TALKING POINTS

OPPONENT HISTORY

UCLA leads the all-time series 96-42 and won both meetings last season.

» The Ducks are 16-15 against the Bruins under head coach Dana Altman and are 4-8 in games played in Pauley Pavilion.

» UO is seeking their first win at Pauley since an 84-81 overtime win against No. 3 ranked UCLA on Jan. 13, 2022.

KJ'S STRONG PLAY

Kwame Evans Jr. tied his career high with 23 points against USC, adding nine rebounds, 2 assists, 2 steals and 1 block.

» It was the most points he's scored in a Big Ten game and most since scoring 23 against UC Riverside in last year's season-opener.

» He hit 9-of-11 free throw attempts, one make shy of tying his career best. It was his second career game with at least 20 points and nine rebounds.

NINTH STRAIGHT RIVALRY WIN

UO beat Oregon State 87-75 on 11/17, the ninth consecutive win over the Beavs.

» Kwame Evans Jr. notched his second career double-double with a season high 16 points and a career best 14 rebounds.

» Nate Bittle (24 points) and Jackson Shelstad (22 points) led the team in scoring. It was the second game in a row with two 20-point scorers for the Ducks.

TWO 20-POINT SCORERS

The Ducks defeated South Dakota State 83-69 on 11/12 in Matthew Knight Arena.

» Jackson Shelstad led the way with 22 points, a career-high-tying 8 assists, 3 steals and 3 rebounds.

» Takai Simpkins net five three pointers (5-10 3FG) en route to 20 points, his most as a Duck.

SECOND HALF SURGE

Oregon improved to 4-1 all time against Rice after a 67-63 win on 11/7.

» The Ducks outscored the Owls 40-31 in the second half, behind a 9-0 run midway through the half.

» Nate Bittle led all scorers with 25 points (7-15 FG), eight rebounds and a career-high-tying 6 blocks.

» UO shot 38 free throws (26-38) compared to just 11 for Rice.

Kwame Evans Jr. is averaging 15.6 points (.511 FG%, .800 FT%), 8.6 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.2 blocks over the last five games. He's started all eight games this season and is averaging career bests in points, rebounds, assists and blocks.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

18 Evans Jr. is yet to miss a game in his Oregon career, playing in all 79 games (40 starts) over his three seasons in Eugene.

Sean Stewart net a new career high of 18 points in his first start for the Ducks vs. Creighton. (8-12 FG, 7 reb, 3 blk.)

14 Dezdrick Lindsay scored in double-figures for the first time in his career vs. Creighton, notching 14 points (6-9 FG).

3 Jackson Shelstad is 3 points from 1,000 career points. He's played in 74 games (712starts) in three seasons for UO.

784 Coach Altman has amassed 784 career wins and is fifth among active coaches in wins. He has 17 NCAA appearances.

## 2025-26 and 2024-25 GAME NOTES

### WON GAME ONE

Oregon's season opener was a nail-biting 60-59 win against Hawaii on 11/4.

- » Takai Simpkins scored 18 points (7-12 FG) in his Ducks debut, including the go-ahead basket with 4.2 seconds to play.
- » Nate Bittle recorded his fourth consecutive double-double dating back to last season, with 12 points and a career-high-tying 14 rebounds, along with four blocks.
- » The Ducks improved to 14-2 in season openers under Dana Altman, and 16-0 in home openers.

### FAMILIAR FACES

UO returns three impact players from last year's postseason run: Nate Bittle, Jackson Shelstad and Kwame Evans Jr.

- » Bittle led the Ducks with 14.2 points per game in 2024-25, adding 7.6 rebounds, 2.1 blocks and 1.9 assists per game. He shot 51.1% from the field, 33.6% from three-point range and 81.1% from the free throw line. Bittle blocked a Big Ten-high 74 shots and his 2.1 blocks per game ranked second in the conference.
- » Shelstad averaged 13.7 points (.451 FG%, .379 3P%, .835 FT%), 2.9 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.0 steals in a team-leading 32.9 minutes per game.
- » Evans Jr. played in all 35 games and averaged 6.1 points (.465 FG%) and 4.6 rebounds in 16.3 minutes off the bench.
- » Dezdrick Lindsay, Jamari Phillips and Oleksandr Kobzystyi are also returning and look to have increased roles this season.

### IMPACT ADDITIONS

The Ducks added experienced DI players in Devon Pryor, Takai Simpkins and Sean Stewart, as well as international players Ege Demir, Wei Lin and Efe Vatan.

