- Getting named among the nation's best freshmen was Caden Pinnick, who was named to the 22-man Jerry Rice Award Watch List this past week.
- Pinnick was a force in the UC Davis homecoming win over No. 14 NAU, throwing for five touchdown passes and 348 yards
- Jacob Psyk has been a force all season, ranking nationally third in forced fumbles, sixth in TFLs and eighth in total sacks. His six sacks along with the team's 15 puts the Aggies 18th in the nation.

PLAYING EXPERIENCE

Tim Plough returned to his alma mater to become the 18th head coach in UC Davis football history in December of 2023. During 2024, the Aggies set a new bar for excellence and under the first year tutelage of Plough UC Davis won a school record 11 games, going 11-3 to finish No. 5 in the nation, the highest in the program's FCS history. UC Davis would go on to reach the quarterfinals of the NCAA FCS Playoffs, getting a second round home game win over No. 12 Illinois State after earning a first round bye as one of the best programs in the nation. Plough's 11-3 record was the best for a first-year head coach in the nation during the 2024 season and his 11 wins are the most by an Aggie first year head coach, passing legendary Aggie head coach Bob Biggs. Plough was honored for his first year successes by being named the AFCA Region Five Coach of the Year and an Eddie Robinson Award finalist. Individually, under Plough UC Davis produced several All-Americans as Miles Hastings, David Meyer, Lan Larison and Rex Connors all earned All-American honors to give UC Davis the most All-Americans in one season in program history. UC Davis also set 19 individual records and six team records during a record setting year. The former Aggie quarterback brings a wealth of coaching experience and his brilliant offensive mind to UC Davis with 11 campaigns as an offensive coordinator under his belt. Plough came to Davis after his most recent stint as an assistant coach at Cal, where he spent the 2023 season. Prior to his time in the Bay Area, he served as the offensive coordinator and leader of the quarterback room at Boise State. He was a part of the coaching staff that recruited the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history in 2021, a group that ranked second in the Mountain West. His expertise was immediately put on display when he spearheaded the conference's top offense that ranked seventh nationally in red zone offense, scoring on 92.5% of its trips to the red zone. Under Plough's mentorship, Broncos' quarterback Hank Bachmeier reached career-high numbers in completions (252), passing yards (3,079), touchdowns (20), and passing yards-per-game (256.6). Plough oversaw the development of First Team All-MWC receiver Khalil Shakir who notched career highs of 77 catches, 1,117 receiving yards, and seven touchdowns. Plough had two separate stints at UC Davis, the most recent being his 2017-2020 stretch. He began his collegiate coaching career with the Aggies in 2008 as a student assistant and quickly climbed the ranks, becoming the offensive coordinator in 2010. He became the youngest offensive coordinator in the nation (FBS and FCS) when he was elevated into that role at the age of 25. Plough held that position through the 2012 season before moving on to Northern Arizona in 2013. Plough returned to his alma mater to become the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the 2017 and 2018 seasons before he was elevated to Associate Head Coach for the next two seasons while maintaining his oversight of the Aggie offense. The San Diego native orchestrated one of the top passing offenses in all of the FCS, ranking sixth nationally in passing yards-per-game (309.2) in 2019. He led the squad to Division I era records in overall (10) and (7) conference victories and grabbed a share of the Big Sky title and the program's first FCS playoff appearance in 2018. Plough was a four-year letterwinner as a quarterback for UC Davis from 2004-2007. He became the starter in 2007 for his senior season. In that season, he completed better than 64 percent of his passes for 1,355 yards and 11 touchdowns.

THE SERIES

For the 14th time in history both UC Davis and Northern Colorado will meet on the gridiron, with the Aggies entering the game off their bye week and on a four game winning streak ... While an improved Northern Colorado team comes in having knocked off than-ranked No. 13 Idaho on the road to go along with an 3-4 record, and despite dropping their previous game they went toe-to-toe with Sacramento State on the road ... The Aggies also enter the game with a five-game winning streak against the Bears.

AN AGGIE WIN WOULD ...

