## Oregon State (4-10, 0-1) vs. No. 2 UCLA (13-1, 0-1)

December 30, 2016 • 8:00 p.m. • Gill Coliseum • Corvallis, Ore.

**THE GAME:** Oregon State faces the ultimate test when it takes on No. 2 UCLA at 8 p.m. on Friday at Gill Coliseum.

**QUICKLY:** Oregon State looks to upset a No. 2-ranked team for the first time since 1989 (84-61 over No. 2 Arizona on Dec. 2, 1989) ... The Beavers have held their last three opponents to a combined 33.7 percent (60-for-178) from the field and 20.0 percent (12-for-60) from behind the arc ... Drew Eubanks has posted three double-doubles in 14 games this season after getting one in 32 games last season ... Stephen Thompson Jr. had career highs with 24 points and 10 field goals against USC ... Gligorije Rakocevic has taken eight free throw attempts the past two games; he took 12 attempts in the first 12 games ... JaQuori McLaughlin has made at least one 3-pointer in a team-best seven consecutive games ... Kendal Manuel is averaging 10.4 points and shooting 40.6 percent (13-for-32) from beyond the arc in seven games as a starter ... Walk-on Matt Dahlen has started the last six games and taken a team-high seven charges ... Tres Tinkle (wrist) and Cheikh N'diaye (shoulder) are out indefinitely with injuries ... Oregon State players have missed 29 games due to injuries.

**vs. UCLA:** Oregon State and UCLA meet for the 131st time with the Bruins holding a 92-38 advantage, including a 38-28 edge in games played in Corvallis.

The Beavers have won four of the last eight meetings overall after dropping 13 straight between 2006 and 2011.

The teams split the series last season. UCLA won 82-73 on Jan. 20, its first win at Gill Coliseum since 2011. Isaac Hamilton scored a game-high 25 points, while Gary Payton II led the Beavers with 17 points and seven assists.

Oregon State snapped an 11-game losing streak to the Bruins at Pauley Pavilion with an 86-82 victory on March 5. Stephen Thompson Jr. scored a then career-high 23 points, all in the second half, to lead the Beavers, while Olaf Schaftenaar and Payton II added 17 points apiece. Hamilton led UCLA with 21 points.

**A WIN OVER THE BRUINS:** If Oregon State defeats UCLA it will improve to 5-10 overall and 1-1 in Pac-12 play. It would also:

- Be the first time Oregon State defeated a No. 2 team since Dec. 2, 1989 (84-61 over No. 2 Arizona at Gill Coliseum).
- Be the third-straight year Oregon State defeated a Top 25 team.
  - The Beavers defeated No. 7 Arizona, 58-56, in 2015 and topped No. 21 USC, 85-70, in 2016.
  - The last time Oregon State upset Top 25 teams three consecutive years was 2004 (90-84 over No. 14 Arizona), 2005 (90-73 over No. 11 Washington) and 2006 (75-65 over No. 24 Arizona).
- Be Oregon State's first two-game winning streak over UCLA since March 4, 2004 (65-56 at Gill Coliseum) and Dec. 31, 2004 (85-80 at Gill Coliseum).

## Everyday Champions: SportUp

As part of the Everyday Champions program, Oregon State launched **SportUp**, college athletics' first start up incubator, during the 2015-16 academic year. With the help of the program, former student-athlete Maureen Tremblay has launched her own business - Revive, an app that tracks workouts for elite athletes to prevent injury.

Initiated in 2011, **Beavers without Borders** is a program that offers global service-learning experiences for student-athletes at Oregon State University.

The program has successfully completed six service projects including trips to Guatemala, Macedonia, Ethiopia, and most recently the Dominican Republic.

Throughout those trips, over 75 student-athletes were able to experience life in a distinct culture, learn about the impact of their work on a community and interact outside of the university context to maximize the intercultural experience.

**QUITE THE START:** Oregon State opens Pac-12 play against No. 22 USC and No. 2 UCLA.

- According to Jesse Hooker of the Pac-12, this is the first time since the formation of the Pac-8 in 1967-68 that travel partners were undefeated heading into conference play. There have been only three times since 1967-68 that two conference teams were unbeaten entering the first week of league play:
  - 2013-14: Arizona (13-0)/Oregon (12-0)
  - 2006-07: Oregon (11-0)/UCLA (11-0)
  - 1994-95: Stanford (9-0)/UCLA (9-0, but 6-0 before start of league play)
- This is just the third time since 1948-49 that Oregon State will face two teams ranked in the Top 25 during the first week of conference play.
  - 1975-76: Jan. 8 -- Oregon State 80, No. 18 USC 70; Jan. 10 -- Oregon State 75, No. 3 UCLA 58
  - 1971-72: Jan. 7 -- No. 1 UCLA 78, Oregon State 72; Jan. 8 -- No. 11 USC 87, Oregon State 75

