PROGRESSIVE LEGENDS CLASSIC

• UCLA continues Regional Round action of the 2012 Progressive Legends Classic against James Madison in New Pauley Pavilion on Thursday night. James Madison will open its 2012-13 season on Thursday evening.

• The Bruins defeated UC Irvine in overtime, 80-79, on Tuesday night. Larry Drew II scored the game-winning basket on a layup with 17 seconds to play. Jordan Adams led UCLA with 26 points, connecting on 16-of-16 free throws.

• UCLA will continue its season in the Progressive Legends Classic next week in Brooklyn, N.Y. (at Barclays Center). The Bruins face Georgetown on Monday, Nov. 19. UCLA will take on Indiana or Georgia the following night.

ABOUT JORDAN ADAMS

CONSECUTIVE 20+ GAMES: Freshman guard Jordan Adams, a 6-foot-5 product from Atlanta, scored a game-high 26 points against UC Irvine on Tuesday after having recorded a game-high 21 points in UCLA's season-opening win on Friday, Nov. 9. In the process, Adams has put himself in elite company with his point totals and free throw shooting.

• Adams' 26 points against UC Irvine (Nov. 13) are the most by any UCLA freshman since Kevin Love registered 29 points in an 88-78 win over Western Kentucky in the "Sweet 16" (March 27, 2008).

• Adams has become the first UCLA freshman to score in double digits in his first two collegiate games since Kevin Love accomplished that feat in November 2007 (Love had 22 in his debut, followed by 21).

• Adams' 21 points versus Indiana State are the most by a UCLA freshman in his collegiate debut since Nov. 9, 2007 (Kevin Love, 22 points, versus Portland State in a 69-48 victory in Pauley Pavilion).

• Adams became the fifth UCLA player under head coach Ben Howland to have logged at least 20 points in the Bruins' season-opening game (Howland's first season was 2003-04). The other four players include Kevin Love (11/9/07), Luc Richard Mbah a Moute (11/15/06), Arron Afflalo (11/15/05) and Michael Fey (11/29/03).

FREE THROW SHOOTING: Jordan Adams was 16-for-16 at the free throw line against UC Irvine (Nov. 13). He finished one free throw shy of Reggie Miller's Pauley Pavilion-record 17-for-17 effort against Arizona State (1/16/86).

• No UCLA player has made at least 16 free throws since Reggie Miller's 17-for-17 performance (1/16/86).

• Other recent "perfect" free throw efforts have come from Darren Collison (13/13, vs. Oregon State, 1/26/08) and Arron Afflalo (13/13, vs. Arizona, 2/4/06).

• Adams' 16-for-16 effort was five free throws shy of the Pac-12 Conference record for free throw percentage – John Block of USC made 21 of 21 free throws against Washington on Feb. 11, 1966.

• Adams' 16-for-16 effort was the best "perfect" free throw performance among Pac-12 players since Jan. 17, 2009, when Washington State's Taylor Rochestie went 16-for-16 at the line against Stanford in Pullman, Wash.

• As a senior in high school (2011-12) at Oak Hill Academy, Adams made 34 straight free throws during the first half of the season (over the course of 12 games), setting a school record for consecutive free throws made.

• Arron Afflalo was the last UCLA player to attempt 16 or more FTs, going 13-for-16 against Arizona (2/4/06).

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

In UCLA's season opener against Indiana State, David Wear (13 pts, 10 rbs) and Kyle Anderson (10 pts, 10 rbs) logged the first double-doubles in any UCLA season opener since Nov. 9, 2007 (Kevin Love, 22 pts/13 rbs, versus Portland State). David Wear has totaled three double-doubles at UCLA (two in 2011-12, one in 2012-13).

EARLY SEASON NOTES

• Now in his 10th season as the Bruins' head coach, Ben Howland has become just the third head coach in program history to have coached UCLA for at least 10 seasons (also Caddy Works and John Wooden).

• UCLA has gone 8-2 in 10 season-opening games under head coach Ben Howland. The Bruins have opened the season with a 2-0 record in seven of nine seasons under Howland's direction.

