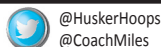

After a thrilling 80-78 win over Dayton on Thanksgiving evening, the Nebraska men's basketball team will look for its first win of the year over a ranked opponent, as the Huskers will take on No. 14/13 (AP/Coaches) UCLA Friday night in the semifinals of the Wooden Legacy.

Tipoff between the Huskers and Bruins is set for 11 p.m. (CT) at Titan Gym in Fullerton. The matchup will be carried on ESPN2 and the WatchESPN app with Doug Sherman, Sean Farnham and Jeff Goodman on the call.

Fans can also listen to all of the action throughout the season on the IMG Husker Sports Network with Kent Pavelka and Jake Muhleisen on the call, including on Huskers.com and the Huskers app.

The Huskers (4-0) used the heroics of sophomore Glynn Watson Jr. and a balanced offensive attack to hold off Dayton, 80-78. Watson sunk two free throws with 8.8

seconds left after Dayton overcame a 13-point second-half deficit to take a 78-77 lead. Watson led Nebraska with 20 points and a career-high five steals to pace four Huskers in double figures, as Nebraska improved to 4-0 for the first time since the 2012-13 season.

One of four sophomores in the Husker starting lineup, Watson keyed a Nebraska attack that shot 57 percent against a Dayton team that held its first three opponents to shoot 38 percent. While Watson and senior guard Tai Webster (16 points) combined for 36 points and six assists, Ed Morrow Jr. controlled the inside with 19 points and 10 boards for his first career double-double.

The Huskers, who are second in the Big Ten in scoring defense (57.8 ppg) and fourth in the conference in field goal percentage (.363) will get its sternest test of the season against a UCLA team that leads the country in scoring at 104.4 points per game. The Bruins, who feature six players averaging double figures, downed Portland, 99-77, late Thursday.

Friday's matchup is just the eighth meeting between the programs and the first since the 1985 NIT. It is the Huskers' first regular-season meeting with UCLA since 1956. A win on Friday night will put the Huskers into Sunday's championship game against either Texas A&M or Virginia Tech at 7:30 p.m. (CT) while the third-place game is set for 3 p.m. (CT). Both games will take place at the Honda Center in Anaheim.

## A LOOK AT UCLA

Under the direction of Steve Alford, UCLA comes into Friday's game with a 5-0 record following a win over Portland. The Bruins, who have reached the Sweet 16 twice in the last three seasons, are prolific offensively, leading the nation with 104.4 points per game and have won their first five contests by at least 15 points. UCLA, which was picked to finish third in the Pac-12, is shooting 57 percent from the field, including 46 percent from 3-point range and average over 25 assists per game. Freshman forward TJ Leaf leads six Bruins in double figures with 19.0 points per game, while freshman Lonzo Ball is at 16.6 points and 9.4 assists per contests. Senior guards Bryce Alford and Isaac Hamilton both average over 17 points per game and shoot 40 percent from 3-point range.

## SERIES HISTORY

UCLA holds a 5-2 lead in the series that dates back to December of 1938...The Bruins have won the last three matchups, including an 82-63 win...Nebraska is 119-122 all-time against the Pac-12, but has not played a Pac-12 school since the 2012-13 season...NU's last week vs. a Pac-12 team was a 64-61 double OT win at USC on Nov. 11, 2011.

## LAST TIME OUT

Glynn Watson Jr. sank two free throws with 8.8 seconds to give Nebraska the lead for good, as the Huskers knocked off Dayton, 80-78, at the Wooden Legacy in Fullerton, Calif.

Watson, who scored 13 of his game-high 20 points in the second half, provided the heroics for Nebraska, which saw a 13-point lead disappear in the final 10 minutes before Watson's free throws put the Huskers ahead.

Trailing 79-78, Dayton had one final shot, but Scoochie Smith was forced into an off-balanced jumper and Ed Morrow Jr. grabbed the rebound with 1.8 seconds left. Morrow split the pair from the line and then deflected Dayton's inbound attempt, as the Flyers were unable to get a shot up before the horn.

Watson's 20 points, a career-high five steals and three assists led four Huskers (4-0) in double figures, as Morrow tallied a career-high 19 points on 9-of-11 shooting and a career-high 10 rebounds while Tai Webster (16) and Anton Gill (10) also finished in double figures as Nebraska shot 57 percent and held Dayton to 38 percent.

## POSTGAME NOTES

- Nebraska improved to 4-0 for the first time since 2012-13.
- Nebraska reached 80 points for the second time season (also vs. Sacramento State)
- Ed Morrow Jr. posted his first career double-double with career highs in both points (19) and rebounds (10). This previous best in points was 15 vs. Sacramento State, while his high in rebounds was seven set against Rutgers last year.
- The five steals by Glynn Watson Jr. was a career high, topping his previous best against Minnesota last season. It also matched the most by a Husker in Miles' four-plus seasons.
- Nebraska shot a season-best 56.9 percent, topping the previous best of 50.0 vs. Mary.
- Watson's 20-point game was his second-highest scoring output of his career (23 vs. Sacramento State).
- Anton Gill set a season high with 10 points, including eight in the first half.
- The Huskers held Dayton to 38.1 percent, the third straight opponent held to under 40 percent from the field.

## HUSKERS TO PLAY IN 2017 ADVOCARE INVITATIONAL

The Huskers men's basketball team will spend next Thanksgiving weekend in Florida, as Nebraska will be one of the eight teams for the 2017 AdvoCare Invitational announced Friday.

