC Davis baseball uniform in 1958, and remained the team's cap logo until 1999, when SME Design (now SME Branding) created a family of logos and marks for the campus. The heritage logo returned on an unofficial basis during the university's Division I era, and became an official brand for the athletics department in 2018.

#### **UNCOMMON ENGINEERING**

Head coach Dan Hawkins put the time to work by hosting

a podcast called Uncommon Engineering during the spring of 2020. Dedicated to "celebrating all the extraordinary experiences life has to offer," Hawkins' podcast brought in a wide variety of guests, which with stories to inspire, motivate and educate its listeners. Guests comprised Mount Everest expeditionists Brad & Tonya Clement (Apr. 17), Holocaust survivor Alexander J. Groth (Apr. 24), astronaut Steve Robinson (May 2), MLB player/manager Clint Hurdle (May 8), Firefall guitarist Jock Bartley (May 15), CFL quarterback and head coach Khari Jones (May 22), recording artist and filmmaker Michael Franti (June 1), UC Davis women's basketball coach Jennifer Gross (June 5), and San Diego Chargers kicker, author and philanthropist Rolf Benirschke (June 12). Jones, Gross and Benirschke each are UC Davis alumni and members of the Cal Aggie Athletics Hall of Fame. #### **AGGIE EVO**

Launched in 2017-18, the Aggie EVO System is UC Davis Athletics' investment in the primary mission of preparing student-athletes for a successful "launch" after graduation. ### UC DAVIS HEALTH STADIUM

No, UC Davis football has not moved to a new home facility: the former Aggie Stadium has been rebranded as UC Davis Health Stadium effective July of 2019.

This comes as a result of an expanded partnership between UC Davis Athletics and UC Davis Health, a collaboration that will feature a new student-athlete performance center located to the immediate north of the campus's multi-use stadium (see AECOM Hunt and Gensler Sport's concept drawing at right).

With an official capacity of 10,849, UC Davis Health Stadium opened in 2007 as one of the three major facilities funded by the Facilities and Campus Enhancement, for F.A.C.E., Initiative of 1999.

The UC Davis women's lacrosse team was the first to compete on its Shaw Sports (formerly Sportexe) turf, defeating Saint Mary's on April 1, 2007. The football team began competing at UC Davis Health Stadium that fall, after more than a half century at Toomey Field.

The Aggie field hockey team also played at UC Davis Health Stadium before moving to its own facility in 2014, while men's soccer has contested key matchups on the turf in past years.

UC Davis Health Stadium was designed by industry leader Ellerbe Beckett, and built by local firm Brown Construction. It features fixed seating on each of the east and west sides, with grass berm seating – now known as the UC Davis Children's Hospital Family Zone – adjacent to each end zones. Beneath the press box resides the Bruce Edwards Club Room, a popular venue for receptions, meetings and other gatherings.

The 2022 season will bring a new field turf as installation was started in June by Tarkett Sports - the leaders in sports surfacing.









# A CRASH COURSE IN UC DAVIS FOOTBALL HISTORY

UC Davis competed in its 100th season of football in 2018, celebrating the occasion with a 10-3 record, a share of the Big Sky Conference championship and an appearance in the NCAA FCS postseason. What follows is your crash course on the high points of Aggie football history, for those unfamiliar with the program and its lore.

#### 20-17

While the Miracle Game (see box at right) arguably ranks as the most storied victory in program history, UC Davis' upset of Stanford on September 18, 2005 certainly rivals for that honor... The Aggies faced a 17-0 deficit by the midway point of the second quarter, with both Cardinal touchdowns coming on defensive plays... However, UC Davis rallied back with 20 unanswered points, culminating with a three-yard TD strike from Jon Grant to Blaise Smith with :08 left.

The win marked the program's first against a I-A team (now called FBS) since 1986, when UC Davis topped Pacific by a 45-41 final down in Stockton.

#### **CRADLE OF COACHES**

When UC Davis faced Southern Utah on October 19, it marked a meeting between two Aggie alumni: **Dan Hawkins** ('83) and **Demario Warren** ('08)... In fact, the Aggie football program has a proud tradition of sending alumni to Division I college head coaching positions... The list begins with 1970 graduate **Paul Hackett** (Pitt, USC), rolls through 1973 alumni **Mike Bellotti** (Oregon) and **Bob Biggs** (UC Davis), and continues with former Hawkins assistant and 1988 grad **Chris Petersen** (Boise State, Washington).

Hackett also takes part in a tradition of Aggie football alums serving on NFL staffs, along with current Denver Broncos head coach **Nathaniel Hackett** and is joined by defensive coordinator **Ejiro Evero**, although no former UC Davis player has had as long of an NFL coaching career as **Myrel Moore**, who served 16 years on the staffs of the Denver Broncos (1972-77, '82-88), Oakland Raiders (1979) and New England Patriots (1991-92)... The Aggie football staff has also served as an early point for such non-alumni mentors as **Gary Patterson**, TCU's head coach since 2000; and **Rich Scangarello**, who earned the post as Denver Broncos OC in 2019... Patterson served as Aggie linebackers coach in 1986, while Scangarello made two different stops at UC Davis as an assistant under Bob Biggs.

#### PROMINENT ALUMNI

In addition to the coaches list above, UC Davis football has enjoyed dozens of alumni entering the professional ranks, with 17 players earning selection in the NFL Draft... Among the most noted are **Ken O'Brien**, a member of the 1983 "Year of the Quarterback" draft who threw for more than 25,000 yards with the Jets and the Eagles; **Mark Grieb**, who retired as one of the all-time passing leaders in Arena Football League history; **Rolf Benirschke**, who earned NFL Man of the Year honors and kicked 146 field goals for the San Diego Chargers; and **Khari Jones**, who led the Winnipeg Blue Bombers to the 2001 Grey Cup... Jones also deserves a spot in the coaching section, as he took over the Montreal Alouettes in 2019.

