• UCSB Travels to No. 2 UCLA, South Point Holiday Hoops Classic

UC Santa Barbara will travel to Westwood on Wednesday, Dec. 14 to play second-ranked UCLA. The game agains the Bruins will be the Gauchos' final true non-conference road game of the season. UCSB will then play a pair of pre-Christmas neutral site games in Las Vegas on Dec. 21 and Dec. 22. They will play Iona in the first game at the South Point Holiday Hoops Classic and Nevada in the second game. The Gauchos will close out 2016 with a pair of home games against Cal State Bakersfield (Dec. 27) and Seattle (Dec. 30).

• The Gaucho Record

UCSB enters Wednesday's game at UCLA with a record of I-6. The Gauchos are coming off of a 77-68 loss at the University of San Diego on Sunday. On Dec. I, they ended a five-game losing streak with a 75-51 home victory over Sonoma State. Previously, Santa Barbara lost home games to Omaha (74-60) and San Francisco (75-63), and road games at Cal State Bakersfield (77-70), SMU (84-57) and USC (96-72).

• UCLA Will be Highest Ranked Opponent Since 2008

UCSB's opponent on Wednesday, UCLA, is ranked No. 2 in both the Associated Press poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. The last time the Gauchos played a team ranked that high, or higher, was when they hosted No. I North Carolina at the Thunderdome on Nov. 21, 2008. The Tar Heels won that game, 84-67.

The Opponents

UCSB has won three of the last four games between the programs. Santa Barbara and UCLA have played 20 times with the Bruins winning 19. The last time the teams played was on Dec. 3, 2013 with UCLA recording an 89-76 decision. The Gauchos only victory in the series came on Dec. 17, 2003 when they won 6 -60.As for their opponents in the South Point Holiday Hoops Classic, they have gone 1-0 against Iona and 7-7 against Nevada. Santa Barbara's Ione game against Iona was in the 2015 South Point Holiday Hoops Classic when it defeated the Gaels, 80-76. UCSB and Nevada have not met since they were Big West Conference opponents. The Wolf Pack and Gauchos split a pair of games during the 1999-2000 season with each team winning at home.

• The Gauchos on the Road

The Gauchos are 0-4 away from home in 2016-17 after falling at Cal State Bakersfield, SMU, USC and San Diego. UCSB was a solid 13-9 record away from home in 2015-16, including 10-6 in true road games. After beginning the season with 2-5 mark in games away from home, the Gauchos closed last season by going 11-4, including 8-2 in true road games.

Half and Half

In its loss at San Diego on Sunday, UCSB was outscored 37-34 in the first half and 40-30 in the second half. Through the first seven games of the season, the Gauchos have been outscored in 11 out of 14 halves. They outscored Cal State Bakersfield 37-33 in the first half of a Nov. 19 game and they outscored Sonoma State in both the first and second half on Dec. I

A Trible Threat

The Gauchos's three-point disadvantage through seven games this season is quite pronounced and Sunday's loss at San Diego was a microcosm. After making four of its first five three-point attempts, UCSB missed 17 of their final 18, including all 10 in the second half, to finish at 5-for-23, 21.7%. The Toreros, on the other hand, made 6-of-13 in the first half and 6-of-13 in the second half to finish 12-of-26, 46.2%. For the season, UCSB is averaging just 6.0 threes per game and shooting 25.9%. They recorded season-highs of eight makes and 42.1% on Dec. I vs. Sonoma State, but they have made five threes three times, have shot under 25.0% on five occasions and are shooting 25.9% overall. Opponents are averaging 10.1 three-pointers and shooting 34.6% from beyond the arc. They have made eight or more six times and 12 or more three times. Two opponents - Cal State Bakerafield and USC - have each made 14 three-point baskets in their victories over the Gauchos

• Youth Gets Takes its Turn

Point guard Eric Childress is the only senior on UCSB's 17-man roster. This marks the first time that the Gauchos have had a roster with that many players and only one senior. In 2012-13 the roster listed just one senior – Nate Garth – but there were only 15 players on the team. This year, Santa Barbara has seven freshmen, six sophomores, three juniors and Childress, the one lonely senior. If you count one year for a sophomore, two years for a junior and three years for a senior, the average experience of a 2016-17 Gaucho is just 0.8 years.

