With its 87-60 win over CSUB on Nov. 3, Cal recorded its 300th victory at Haas Pavilion.

NOTEWORTHY...

THE CLASSIC CONTINUES

The Empire Classic finale will take place at Chase Center in San Francisco on Tuesday (Nov. 25), featuring California against No. 19/20 UCLA at 7 p.m. in a game that will be televised on ESPN. Both teams have won their first two games on their respective home courts in the Classic, having beaten Presbyterian and Sacramento State.

FOLLOW ALONG

 Cal's clash with UCLA will air on ESPN with Ben Braun and Chris Sylvester on the call. Fans can also catch Justin Allegri and Theo Robertson on the Cal Bears Sports Network radio broadcast on 810 AM and The Varsity App.

LAST ACTION

- Cal hauled in its fifth win at Haas Pavilion behind another 90-point outing as the Golden Bears topped visiting Sacramento State 91-67 on November 211. Led by Chris Bell's 21 points, Cal had four Bears in double digits for the fourth time this season in improving to 5-1 overall.
- Cal crafted a 22-2 rally to work out ahead of the Hornets in the first half and stay the course to a 47-33 halftime advantage. The Bears were shooting 48.6 percent from the floor to lead Sacramento State's 35.5 percent, and Cal had landed nine 3-pointers in those first 20 minutes to help craft that lead. The rebounding margin was tighter, with the Hornets ahead 19-18. The Bears bumped up their efforts in the second half to finish out at 50.8 percent overall while they went and landed a season-high 15 threes on the night. The Hornets still held the edge on the boards 43-42, but shot just 26.9 percent overall from the floor.
- Chris Bell's game-high 21 points went along with 16 apiece from Dai Dai Ames and Justin Pippen and 14 from John Camden, who hit four 3-pointers for the Bears. Milos Ilic led on the boards with a season-high nine rebounds for Cal. Cal senior Rytis Petraitis also made his mark in scoring his 1,000th career point tonight. Sacramento State was led by Brandon Gardner's 19 points, while Mark Lavrenov scored 14 and Prophet Johnson added 12 points to go along with 11 rebounds for a Hornet double-double.
- On his first basket of the game, Rytis Petraitis scored his 1,000th career point.
- With a game-high 21 points, Chris Bell scored in double digits for the fifth straight game and registered his second 20-point game as a Bear.
- Bell, Justin Pippen (16 points), Dai Dai Ames (16) and John Camden (14) hit double digits for the fifth time this season.
- · Pippen's 16 points tonight set his new career high.
- · Milos Ilic pulled in a season-high nine rebounds.
- TT Carr set new career highs with seven points scored and two 3-pointers made.
- Cal's 15 threes made matched its season high and was one off of the program record last hit in 2022-23.
- $\cdot\;$ Cal matched its season high of nine Bears scoring in a game.
- Cal's 50.8 percent shooting effort was its fourth 50+ game of the season.
- This was the third time this season that Cal has scored 90+ points in a game (93 vs. Cal State Fullerton, 96 at Kansas State and 91 tonight vs. Sacramento State).

LIGHTING UP THE LITTLE APPLE

- Cal carved down a 25-point deficit with help from a hot 3-point outing in the second half but came up just short of host Kansas State in a 99-96 loss to the Wildcats in Manhattan, Kansas, on November 13. Chris Bell drained seven of Cal's 15 threes on the night including five in the last five minutes of play and Dai Dai Ames added five of his own in a wild one to mark the Golden Bears' first road test of the season.
- K-State finished out the three-point win shooting 64.4 percent overall with nine 3-pointers landed. Cal finished up at 56.5

- percent overall with 15 threes hit and outrebounding its host 26-25. Both teams also had 17 assists apiece, while K-State was 14-of-21 from the free-throw line and Cal was 11-of-14 from the stripe.
- Chris Bell led all scorers with 27 points for the Bears and was joined in double digits once again by Dai Dai Ames (25 points) along with Justin Pippen (14) and Lee Dort (10).
- K-State was paced by PJ Haggerty's 23 points along with 21 from Khamari McGriff, 20 from Nate Johnson and 16 from David Castillo.
- TI Carr scored his first points as a Bear when he went 2-for-2 from the free-throw line in the first half and finished with six total points.
- Carr also set career highs with six rebounds and five assists.
- Nolan Dorsey hit his first 3-pointer as a Bear with his strike in the first half.
- · Dhiaukuei Manyiel Dut recorded a career-high three blocks.
- · Chris Bell made a season-high seven 3-pointers one short of his career high.
- Dai Dai Ames scored a season-high 25 points and tied his career high of seven assists.
- · Ames also recorded a career-high five steals.
- For the second straight game, Ames missed only a single 3-pointer (6-of-7 vs. CSF, 5-of-6 at K-State).
- · For the third straight game, Ames did not miss a free throw
- · John Camden had a season-high three assists.
- Ames (25) and Pippen (14) have both now scored in double digits in all four games this season.
- Manyiel Dut scored his first points as a Bear with his basket in the second half, and recorded his first career steal.
- · Cal recorded a season-high 21 assists
- · Cal had four players score in double digits for the fourth straight game.
- With 93 points scored vs. Cal State Fullerton and 96 at K-State, Cal has recorded back-to-back games with 90+ points scored for the first time since 2014.