**TEAM NOTES:** Here are some quick-hitters about the 2016-17 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- The eight players who didn't return played a combined 622 games at Oregon State; the nine returning players played a combined 232 games for the Beavers entering this season.
- In three seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 32-6 when leading at halftime and 34-3 when leading with five minutes to play.
- The Beavers were 9-2 the last two seasons in games decided by five points or less; they are 0-5 in those games this season.
- Oregon State was 19-1 the last two seasons when outrebounding its opponent; they are 3-3 in those games this season.
- The rebounding margin has improved to -0.1 this season compared to -2.5 last season (last in the Pac-12).
- The turnover margin has gone from +2.2 last season (third in the Pac-12) to -2.9 this season (last in the Pac-12).
- The Beavers have more turnovers than their opponent in nine of the 14 games; they had more turnovers in only five of the 32 games last season.
- Cheikh N'diaye is the only senior on the team; he has missed the last five games with an injured left shoulder.
- Kendal Manuel and Daine Muller are both from Billings, Mont., and have the same birthday (Sept. 13).
- Daine Muller and Tanner Sanders were both awarded scholarships for this season because of their work on the court and in the classroom.
- Eight players have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; the team has a cumulative GPA of 3.12.

**CHEIKH N'DIAYE:** Here are some quick hitters about Cheikh N'diaye, a senior center from Dakar, Senegal:

- Is out indefinitely with an injured left shoulder.
- Had career highs with 10 points, four field goals and seven field goal attempts at Mississippi State.
- Started the first eight games of the season; had started five times in 71 career games entering this season.
- Speaks five languages: French, Wolof, Serer, Creole, English.

**DREW EUBANKS:** Here are some quick hitters about Drew Eubanks, a sophomore forward from Troutdale, Ore:

- Is the only player on the team to start all 14 games.
- Is third in the Pac-12 in blocked shots (2.8), sixth in field goal percentage (.580) and seventh in rebounding (8.9).
- Averaging 16.4 points and 10.1 rebounds at Gill Coliseum, 10.0 points and 7.2 rebounds in games away from home (including the two in Portland).
- Has three double-doubles in 14 games this season after getting one in 32 games last season.
- Has career highs for points (32 vs. Southern Oregon) rebounds (18 vs. Lamar) and blocked shots (7 vs. Prairie View A&M) this season. The seven blocked shots tied an Oregon State single-game record (Gary Payton II, Nov. 21, 2015 vs. Colorado).
- Has at least one blocked shot in 13 of the 14 games.
- Has a 3.07 cumulative GPA at Oregon State.

# WAYNE TINKLE

## Head Coach 3rd Year Montana, 2005

Wayne Tinkle has delivered as promised in his first two seasons as Oregon State's head basketball coach.

In Year 1, he guided a team picked to finish last in the Pacific-12 Conference after losing its top five scorers from the previous season to a 17-14 overall record, the most home wins (15) in school history, and victories over Pac-12 champion Arizona and NCAA Sweet-16 finisher UCLA.

In Year 2, he surpassed those milestones and capped another season of notable accomplishments when the Beavers garnered their first berth in the NCAA Tournament in 26 seasons.

The Beavers went 19-13, their most wins in a regular season since 1990. Tinkle thus became just the second coach in the program's long and storied history with at least 17 games in his first two seasons. Bob Hager did so in 1923 (19-7) and 1924 (20-5).

OSU finished in a three-way tie for sixth place with a 9-9 Pac-12 record, its best conference record since 1993. The Beavers won 17 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1989 (22-8) and 1990 (22-7).

During the 2015-16 season, Oregon State defeated seven teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament -- California, Colorado, Iona, Oregon, USC, Tulsa and Utah.

Tinkle is now 36-27 (.571) in his OSU tenure, with two wins over top-25 opposition. The Beavers defeated No. 7 Arizona, 58-56, in 2015 and topped No. 21 USC, 85-70, this past season. It's the first time they've defeated Top 25 teams in back-to-back seasons since 2005-2006.

Under Tinkle the Beavers are 29-5 when leading at halftime; 30-2 when leading with five minutes to play; 19-1 when outrebounding its opponent, and 9-2 in games decided by five points or less. They are also 27-5 (.844) at home in Gill Coliseum.

The 50-year-old Tinkle became the fourth OSU coach since 1928 to record a winning record in his first season in 2015. He joined Beaver legends Slat's Gill, Paul Valenti and Jim Anderson in that exclusive fraternity.