Williams in 19th Season, Longest Tenured Coach West of South Dakota

Bob Williams is in his 19th season as head coach of the UCSB men's basketball. Williams' tenure is the longest in school history. In addition to having the longest tenure in Gaucho history, he now stands alone as having the longest tenure of any active coach west of the Mississippi River. Williams has been in Santa Barbara one year longer than Mark Few has been at Gonzaga and Steve Fisher has been at San Diego State. South Dakota State's Scott Nagy has been at the helm of the Jackrabbits since 1995-96, however, South Dakota State didn't move to Division I until 2004-05, thus Williams is the longest tenured active Division I head coach west of Lansing, Mich. Tom Izzo began his stint at Michigan State in 1995-96.

Williams Has Third Most Victories in Big West History

When the Gauchos won at UC Riverside on Feb. 18, 2016, Bob Williams become the third coach in league history to reach the 300 victory mark. UCSB's all-time leader in coaching wins with 308, Williams trails only Bob Thomason (436 at Pacific) and Jerry Tarkanian (405 at LBSU and UNLV) in wins by a coach during their tenure in the Big West Conference.

• Williams Approaches 500 Wins

UCSB's win over Sonoma State on Dec. I gave Bob Williams 497 career coaching wins and he needs just, you guessed it, three to reach 500 in his career. Williams has accumulated 308 of his wins since arriving in Santa Barbara for the 1998-99 season. He had 158 wins while the head coach at UC Davis and 31 at Menlo College.

Gaucho Big Men Emerge

In the last three games, UCSB's top three frontcourt players – Jalen Canty, Ami Lakoju and Alex Hart have emerged as a force. Overall, the trio is averaging 24.4 points and 16.7 rebounds per game while – shooting 58.8% from the field. In the last three games, they are combining to average 34.0 points and 19.3 rebounds while making 44 out of 70 field goal attempts, 62.9%. Canty is second on the team in scoring at 11.3 points per game and he leads the way in rebounding at 7.1 per game. Lakoju has the highest field goal percentage at 75.9%.

Turnover Turnaround

Since committing a season-high 21 turnovers in a Nov. 19 game against Cal State Bakersfield, the Gauchos have done a good job of taking care of the ball. Most recently, on Dec. I I at the University of San Diego, they had 10 turnovers. On Nov. 27 at USC, they had a season-low nine turnovers. UCSB opened the year with 18 turnovers against Omaha and averaged 16.7 through the first three games of the year. In the last four games – at SMU, at USC, vs. Sonoma State and at USD – the Gauchos have totaled 40 turnovers, an average of 10.0 per game.

• The Name Should be Changed to "Costly Throws"
For the time being, when a UCSB player gets fouled while shooting or after an opposing team has committed seven fouls in a half, they will shoot free throws. However, those "free" throws are becoming more costly. As a team, the Gauchos are making just 62.0% of their free throws. On Sunday, they hit just 9-of-17, 52.9%. In fact, they have made 70.0% or better just twice this season having hit 7-of-9 (77.8%) in the Nov. 12 opener against Omaha and 8-of-10 (80.0%) on Nov. 22 at SMU. In the last six games, UCSB has made just 68 out of its 112 free throw attempts, 60.7%, and in its last three games it has gone 29-of-52, 55.8%.

Bob Williams Head Coach • 19th Season

2016-17 is Bob Williams' 19th season at UC Santa Barbara. He is the longest tenured Division I head coach west of the Lansing, Michigan and the winningest coach in the school's history with 308.