- » Pryor played in 30 games in two seasons at Texas and averaged 3.2 points and 2.0 rebounds in 12.1 minutes last season.
- » Simpkins was named to the All-CAA second team in 24-25 with averages of 16.4 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.6 assists at Elon. He closed the season with five 20-plus point games in his last six contests, averaging 25.7 points, 3.3 assists and 2.0 rebounds over the six-game span.
- » Stewart has played 63 career games for Duke and Ohio State. He started all 30 games for the Buckeyes last year and averaged 5.7 points and 5.8 rebounds in 18.4 minutes.
- » Demir played three seasons in Turkey. Last season he averaged 5.0 points and 4.9 rebounds for Darüssafaka Lassa in 15.3 minutes.
- » Lin spent three seasons with the Nanjing Monkey Kings in the Chinese Basketball Association and averaged 21.0 points (.413 FG%, .349 3P%, .876 FT%), 5.0 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals in 34.1 minutes last season.
- » Vatan spent last season with Galatasaray in the U19 league and notched 16.7 points, 6.5 rebounds and 1.6 assists in 31.4 minutes.

### ALTMAN'S DUCKS...

- » Are 226-71 when totaling fewer turnovers than the opponent.
- » Are 265-40 when outrebounding the opponent.
- » Are 255-32 when holding opponents to 69 or fewer points.

### 2024-25 NOTES ROUND OF 32

UO advanced to the second round for the ninth time under Dana Altman with a wire-to-wire 81-52 victory over Liberty.

- » The Ducks shot 54.4% from the field and 47.6% from three.
- » UO's 29-point win was the second largest margin of victory for the Ducks in an NCAA Tournament game.
- » Jackson Shelstad led all scorers with 17 points, netting 15 in the first half. He finished +28 on the night.

### ALL-CONFERENCE DUCKS

Ducks Nate Bittle and Jackson Shelstad were voted to the All-Big Ten third team, while Bittle and TJ Bamba both made the All-Defensive Team.

- » Bittle and Shelstad led the Ducks in scoring, each averaging close to 14 points per game, with Bittle adding 2.1 blocks per game, second-most in the Big Ten.
- » Bamba anchored the perimeter defensive with 1.7 steals per game, fifth most in the conference.

### BITTLE MANIA

Nate Bittle was named one of five finalists for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year award on March 7.

- » The Big Ten's blocks leader was one of three players nationwide to total at least 490 points, 260 rebounds and 70 blocks this season. He was the only one of the three to make over 30 three pointers.
- » He recorded a career-high 36 points (13-20 FG, 3-4 3FG, 7-8 FT), 12 rebounds, 2 blocks, 2 assists and a steal on 3/9 at UW.
- » It was the most points by a Duck since Jermaine Couisnard scored 40 in last season's NCAA Tournament and he joined Luke Jackson as the only UO players with 35 points and 10 rebounds in a single game since at least 1996-97.

### MARCHING ON

Oregon has won 77 games in the month of March since Coach Altman took over in 2010-11, most in the country in that span.

- » Oregon is 77-32 (.706) in the month of March under Altman.

### CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Oregon has won 26 conference tournament games under Dana Altman.

- » In 2024, UO won its sixth Pac-12 Tournament last season, defeating Colorado 75-68 in the championship game.
- » It was Altman's fourth title (tied with Lute Olson, Arizona, for most in conference history).
- » Altman finished 25-9 in Pac-12 Tournament games (.735) and his 25 Pac-12 Tournament wins were the most-ever.
- » Jackson Shelstad made the 2024 All-Tournament Team, scoring 21 points against Arizona, adding a career-high three blocks. The then-freshman scored 17 in the title game.
- » In 2025, UO defeated Indiana 72-59 in the team's first-ever BIG Tournament game.
- » The Ducks have won at least one conference tournament game in 12 straight tournaments.

### OT UW VICTORY

The Ducks won their seventh game in a row after defeating UW 80-73 on 3/9 in Seattle. UO outscored UW 12-5 in overtime.

- » Nate Bittle scorched the nets with a new career-high 36 points and 12 rebounds.
- » KJ Evans recorded his first career double-double with 11 points, 11 rebounds 2 blocks.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy added 14 points with three assists and TJ Bamba finished with 10 points and four assists.

### 6TH-STRAIGHT WIN

UO won its sixth game in a row on 3/4, defeating Indiana 73-64 in Eugene.