• The Bruins have opened the season 3-0 five times in Ben Howland's previous nine seasons at the helm. UCLA's best start to any season in the Howland Era took place in 2006-07, opening the year 14-0 (first loss was Jan. 6, 2007).

• Prior to the season-opening win over Indiana State (Nov. 9), two of UCLA's 17 players had played in "old" Pauley Pavilion – juniors Tyler Lamb and Joshua Smith. David and Travis Wear were members of the 2010-11 team (UCLA's most recent season in Pauley Pavilion) but sat out due to NCAA rules after having transferred from North Carolina.

• The Bruins have posted a 111-24 record (.822) in Pauley Pavilion under head coach Ben Howland. Now in its 47th season in the building, UCLA has compiled a 639-99 record (.866) in Pauley Pavilion.

WEEKLY AVAILABILITY

Ben Howland's weekly press conference take place in the media room of New Pauley Pavilion (northeast corner, event level). Press conferences are slated to begin each Tuesday at 3:30 p.m. Dates and times are subject to change. Selected players will be available to the media following Coach Howland's remarks. Press conferences are not open to the public.

CREDENTIALS

Admission to Pauley Pavilion's press seating and media room is by credential only. All credential requests should be made through UCLA's credential website at least two days in advance of the game. Website address and instructions can be obtained by emailing Alex Timiraos (atimiraos@athletics.ucla.edu). Members of the media covering UCLA should request credentials for road games through Timiraos (via email, or phone at 310-206-0524).

CREDENTIAL PICKUP

Credentials are available during the week at the Sports Information Office. Credentials not claimed prior to game day will be available at Pauley Pavilion's "Will Call" window (Northwest corner of the arena). The media will call window and entrance open two hours prior to tip-off.

MEDIA SEATING

A press pass enables entrance at Pauley Pavilion's Northwest media gate (across from the intramural field). Press seating is located in the upper level of the arena's south side (opposite team benches). Overflow seating is available on a limited basis. Pauley Pavilion's media workroom is located in the Northeast corner of the building on the event level.

POSTGAME PROCEDURE

Head coach Ben Howland and selected players will be available to the media in New Pauley Pavilion's media room following a 10-minute cooling off period after each game. UCLA's locker room is closed to the media. To access the media room during or after the game, follow the stairwell down to the court and proceed to the northeast corner (elevator access available on the southeast corner of the building). The visiting team's head coach will be available following a 10-minute cooling off period outside the visiting locker room (northwest corner, event level).

BRUINS IN OVERTIME

With Tuesday night's 80-79 overtime victory against UC Irvine, UCLA improved its record to 11-7 in overtime during head coach Ben Howland's tenure (since 2003-04). UCLA did not play any overtime contests last season and has now won three of its last four games that have extended to overtime (Bruins went 2-1 in overtime in 2010-11). Against UC Irvine, Jordan Adams scored six of UCLA's 13 overtime points (going 4-for-4 at the free throw line).

A GLANCE AT JAMES MADISON

James Madison opens its season against UCLA on Thursday evening. The Dukes, hailing from Harrisonburg, Va., went 12-20 overall last season, posting a 5-13 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) to finish eighth in the league. After a 7-4 start, key injuries piled up as the Dukes went 5-16 the rest of the way. James Madison was picked to finish sixth out of 11 conference teams in the CAA preseason poll.

UPCOMING OPPONENTS

UCLA is currently in a 23-day span that features eight regular-season games (Nov. 9-Dec. 1). The Bruins will fly to Brooklyn this weekend and will face Georgetown on Monday and either Indiana or Georgia on Tuesday, Nov. 20. The Bruins will host Cal Poly (Nov. 25) and Cal State Northridge (Nov. 28) the week after Thanksgiving. UCLA will face San Diego State (Dec. 1) at the Honda Center in Anaheim, Calif., in the annual John R. Wooden Classic in two weeks.