On Feb. 18, 2016, in a win at UC Riverside, Williams joined Jerry Tarkanian (UNLV) and Bob Thomason (Pacific) as the only coaches in Big West history to reach the 300 win mark during their time coaching a conference school. For the second straight season, the Gauchos finished with a 19-14 overall record and an 11-5 mark in league play. They advanced to the inaugural Vegas 16 Tournament where they defeated Northern Illinois in the first round, the program's first postseason win since 1990.

In 2014-15, Williams led UCSB to a 19-14 overall record and an 11-5 record in the Big West Conference. After losing an overtime heartbreaker in the Big West Tournament semifinal to UC Irvine, the Gauchos were awarded a bid to the College Basketball Invitational, the program's seventh postseason appearance under Williams.

In 2013-14, Williams guided UCSB to a 21-9 overall record and a 12-4 mark in the Big West. The 10-win improvement over the previous season was the third largest in NCAA and it was the fifth time that a Williams-led Gaucho team won 20 games. In the history of the program, that feat has been achieved 11 times.

Williams' 2012-13 Gauchos battled through an injury-riddled 11-20 season, but the team closed the regular season on a three-game winning streak and then lost a heartbreaker in the Big West Tournament to the eventual champion,

In 2011-12, Williams became UCSB's all-time leader in coaching victories when, on January 2, 2012, his team defeated Cal Poly, 58-57. With the win over the Mustangs, Williams passed Jerry Pimm to seize the top spot on the list. The Gauchos ended the season with a 20-11 overall record and played

in the College Insider Tournament.

In 2010-11, Williams guided the Gauchos to their second straight Big West Tournament championship and, as a result, their second straight NCAA Tournament berth. It marked the third NCAA Tournament bid under Williams, the fifth overall for the school and it was the first time the program had gone to the tourney in consecutive seasons.

On Feb. 5, 2011, he recorded his 400th career win when his team defeated UC Davis in overtime, 93-86. In 2009-10, he guided the Gauchos to a 20-10 overall record, a Big West regular season championship, their second Big West Tournament title, and an NCAA Tournament berth. Following the season, Williams was named Big West Coach of the Year for the third time. It was the third time a Williams-coached Gaucho team had won 20 or more games.

In 2008-09, Williams coached the Gauchos to a 16-15 overall record and an 8-8 mark in the Big West Conference. The record, however, doesn't tell the entire story. UCSB was forced to overcome a myriad of injuries and at one point stood at 8-13 overall and 2-7 in league play.

In 2007-08, Williams led the Gauchos to a 23-9 overall record. The 23 wins were a school record, and UCSB also won its second Big West regular season title with a 12-4 conference record. Following the campaign, the Gauchos were awarded a bid to the National Invitation Tournament. It was the third time that a Williams team advanced to postseason play.

The 2002 Gauchos won the school's first Big West Tournament title, advancing to the NCAA Tournament, and in 2003, they won the league's regular season title and played in the NIT.

In 1998-99, Williams took over a UCSB program that had not recorded a winning season in five years, and after seeing his team lose its first eight games that year - extending a two-season losing streak to 16 straight games - the Gauchos turned things around, winning 15 of their final 20 games and finishing on top in the Big West's Western Division.

Williams has a UCSB record of 308-244. The 308 wins are the most in school history. He has guided the program to 15 winning seasons in his first 18 years – including this season and 10 of the last 11 - and five 20 win seasons. He has a career record of 181-113 in Big West games and his .616 winning percentage in league games is one of the highest among the league's active coaches.

Prior to his arrival at UCSB, Williams spent eight years at UC Davis and in those eight years, his teams recorded 20 or more wins five times and a 158-76 record. In Williams' final season, the Aggies went 31-2, won the NCAA Division II National Championship and he was named NABC Division II Coach of the Year. Including two seasons at Menlo College, Williams has an overall career record of 497-344 (.591) at four-year schools.