- » The game saw 10 ties and 10 lead changes before Oregon closed the game on a 10-0 run to secure the victory.
- » Jackson Shelstad led the team with 17 points, including the go-ahead three-pointer that sparked the run.

### USC SWEEP

UO picked up the season sweep against USC on 3/1, defeating the Trojans 82-61 while outscoring USC 43-27 in the second half.

- » Keeshawn Barthelemy sparked the second half run, scoring 14 of his 20 point in the frame, including 4-5 three's.
- » Jackson Shelstad (19 pts 4 ast) and Nate Bittle (15 pts, 7 reb, 5 blk) also reached double-digits, while KJ Evans was a plus-15 off the bench with 8 pts, 6 reb, & 2 blk.

### RANKED ROAD WIN AT WISCONSIN

The Ducks defeated No. 11 Wisconsin 77-73 in OT on 2/22, led by a then-career-high-tying 23 points from Nate Bittle.

- » UO trailed by as many as 17 in the contest and was down 14 with 6:15 left in the game.
- » Shelstad forced OT with a pull-up three-pointer with 12 seconds left. The Ducks outscore the Badgers 11-7 in OT, behind six points from Bittle in the extra frame.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy scored 14 points in the contest and KJ Evans added 10 points and nine rebounds off the bench.



## 2024-25 GAME NOTES continued

### DEFENSE LIFTS UO OVER RUTGERS

The Ducks allowed a conference opponent season-low 57 points in the 75-57 victory over Rutgers on 2/16 in Eugene.

- » Jackson Shelstad net a game-high 19 pts (8-13 FG), while Nate Bittle added a double-double (15 pts, 10 reb) with 5 blk.
- » TJ Bamba tied his career-high with 6 assists, adding 11 points.
- » The Ducks net a season-high 13 three-pointers on a season-best 59.1 percent from three.

### NORTHWESTERN WIN

UO got back on track with an 81-75 victory over Northwestern on 2/11 in Eugene.

- » Jackson Shelstad net a career-high 26 points, connecting on 8-of-11 field goals and 4-of-6 three-point attempts.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy made his fourth start of the season and net 19 points on 4-of-6 three-pointers.
- » The Ducks dished out 16 assists on 24 field goals, the most since recording 22 against Penn State.

### LATE SURGE LEADS DUCKS PAST UW

Oregon beat Washington for the third game in a row on 1/21.

- » TJ Bamba posted his second 20-plus point game of the season, one of five Ducks in double-figures.
- » UO held the Huskies to just 4-of-21 shooting from three-point range, the second-consecutive game Oregon has held their opponent to under 20% from deep.

### DUCKS TRUMP BUCKS

Oregon beat Ohio State 73-71 in come-from-behind fashion to stay unbeaten in true road games so far this season.

- » Jackson Shelstad (24 pts) and Nate Bittle (21 pts) became the first UO teammates to each score 20+ in 2024-25.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy scored his 1,000th-career point on a three that kicked off Oregon's 11-4 run in the final three minutes.

### BOUNCE BACK TERPS WIN

Oregon defeated Maryland 83-79 on 1/5 in the first-ever meeting between the teams.

- » Oregon improved to 5-1 when trailing at halftime, coming back from down 13 in the first half with a 14-point run to start the second half.
- » Jackson Shelstad recorded his second 20-point game of the season on a career-high five made three-pointers.

### PLAYERS ERA FESTIVAL CHAMPS

Oregon defeated No. 9 Alabama 83-81 on 11/30 to win the first-ever Players Era Festival tournament title.

- » Keeshawn Barthelemy scored a career-high-tying 22 points (7-11 FG) off the bench, adding four assists.
- » Nate Bittle net the go-ahead basket with 4 seconds to play, finishing with 19 points, 9 rebounds and 3 assists.

### VICTORY OVER SDSU IN VEGAS

UO defeated SDSU 78-68 on 11/27, advancing to the finals of the Players Era Festival.

- » T.J. Bamba recorded his first 20-point game as a Duck with a team-high 22 points and 5 ast.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy added 16 points (3-4 3FG) and a career-high five steals.
- » Brandon Angel and Jackson Shelstad each added 12 points.

### TOP 20 WIN OVER TEXAS A&M

Oregon picked up its first ranked win of the season on 11/26, defeating No. 20 ranked Texas A&M 80-70 in Las Vegas.

