BIG SOUTH FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK -

Chidi Chiakwelu was named Big South Conference Freshman of the Week this week (November 17). Chiakwelu is the 13th player in the program's history to earn the Big South Freshman of the Week award. Chiakwelu made three big blocks while scoring four crucial points in Presbyterian's road win at Georgia State (November 10). He recorded his first career double-figure scoring game with 11 points on 5-for-6 shooting from the field at South Carolina (November 12).

REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENTS -

For the fifth straight season, Presbyterian is playing in a tournament in the month of November with the Empire Classic in California. The Blue Hose played Sacramento State on Sunday and California on Tuesday. PC finishes Empire Classic play at UCLA. The Empire Classic is the 14th regular-season tournament that PC has played in since moving to Division I in 2007-08. Last season, the Blue Hose won the Axe'Em Classic title at Stephen F. Austin with wins over Stephen F. Austin, Youngstown State, and Monmouth. In the 2021-22 season, the Blue Hose claimed the University of New Orleans Classic title with wins over New Orleans, VMI, and Central Arkansas. In the 2023-24 season, the Blue Hose won two games with victories over North Florida and Northwestern State in the First Coast Classic at North Florida.

NEARLY RECORD BREAKING REBOUNDS

TOTALS - Redshirt junior forward Jaylen Peterson grabbed 17 rebounds in the win over Bluefield (November 5). His 17 rebounds are tied for the fourth highest single game rebounds total in Presbyterian's DI era. The DI era record for rebounds in a game is 18.

DOUBLE DIGIT BOARDS -

Redshirt senior forward Jonah Pierce has grabbed double-figure rebounds in three of Presbyterian's first seven games. He corralled 13 rebounds against Navy (November 3) and ETSU (November 8). He recorded 14 rebounds at Sacramento State (November 16).

PC COACH QUINTON FERRELL - Quinton Ferrell is in his seventh season as the head coach of his alma mater, Presbyterian College. Ferrell, a former Blue Hose team captain and a 2007 PC graduate, is one of 51 coaches in the NCAA Division I ranks who are coaching their alma mater.

EARLIEST FIRST GAME IN SCHOOL HISTORY - Presbyterian's season opening game against Navy on Monday, November 3, marked the earliest date that the Blue Hose have begun a season in school history. The previous earliest season opener was last season with a November 4th opening game at Charlotte.

HOME OPENER - Presbyterian is 16-2 in their home opening game while a member of Division I.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK - Presbyterian scored 105 points in their win over Bluefield (November 5). In the Division I era, the Blue Hose have scored at least 100 points in a game 16 times, and PC is 16-0 in those games. In the 2018-19 season, Presbyterian scored 100 points five times. In the 2017-18, 2023-24, and the 2024-25 seasons, PC reached the century mark twice. In the 2025-26, 2016-17, 2015-16, 2011-12, and 2007-08 seasons, PC recorded a one hundred point scoring game in each of those seasons.

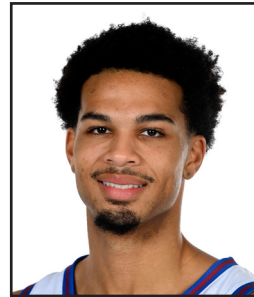

Head Coach Quinton Ferrell Seventh Season

Quinton Ferrell is in his seventh season as head coach, and twelfth overall as a member of the PC coaching staff, having served as an assistant coach from 2007-2012.

Ferrell, who helped Presbyterian College to an NCAA Division II Tournament appearance in 2005 and two 20-win seasons in his four years as a student-athlete, returned to his alma mater as the 19th head coach in men's basketball program history on April 11, 2019.

COACHING CAREER AT PRESBYTERIAN

In his first season (2019-20), the Blue Hose collected a 10-22 overall record and 7-11 mark in the league. The 10 overall wins tied for seventh in the PC DI record book for total victories, and the seven conference wins, tied for fourth. PC experienced a five-game winning streak during the season, which tied for the longest winning streak since the 2017 season.

In his second season (2020-21), which came during the COVID-19 pandemic, Rayshon Harrison was named Big South Conference Freshman of the Year, Second Team All-Big South Conference, as well as being a CollegeInsider.com Freshman All-American. Owen McCormack earned Big South Conference All-Academic team honors.

In his third season (2021-22), the Blue Hose defeated VMI, New Orleans, and Central Arkansas to capture the University of New Orleans Classic title. Rayshon Harrison was named Second Team All-Big South Conference and earned Second Team NABC All-District 3 honors. Owen McCormack garnered the Big South Scholar-Athlete of the Year award while being named to the Big South Conference All-Academic team. Marquis Barnett was named to the Big South All-Freshman team. Owen McCormack and Jack McMahon were recognized for their hard work in the classroom by being selected for the NABC Honors Court. McCormack also earned College Sports Communicators Academic All-District honors.

In his fourth season (2022-23), Jalen Forrest was named to the Big South All-Freshman team. Owen McCormack claimed the Big South Scholar-Athlete of the Year award for the second straight season while being named to the Big South Conference All-Academic team for the second time. McCormack also earned College Sports Communicators Academic All-District honors again.

