Los Angeles, CA—The UC Riverside Men's Basketball Team travels west this Wednesday, November 30 for an 8 pm PT tip at UCLA's famed Pauley Pavilion.

The Highlanders are coming off of an 85-67 loss at Utah, which continued the coming out party for freshman Dikymbe Martin. The J.W. North High School graduate scored 15 points against the Runnin' Utes, and has now scored 41 points on 17 of 24 shooting over his last two games. Martin also has made six of his last seven three-pointers, and has 10 assists and just two turnovers over those last two games.

Martin is the team's leading scorer at 12.5 points per game, as well as its leader in field goal percentage (57.1%), three-point field goal percentage (75.0%), assists per game (3.0), steals per game (2.25), and assist-to-turnover ratio (4-1).

Chance Murray led the Highlanders in scoring at Utah with 17 points. He ranks third on the team in scoring at 12.0 points per game. Malik Thames is second on the team in scoring at 12.3 points per game, but missed the game against the Runnin' Utes due to personal reasons. Alex Larsson is UC Riverside's top post player averaging 9.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.

UCLA is 7-0 after topping Texas A&M, 74-67, in the title game of the Direct TV Wooden Classic at Honda Center in Anaheim, California. Two of the Bruins' victories are over Big West opponents—102-87 over CSUN, and 114-77 against Long Beach State. They also topped former Big West member, Pacific, in the team's season opener, 119-80.

UCLA is averaging 96.9 points per game, outscoring opponents by 21.6 points per game, while making 54.7 percent shooting from the field, and 45.2 percent from three-point range.

Six Bruins are averaging double figures in scoring led by TJ Leaf's 17.1 points per game. Leaf is also the team's second leading rebounder at 8.9 boards per game. Bryce Alford is just behind Leaf at 17.0 points per game, followed by Isaac Hamilton (16.7), Lonzo Ball (16.0), Aaron Holiday (12.1), and Thomas Welsh (10.6). Welsh is averaging a near double-double with 9.4 rebounds per game.

The Highlanders are 0-4 all-time against the Bruins. The last time the clubs met was on December 10, 2014 when UCLA topped UC Riverside, 77-67.

DENNIS CUTTS

Head Men's Basketball Coach



Dennis Cutts was named head coach of the UC Riverside Men's Basketball Team in April of 2014 after serving as the team's interim head coach for the 2013-14 season. He accepted the position as interim head coach on July 10, 2013, when Jim Wooldridge stepped down to become the interim athletics director for the Highlanders.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the Highlanders nearly doubled their win total from the previous year earning the eight seed in the Big West Conference Tournament. UC Riverside averaged 70.9 points per game that season in conference play—the highest average since the Highlanders joined the Big West, and 11.1 points more per game than the team averaged the year prior. UC Riverside also saw its home attendance increase by 20 percent in 2013-14.

In the 2014-15 campaign, the Highlanders won the second most games in the Division I history of the program, and the second most conference games as well. Coach Cutts was named one of ten finalists for the 2015 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year award. They earned the sixth seed in the Big West Conference Tournament.

UC Riverside had a first team All-Conference player Taylor Johns as well as Newcomer of the Year and second team All-Conference player Jaylen Bland. Johns and Bland were the highest scoring duo in UC Riverside's Division I history. Coach Cutts earned an extension through the 2019-20 season.

Last season, UC Riverside continued to build upon its success by yet again posting the second most wins in the program's Division I, while recording the most road wins and non-conference wins in during that tie. The Highlanders also earned the sixth seed in the Big West Conference Tournament for the second year in a row.

UCR broke several school Division I-era records during the year including highest scoring average, most assists, most three pointers made and most rebounds. A number of those marks are the highest in the program in more than a quarter century including the most assists and most three pointers since the 1988-89 campaign. UC Riverside's rebound figure was the highest since the 1994-95 season.

The Highlanders also won at Hawaii for the first time in their Big West history. Jaylen Bland finished third in the entire country in made three pointers (118) and earned Second Team All-Conference honors, while Secean Johnson earned Honorable Mention All-Conference accolades.

Cutts returns all nine scholarship players from the 2015-16 season, one of the only schools in the entire country to retain all of their players.

Cutts originally joined the men's basketball staff as an assistant coach in May of 2007, rejoining Wooldridge, with whom he worked at Kansas State as the team's director of basketball operations. Cutts brings over 20 years of coaching experience to the Highlanders bench.