BALANCED BEARS

- All five Cal starters are averaging in double figures through the first five games of the year.
- Dai Dai Ames (18.8 ppg), Chris Bell (15.7), John Camden (14.8) and Justin Pippen (12.8) have hit double digits in five of Cal's six games this season, while Lee Dort (10.5) has done it three times.

ALL DAY DAI DAI

 Dai Dai Ames leads Cal in scoring with 18.8 points per game thanks to an 11-of-13 effort from 3-point range in a two-game span vs. Cal State Fullerton and Kansas State. He leads the team with 17 threes made to date.

BELL RINGER

Chris Bell hit five 3-pointers in four minutes of play at Kansas State to help turn a 17-point deficit into a six-point margin with 37 seconds left. The Bears came up short in a 99-96 loss, although Bell finished with a season-high 27 points on 7-of-9 shooting from 3-point range. He has now turned out three 20-point outings as a Bear.

MOVING THE BALL

- Cal has dished out 20+ assists in three different games this season.
- Justin Pippen is the Bears' top distributor with 5.33 assists per game, including a career-high seven served up vs. CSUB in Cal's season opener.

FIRST TIME OUT

 In Cal's season opener, seven newcomers scored their first points as Bears: Dai Dai Ames (18 points), Chris Bell (5), John Camden (22), Nolan Dorsey (2), Milos Ilic (4), Mantas Kočanas (2) and Justin Pippen (15).

- Also making their Cal debuts on Nov. 3 were transfer Dhiaukuei Manviel Dut and true freshmen Luke Butler and TT Carr.
- Cal's season-opening win marked the 300th victory recorded by the Bears at Haas Pavilion.

HOT START

- Cal's 3-0 start to 2025-26 was its first since the 2019-20 season when the Bears opened at 4-0.
- The Bears recorded 90+ points in back-to-back games the first time Cal has done so since 2014 — vs. Cal State Fullerton and Kansas State.
- Cal scored a season-high 96 points at Kansas State on a season-best 56.5% shooting along with 53.6% from 3-point range.
- Cal has shot over 50 percent in four games this season, going 3-1 in those games.
- After a 91-point effort vs. Sacramento State, Cal has three 90+ games this season.

CENTURY CLUB

 Cal's 93-65 win over Cal State Fullerton on November 10 marked Mark Madsen's 100th career victory as a head coach.

 Of Cal's nine transfer additions, six are post players who stretch the Bears' size in the frontcourt. Spanning from 6-foot-7 Chris Bell to 7-footer Dhiaukuei Manyiel Dut, the group checks in at an average of 6-foot-9.

BACK FOR MORE

 Cal returns three Bears who saw time in the starting lineup last season – F Rytis Petraitis (29 starts), G DeJuan Campbell (16) and F Lee Dort (1).

TV TIME

- Cal is locked in with 19 televised tests in its second season in the Atlantic Coast Conference. All 18 of the Golden Bears' ACC regularseason games will be televised, along with a nonconference clash against UCLA at Chase Center as part of the Empire Classic.
- In all, Cal will play four times on ESPN's family of networks ESPN, ESPN2 or ESPNU along with 15 games on the ACC Network. Cal's 11 nonconference home games will stream on ACCNX.

CHAMPIONSHIP RINGS

Mark Madsen is one of four NCAA Division I head coaches that won an NBA title during their playing careers. Madsen is the only one of those four coaches to have won two NBA titles, both coming with the Los Angeles Lakers in 2001 and 2002.





MARK MADSEN

CALIFORNIA MEN'S BASKETBALL HEAD COACH · 3rd SEASON AT CAL · STANFORD, 2000 CAREER COACHING RECORD: 102-90 | RECORD AT CAL: 32-39

Mark Madsen, a two-time NBA champion with East Bay roots and a proven track record as both a college and professional coach, was named the 19th head coach in California men's basketball history on March 29, 2023. After reinvigorating the Cal program and its fan base with a 10-win improvement in his first year at the helm in 2023-24, Madsen led the Golden Bears into their inaugural season as members of the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2024-25.