Give the Aggies four-straight wins to open conference play, making it the second-straight year UC Davis can claim a four-game undefeated start to conference action ... the win would also extend the Aggies winning streak over Northern Colorado to a series-high six games ... UC Davis would also remain tied a top the Big Sky Conference ... It would also make it two wins off bye weeks for the 2025 Aggies and improve head coach Tim Plough to 3-0 all-time coming off bye weeks.

HOLDING SERVE ON HOME COURT

It was the second time in four years that Northern Arizona had been the opponent for the Aggies on homecoming and UC Davis made sure to act the way of proper hosts, knocking off Northern Arizona 45-24 for the sixth-straight homecoming victory. The win improved the Aggies homecoming record over the past seven homecoming games to 6-1 and over that stretch the Ags have outscored their opponents 304-156.

CADEN AND JERRY RICE

On Oct. 22, Stats Perform released it 2025 Jerry Rice Award Watch List and after a torrid start to the season Caden Pinnick was named among the 22 best freshmen in the nation. So far this season Pinnick has a completion percentage of 69.3 percent and has been averaging 235.7 passing yards per game. Starting all six games for the Aggies, Pinnick has rushed for 127 yards on 55 attempts, adding two more touchdowns on the ground for an average of 21.2 rushing yards per game. Nationally, Pinnick ranks third in passing efficiency (181.1); seventh in points responsible per game (18.0) and yards per pass attempt (9.4); eighth in passing touchdowns; ninth in completion percentage and 18th in passing yards per game and passing yards per completion (13.6).

CONFERENCE RECORD THREE-STRAIGHT FOR PINNICK

Pinnick tied a conference record, earning his third-straight Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week award following his top performance against NAU. In that game Pinnick threw for 348 yards, going 25-for-29 while tossing five touchdowns. The five touchdowns were the most thrown by an Aggie quarterback since 2018 and only the seventh time in program history an Aggie quarterback threw at least five in a game.

COMMITTEE SPEAKS

During the Aggie bye week, the FCS Committee announced its initial top 10 ranking of the season, placing UC Davis sixth. The seeding means that if the season ended today the Aggies would have a first round bye and host a second round game for the second-straight season.

PSYK KNOCKS IT OUT

Psyk sits third in the nation in forced fumbles with three over six games.

FISHER AVERAGES AMONG THE NATIONS BEST

After six games, Jordan Fisher has been averaging a high yardage per carry and his 7.1 yards per carry is evident of that. Nationally that places Fisher seventh in the country

NINE STRAIGHT OVER THAT TEAM DOWN SOUTH

Last weekend the Aggies went down to San Luis Obispo to take on “That Team Down South”, and after using 14 points in the final 15 the Aggies pulled away from Cal Poly to retain the Golden Horseshoe for the ninth-straight time. In the game Caden Pinnick accounted for 373 yards and four touchdowns while the defense held the Mustangs to just 71 yards rushing on 31 attempts. The ninth-straight win extends the longest winning streak in the history of a series that dates back to 1939.

PINNICK AWARDED FOR HIS SKILLS

During the Aggie win over Cal Poly, Pinnick passed for 313 yards, rushed for 60 yards, and went 21-for-26 for a career-best 81 percent completion percentage. He threw for three TDs and ran for one more, and the conference took notice naming him Big Sky Offensive POTW for the second straight week. It’s his third weekly award, adding to his Stats Perform National Freshman Player of the Week earlier in the season (week one).

BIG SKY BIG PINNICK

Since the start of Big Sky Conference play, Aggie quarterback Caden Pinnick has been on fire, going 37-for-53, throwing 601 yards and five touchdowns for a passing efficiency of 196.2. The back-to-back Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week has also rushed for 108 yards and two rushing touchdowns, totaling 709 all-purpose yards with an average of 354.5 offense yards over opening pair of conference games.

NEW THREADS SAME AGS

Debuting brand new Tahoe-themed jerseys in the Big Sky Conference opener the Aggies took care of business against Weber State, winning 34-12 to go 1-0 early in the conference season. UC Davis used over 300 yards of total offense from Caden Pinnick and the best overall defensive performance up to this point in the season to secure the conference win.