In his fifth season (2023-24), he guided the Blue Hose to the program's second postseason tournament bid in the Division I era with a berth in the CBI. Presbyterian began the season with a road victory at SEC foe Vanderbilt. The Blue Hose tied for fifth in the Big South, which was tied for the highest Big South finish in school history. Marquis Barnett was a Second Team All-Big South honoree. Kory Mincy earned Big South All-Freshman team accolades. Trevon Reddish-Rhone was recognized for his hard work in the classroom with a Big South All-Academic team selection.

In his sixth season (2024-25), he guided the Blue Hose to the program's third postseason tournament berth in the DI era with a trip to the CBI. The Blue Hose recorded seven Big South Conference wins, which was tied for the fourth most Big South wins in school history. Presbyterian earned the fifth seed in the Big South Tournament, which was the highest Big South Tournament seed in the program's history. Presbyterian was recognized for its hard work in the classroom by earning the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award for the first time in school history. Kobe Stewart was a Second Team All-Big South selection. Mincy was an Honorable Mention All-Big South honoree. Iverson King made the Big South All-Freshman team. Kaleb Scott was a Big South All-Academic Team selection.

PREVIOUS COACHING EXPERIENCE

Ferrell returned to PC after five seasons as an assistant coach at the College of Charleston, where he had a major responsibility in recruiting, scouting, and developing perimeter players.

Before CoFC, Ferrell served as an assistant coach at Army for one season under head coach Zach Spiker.

During the 2012-13 season, Ferrell served as an assistant coach at The Citadel under head coach Chuck Driesell. Before his tenure at The Citadel, Ferrell spent five years as an assistant coach at PC. In addition to working with both perimeter and post players, he was responsible for a wide variety of tasks including recruiting, scouting, team travel, equipment, and academics.

In 2007-08, Ferrell helped the Blue Hose transition from NCAA Division II status into the NCAA Division I ranks and was part of a staff that engineered victories over Auburn, Wake Forest, and 20th-ranked Cincinnati during his time in Clinton, S.C. He recruited the top two scorers in school history in Khalid Mutakabbir (1,576 points) and Al'Lonzo Coleman (1,501 points), who went on to earn All-Big South Conference honors twice.

COLLEGIATE PLAYING CAREER

Ferrell joined the Blue Hose coaching staff the first time around after a productive four years on the PC men's basketball team. A three-year starter at point guard for PC, Ferrell is regarded as one of the best defenders to ever play at PC under former head coach Gregg Nibert.

Ferrell was on the 2005-06 Blue Hose basketball team that advanced to the NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Semifinals. He was also a senior captain on the 2006-07 Blue Hose squad that finished with 20 wins for the second consecutive season, leading the Blue Hose in assists and steals in each of his final two seasons, and was twice named the program's Most Valuable Defensive Player.

Ferrell graduated from Presbyterian with a degree in accounting in 2007.

Ferrell is married to the former Kimberly Turner, of Augusta, Ga., and the couple has a son, Qaiden Mauricio (9), and daughters, Keziah Renata (7) and Kelsie Riel (1).

AL'LONZO COLEMAN ASSISTANT COACH

Former Blue Hose standout forward Al'Lonzo Coleman is in his third season as an assistant coach. Coleman joined the Blue Hose coaching staff after spending 11 years playing professional basketball.

In his two seasons on the Blue Hose coaching staff (2023-25), Presbyterian earned consecutive postseason tournament berths with bids to the CBI. Three players garnered All-Big South honors, while two players were named to the Big South All-Freshman team. Presbyterian began the 2023-24 season with a road victory at SEC foe Vanderbilt. In the 2024-25 season, the Blue Hose recorded seven Big South Conference wins, which was tied for the fourth most Big South wins in school history. Presbyterian earned the fifth seed to the 2025 Big South Tournament, which was the highest Big South Tournament seed in the program's history. In 2025, Presbyterian was recognized for its hard work in the classroom by earning the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award for the first time in school history.

Before joining Presbyterian's coaching staff, he played pro basketball in Argentina, Ecuador, Mexico, Iceland, Finland, Israel, France, the Dominican Republic, Hungary, and Turkey. He averaged double-figure points in each of his 11 seasons of professional basketball. He averaged 20.7 points and 12.1 rebounds playing for Stjarnan in Iceland's First Division in the 2015-16 season while earning All-League honors. Playing for Hapoel Ramat Gan in Israel, he averaged 19.0 points and 14.0 rebounds. During his career, he was a two-time Import Player of the Year in Israel in the 2017-18 and 2020-21 seasons. In 2016-17, he was a member of the All-Defensive team in Finland. He played on three teams that reached the Finals of their respective leagues, including being part of a league championship team in Ecuador.