Tinkle's debut season was also replete with accomplishments and highlight moments. The Beavers:

- Set a school record for their best start at Gill Coliseum (14-0) and the most home wins in a single season (15).
- Posted an 8-10 Pac-12 record, their best conference mark since the 1992-93 team finished 9-9.
- Defeated No. 7 Arizona for their first win over a top-10 team in 15 years.
- Defeated Arizona, UCLA and Washington in the same season for the first time since 1990.
- Also downed DePaul of the Big East and Mississippi State of the SEC.

Tinkle stressed defense from his first day on the job and the Beavers responded. They led the Pac-12 in steals, 3-point field goal percentage defense and turnover margin. They also set school records for scoring defense, field-goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage defense.

Tinkle steadfastly preached the value of teamwork but the Beavers have enjoyed their share of individual accomplishments as well in his first two seasons.

In 2016, senior guard Gary Payton II earned Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year honors for the second year in a row. He broke his father's (former OSU All-American Gary Payton) school record of at least one steal in 38 consecutive games.

Payton II also earned first-team all-Pac-12 and Pac-12 all-defensive honors for the second season in a row. Also, forward Tres Tinkle, Wayne Tinkle's son, earned honorable-mention on the All-Freshman Team.

In 2015, Payton II was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year and earned All-Pac-12

First Team and Pac-12 All-Defensive Team honors after finishing second in the nation in steals. The junior transfer had a steal in all 31 games, the second-longest streak in school history. His 95 steals were the second most in Oregon State single-season history and tied for the third most in a season in Pac-12 history.

Tinkle inherited a senior-less program depleted by the graduation or transfer of six players who combined for 128 starts. That manpower shortage was further exacerbated in the offseason when Chai Baker, a touted incoming recruit from Florida who was expected to see significant playing time, was stricken with a heart ailment that sidelined him for the season.

Baker's illness left the Beavers with just eight scholarship players. However, Tinkle cleared that hurdle by holding a campus-wide open tryout just before the start of practice.

Five of the 22 participants were added to the official roster, joining two walk-ons from the previous season, and all played a major part in the team's success, as role players or by pushing the starters in practice. Tinkle subsequently rewarded them for their dedication and commitment by starting five walk-ons, all from the state of Oregon, against rival Oregon in the team's final regular-season home game.

The success of Tinkle's first season at OSU was noted nationally as he was named a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year.

Tinkle was named the 21st head coach in OSU history on May 19, 2014, after leading Montana to three NCAA Tournament appearances and seven winning records in eight seasons. His Grizzlies captured Big Sky Conference regular-season titles in 2010, 2012 and 2013, and Big Sky Conference Tournament championships in 2012 and 2013.

He led Montana to four consecutive postseason trips from 2010-13, including the NCAA Tournament in 2010, 2012 and 2013. His 97 conference wins are the most by any Montana coach and his 158 overall victories are the second-most in school history.

He was named the Big Sky Coach of the Year after the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, and the NABC Division I All-District 6 Coach of the Year in 2012. He is the only coach in Montana history with three NCAA-Tournament berths and two Big Sky Coach of the Year awards.

Tinkle directed Montana to 25-7 seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 when the Grizzlies won the second-most games in school history in successive seasons. They won 25 consecutive Big Sky games in that span and set a conference record with 19 league wins in 2012-13.

Montana had winning records in seven of Tinkle's eight years as head coach and won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons (2010-13). He also went to the NCAA tournament three times during his five years as an assistant coach under Don Holst, Pat Kennedy and Larry Krystkowiak, presently the head coach at the University of Utah.

The son of a college administrator, Tinkle was born on Jan. 26, 1966 in Milwaukee, Wis., as the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He graduated from Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash., in 1984, and then enrolled at Montana, where he had a standout career from 1986-89.

Tinkle was a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. He ranks fourth all-time at Montana in rebounds (836), and sixth in points (1,500). He earned the team's Carl Dragstedt Award (MVP) in 1988 and 1989; led the team in rebounding in 1987, 1988 and 1989, and led the team in scoring in 1988 and 1989.

He then played professionally for 12 years with stints in the CBA and in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece before retiring to become a coach.

Tinkle earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Montana in health and human performance in 2005.

Tinkle is married to the former Lisa McLeod, who was a standout basketball player at Montana and was inducted into the Grizzly Sports Hall of Fame in 2011. They have two daughters, Joslyn and Elle, and one son, Tres.

Joslyn played in three basketball Final Fours during her four-year career at Stanford. Elle redshirted this past season at Gonzaga and helped lead the Bulldogs to the Sweet 16 in 2015.

A two-time Gatorade Montana Player of the Year at Missoula's Hellgate High School, Tres joined the program for the 2015-16 season and earned Pac-12 All-Freshman Team honorable mention recognition.