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE UC DAVIS TAHOE ENVIRONMENT RESEARCH CENTER

The Aggies and the UC Davis Tahoe Environment Research Center came together during the summer to create a partnership where UC Davis athletics will wear special “Aqua Blue” jerseys to promote the research and work being done daily at Lake Tahoe by UC Davis specialists. Against Weber State the Aggies broke the “Aqua Blues” out for the first time, with the jerseys showcasing a special logo where the “CA” stretches from coast to coast in the middle of Lake Tahoe.

PINNICK SHINES AND THE BIG SKY NOTICES

During the UC Davis win over Weber State, Caden Pinnick had his best game yet as an Aggie collecting over 300 yards of offense while scoring three touchdowns. The excellent performance earned him Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week honors, his second weekly award this season. Pinnick finished with 288 passing yards, going 16-for-27 and he threw a pair of touchdown. The Aggie signal caller also ran for 48 yards on 11 attempts, scoring one more touchdown on the ground, the first of his career.

Over a two game stretch from Sept. 20-27, Psyk was unstoppable collecting 16 total tackles and 6.5 tackles for loss in those two games. He also recorded 4.5 sacks over the two game stretch and after the Aggie win against Southern Utah, Psyk was named the Big Sky co-Defensive POTW.

17,217 MAKES IT A HOME OPENING PARTY

The Ags finally opened UC Davis Health Stadium when they welcome not only Southern Utah but also a record number of 17,217 Aggie fans, students and members of the Davis community. The Aggies did not disappoint, putting on a offensive show on the ground that nearly set a record that has stood since 1993 knocking off SUU 50-34 for the home opening win. As a team the Aggies rushed for 357 yards, the most in a game since 2021.

A PAIR OF AGGIES HIT THE GROUND CENTURY MARK

Jordan Fisher and Carter Vargas were explosive on the ground each breaking the century mark against Southern Utah to give UC Davis a pair of 100-yard rushers in a single game for only the eighth time in program history and first time since 2012. In the game Fisher broke out for his second-career 100-yard rushing game finishing with 170 yards and two touchdowns on 12 carries, while Vargas averaged 22.7 yards per carry on his way to 136 yards and two rushing touchdowns on just six touches.

CONNORS PASSES A CAL AGGIE HALL OF FAMER

Rex Connors set the program record for total tackles in the Aggie game at Washington, finishing with eight total tackles in the game to hit the 291 mark for his career. Connors passed Cal Aggie Hall of Famer Kris Spraker who sits at 290 career tackles during his career from 1997-2000. Connors moved into second-place at Utah Tech, passing Jason Hairston who sits at 271 total tackles from 1992-94 and he entered the game at Washington with 279 total tackles.

HAS IT REALLY BEEN 20 YEARS SINCE THAT DAY ON THAT FARM?

20 years ago, on Sept. 17, 2005, the 0-2 Aggies travelled a down the road to Stanford for its first matchup against the Cardinal in program history. The Aggies had only recently made the transition from Division II to Division I and entered the game 0-2 after close losses to open the season. It meant no difference, despite early turnovers that led directly to Stanford scores, the Aggies held their own up front and on both sides of the ball to keep things close. In the final two minutes Jon Grant took his Aggie offense down the field to set up a game winning score. The pass, caught by Blaise Smith in the corner of the end zone, capped off a great play called by head coach Bob Biggs to give the Aggies a win.

24 UNANSWERED IN THE HIGH DESERT

UC Davis traveled to St. George, Utah on Aug. 30 and late in the third quarter they were trailing by 17 points. It was there they got rolling, scoring back-to-back touchdowns to get within three points late in the third quarter. A Ridley field goal near the end of the quarter tied things up and set UC Davis up to finish off its biggest comeback since 2018. Pinnick then hit Gbatu Jr., for a 60-yard touchdown that put the Aggies ahead for good Rutchena then sealed the game with an interception to lock up the win.

PINNICK EARNS NATIONAL FRESHMAN HONORS

Pinnick was named the Stats Perform FCS National Freshman Player of the Week after the Aggie game at Utah Tech.