#### AGGIE FOOTBALL BY THE NUMBERS

- **3** individuals associated with UC Davis football are enshrined in the College Football Hall of Fame. Ken O'Brien entered in 1997 for his outstanding playing career. Two years later, Jim Sochor earned induction for his coaching career. Most recently, Mike Bellotti entered the CFB Hall in 2014 in honor of his coaching accomplishments at Oregon.
- **5**: The number of conference affiliations UC Davis football has held, namely the Far Western Conference (1925-81), the Northern California Athletic Conference (1982-92), the American West Conference (1993), the Great West Conference (2004-11) and the Big Sky Conference (2012-present).
- **12** UC Davis players have earned NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship Award winners, an honor roll that includes Arena Football Hall of Famer Mark Grieb and San Diego Chargers Hall of Famer Rolf Benirschke.
- **14** Aggies have won CoSIDA Academic All-America honors (now sponsored by Google Cloud), with Ryan Parenteau and Tiger Garcia being the most recent recipients.
- 21: The Aggies made their first-ever appearance in the FCS playoffs in 2018, and returned in 2021, making it the 21st overall NCAA postseason berth through all divisions not counting a pair of College Division bowl games in the 1940s.
- 22 program alumni have appeared in at least one regular-season NFL game, with four players Ken O'Brien (1983), Tom Williams (1970), Bo Eason (1984) and Mike Wise (1986) drafted in one of the top two rounds.
- **24**: Aggie quarterback Ken O'Brien was chosen as the 24th overall pick of the 1983 NFL Draft (a.k.a. the Year of the Quarterback), making him the highest UC Davis selection in history. O'Brien passed for 25,094 yards and 128 touchdowns in the NFL, mostly with the New York Jets.
- 25: The only retired number in program history belonged to Sam Paneno, who suffered a severe knee injury during overtime of a September 11, 1999 game at Western Oregon. Due to complications with circulation, Paneno had the lower portion of his right leg amputated nine days later. His positive attitude throughout the ordeal earned national attention. Paneno was bestowed with the NCAA's inaugural Inspiration Award in 2001. Paneno graduated from UC Davis' King Hall School of Law in 2005, later established a nonprofit to protect abused and impoverished children and ran a law practice specializing in special education.
- **30**: The 2018 Big Sky Conference title marked the 30th league championship in history, a list that included 20 straight crowns from 1971-90.
- **37**: The number of consecutive winning seasons UC Davis enjoyed (1972-2008) under the guidance of head coaches Jim Sochor (1970-88), Bob Foster (1989-92) and Bob Biggs (1993-2012)

### A CRASH COURSE IN UC DAVIS FOOTBALL HISTORY

Outside the world of football and onto the screens, Benirschke's heroics with ulcerative colitis (which nearly ended his NFL career) and his subsequent humanitarian efforts made him a national hero, although he arguably gained the most public attention during a brief stint as the host of TV's Wheel of Fortune... Former Aggie safety **Bo Eason** went from a successful NFL career to an acting career (Miami Rhapsody), with a one-man, semi-autobiographical play called Runt of the Litter earning rave critical response... **Tim Lajcik** (pronounced "LAY-sick") an Aggie All-American in both football and wrestling, has 60 credits as a stunt perfomer (John Wick)... The UC Davis football leader for onscreen credits belongs to **Jim Haynie**, who turned his 1963 degree in dramatic art to nearly 100 roles – most notably **The Peacemaker**, **Pretty In Pink** and **The Bridges of Madison County**.

#### **NAMESAKES**

Two landmarks stand near the main entrance of UC Davis Health Stadium, both named after key university figures... The victory bell is named for Thomas Tavernetti, a university faculty member from 1913 to 1930... The bell is mentioned in the school fight song, "Aggie Fight," and rung after each home win... Across the plaza is a statue of Jim Sochor, who served as UC Davis head football coach from 1970-88... Sochor won 156 games and 17 conference titles in his career, and instilled a belief system later known as "Aggie Pride" (see below).

#### THE TOOM

Before moving to Aggie Stadium (now known as UC Davis Health Stadium) in 2007, UC Davis football played almost six decades worth of its home games at the corner of Russell Boulevard and A Street in a venue opened in 1949 and named for athletics director Crip Toomey in 1962... Toomey Field, or "The Toom" as it is known to many an alum, hosted a total of 286 Aggie home football contests, including nationally televised NCAA semifinal games in 1977 (Lehigh), 1982 (North Dakota State) and 1983 (North Dakota State).

#### **AGGIE PRIDE**

The term has since been appropriated by various entities on the UC Davis campus, but Aggie Pride belief system has its roots with the football program... After taking the helm in 1970, head coach Jim Sochor instilled a new culture: "We knew that everybody we played would be bigger, stronger and faster than we were. We had to find a way. And that way was that no one would be closer as a football team than we would be. Our central values became trust, unity and togetherness"... Bob Foster, the long-time Sochor assistant and later the Aggie head coach in his own right, is credited for giving Aggie Pride its name.

#### THE MIRACLE GAME

No two knowledgeable Aggie fans would ever agree on a top five list of the most memorable or significant victories in UC Davis football history, but everyone should have the 30-29 win over Cal State Hayward on Nov. 6, 1971 high on that list (if not on top). The Aggies trailed the defending conference champs, 29-14, entering the final minute of play. What follows is the play-by-play from that point forward.

DRIVE START: Steve Nathan's 30-yard punt return to the Hayward 42 with 0:44 remaining in regulation. UC Davis has no timeouts.
