OPENING TIP: Northwestern completes its two-game Los Angeles road trip on Saturday at UCLA after claiming a 74-68 win at USC on Wednesday night where it maintained a lead the entirety of the second half and improved to 2-0 against the Trojans since they joined the Big Ten Conference. Three true first-years started at USC (Tyler Kropf, Jake West, Tre Singleton) for the first time at Northwestern since at least 2004-05, and became the first trio of rookie starters to win a Big Ten Conference game across the entire league during the 2025-26 season. UCLA and Northwestern will meet for the 3rd time in the last 4 seasons, but the 'Cats are making their first trip to Pauley Pavilion in program history and are playing their first road game at UCLA since 1948.

NICKY BUCKETS: Last season, senior forward Nick Martinelli became the 4th Wildcat to lead the Big Ten in scoring, joining John Shurna (2011-12, 20.0), Joe Ruklick (1958-59, 23.0), and Ray Ragelis (1950-51, 19.1), while setting the school's single-season scoring record (676 points). This season, he leads the nation in scoring (23.6), and places 6th in the B1G and 69th nationally in FG percentage (55.1) and is 16th in the league in rebounding (6.7). He is shooting 52.1% from 3-point distance, the 9th-best mark nationally (KenPom). Martinelli has scored in double-figures in 44 of his last 44 games, and had a streak of 30 games, the longest by a Wildcat since Evan Eschmeyer (1997-99, 65). The Glenview, Ill., product has scored in double-figures 61 times in his career and scored 20+ points 35 times in his career, which ranks third at Northwestern since 2004 (Table on Page 4). Martinelli has scored 20+ points in 10 straight games, which is the longest streak by a Wildcat since at least 1996-97. Its the longest active streak of 20+ point games in the country. His streak is tied for the 3rd longest in the Big Ten since 1996-97 with Quincy Lewis (10, Minnesota, 1999), and trailing Zach Edey (16, Purdue, 2024) and Luka Garza (19, Iowa, 2020) (BTN Research). On Thursday, he was named one of 25 players selected to the USBWA Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List. He ranks 15th in school history for career points with 1,453 (Page 4).

NOTABLE NUMBERS: Northwestern leads the country with an assist/turnover ratio of 2.16. Since 1993 only 5 teams have exceeded 2.0 AST:TO: 2025-26 Purdue (2.14), 2024-25 Gonzaga (2.07), 2020-21 Iowa (2.02), 2005-06 West Virginia (2.01).

- The team is averaging a nation-best 8.4 turnovers lost per game. The 'Cats have turned the ball over 10 or fewer times in eight of their last nine games.
- Northwestern is averaging 18.1 assists per game, which ranks 21st nationally, and had 22 last time out at USC, its most since Nov. 10 against Cleveland State (26). It is Northwestern's most assists per game since 1993-94 (17.8). Jayden Reid leads the team and ranks 4th in the Big Ten averaging 5.4 assists per game.
- Northwestern is recording an average of 3.9 blocks per game, which is 7th in the Big Ten, and the team's most since 2018-19 (4.2). The 'Cats have averaged over 4+ blocks per game three times in program history, all during the Chris Collins era: 2016-17 (4.9), 2017-18 (4.3), 2018-19 (4.2)
- NU's opponents are shooting 30.0% from 3-point distance, the 4th-best mark in the Big Ten and 30th best nationally.
- Seven of Northwestern's games this season have been decided by five points or fewer (t-7th most in the country this season), after the team played a school-record 13 games decided by five points or fewer in 2024-25 (5-8). Over the last four seasons, Northwestern has played 42 games (20-22) decided by 5 points or fewer, the 5th-most in the country.







MORE NOTES...

LAST TIME OUT: Northwestern led for the duration of the second half and defeated USC on the road at Galen Center 74-68 on Wednesday (Jan. 21) evening for its first Big Ten win of the season.