The eight-team field for the 2017 tournament – to be held Thursday, Friday and Sunday, Nov. 23, 24 and 26, at HP Field House at ESPN Wide World of Sports near Orlando, Fla. – will include Long Beach State, Marist, Missouri, Nebraska, Oregon State, St. John's, UCF and West Virginia. Three teams played in postseason tournaments in 2016, including Oregon State and West Virginia, which made the NCAA Tournament in 2016, and Long Beach State, which qualified for the NIT.

For Husker fans, the field features a potential matchup with an old rival, as the Huskers and Missouri could meet for the first time since Nebraska joined the Big Ten. The series dates back to 1908, but the teams have not met since the 2010-11 campaign. While the Huskers and Tigers have met 119 times, NU has played the remainder of the field just 14 times and none since a win over Oregon State in 2009. NU has played Oregon State 10 times, and has not faced Long Beach State since 1996 and West Virginia since 1930. The Huskers have never squared off against Marist, St. John's or UCF.

## QUICK HITTERS

•Friday's meeting is the first between the two coaches since Miles' Colorado State team knocked off Alford's No. 18 New Mexico squad, 71-63, on Feb. 21, 2012. It is one of two wins Miles had over Alford when their tenures overlapped in the Mountain West.

•Nebraska shot 57 percent on Thursday and the Huskers are 22-2 under Miles when shooting at least 50 percent from the field.

•The Huskers got a major boost from junior Anton Gill, who scored a season-high 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting. It was the third double-figure scoring effort for Gill in his career and first at NU. He had just three points in his first three contests.

•Nebraska has held its last three opponents under 40 percent shooting, while Dayton became the first time to average more than a point per possession vs. the Huskers.

•NU is now 16-2 under Miles when scoring at least 80 points following last night's win.

A proven program builder who has enjoyed success at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels, Tim Miles was named the 27th basketball coach at the University of Nebraska on March 24, 2012. He is believed to be the only active coach who has made national tournament appearances at four-year schools at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

In 2015-16, Miles guided a youthful Husker team to 16 wins against a schedule featuring 11 ranked opponents. The Huskers also won multiple games in the conference tournament for the first time in a decade, including a win over a Wisconsin team which eventually reached the NCAA Sweet 16. Shavon Shields repeated as a first-team Academic All-American and was a second-team All-Big Ten pick.

In 2014-15, the Huskers garnered their first national ranking since 1995 and enjoyed record-setting attendance numbers, establishing a school-record attendance of 15,569 fans per game to rank 10th nationally. Terran Petteway earned All-Big Ten honors for the second straight year and earned an invitation to training camp with the Atlanta Hawks.

In 2013-14, Miles was named Big Ten Coach of the Year and Jim Phalen National Coach of the Year after guiding the Huskers to an 11-7 Big Ten mark and a fourth-place finish after the team was picked to finish 12th in the preseason. NU's 11 conference wins were its highest total since 1965-66, while the fourth-place finish was the Huskers' best since 1997-98. Miles became the first Husker coach to garner conference coach of the year accolades since 1991 after guiding the Huskers to their first NCAA appearance in 16 years.

Before taking over the Nebraska program, Miles spent the previous five seasons building the Colorado State program. He increased his victory total in each of his five years at CSU, culminating in a 20-12 record and the school's first NCAA appearance in nine seasons during his final year in Fort Collins. After winning 16 games in his first two years, his teams went 55-41 over the last three years, reaching postseason play in each campaign.

The 2011-12 Rams posted the school's first 20-win season since 1997-98 while playing a schedule that was rated as the fourth-toughest in the country. Colorado State set a school record with three wins over ranked teams and placed three players on the All-Mountain West teams, and Miles was named the District VIII Coach of the Year by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association for his efforts. The Rams, one of four Mountain West teams to receive bids in the 2012 NCAA Tournament, averaged 70.1 points per game on the season and topped the Mountain West Conference in field-goal percentage (47.1), 3-point percentage (40.0) and free throw percentage (76.8).

With 22 years of experience as a head coach at four institutions, he has compiled a career record of 350-287 that includes three conference championships and seven postseason tournament appearances.

Before taking over the Colorado State program, Miles spent six seasons at North Dakota State, guiding the Bison through the transition to the Division I ranks. He won at least 16 games in each of his final five seasons at the school, including the program's first three years at the Division I level. Miles' tenure at NDSU was highlighted by a pair of road wins over top-15 squads in his final two seasons.

Miles showed his ability to turn around programs during his tenure at Southwest Minnesota State University. He took a program that had only one winning season in the previous decade and went 78-39 in his four seasons at the school, recorded the first 20-win season in school history, and led Southwest Minnesota State to its first back-to-back winning seasons in more than two decades.

Miles began his head coaching career at Mayville (N.D.) State University, guiding the program to a 35-22 record from 1995 to 1997 and a pair of conference titles. He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Northern State for six seasons from 1989-90 through 1994-95 and helped the Wolves to five NAIA playoff appearances and five regional titles. He was the recruiting coordinator for NSU and was responsible for bringing in and coaching five All-Americans at that school.

A native of Doland, S.D., he graduated from the University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D., in 1989 and earned a master's degree in health and physical education from Northern State in Aberdeen, S.D., in 1990. He was inducted into the University of Mary Athletic Hall of Fame in 2007.