During his career at Presbyterian, Coleman became the first player in the program's history to garner First Team All-Big South honors when he collected the accolade in 2012. He was a Second Team All-Big South selection in 2009. As a freshman, while helping the Blue Hose usher in the Division I era, he was named NCAA Division I Independent Newcomer of the Year in 2008 after leading the Blue Hose in scoring (11.2 ppg) and rebounding (5.0 rpg). He also garnered a spot on the All-Independent Second Team and the Division I Independent All-Newcomer team.

In his stellar career at Presbyterian from 2007-12, Coleman scored 1,499 points, which is the third most points scored by a Blue Hose player in the Division I era, while grabbing a program Division I record 786 rebounds. Coleman was the first player in school history to score 1,000 points in Division I basketball. He holds Presbyterian Division I era career records for free throws made (417), free throws attempted (632), defensive rebounds (532), and offensive rebounds (254).

A Charlotte, North Carolina native, Coleman graduated from Presbyterian with a degree in Business Management with a double minor in Physical Education and Coaching in 2012. Coleman has a daughter, Zoë (9).



JUSTIN GRIFFITH ASSISTANT COACH

Justin Griffith is in his fourth season as an assistant coach at Presbyterian College.

Griffith during his 13-year college coaching career, which has included stops at Presbyterian, North Carolina Wesleyan, Lander, Mount Olive, and Winston-Salem State, has coached and recruited four All-Americans, five All-Region players, 28 All-Conference Players, three Conference Defensive Players of the Year, two Conference Players of the Year and one Conference Freshman of the Year.

In his three seasons at Presbyterian, the Blue Hose have earned two postseason tournament berths with back-to-back trips to the CBI (2024, 2025). He has coached three All-Big South selections and three Big South All-Freshman team honorees. The Blue Hose also began the 2023-24 season with a road victory at SEC foe Vanderbilt. In the 2024-25 season, the Blue Hose recorded seven Big South Conference wins, which was tied for the fourth most Big South wins in school history. Before his time at North Carolina Wesleyan, Griffith spent the 2019-20 season as an assistant coach at Lander University.

Griffith began his coaching career at the University of Mount Olive in 2012. During his six seasons at Mount Olive, the Trojans won the 2014 Conference Carolinas Championship while finishing in the top four in the conference five of his six seasons.

In the 2013-14 season, Griffith left Mount Olive for one season to be on the coaching staff at Winston-Salem State. He would return to Mount Olive for the 2014-15 season. In his one season at Winston-Salem State, he helped guide the Rams to a 19-7 record, which included the CIAA South Division regular-season title and a trip to the CIAA championship game.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native graduated in 2012 with a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from North Carolina Wesleyan. During his playing career at North Carolina Wesleyan, he was a two-year team captain who helped the Bishops capture three USA South Conference Championships. In 2020, Griffith graduated with a Master's degree in Athletic Administration from Coker University.

Griffith and his wife Juannette, have one daughter: Zoe.



ROB LANE ASSISTANT COACH

Before Sarah Lawrence, Lane was a graduate assistant at his alma mater, the University of Pittsburgh, from 2019-21. In that role, he assisted with day-to-day operations, video scouting and analytics, skill development, and on-campus recruiting. At Pitt, he played a role in the development of All-American Justin Champagnie.

As an undergraduate at Pitt, he was a four-year manager with the men's basketball program. In 2019, the White Plains, New York native graduated from Pittsburgh with a degree in communications and a minor in sociology.

Lane and his wife, Bailee, were married in May of 2025, and they reside in Fountain Inn, South Carolina.

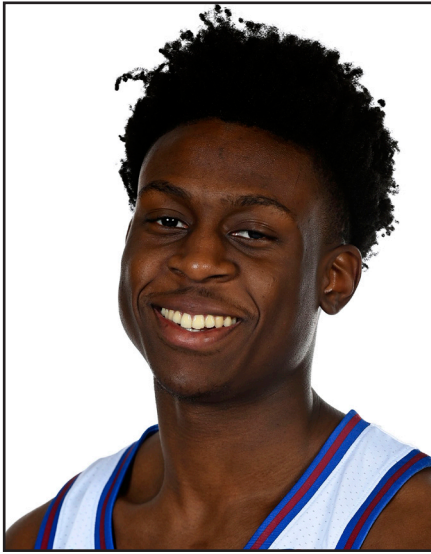

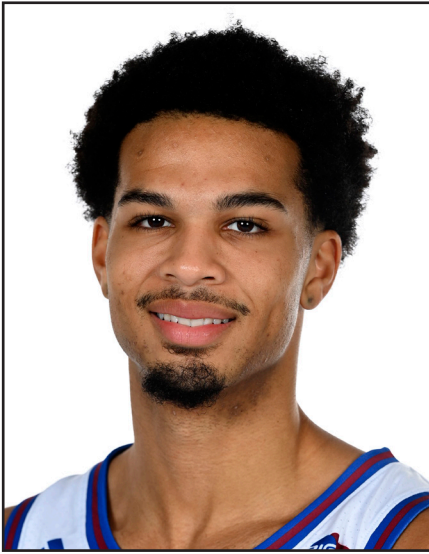