As the director of basketball operations with the Wildcats, Cutts assisted in coordinating recruiting activities for the program, running the Jim Wooldridge Basketball Camp, organizing K-State coaching clinics and overseeing the Wildcat Faculty/Staff Club. In addition, he coordinated all team travel and oversaw special projects for the basketball office.

Cutts was an associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for Phil Johnson at San Jose State from 2002 to 2005. He assisted in the development and recruitment of several all-conference players, including Marquin Chandler, a Second-Team All-Western Athletic Conference (WAC) forward. In addition to his on-the-floor coaching duties, Cutts was in charge of the team's scheduling of opponents and facilities as well as academic monitoring.

Cutts was a four-year letter winner at State University of New York at Albany, helping his team to four consecutive winning seasons, including three 20-win campaigns. As a senior, Cutts was team captain and most valuable player of a Great Dane squad that reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Division III Tournament. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in sociology with a minor in business administration in 1990.

Following graduation, the Massapequa, NY native began his coaching career in Killarney, Ireland in 1990 as a player-coach for the St. Paul's Basketball Club senior men's "A" team. He also coached the men's "B" team, the senior women's "A" team and boys' teams ranging in ages up to 19-years-old. In addition, he was an instructor at the Institute for International Sport in Killarney.

He returned to the United States in 1991 and spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Pima Community College (1991-94) in Tucson, AZ and two as an assistant coach at Northland Pioneer College (1994-96) in Holbrook, AZ.

Cutts reached the Division I level in 1996 when he joined the staff at Stephen F. Austin, spending three years as the program's recruiting coordinator and overseeing the development of the Lumberjacks' offense. He then moved on to Northern Arizona and worked under Mike Adras, where he was assistant coach and recruiting coordinator from 1999 through 2002. In 2000 he helped the Lumberjacks to a 20-11 mark, the Big Sky Tournament Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament. He coordinated the team's offensive schemes and worked in the development of the perimeter players. Cutts also had duties in scouting opponents and academic supervision.

Cutts is a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches. He and his wife Evon reside in Riverside.

ON POINT

The Highlanders averaged 69.7 points per game last year, which is the most since the 1999-2000 team averaged 70.4 points per game.

This season, they are averaging 70.0 points per game.

FREE OF CHARGE

The Highlanders made 70.4 percent of their free throws on the season last year, including a league best 73.8 percent in conference play. The last time UC Riverside connected on a higher percentage of free throws in a season was 2003-04 when they made 71.6 percent from the charity stripe.

They are making 69.7 percent of their free throws this season.



PUT A LID ON IT

In 2015-16, the Highlanders held opponents to 26.5 percent shooting from three-point range (58 of 219) over their first 12 games, but over their last 21 games, opponents made 38.5 percent of their shots from long range (140 of 364).

This season, opponents are making 29.2 percent of their three-pointers.

THREE BAWLIN

The Highlanders struggled from behind the arc in the 2012-13 season connecting on just 28.9 percent of their shots from three-point range, which is the lowest percentage for a UCR squad during the team's Division I era.

Those struggles continued in 2013-14 as the Highlanders made 30.2 percent from long distance.

Two years ago, the Highlanders connected on 34.3 percent of their threes.

Last year they made 35.2 percent of their shots from beyond the arc.

This season, UC Riverside is making 30.8 percent of its threes (24 of 78).

Last season, 39.0 percent of the Highlanders' shots from the field came from three-point range which is the highest percentage the program has posted since joining the Big West Conference. The year prior, 35.6 percent of UCR's shots were from long distance.

So far in 2016-17, 29.4 percent of the Highlanders' shots are from three-point range.

IN THE BLACK

The Highlanders have never had a season in their Division I history (2001-02 to present) in which they outscored the opposition over the course of the year. The closest they came prior to 2015-16 was during their 17-13 campaign of 2008-09 when they scored 1,806 and gave up 1,818.

Last year the Highlanders were outscored by the opposition by one point (2,300 to 2,299). This season, UCR has scored the same number of points as its opposition (280 to 280).

STOP THIEF!

Jaylen Bland's 43 steals as a junior were the second most in the program since the Highlanders joined the Big West Conference. Last season he topped Larry Cunningham's Division I-era record with 47. That is the most in the program since the 1995-96 season when K.J. Roberts picked up 58.