- » The Ducks went on two separate 10-point scoring runs, including a 16-0 run to regain the lead in the second half.
- » T.J. Bamba scored a season-high 18 points (10-12 FT), followed by Brandon Angel (16 points, 5-6 FG) and Jackson Shelstad (16 points).
- » UO forced 13 turnovers, scoring 20 points off turnovers.
- » A&M was held to just 27% shooting in the second half.

### SEASON SUPERLATIVES

- » Bittle dished out a career-high-tying six assists vs. Indiana on 3/13, after setting his career mark in the first meeting between the two teams on 3/4.
- » Evans Jr. recorded his first career double-double with 11 pts and 11 reb against UW.
- » The Ducks shot a season-best 90.5 percent from the free throw line against Indiana, hitting 19-of-21 attempts.
- » UO forced Wisconsin into 17 turnovers on 2/22, the most by the Badgers this season and most by a UO opponent in conference play.
- » Oregon held USC to 23.3% from the field in the second half, including 0-10 from three.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy went 8-10 from the field and 4-6 from three-point range against USC, totaling 20 points.
- » Bittle tied his career high of 23 points against Wisconsin, adding six rebounds and three blocks. He finished +13 in the game.
- » Jackson Shelstad scored a career-high 26 points vs. Northwestern, his fifth 20-point game of the season, all coming in Big 10 play.
- » Supreme Cook grabbed his 1,000th career rebound against Rutgers, his 146th career game for Fairfield, Georgetown and Oregon.
- » Rutgers' 57 points were the fewest by an Oregon opponent in conference play since Cal was held to 51 on 3/2/23.
- » Oregon is 13-4 this season when recording five or more steals and 4-0 when posting double-digit steals in a game.
- » The Ducks outscored Washington 20-9 over the final 5:36 of the game on 1/21, including a 9-0 run.
- » Oregon held Purdue to just 2-of-12 shooting from three-point range, the Ducks' sixth time this season holding an opponent under 20% from deep.
- » Nate Bittle's career-high six blocked shots against Purdue were the most in a game by a Duck since KJ Evans swatted six last season.
- » The Ducks recorded a season-high 22 assists on 31 makes in the win over Penn State on 1/12.
- » Keeshawn Barthelemy eclipsed the 1,000 point marker for his career with his three-pointer late in the second half vs. OSU on 1/9, helping secure the Ducks' come-from-behind win.
- » UO shot 51.8% from the field and 42.9% from three against Maryland on 1/5, along with 86.7% from the free throw line.
- » Supreme Cook scored a season-high 20 points vs. Illinois on 1/2, finishing 8-for-11 from the field.
- » Oregon finished nonconference play 11-0, the first unbeaten nonconference slate since 2013-14.
- » The Ducks shot a season-high 55% from the field vs. Weber State (33-60 FGA) on 12/29, connecting on 9-of-22 three-point attempts (40.9%).
- » UO combined for 44 bench points vs. SFA, behind 14 apiece from Supreme Cook and Jadrian Tracey, and 8 from KJ Evans.
- » The Ducks led for 37:40 against SFA, leading wire-to-wire with no ties or lead changes.
- » USC was held to 31.0% shooting in the second half on 12/4, hitting just 9-of-29 attempts, and no three pointers.
- » UO forced 15 turnovers against Alabama on 11/30, outscoring the Tide 17-5 in points off turnovers.
- » Oregon was a +17 on the glass against SDSU (41-24) on 11/27, outscoring the Aztecs 18-4 in second chance points.
- » TJ Bamba (22 pts), Keeshawn Barthelemy (16), Jackson Shelstad (12), Brandon Angel (12) and Nate Bittle (11) all scored in double figures against SDSU, the first time since 2/1/24 that five Ducks scored 10-plus.
- » Oregon went on two 10-point scoring runs against Texas A&M on 11/26, a 16-point run and a 10-0 run to pull away late.
- » 11 of Jackson Shelstad's then-season-high 15 points came in the second half against Oregon St.
- » Kwame Evans Jr. set a new career high against UC Riverside in the season opener, scoring 23 points (8-15 FG, 2-5 3FG, 5-5FT).