Madsen's first year in Bear Territory was marked by Cal's best finish in the Pac-12 Conference standings since 2016-17 with a tie for sixth place (13-19, 9-11). The Bears' nine conference wins – each against a different opponent, including marquee victories against UCLA and NCAA Tournament teams Washington State, Oregon and Colorado – were the fourth-most by a first-year head coach in program history.

Madsen was awarded a two-year contract extension in March 2024, keeping him in Berkeley until 2030.

Cal won 10 home games, including six of its final eight, inside Has Pavilion in 2023-24. The final eight-game span was spotlighted by Cal's first sold-out crowd since Jan. 29, 2017, when 11,801 were on hand for the Bears' 83-77 overtime win against USC on Feb. 7, 2024. That sellout was sandwiched by attendances of 8,710 against Stanford on Jan. 26 and 9,280 against UCLA on Feb. 10.

Cal won 14 games in 2024-25 and reached the ACC Tournament second round following a double-overtime win over Virginia Tech in the opening round; the Bears became just the second No. 15 seed to win a game in the ACC Tournament. Cal went 11-6 at home in Madsen's second year – including wins over ACC foes Virginia, Florida State, Miami, NC State and Boston College – and picked up a 71-66 road win at USC in nonconference play.

'Mad Dog' - the nickname Madsen received from his fifth grade P.E. teacher at Montair Elementary School in Danville - didn't waste a second in implementing his vision for Cal men's basketball. He and his staff aggressively pursued some of the top recruits in the country in the transfer portal and on the high school level, and On3 ranked the Bears' 2023 transfer class as the eighth-best in the nation. That transfer class was highlighted by Jaylon Tyson - who went on to be selected No. 20 overall in the first round of the 2024 NBA Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers in June 2024 - and Fardaws Aimaq, who led the Pac-12 in rebounding (11.0 RPG) and was one of only six major-conference players to average a double-double in the 2023-24 season.

Madsen and company restocked the Cal roster again through the transfer portal heading into the 2024-25 campaign; 10 of Cal's 11 scholarship newcomers this season are transfers, making up the 12th-ranked transfer class in the country (0n3). Among the 11 total scholarship newcomers were sophomore guard and All-ACC Team honorable mention Andrej Stojakovic – who increased his scoring from 7.8 PPG to 17.9 PPG in a single season after transferring from Stanford – and freshman guard Jeremiah Wilkinson, who was named 2024-25 ACC

Sixth Man of the Year and earned a spot on the ACC All-Rookie Team on the way to one of the most dynamic freshman seasons in program history.

Following a decorated playing career which included a trip to the NCAA Final Four at Stanford and two NBA championships while playing for the Los Angeles Lakers, Madsen is considered a rising star in the coaching ranks. Prior to Cal, he most recently led Utah Valley to the semifinals of the 2023 NIT. Madsen was named the 2023 Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year and led the Wolverines to a pair of conference titles during his four seasons at the helm. He was well-recognized for his efforts during the 2022-23 campaign as he was named District Coach of the Year by both the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) and a finalist for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year award, which is presented annually to the top Division I mid-major coach in college basketball.

Madsen was 70-51 (.578) overall and 39-25 (.609) in WAC play in four seasons at Utah Valley. Following an 11-win season in his first year in 2019-20, Madsen led the Wolverines to a share of the WAC regular-season title in 2020-21 and back-to-back 20-win seasons in 2021-22 and 2022-23. Madsen's 2022-23 squad won a program

Madsen spent six seasons as an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Lakers (2013-19) prior to leading Utah Valley. During his time on the Los Angeles bench, he coached NBA superstars LeBron James, Kobe Bryant and Steve Nash, among others. He also played alongside some of the NBA's greatest players, including Bryant, Shaquille O'Neal and Kevin Garnett. Following three seasons played with the Lakers (2000-03), Madsen played six further seasons with the Minnesota Timpopulae.

Madsen's first coaching position came as an assistant coach for the Utah Flash of the NBA Development League during the 2009-10 season. He later returned to his alma mater to earn an MBA from the Stanford Graduate School of Business in 2012 and spent the 2012-13 season as an assistant coach for the Cardinal, working in recruiting, opponent game planning and player development.

A 2019 Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame inductee, Madsen earned All-America honors twice while helping lead the Cardinal to four NCAA Tournament appearances – including the 1998 Final Four – in as many seasons played from 1996-2000. He averaged 10.9 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in his Stanford career and ranks fourth in field goal percentage (.587) and sixth in rebounds (857) in program history. Madsen earned an undergraduate degree in economics from Stanford in 2000

Madsen served a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Spain. Madsen and his wife, Hannah, have three sons (William, Leroy and Mark) and two daughters (Alexandria and Anastasia).






