GAME #3: The USD Toreros (0-2) head to Los Angeles to take on the No. 16 UCLA Bruins (2-0) this Thursday, November 17, in a 8:00 p.m. contest at Pauley Pavilion.

SERIES RECORD: This is the fifth meeting between USD and UCLA with the Bruins owning a 3-1 lead in the series... In their last meeting on Dec. 7, 2014, UCLA dealt the Toreros a 75-68 setback... USD's lone win came in their second game of the 2002-03 campaign, a 86-81 overtime victory at Pauley over the #14 Bruins... That Torero team, under the direction of former UCLA All-American Brad Holland, went on to finish 18-12 and advance to the NCAA Tournament.

RADIO/TV: All USD home and away games will be broadcast on ESPN 1700AM with Jack Cronin (3rd season) bringing you all the action; his pre-game show airs 15 minutes prior to tip-off. The game will be televised by Pac-12 Networks (Ted Robinson and Don MacLean), and air in the SoCal market on AM 570 (Josh Lewin & Tracy Murray).

HEAD COACH LAMONT SMITH (2ND YEAR): Coach **Lamont Smith** (San Diego, 1998) enters his second year at the helm of the Torero basketball program... Last year he guided the Toreros to a 9-21 record that included a 53-48 win over SDSU at Petco Park, and WCC sweep of Portland... Prior to USD he was at the University of New Mexico where he was the Associate Head Coach... Prior to UNM he spent time at Washington, Arizona State, Santa Clara, Saint Mary's College and Saint Louis University... Smith returns to USD where he was a member of the men's basketball team from 1994-99... He started all 27 games his senior year in 1998-99 for the 18-9 Toreros... He was named the Toreros' Defensive Player of the Year in 1997 and 1999 and served as the team captain from 1997-99... Smith earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications from the University of San Diego in 1998... Lamont and his wife Kimberly have two daughters -- Payton and Olivia.

TOREROS DROP HOME OPENER TO SAMFORD: The USD Toreros dropped an 83-65 decison to Samford in their 2016-17 home opener Monday evening... Sophomore guard **Olin Carter III** was the team's leading scorer for the second straight game as he finished with 15 points... Freshman guard **Nassir Barrino** reached double-figures for the second straight as he finished with 14 points and a team-high 7 rebounds... Junior forward **Cameron Neubauer** chipped in 9 points and 5 rebounds, while freshman guard **Mark Carbone** contributed 8 points off the bench... Samford's Demtrius Denzel-Dyson connected on his first four three-pointers before the first half clock hit 16 minutes, and he would lead five Bulldogs in double-digits with 20 points... He was followed by center Wyatt Walker with 16 points and 15 rebounds.

16-17 USD RECORD WHEN: TOREROS DROP HARD-FOUGHT 69-59 CONTEST TO AZTECS: The Toreros opened up their season this past Friday at a sold-out Viejas Arena against the San Diego Aztecs. USD got off to a great start and competed well against the Aztecs, but came up short in the end, 69-59. Sophomore guard Olin Carter III scored a team-high 17 points, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Aztecs' backcourt tandem of Jeremy Hemsly (career-high 25 points) and Trey Kell (23 points). For USD, freshman point guard Nassir Barrino reached double figures with 11 points, and it was his early 6 points that helped the Toreros build early leads in the first half. Freshman forward **Juwan Gray** also came in hit some big baskets in the first half and he would finish with 7 points in 19 minutes of action. SDSU would use a 13-0 run late in the first half to take a 35-31 lead before Carter scored with 8 seconds left to pull USD to within two at the break. The host Aztecs used another big run in the second half and would pull ahead by as many as 19 points, but the Toreros would compete to the end and get within 10 points in the final minute on a long three from Carter. **Brett Bailey** grabbed a team-high 9 rebounds and his 8 points was matched by forward Cameron Neubauer.

TORERO TIDBITS:

* Head Coach Lamont Smith, who enters his second season at the helm of the Torero men's basketball program, will have one of the youngest rosters in NCAA Division I basketball this season. Senior forward Brett Bailey and junior forward Cameron Neubauer will be the only upper class returners from last year's squad that finished 9-21. Bailey (6.9 ppg) is joined by sophomore guard **Olin Carter III** (7.3 ppg) as the team's two returning starters. Carter is one of four sophomores back that earned valuable experience in their rookie year. He is joined by 6-5 guard **Tyler Williams**, 6-8 forward **Alex Floresca**, and 6-4 walk-on guard **Hunter Summy**. Coach Smith and his staff were busy in the offseason and signed five freshmen – 6-0 guard Nassir Barrino (Newark, NJ), 6-2 guard Mark Carbone (Wethersfield, CT), 6-8 forward **Juwan Gray** (Dover, DE), 6-10 forward **José Martinez** (Cayey, Puerto Rico) and 6-10 forward Frank Ryder (Boulder, CO). Nick Busch, a 6-4 guard from Santa Barbara, joins the squad as a walk-on. Two junior transfers, Isaiah Wright (6-2 guard from Utah) and Isaiah Pineiro (6-6 forward from Portland State) will make the Toreros better each and every day with their leadership and experience, but due to NCAA transfer rules, will not be eligible until the 2017-18 campaign.