## MATTHEW KNIGHT ARENA

### MATTHEW KNIGHT ARENA FACTS

- Matthew Knight Arena was the first LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Gold certified Arena in the NCAA. LEED provides standards to recognize Green buildings.
- » Opened January 13, 2011 with a 68-62 victory over USC.
  - » The lower bowl of Matthew Knight Arena is closer to the floor and steeper than Mac Court.
  - » Over 50 Point of Sale lines are available to purchase food and beverage in 20 different locations.
  - » Over 200 TVs located in the arena and over 100 of these are located throughout the concourses.
  - » There are four times as many toilets as in Mac Court with over 130 women's toilets, 65 men's toilets and 4 family toilets.
  - » There are four loading dock bays with room underground to turn a 70' truck 360 degrees.
  - » The clean span roof trusses are over 260' long.

### CONSTRUCTION FACTS

- » 1,890 employees worked at the site.
- » 330,000 cubic yards of dirt were excavated (that's 30,000 dump truck loads).
- » 50,000 cubic yards of rock.
- » 39,000 cubic yards of concrete were poured in the arena and the garage (that's 3,900 mixers full).
- » 4,840 tons (over 9 million lbs.) of reinforcing steel was placed in the concrete.
- » 580,000 lbs. of precast concrete forms the seating bowl.
- » Over 2,900 tons of structural steel were placed.
- » Over 800,000 man hours.

### KILKENNY FLOOR & MATT LOGO

- » The court at Matthew Knight Arena has a fresh new look for Oregon's first season in the Big Ten Conference.
- » Highlighting the new Kilkenney Court surface are a more prominent 'O' logo at center court, a reimagining of the tree design reminding opponents they're playing "Deep in the Woods" when they come to Eugene, and other touches conceptualized by the design team at Van Horne Brands.
- » Floor design and concept is a nod to the Tall Firs, the nickname of Oregon's 1939 national championship winning men's basketball team, and three logos on the floor are an homage to the family of former Oregon athletic director Pat Kilkenney.
- » More than 270 photos of trees from around the Northwest were taken to incorporate in the design, reinforcing the deep roots of the university in the region.
- » The Killkenney Court mark at each end includes a new image blending a shamrock with the Duck foot, honoring the "Lucky Duck" charitable foundation started in 2005 by Stephanie and Pat Kilkenney.
- » The unique logo, located near the sideline on each half, spells out "MATT" in a toothy grin reminiscing Matthew Knight - the late son of Nike founder Phil Knight - as a child.
- » The surface incorporates a tribute to the arena's namesake, who passed away in 2004. Near each baseline are images of Ducks flying in a "missing man" formation, with a gap in the flying-V formation to symbolize the legacy and memory of Matthew Knight.

## HEAD COACH DANA ALTMAN

Dana Altman is one of only three active coaches in NCAA Division I with 28 consecutive winning seasons. He is part of an exclusive fraternity that includes Hall-of-Famers Tom Izzo and Bill Self.

Altman became the 24th head coach to record 700 career wins at the Division I level in 2021-22 and is the winningest head coach in Oregon history with 370 wins. In 2016-17, Altman led Oregon back to the Final Four for the first time in 78 years and coached the Ducks to consecutive Pac-12 titles in 2020 and 2021.

Oregon has won 20 or more games in all 15 seasons with Altman as head coach. The Ducks are one of four DI program with 20-plus wins in 15-straight seasons, alongside Belmont, Gonzaga, and Kansas. Coach Altman is one of three coaches to have been named a DI conference coach of the year at four schools, joining Kermit Davis and Cliff Ellis. In 2019, he became the winningest coach in Pac-12 Tournament history and joined Lute Olson (Arizona) as the only coaches to win the conference tournament four times.

The 2013 National Coach of the Year and three-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year enters the 2025-26 season 370-176 in Eugene, and 780-405 in 36 seasons as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level in stints at Oregon, Creighton, Kansas State and Marshall. He's reached the NCAA Tournament 17 times; once with Kansas State, seven times at Creighton and nine times at Oregon.

### 2024-25 season:

- » Reached the NCAA Tournament for the 17th time in his career and ninth time at Oregon, winning 25 games to extend his 20-win season streak to 15 seasons.
- » Led the Ducks to a 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament, improving to 8-0 in first round games after defeating 12th seeded Liberty 81-52 in the round of 64.
- » UO won the inaugural Players Era Festival in November and ranked as high as No. 9 in the AP Poll after winning nine-straight games to start the season, including ranked wins over No. 20 Texas A&M and No. 9 Alabama.
- » Nate Bittle and Jackson Shelstad became the first Ducks named to an All-Big Ten team when they earned third team All-Big Ten honors. Bittle and TJ Bamba were two of the five members of the Big Ten All-Defensive team and Bittle was one of five finalists for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.