BIG SKY GIVES REX WEEKLY FLOWERS

With 15 tackles at Utah Tech, Rex Connors was named the Big Sky Defensive Player of the Week. Connors finished with eight solo tackles and seven assisted tackles to lead the defense in St. George.

HOME AND HOME WITH NORTH DAKOTA STATE

UC Davis and North Dakota State announced on Sept. 1, 2025 a home and home series starting in 2028. The Aggies will head to N.D. to face the Bison in 2028 before the series moves to Davis., in 2029. It is a rematch of former Great West Conference foes and when they meet in 2028 it will be the 12th time in history and the first since 2019.

MOTHER NATURE WINS THE DAY

UC Davis and No. 11 Mercer met for the first time in program history at the historic Cramton Bowl, taking part in the 2025 FCS Kickoff Classic. With 7:46 to go in the game a storm rolled through Montgomery, Alabama sending the game into a weather delay that would eventually end in the game being considered a "No Contest". With time rolling on, both sides agreed that finishing the game was not possible due to the weather. All the stats for that game will not count for either team, it will be as if the game never happened.

ADDING TO THE HISTORY AT THE CRAMTON BOWL

UC Davis headed to Montgomery to play in the historic Cramton Bowl, first opening in 1922 and the bowl has played host to many football and baseball games in its decorated history. For this game, the Aggies entered as the highest ranked FCS team to ever play on the historic patch of grass, sitting behind Alabama who lost a 1953 game to Southern Miss., when ranked No. 5 in the nation. It is also the first time a pair of top-20 teams met in the Cramton Bowl.

AGS ON ESPN

For the first time in program history UC Davis finds itself on the linear flagship network ESPN, thanks to the Kickoff Classic being broadcast on the network. The game between the Aggies and Bears was unique since it was played on Week 0. Among FCS games the Kickoff Classic was one of five games being played across the nation. On the FBS side, only five games were going with three happening during the Kickoff Classic. Meaning that across the nation UC Davis were one of only five games playing at the same time.

RANKED AMONG THE BEST

UC Davis enters the season ranked inside the top 10 in both the Stats Perform and AFCA Preseason polls. The Aggies come in at No. 8 in the Stats Perform poll and No. 7 in the AFCA poll. Its the highest preseason ranking the Aggies have earned since the 2019 preseason.

NATIONAL DAVIS

UC Davis finds itself on a program record three nationally broadcast games. Starting with the season opener on ESPN, the Aggies will be on the Big 10 Network at Washington and on ESPN2 when they head to No. 2 Montana State in November.

EARLY START

The Aug. 23 kickoff date marks the earliest kickoff in program history. Besting four games played on August 30. It also marks the ninth time in history and third straight season the Aggies will have at least one game in August.

ROAD WARRIORS

UC Davis, for the first time since 2006, opens its first three games away from Davis, California. After the Aggies visit Montgomery, they will travel to St. George, Utah to face Utah Tech before heading to Seattle, Washington to face the Washington Huskies. This year marks the third time in program history the Aggies have begun their season away from home for so long, spending the opening three weekends away in 2006 and 1978.

REX IS BACK ... THE NATION HAS TAKEN NOTICE

Returning for 2025 is talented safety Rex Connors, and he brings with him a collection of 2024 honors that have evolved into 2025 preseason accolades. Connors ended 2024 as a four-time All-American, first team All-Big Sky Conference honors and his 74 solo tackles set a program record. This season he comes in ranked as the No. 1 returning safety by HERO Sports and he has already earned multiple preseason All-American honors. Connors also became the first Aggie to earn Big Sky Preseason Defensive Player of the Year honors to go along with Preseason All-Conference.

WATCHING REX

Entering the season, Rex Connors has found himself on a pair of prestigious watch lists. He was named to the Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watchlist, a place he has found himself on for two-straight seasons. Connors was also named to the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 Watchlist, placing him among some of the best NFL prospects in the nation.