- Nick Martinelli reached 20+ points for the 10th straight game with 22 points and added 5 rebounds and a career-high 5 assists. He scored 17 points in the second half.
- Playing a career-high 34 minutes, Jake West notched career-highs across the board with 11 points, 3 rebounds and 5 assists. He is the first Wildcat rookie to post 10+ points, 3+ rebounds and 5+ assists since Boo Buie against Nebraska on March 1, 2020.
- Tyler Kropp, making his first career start, also had career marks of 11 points, 9 rebounds and one assist in 28 minutes. He was a team-best +12. He is the first Wildcat first-year to have 11+ points and 9+ rebounds since Dererk Pardon against Nebraska on Dec. 30, 2015.
- Kropp and Jake West became the first rookie due to each have 10+ points for the 'Cats since Boo Buie and Ryan Young on March 1, 2020 against Nebraska.
- Making his first start in a Northwestern jersey, Holy Cross transfer Max Green had 9 points, 3 rebounds and 3 assists in a season-high 31 minutes.
- Northwestern shot 45.2% (28-of-62) from the field, while limiting USC to a 38.5% mark (20-of-52).
- The 'Cats survived despite USC (26-of-43) being awarded 25 more free throws than Northwestern (15-of-18).
- Northwestern continued to take care of the ball, committing just 6 turnovers.
- The 'Cats owned the paint, scoring 44 points, their highest in Big Ten play this year and most since Dec. 16 against Valpo (50).
- USC shot just 15.4% from 3-point distance (2-of-13). It is the lowest percentage a Big Ten shot against the 'Cats since Michigan State shot 11.8% (2-for-17) on March 6, 2024.

LAST TIME VS. UCLA: Northwestern went on a 13-0 run in the final three minutes of the game but came up just short to UCLA 73-69 on Senior Day inside Welsh-Ryan Arena on March 4, 2025.

- Playing in his final home game, Ty Berry posted game-highs of 22 points, 7 rebounds and 3 steals.
- Nick Martinelli had 20 points, 6 rebounds and 3 assists.
- Northwestern capitalized on 12 UCLA turnovers leading to 19 points off turnovers.
- Northwestern last led at the 14:30 mark of the second half before ultimately cutting the deficit to just one point.

SERIES STUFF: Northwestern and UCLA will be meeting for the 3rd time in the last 4 seasons, with the Bruins holding a series lead of 6-1 against the Wildcats.

- Northwestern is making its first trip to Los Angeles since Dec. 21, 1948, when it fell to the Bruins in John Wooden's first season at UCLA by a 49-44 score at the Pan-Pacific Auditorium.
- Head coach Chris Collins is 0-2 in his career against UCLA.

SPEED LIMIT 65: Northwestern is 48-5 when holding its opponent to 65 or fewer points over the last four seasons, which is the 2nd-best win% (.904) in the Big Ten Conference over that span (min. 40 games) (Purdue, .923). Dating back to last season, the team has won 15 of 16 games when doing so.

PUSH THE PACE: Northwestern is looking to push in transition at a much higher rate than last season. The 2024-25 team averaged 7.2 fastbreak points per game last season which ranked 15th in the Big Ten and 303rd nationally. This season Northwestern ranks 3rd in the Big Ten and places 86th nationally, posting an average of 13.1 fastbreak points per game.

D-UP: Northwestern's opponents are shooting only 30.0% from 3-point distance this season, which ranks fourth in the Big Ten and 30th nationally.

THE METRICS: Northwestern has the 25th toughest schedule in the country (KenPom), its toughest since the 2020-21 team faced the 2nd toughest schedule nationally.

- Northwestern's adjusted offensive efficiency is 119.6, the 55th best mark nationally, the team's best mark since the 2023-24 team was 35th nationally (115.9).
- The 'Cats average defensive possession length of 19.0 is 365th nationally.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Northwestern has started first-years a total of 20 times this season, made up by the pair of Tre Singleton (16), Jake West (3) and Tyler Kropp (1).

- Northwestern has recorded its most total starts by first-years since 2021-22 (22). In the 2022-23 and 2023-24 seasons, Northwestern did not start a first-year.
- Singleton has started 16 games, the most by a Wildcat first-year since Ryan Young (31) and Robbie Beran (18) in 2019-20

MORE NOTES...

CHRIS COLLINS THE PIONEER: Northwestern Sullivan-Ubben Head Coach Chris Collins begins his 13th season (4th longest tenure in Big Ten) leading the Wildcats program in 2025-26. Collins owns a 202-195 record in Evanston, and has won the second-most games in program history behind only Naismith Hall of Famer Dutch Lonborg's (1927-50) 236 victories. Over the last four complete seasons from 2021-25, Northwestern has won 38 Big Ten games, equaling the stretch from 1930-34 (38) as the most over a four-season period in school history. Of the six 20+ win seasons in program history, Collins has guided the team to four of them.

BALL CONTROL: Over the last three seasons combined, the Wildcats turnover percentage of 11.7% ranks fourth in the country behind Houston, Iowa and NC State. Their 8.9 turnovers per game in that span ranks third in the country trailing Virginia (8.7) and Houston (8.3). This season, the 'Cats rank 1st nationally turning the ball over 8.5 times per game.

