MATADORS TRAVEL TO FACE NO. 16 BRUINS

CSUN Men's Basketball opened up its 59th season on Friday evening with a 96-72 win over Pomona-Pitzer at The Matadome. The Matadors conclude the weekend with a Sunday road game at No. 16 UCLA at 6 p.m. The game will be aired live on the Pac-12 Network and both Ghizal Hasan and Alan Zinsmeister will call all the action from UCLA on an audio broadcast on the CSUN Sports Network.

SEASON OPENING WIN

CSUN (1-0) cruised to a 24-point victory over Pomona-Pitzer in its season opener. Four Matadors scored in double figures led by junior guard Darin Johnson who made his CSUN debut and finished with 20 points and seven rebounds. Kendall Smith had 17 points in the win while Aaron Parks and Tayrion Dawson had 16 and 15 points respectively.

Much like its exhibition victory over Cal State LA on October 29, CSUN enjoyed a lead for most of the night against Pomona-Pitzer. The Matadors led by as many as 41 points before collecting a 96-72 win to stretch their home-opening winning streak to 15 games.

The Matadors posted a 20-0 edge in fast break points and their bench also outscored the Sagehen reserves, 32-12. From beyond the arc, the Matadors knocked down eight of 17 from downtown with both Smith and Johnson hitting 4-of-5 apiece.

A total of nine Matadors made their debut in a CSUN uniform on Friday. Transfers Rakim Lubin, Johnson and Dylan Johns all started the contest in their respective debuts while Siyao Sun, Reggie Theus Jr., Mahamadou Kaba-Camara, Julian Richardson, Antonio Bruno and Blair Orr all received minutes off the bench in their first CSUN games.

Playing down low, Lubin finished with six points, six rebounds and two assists in eight minutes and Johns had six rebounds, four blocks and five points.

EXHIBITION VICTORY OVER CAL STATE LA

CSUN is coming off a 94-75 victory over Cal State LA in a home exhibition game on October 29. Junior guard Kendall Smith led all scorers with 23 points on 9-of-14 shooting and he finished with four rebounds and three steals. In his unofficial CSUN debut, junior forward Darin Johnson scored 20 points, grabbed seven rebounds and knocked down 3-of-4 shots from 3-point range. The Matadors led by as many as 23 points in the exhibition contest and never trailed.

A GLANCE AT THE ROSTER

Fourth year head coach Reggie Theus possesses a 16-man roster consisting of nine upperclassmen, seven letterwinners and nine newcomers. CSUN has also added six transfers including four from Division I schools. The team's lone senior, guard Aaron Parks, is the only Matador on the roster who has played more than one season with the team.

SERIES HISTORY

Against UCLA, the Matadors are 1-8 all-time with all games taking place inside Pauley Pavilion. The Bruins have won four-straight over the Matadors including a 77-45 victory last season.

A CLOSER LOOK AT UCLA

Last season, the Bruins finished 15-17 overall and 6-12 in Pac-12 play. Starting the season 8-3, UCLA went 7-14 down the stretch and concluded last season 10th in the Pac-12. In the opening round of the Pac-12 Tournament, USC defeated UCLA, 95-71. The Bruins were ranked 16th in this season's AP Preseason Poll and selected third in the Pac-12 Preseason Media Poll. UCLA brings back its two leading scorers from a year ago in senior guards Isaac Hamilton and Bruce Alford. The tandem played in all 32 games last season as Hamilton led the team with 16.8 points to go along with 4.2 rebounds and 3.3 assists while Alford scored 16.1 points, grabbed 3.8 rebounds and dished out 5.2 assists. Hamilton earned 2016 All-Pac 12 Second Team honors and Alford received an Honorable Mention. Also scoring in double-figures last season, junior center Thomas Welsh averaged 11.2 points and 8.5 rebounds for the Bruins and sophomore guard Aaron Holiday finished with 10.3 points and 4.0 assists.