ALL-AMERICAN AGGIES

the Aggies have been finding themselves individually on several All-American lists, with five Aggies earning honors. Rex Connors (first team), Winston Williams (second team), Hunter Ridley (second team) and Porter Connors (third team) earned the honor from Stats Perform. While FCS Football Central added Jacob Psyk (second team) to a collection that saw Connors and Ridley earn first team honors, Williams earn second team honors and Porter bring home third team honors. It's the most preseason All-Americans in program history.

RUNNING THE CONFERENCE

During the preseason awards given out by the Big Sky Conference, the Aggies brought home the most awards in the league. Earning seven All-Conference honors while boasting the Preseason Defensive MVP in Rex Connors. Rex was joined by Porter, Samuel Gbatu Jr., Winston Williams, Ernesto Nava, Eli Simonson and Hunter Ridley on the list of honorees.

STRONG UP FRONT

UC Davis returns all its starting offensive linemen from the 2024 team, making them one of three teams in the nation that can make that claim. The collection of talent meant that HERO Sports named the Aggie offensive line as the fourth best returning line in the nation.

WILLIAMS NAMED AMONG THE BEST

HERO Sports named Aggie tight end Winston Williams as the second-best returning tight end in the nation. The preseason All-American finished 2024 with 265 receiving yards, six receiving touchdowns on 34 receptions and he enters the season with a career total of 326 receiving yards.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

The Aggies brought in a large collection of freshman and transfers, with several of those incomers already finding themselves either on the field or near the top of the depth chart.

GOOD WORKS RIDLEY

Hunter Ridley earned the honor of being among 197 nominees named to the 2025 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, recognizing his commitment to community service and leadership beyond the gridiron.

DRAFTED TEDDYE

Former Aggie linebacker Teddy Buchanan heard his name called during the 2025 NFL Draft, becoming the first Aggie drafted since J.T. O’Sullivan (2002) when he went to the Baltimore Ravens in the fourth round with the 129th overall pick.

CLUB FRED IS OPEN FOR BUSINESS

During the offseason, UC Davis athletics proudly announced that thanks to the contributions from The Arp Family Foundation that the UC Davis football defensive line coaching position was renamed the Jane and Fred Arp Defensive Line Coach. Fred was a former Aggie and is a member of the Cal Aggie Athletics Hall of Fame. He spent 41 seasons on the coaching staff at Davis.

NAMESAKES

Two landmarks stand near the main entrance of UC Davis Health Stadium, both named after key university figures. The victory bell is named for Thomas Tavernetti, a university faculty member from 1913 to 1930... The bell is mentioned in the school fight song, “Aggie Fight,” and rung after each home win... Across the plaza is a statue of Jim Sochor, who served as UC Davis head football coach from 1970-88... Sochor won 156 games and 17 conference titles in his career, and instilled a belief system later known as “Aggie Pride” (see below).

THE TOOM

Before moving to Aggie Stadium (UC Davis Health Stadium) in 2007, UC Davis football played almost six decades worth of its home games at the corner of Russell Boulevard and A Street in a venue opened in 1949 and named for athletics director Crip Toomey in 1962... Toomey Field, or “The Toom” as it is known to many an alum, hosted a total of 286 Aggie home football contests, including nationally televised NCAA semifinal games in 1977 (Lehigh), 1982 (North Dakota State) and 1983 (NDSU)

AGGIE PRIDE

The term has since been appropriated by various entities on the Davis campus, but Aggie Pride belief system has its roots with the football program. After taking the helm in 1970, head coach Jim Sochor instilled a new culture: “We knew that everybody we played would be bigger, stronger and faster than we were. We had to find a way. And that way was that no one would be closer as a football team than we would be. Our central values became trust, unity and togetherness.” Bob Foster, the long-time Sochor assistant and is credited for giving Aggie Pride its name.