20 & 6 SEASONS: Nick Martinelli is looking to become the first Wildcat to have back-to-back seasons of 20 points and 6 rebounds per game since Jim Burns from 1965-67. The last five Big Ten players to do so are Zach Edey (Purdue, 2022-24), Luka Garza (Iowa, 2019-21), Glenn Robinson (Purdue, 1992-94), Steve Smith (Michigan State, 1988-90) and Glen Rice (Michigan, 1987-89).

GREEN LIGHT: On Nov. 10 against Cleveland State, Max Green came off the bench to score 16 points in just 4:30 of the second half. He went 6-for-8 from the field, including 4-of-6 from 3-point distance. He played 9 minutes, becoming the first Big Ten player to record 16 points in 9 or fewer minutes played since at least 2004. Over the last 10 seasons, Green is the only high major player to accomplish the feat and just one of 5 players nationally to do so against a DI opponent.

MORE NOTES...

SCHOOL EXPERIENCE: The Wildcats returners (excluding walk-ons) have combined to play nine seasons at Northwestern, which is the sixth most in the Big Ten.

SEASONS ON CURRENT SCHOOL ROSTER

DEFENSE DEFENSE: Over the last three seasons (2022-25), Northwestern is one of just 14 schools nationally to allow less than 70 points per game and post a top 60 defensive rating in each season, joining Houston, Tennessee, Duke, Saint Mary's, Iowa State, San Diego State, Cincinnati, VCU, Auburn, North Texas, UCLA, Maryland and Michigan State.

NOT FOR THE FAINT OF HEART: Over the last three seasons, Northwestern has played nine overtime games, which ranks fourth in the country. The next closest Big Ten team is Ohio State with five games. The Wildcats went 3-0 in home overtime games in 2024-25 and 3-1 overall (OT loss at No. 20 Michigan). At home, Northwestern has won five straight overtime games, its longest streak since winning six straight from 2014-17.

WELCOME TO OUR CLUB: A total of eight newcomers joined the Wildcats roster for the 2025-26 season, with three coming via the transfer portal and five from the prep ranks. It's the most newcomers for the Wildcats since 2019-20 (8). Portal additions (stats from 2024-25): Jr. G Jayden Reid (USF, 12.6 ppg, 3.6 apg, 1.8 spg), G Max Green (Holy Cross, 14.9 ppg, 5.6 rpg, 3.5 apg) and F Arrinten Page (Cincinnati, 3.5 ppg, 2.3 rpg, 0.5 bpg). The Wildcats five high school additions were ranked as the No. 10 class in the country by 247Sports at the time of their signing, the highest rated class in the modern recruiting era. The class includes C Cade Bennerman (Nashville Tenn, Father Ryan), G Phoenix Gill (Chicago, Ill., St. Ignatius), F Tyler Kropp (Powell, Ohio, Olentangy Liberty), F Tre Singleton (Jeffersonville, Ind., Jeffersonville) and G Jake West (Philadelphia, Pa., William Penn Charter). Singleton is the highest rated recruit in school history, and was rated the No. 92 player in the country by 247Sports.

CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



The 2022-23 Big Ten Coach of the Year, Sullivan-Ubben Head Men's Basketball Coach Chris Collins has guided Northwestern men's basketball to new heights over his 12 seasons, appearing in the 2017, 2023 and 2024 NCAA Tournaments, the only NCAA postseason appearances in program history. Collins has recorded 201 victories in Evanston, the second-most wins by a head coach in program history. He was named the University's 24th head coach on March 27, 2013, and is the fourth-longest tenured coach in the 18-team Big Ten Conference. Collins signed a contract extension this past offseason which will keep him in Evanston through 2030.

Collins guided Northwestern to its first back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, reaching the Second Round in both 2023 and 2024.

Most recently in 2024-25, Northwestern posted its third consecutive winning season with a 17-16 record, despite playing a large portion of the season without two of its top three scorers due to injury. Nick Martinelli became the first Wildcat to lead the Big Ten in scoring since 2011-12 (John Shurna), averaging 20.5 points per game, the highest scoring average by a Wildcat since Evan Eschmeyer (21.7) in 1997-98. Martinelli was named All-Big Ten Second Team. Brooks Barnhizer, who was named All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and NABC All-District Second Team, posted averages of 17.1 points, 8.8 rebounds, 4.2 assists, 2.3 steals and 1.1 blocks per game in 17 games before missing the remainder of the season due to injury.