WHO'S BACK

The Bruins return three starters from its 2011-12 team – junior forwards David Wear (10.2 ppg) and Travis Wear (11.5 ppg) and junior guard Tyler Lamb (8.8 ppg). Junior center Joshua Smith (9.9 ppg) and sophomore guard Norman Powell (4.6 ppg) saw significant action off the bench for UCLA last season. Lamb and Powell were two of three players on the team (along with then-senior Lazeric Jones) to have played in all 33 games.

WELCOME TO WESTWOOD

UCLA's program has welcomed eight newcomers – five freshmen, one sophomore, and two juniors – in addition to gaining the services of redshirt senior guard Larry Drew II, who sat out the 2011-12 season after transferring from North Carolina. ESPN.com has ranked UCLA's incoming class as the nation's No. 1 recruiting class (featuring true freshmen Jordan Adams, Kyle Anderson, Shabazz Muhammad and Tony Parker).

RETURNING HOME

UCLA played 19 home games on the road in 2011-12 – 14 at the Los Angeles Sports Arena, four at the Honda Center (Anaheim, Calif.) and one exhibition game at Citizens Business Bank Arena (Ontario, Calif.). After winning the exhibition game in Ontario, the Bruins posted a 14-4 record at their local "home" venues, including a perfect 4-0 mark at the Honda Center in Anaheim. UCLA went 10-4 in games played at the Los Angeles Sports Arena.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

UCLA plays its first season in New Pauley Pavilion in 2012-13 after the iconic arena underwent a 33-month, \$136 renovation. Originally opened in 1965, Pauley Pavilion is one of the nation's premier all-around collegiate facilities. While calling Pauley Pavilion home, the men's basketball program has won nine NCAA Championships and 21 conference titles. The Bruins have logged an all-time 639-99 (.866) record in Pauley Pavilion (now in its 47th season).

RECORD SETTING: UCLA's crowd of 13,513 against Indiana State on Friday, Nov. 9, broke the single-game record for Pauley Pavilion attendance. Previously, Pauley Pavilion had hosted 13,478 fans in a 73-69 win over Duke on Feb. 23, 1997. The arena's next-largest crowd came four days before (13,382 vs. USC on 2/19/97).

NEW PAULEY PAVILION

The complete renovation of UCLA's historic arena, Pauley Pavilion, took 33 months and cost just under \$136 million. New Pauley Pavilion seats approximately 13,800 fans – 1,000 more than the "old" Pauley Pavilion. Other key features of the renovated facility include a custom-designed video board, additional LED hustle boards, major increases in restrooms and a wider variety of concession stands. Here are a few key features, at a glance:

- New Pauley Pavilion houses a 16-foot by 12-foot, LED, High Definition Daktronics Video board perched above center court with all four sides visible to fans.
- In addition, there are LED hustle boards in each of the corners that track player statistics, as well as an LED ribbon board encircling the top of the arena.
- New Pauley Pavilion now has 154% more restrooms through the building, including on the event level.
- The pavilion's North side hosts a grand lobby that highlights the theme "Champions Made Here" as well as the multi-purpose Pavilion Club for game-day hospitality.
- Additional dining options include California Pizza Kitchen, Subway, Full Court Press Panini, Jamba Juice, Pavilion Market, Joe Brewin Coffee Stand, the outdoor South Plaza and traditional fare.
- Not only does New Pauley Pavilion have a wider variety of concession stands, the arena now features a UCLA team store in the Northeast corner, operated by ASUCLA.
- New Pauley Pavilion includes nearly 100 monitors throughout the building, many of which are used to show the game telecast. Other monitors can be used as menu boards at numerous concession points.
- The renovation established 70,000 additional square feet of usable space than existed in the building's previous configuration. Additions include two state-of-the-art locker rooms with cherry wood lockers and adjacent lounge areas, a 24-seat film room, weight room and sports medicine room.

RANKING UCLA

UCLA has gone 21-15 (.583) against ranked teams the last six seasons. The Bruins went 11-2 against ranked teams in 2006-07, 7-2 versus ranked foes in 2007-08, 1-4 against ranked teams in 2008-09, 0-2 in 2009-10, 2-3 in 2010-11 and 0-2 in 2011-12.