- * USD will be one of the youngest basketball teams in the NCAA Division I ranks this season with just two upperclassmen - senior forward **Brett Bailey** (Spokane, Washington) and junior forward **Cameron Neubauer** (Berlin, Germany).
- * Coach Smith will look to his two returning starters to lead his Torero squad this season. Senior forward **Brett Bailey** owns 48 career starts in 95 games of action. Last year he ranked fifth on the team in scoring (6.8) and was first in rebounding (4.8). He scored a season-high 22 points against Santa Clara, and notched a double-double (11 points/10 rebounds) against Denver. Olin Carter III ranked second on the team in starts with 27 and over the team's last 12 games averaged 10.9 points... He played a big role in the team's upset over SDSU on Dec. 6th with all 12 points coming in the first half from three-point range. He closed out his the season with a team-high 20 points in the first round of the WCC Tournament against LMU.
- * USD will miss the services of graduated seniors Duda Sanadze (12.8 ppg, 4.0 rpg) and Jito Kok (USD career leader with 269 blocked shots). Guards Vasa Pusica (8.3 ppg, 4.0 rpg) and Marcus Harris (6.6 ppg) both transferred out. Pusica ended up at Northeastern, while Harris landed at Sam Houston State.
- * David Fizdale, a 1996 graduate of the University of San Diego, was officially introduced on May 29th as the new head coach of the Memphis Grizzlies. Fizdale played at USD from 1992-96 and following an internship with the Miami Heat video staff in 1997-98, returned to USD as an assistant coach for the Torero men's basketball program from 1998-2002. Fizdale, 41, becomes the fifth former Torero basketball player to be named an NBA head coach. He follows in the footsteps of Bernie Bickerstaff (Seattle, Denver, Washington, Charlotte, and Los Angeles - interim), Eric Musselman (Golden State & Sacramento), Mike Brown (Cleveland & Los Angeles) and James Borrego (Orlando - interim).

Through two victories against Pacific (119-80) and CSUN (102-87), UCLA is averaging 110.5 points per game... Senior guard Bryce Alford leads the way with his 25.0 points per game average... He is joined in the double-digit scoring column by senior guard Isaac Hamilton (19.5 ppg), freshman forward TJ Leaf (17.0 ppg, 10.5 rpg), freshman guard Lonzo Ball (16.0 ppg) and sophomore guard Aaron Holiday (15.5 ppg)... In the season opening win over Pacific, freshman guarf Lonzo Ball had 19 points, 11 assists and eight rebounds, and classmate TJ Leaf totaled 22 points and 15 rebounds... Senior guard Bryce Alford led all scorers with 30 points and the team made 18-of-30 threes... Against CSUN, the Bruins had seven players in double figures led by Hamilton (22 points) and Alford (20)... Head Coach Steve Alford is in his 4th season... He returns 4 starters and 10 lettermen from last year's 15-17 ball club... He welcomes five newcomers to the 2016-17 squad.

Toreros sign two guards to NLI

(San Diego, Calif.) - University of San Diego men's basketball head coach Lamont Smith and his staff are excited to announce they have signed two high school guards to a national letter of intent and scholarship agreement for the upcoming 2017-18 school year. Joining the Toreros will be Joey Calcaterra, a 6'3" guard from Kentfield, California, and Emanuel Hylton, a 6'3" guard from Silver Springs, Maryland.

"We couldn't be more excited to add these two young players, Joey and Emanuel, to our future backcourt at USD," said head coach Lamont Smith. "Both of them will have a chance to come in and learn from some veterans, while also competing for playing time as freshmen. On top of their basketball ability, we value the high level of character both young men possess. They will be exceptional additions to our program, University, and Torero community."

Joey Calcaterra is a 6-2 guard from Kentfield, CA and plays at Marin Catholic High School in the Bay Area. Last season he led his team in scoring averaging 27.4 points, 5 rebounds, 3 assists, and 3 steals per game. He was named 1st Team All-League in the Marin County Athletic League (MCAL), 2nd Team All-Metro Bay Area, and 1st Team All-State California Juniors. Joey's brothers, Frankie and Nick, currently play at Cal Lutheran University and San Francisco State University, respectively.

Stated Coach Smith, "Joey is a high-level shooter and scoring guard that will add depth to our perimeter and give us a consistent 3-point threat to help stretch defenses. Joey is very competitive and does whatever is needed to help his team win. He comes from a basketball family so his passion for the game fits very well with our staff and current roster."

Emanuel Hylton is a 6-3 guard from Silver Springs, MD who currently attends St. John's College High School, which won the 2016 Washington Catholic Athletic Conference (WCAC) champion-ship and posted a 30-5 record. The WCAC is considered one of the best high school basketball conferences in the country. Emanuel was a vital contributor on a roster that graduated four Division I guards in 2016.

Added Coach Smith, "Emanuel is a combo guard with great size who can score from all three levels of the floor, but also is really good at making others better and getting his teammates shots. He plays at St. John's College High School, which is one of the best teams in the highly-competitive Washington, D.C. area. Our staff is looking forward to having Emanuel's playmaking ability and defensive grit each day in our program."

Cronin graduated in 2004 from the University of California, Berkeley with a degree in Integrative Biology.