The 2023-24 team finished with a 22-12 overall record, tied for third in the Big Ten Conference standings with a 12-8 mark and won its NCAA Tournament First Round game over FAU 77-65 in overtime. Northwestern placed in the top three of the conference standings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1958-59 and 1959-60. The Wildcats tied their program record for most Big Ten wins in a season and claimed 24 league victories over the last two seasons, the most over a two year stretch in school history.

Northwestern won two games over AP Top 10 opponents in a season for the first time in program history. The 'Cats took down No. 1 Purdue for the second straight season, earning a 92-88 overtime win on Dec. 1, and defeated No. 10 Illinois 96-91 in overtime on Jan. 24.

Boo Buie became the first player in school history to be named a unanimous All-Big Ten First Team selection and broke the school's career scoring record by finishing his career with 2,187 points. Brooks Barnhizer earned All-Big Ten Third Team recognition and All-Defensive team honors. Collins was named a

2024 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year finalist.

In the 2022-23 season, Collins led the team to the school's second NCAA Tournament berth, a 22-12 overall record, and a second-place finish in the Big Ten Conference standings with a 12-8 league ledger. For the first time since 1958-59, Northwestern finished second in the league standings, while also setting a school record for conference wins in a single-season. Collins was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year, the second time in Northwestern history a coach has earned the award. Additionally, he received national recognition as the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year Semifinalist.

The regular season was highlighted by a school-record four wins over AP ranked opponents and the program's first victory against the nation's No. 1 team, on Feb. 12 against No. 1 Purdue, 64-58, inside Welsh-Ryan Arena. Playing away from home, the team went 7-4 in true road contests, winning the most road games in a season since 1958-59. The 'Cats captured their first win over a ranked Indiana team since 1988 by downing the No. 15 Hoosiers 84-83 at Assembly Hall on Jan. 8. Northwestern won back-to-back road games over ranked opponents for the first time in school history as it defeated No. 20 Michigan State 70-63 in East Lansing.

Northwestern earned a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, the highest in school history, and defeated Boise State 75-67 in the First Round in Sacramento, Calif. The 'Cats improved to 2-0 all-time in NCAA Tournament First Round games.

Under his coaching, Northwestern's senior guards of Chase Audige and Boo Buie combined to become one of the best backcourts in the country and in school history. Audige was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, a first at NU since 1994, and an All-Big Ten Second Team selection. Buie posted one of the best seasons by a point guard in program history and became the first Wildcat named All-Big Ten First Team since John Shurna in 2012. Buie was also a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, which is awarded to the nation's best point guard. The duo became the first Northwestern teammates to earn first and second team All-Big Ten honors since 1963-64.

Collins led the Wildcats to accomplishments never before reached during the 2016-17 season. The unforgettable campaign saw Northwestern accumulate a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history.

NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play — the program's first since 1933 — saw the team crack the top 25 of the Associated Press poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years.

Northwestern went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign. Five of the victories came on the road, including a 66-59 triumph at No. 7/5 Wisconsin on Feb. 12.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77

while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Collins worked primarily with backcourt players during his time at Duke and tutored All-Americans Jason Williams, Mike Dunleavy, Chris Duhon, J.J. Redick, Gerald Henderson, DeMarcus Nelson, Jon Scheyer, Nolan Smith and Austin Rivers, in addition to NBA draft picks Daniel Ewing, Kyrie Irving and Kyle Singler.

Collins also served as a court coach and scout for Mike Krzyzewski, assisting the USA Basketball Senior National Team staff with on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including during the program's gold-medal performances at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, 2010 FIBA World Championships and 2012 London Olympics.

In his first season as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won the 2001 national championship with an 82-72 victory over Arizona. Along the way, Williams earned unanimous first-team All-America and National Player of the Year honors by the NABC. Duhon, a freshman under Collins' tutelage in 2001, was named the ACC Rookie of the Year.

Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. In 1999-2000, Collins was part of a staff that guided the Pirates to a 22-10 record and the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament. Prior to Seton Hall, Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

As a player, Collins played professional basketball in Finland during the 1996-97 season, leading the league in scoring.

While at Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and four-year letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins is the son of Naismith Hall of Famer (2024), NBA All-Star, NBA Head Coach and Olympian, Doug Collins, who also spent many years as a television analyst for ESPN. A native of nearby Northbrook, Ill., Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.