UC DAVIS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- Pinnick made it three-straight Big Sky Offensive POTW honors following his five touchdown 348 passing yard performance in the Aggie win over Northern Arizona. The honor ties a conference record.
- Pinnick became the first Aggie QB to throw for at least five touchdowns in a game since Jake Maier did it in 2018
- Pinnick was named to the Jerry Rice Award Watch List
- A second-straight Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week award came Pinnick's way after the Aggies knocked off Cal Poly. Pinnick threw for 313 yards and three touchdowns while rushing for 60 yards and one touchdown. He was a solid 21-for-26 (81%) on the night.
- Following a performance where Pinnick threw for 288 yards and ran for 48, being responsible for three touchdowns, the Aggie signal caller was named the Big Sky Offensive Player of the Week

Oct. 11, 2025 | Davis, Calif. | UC Davis Health Stadium | 9,937

The Aggies took their opening drive down 29 yards and got the scoring opened with a 42-yard field goal nailed through the up-rights by Hunter Ridley. Northern Arizona took the lead for its only time in the game when they went 13 plays for 65 yards capped off by a 20-yard touchdown pass to put the Lumberjacks up 7-3. That play essentially ended the first period with NAU leading 7-3. Back-to-back punts to by both UC Davis and Northern Arizona opened the second quarter before the Aggies wrestled back the lead on an explosive drive by Gbatu Jr. In the opening play Pinnick hit Gbatu Jr., up the middle for 47 yards placing the Aggies near midfield. And three plays later Pinnick again found Gbatu Jr., streaking deep hitting him for a 31-yard catch and run as the Aggie receiver streaked down the sideline to cash in the first Aggie touchdown of the game. Northern Arizona drove into the red zone on its next possession, but the Aggie defense locked in, keeping the Lumberjacks out of the endzone and forcing a field goal attempt that NAU missed allowing the score to stay at 10-7. The half came to an end with the Aggies creating a turnover and setting themselves up for a possible score before the break. Psyk caused the fumble on a strip sack before Nate Rutchena recovered the loose ball to give Davis the ball on the NAU 39. Several plays later, Ridley lined up for a 50-yard field goal attempt, and despite sending it the ball floated just short of sailing over the cross bar. With the half ending UC Davis held a 10-7 lead. It did not take long for the Aggies to get on the board in the second half when on the first possession Fisher broke one up the middle. He went 59 yards up the middle to cash in for six immediately giving the Aggies early momentum to open the second half and a 17-7. Northern Arizona answered with a touchdown drive that went 62 yards in six plays and ended in a seven-yard rush up the middle to make it 17-14. UC Davis had an answer, and it came on the next drive. Pinnick battled through a sack in the drive, maintaining his composure to set up an Aggie score. On third and two from the UC Davis 49-yard line Pinnick took a shotgun snap and with some help from Fisher, Vargas and a quick slight of hands the Aggies found the end zone. After faking the hand off to Fisher, Pinnick shoveled a pass to Vargas who had gone in pre-snap motion and came across Pinnick's face who took the shovel pass 50 yards to the house to make it 24-14 Aggies. In what was a back-and-forth quarter, NAU answered with a field goal from 32 yards out to make it 24-17. UC Davis opened the fourth quarter by finishing a drive they started in the previous period, capping off a 75-yard 13-play drive to make it 31-17 in the blink of an eye. Stacy Dobbins, who finished the game with 71 yards receiving, made the big play in the drive hauling in a 25-yard pitch and catch from Pinnick to kick start the drive's momentum. Following a long kickoff return, Northern Arizona answered with a rushing touchdown from four yards out to make it 31-24, it would be the last time the Lumberjacks would find the scoreboard. But on the next drive Northern Arizona had thought the momentum was moving in their direction. On the first play of the Aggie drive after the NAU score, Vargas was stripped and ended up fumbling away the possession at mid-field. The Aggie turnover meant the Northern Arizona was in position to drive and potentially tie the game midway through the final quarter, the Aggie defense had different plans. On the next play, acting as the first play of the NAU drive, Khalani Riddick came flying in and with a swing of his fist punched the ball out creating a fumble that was quickly recovered by Jake Williams. The Aggies then took the next possession down and put the final nail in the Lumberjack coffin, using six plays to go 47 yards. The drive was capped off by Pinnick finding Dobbins from 10 yards out for six, making it 38-24 Aggies. One more cherry was placed on top for UC Davis when Pinnick delivered Mitchell Dixon a birthday present with an over the shoulder touchdown pass to put the finishing touches on a 45-24 Aggie victory.