UCLA returned to the top of the AP poll's No. 1 spot for the first time in 12 years on Nov. 27, 2006. Prior to that ranking, UCLA was previously ranked No. 1 in the final AP poll of the 1995 season, the year in which UCLA captured its 11th NCAA Championship.

UCLA has gone 242-15 (.942) in 257 games when playing as the nation's No. 1-ranked team. The Bruins have gone 128-3 in 131 home games as the No. 1-ranked team. In all, UCLA has spent 134 weeks ranked No. 1 in the country (12 ahead of second-place Duke, 122).

NEW YORK HISTORY

The Bruins are set to play two games next week in Brooklyn, N.Y., at Barclays Center. UCLA has recorded a 15-12 all-time record while playing in New York City, with nearly all of those games having been played at Madison Square Garden. Under head coach Ben Howland, the Bruins have gone 2-5 in seven contests in the Big Apple.

PRESEASON PROJECTIONS

UCLA was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 Conference men's basketball standings, according to a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover Pac-12 hoops. The Bruins trailed Arizona in the preseason poll by one point and received 16 of 35 first-place votes (Arizona gained 15 first-place votes). California, Stanford and Washington were selected third, fourth and fifth, respectively. Rounding out the conference's preseason poll, in order, were Colorado, Oregon, Oregon State, USC, Washington State, Arizona State and Utah. The last time that the predicted winner captured the conference's regular-season crown was in 2009-2010 (California). Washington won the 2011-12 regular-season crown, while Colorado won the 2011-12 Pac-12 Conference Tournament.

BRUINS ON TELEVISION

All 31 regular-season UCLA men's basketball games will be televised on either a regional or national basis. UCLA will have at least 11 games televised by the ESPN family of networks. Fox Sports Net will televise at least five games, while Pac-12 Networks will carry 13 contests. UCLA's home game against Oregon (Jan. 19) and road contest versus Washington (March 9, season finale) will be broadcast on CBS. Over the past 31 seasons, 762 games have been broadcast live in Los Angeles. ESPN will originate its weekly College Gameday program from Pauley Pavilion on March 2, 2013, when the Bruins host Arizona in their final regular-season home contest.

INJURY REPORT

Freshman Kyle Anderson and junior Tyler Lamb are both listed as gametime decisions for Thursday night. Anderson has a bone contusion on his right wrist (sustained Nov. 13). Lamb has a swollen left knee. He missed four weeks prior to the season after having undergone arthroscopic surgery on his left knee (Oct. 9). Lamb had four points in 14 minutes of UCLA's game last Friday (did not play on Tuesday). Sophomore Nick Kazemi remains sidelined with a sprained left MCL (sustained during practice on Oct. 26) and is expected to miss 1-2 months.

FOREIGN TOUR

The Bruins enjoyed a goodwill tour in China in August 2012, going 3-0 in exhibition games against university and professional teams. The Bruins landed in Beijing on Thursday, Aug. 23, traveled to Shanghai on Sunday, Aug. 26 and returned to Los Angeles the evening of Wednesday, Aug. 29. Among the most memorable sightseeing adventures included trips to the Great Wall of China and the Forbidden City (Beijing) on Friday, Aug. 24.

UCLA 116, Tsinghua University 68 - Saturday, Aug. 25, 2012 (Beijing)

David Wear recorded game-highs with 22 points and 15 rebounds, connecting on 10 of 11 shots as UCLA cruised to an 116-68 win over Tsinghua University in its first of three exhibition games. Travis Wear and Norman Powell each finished with 19 points. The Bruins had six players score in double figures. Joshua Smith recorded 18 points, while Tyler Lamb had 14 points. Kyle Anderson registered 11 points, 13 rebounds and six assists.

UCLA 72, Shanghai Jiao Tong University 31 - Monday, Aug. 27, 2012 (Shanghai)

Jordan Adams led the Bruins with 20 points in UCLA's 72-31 win over Shanghai Jiao Tong University. Adams scored 11 of UCLA's first 15 points, including the first seven points of the game. He finished 9-for-17 from the field. Travis Wear registered a double-double, scoring 12 points and grabbing a game-high 12 rebounds. Norman Powell had 13 points (on 6-of-10 shooting) and Joshua Smith finished with 10 points and six rebounds.