PARKS DEPARTMENT

Senior quard Aaron Parks has averaged 9.5 points, 2.8 rebound and 1.7 assists over his Matador career

- Totaled 786 points in his career and is 214 away from hitting the 1,000-point milestone reached by only 18 other

HEAD COACH REGGIE THEUS

Fourth Season • California Coast, 2002 • 78-85 Overall Division I Record (37-62 at CSUN)

NBA All-Star and NCAA All-American Reggie Theus enters his fourth season as the head coach of the CSUN Men's Basketball Team in 2016-17. In his three seasons at CSUN, he has taken the team to the Big West Tournament twice and to the tournament final once, leading the same group that hadn't played in the postseason since 2011. In his first year with the

Matadors, the team won its most since the 2008-09 season.

Under his leadership, four CSUN players have received All-Conference honors, among many other awards, and numerous student-ath- letes have set all-time CSUN records and moved into the Big West Conference's all-time top 10 lists. At CSUN, he has coached two Academic All-Americans, several of his student-athletes have been honored at the Varsity N Scholar-Athlete Recognition Ceremony and 100% of his seniors have graduated.

As a player, Theus was an All-American at UNLV, spent 13 seasons in the NBA and was a two-time All Star. He is one of only nine players in NBA history – fourth upon his retirement in 1991 - to score at least 19,000 points and dish out 6,000 assists and upon his retirement, he ranked 21st all-time in points scored and 10th all-time in assists.

Theus also has more than 12 years of collegiate and professional coaching experience. He currently ranks 26th on UNLV's all-time scoring list and had his jersey retired by the Rebels in 1997 after being inducted into the UNLV Athletics Hall of Fame in 1989.

Theus was the ninth overall pick of the Chicago Bulls after his junior season and in his first year, was named to the NBA's All-Rookie Team and was runner up for Rookie of the Year. Theus spent five and a half seasons with the Bulls and still ranks on many of the Bulls' all-time top ten lists. He is eighth all-time in points scored, seventh all-time in free throws made and fifth in assists. Theus went on to play for the Kings, Hawks, Magic and Nets, and after four and a half seasons with the Kings, he ranks fifth all-time in assists and is among the top five in many Sacramento-era categories.

As a tribute to his impact on the game of basketball, the Sacramento Kings honored Theus as one of their "Original 1985 Legends" to mark the team's 30th Anniversary in Sacramento and honored him in ceramic with a bobblehead during the 2015-16 season, the team's

final in Sleep Train Arena.

Before coming to CSUN, Theus spent one season as the Head Coach of the Los Angeles Lakers' D-League affiliate, the Los Angeles D-Fenders. Prior to that, Theus spent time as an assistant coach with the Minnesota Timberwolves (2009-11),

the head coach of the Sacramento Kings (2007-9), the head coach at New Mexico State (2006-7) and an assistant coach at the University of Louisville (2003-5).

He led New Mexico State to the NCAA Tournament in 2006-7 with a 25-9 record, and while with Louisville, he was named one of the Top 25 recruiters in the nation by Rivals.com and the team advanced to the NCAA Final Four after going 33-3.

Theus is originally from Los Angeles, CA and his #24 jersey was retired at Inglewood High School on November 12, 2014 on what has been official declared "Reggie Theus Day" by Inglewood Unified State Trustee Dr. Don Brann.

After retiring as a player, Theus starred for three seasons on the network television sitcom "Hang Time" and served as a broadcaster for ESPN and TNT and an analyst, panelist and host on numerous sports talk shows, including "Inside the NBA" and "Best Damn Sports Show Period" on Fox Sports. For the past two winters he was an NCAA Tournament Analyst on KCBS-TV in Los Angeles.

Theus completed his bachelor's degree in business administration from California Coast University in 2002, and also has a bachelor's degree in public administration from Central Michigan University. Theus is an avid outdoorsman with a passion for archery. He and his wife Elaine have three children, Raquel, Reggie - who plays for the Matadors - and Rhyan, and reside in Los Angeles.