UCLA 92, Shanghai Sharks 63 - Tuesday, Aug. 28, 2012 (Shanghai)

Travis Wear scored a game-high 26 points while Kyle Anderson logged a double-double with 21 points and 11 rebounds in UCLA's 92-63 win over the Shanghai Sharks of the Chinese Basketball Association (CBA). Jordan Adams scored 18 points on 7-of-15 shooting, and Tyler Lamb rounded out the Bruins' list of double-digit scorers with 15 points and a game-leading six steals. UCLA met former NBA standout Yao Ming (Shanghai Sharks co-owner) following the game.

NOTES ON BEN HOWLAND

- Embarking on his 10th season at UCLA, Howland has now spent over half his head coaching tenure at UCLA. He was announced as UCLA's head coach April 3, 2003, after four seasons as head coach at Pittsburgh.
- Since the Pac-12 expanded to 10 teams in 1978-79, only six coaches have coached at their schools for at least 10 seasons – Lute Olson (24/Arizona), Ralph Miller (19/Oregon State), Mike Montgomery (18/Stanford), Ernie Kent (13/Oregon), Ben Braun (12/California) and Lorenzo Romar (11th at Washington this year). Ben Howland, currently in his 10th season at UCLA, is on his way to becoming the seventh coach in that category.
- In nine trips to the NCAA Tournament, Howland has coached his teams to five "Sweet 16" appearances and three Final Four appearances (all with UCLA, from 2006-2008).
- Howland's 97 victories at UCLA from 2006 through 2008 stand as the highest three-year win total in school history. He became one of three coaches in NCAA Division I history to win at least 30 games in three consecutive seasons, joining Adolph Rupp (Kentucky, 1947-49) and John Calipari (2006-08).
- Howland has secured Conference Coach of the Year acclaim in three different leagues – 2006, Pac-10 at UCLA; 2002, Big East at Pittsburgh; and in 1997, Big Sky at Northern Arizona.
- Through nine years as UCLA's head coach, Howland has helped produce 12 NBA Draft selections, the highest total among Pac-12 programs in that span. The Bruins' 12 draft selections rank among the top five, nationally (2004-12).

- Since 1948, UCLA stands as the all-time collegiate leader in NBA Draft selections with 108, ahead of Kentucky (106), North Carolina (101) and Duke (77).
- UCLA currently has 11 former players competing in the NBA, five of which were drafted in the first round.
- Russell Westbrook and Kevin Love were taken in back-to-back selections (No. 4, No. 5) in the first round of the 2008 NBA Draft by the Seattle SuperSonics and Memphis Grizzlies, respectively.
- Ben Howland has produced six first-round NBA Draft selections in nine seasons as UCLA's head coach – Jordan Farmar (2006), Arron Afflalo (2007), Russell Westbrook (2008), Kevin Love (2008), Jrue Holiday (2009) and Darren Collison (2009).
- Russell Westbrook helped the Oklahoma City Thunder win the 2012 NBA Western Conference title, guiding the team to a 47-19 (.712) regular-season record, the third-best mark among all 30 NBA teams.
- Kevin Love and Russell Westbrook both competed for the USA Men's Basketball Olympic Team over the summer, leading Team USA to the gold medal in London.
- Five former UCLA basketball players changed NBA teams over the summer – Arron Afflalo from Denver to Orlando, Trevor Ariza from New Orleans to Washington, Matt Barnes from the L.A. Lakers to the L.A. Clippers, Darren Collison from the Indiana Pacers to the Dallas Mavericks and Ryan Hollins from the Boston Celtics to the L.A. Clippers.

Wooden to win three straight conference titles and is UCLA's only head coach other than Wooden to have guided the program to three consecutive NCAA Final Four appearances. In 18 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Howland has led his teams to the NCAA Tournament nine times and to the "Sweet 16" five times, including three consecutive trips at UCLA (2006-08).
