ERIC MUSSELMAN

HEAD COACH • SECOND YEAR

Eric Musselman has over 30 years of coaching experience, including 10 years as a collegiate head coach. As one of the winningest active coaches in college basketball, Musselman is ready for his second season with USC Men's Basketball, bringing in one of the best transfer portal classes in the nation and some of the most elite freshmen to build this year's roster.

He took the role with the Trojans on April 5, 2024, creating a team from scratch with only one player from the previous team returning to the roster. With this new team built in the famous Portal House, Musselman and his staff were ready for their first season in the Big Ten. He led the Trojans to key victories, including a win in Galen over No. 7 Michigan State and on the road over No. 13 Illinois. Along with that, the Trojans took down Rutgers in a double-overtime thriller in the first round of the Big Ten Championships before falling in a tight contest to Purdue. USC went on to compete in the inaugural College Basketball Crown, taking down Tulane in the first round before falling to Villanova in a close 62-61 game. To add to those successes, he coached his first All-Big Ten honoree in Desmond Claude, who finished with honorable mention honors, and developed one of the best freshmen in the Big Ten in Wesley Yates III. Off the court, the team had the best GPA in program history, boasting a 3.264 GPA during that season.

Prior to USC, Musselman was the head coach at the University of Arkansas. In his five seasons with the Razorbacks, Musselman kept a record of 111-59 while making back-to-back Elite Eight appearances and three-straight Sweet Sixteen appearances for the first time since the mid-1990s. These winning seasons were bolstered by the talent Musselman brought into Arkansas. He had two seasons with the Top Five recruiting classes with the likes of Moses Moody, Anthony Black and Nick Smith Jr., with all three of those players being selected in the First Round of the NBA Draft. He also coached the 2020 SEC Co-Player of the Year and All-American Mason Jones along with two other All-Americans in Moody and JD Notae.

Before making his way to Fayetteville, Musselman began his collegiate head coaching career at the University of Nevada, where he led the Wolf Pack for four seasons to a 110-34 record. He won the CBI title in his first year before going to three-straight NCAA Tournaments after that, including a Sweet Sixteen run in 2018. In his first year with the program, Musselman created a new culture for the program, making the sixth-most improved program in the NCAA after their CBI win. He topped that off with the NCAA Tournament run in 2018 that earned him numerous Coach of the Year honors. Adding to that, Musselman also coached the Wolf Pack into the AP Top 25, staying in the Top 10 for 16 consecutive weeks. He also developed phenomenal talent, including two-time All-American and Mountain West Player of the Year Caleb Martin. Over those four seasons, 13 of his players earned All-Mountain West honors.

Over his 10 years as a head coach, Musselman produced four All-Americans, two conference Player of the Year honorees, three Sixth Man of the Year recipients, and 21 All-Conference players.

ROAD WARRIORS

USC has racked up frequent flyer miles with its road schedule this season. So far, the Trojans will have logged 18,539.8 flight miles across nine states.

Additionally, USC is the only Big Ten and Power-4 team to take a three-game road trip in conference play this season. The Trojans embarked on a 10-day swing to take on Michigan, Michigan State and Minnesota to begin the new year.

Despite the travel, USC has been racking up road wins this season. The Trojans are 9-4 away from the Galen Center, and their nine road and neutral site wins are tied with Illinois and Purdue for the third-most in the Big Ten (Michigan leads the way with 11, while Purdue has 10).

ARENAS ACTIVATED

Alijah Arenas has made his official debut with the Trojans, playing his first game for the Cardinal and Gold against Northwestern on Wednesday, Jan. 21. Since then, he has averaged 14.3 points per game — the third-most on the team — with three 20-point games.

So far, he is the only Trojan to earn a Big Ten weekly award. He was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week award on Feb. 9 after setting multiple career highs with 29 points and six rebounds against Indiana, then leading the team with 24 points, including the game-winning layup, against Penn State.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Alijah Arenas' 29-point night against Indiana matched his father Gilbert's freshman-year single-game high of 29 points. Gilbert, who starred at the University of Arizona from 1999-2001, scored 29 points against Arizona State on Feb. 6, 2000. Alijah was one point shy of matching Gilbert's career high of 30 points, which he set against UCLA on Feb. 15, 2001.

INJURY UPDATE

USC has been hit with the injury bug this year. Guard Rodney Rice is out for the season following his shoulder surgery, while forward Amari Dickerson is sidelined for three to four months with a hip injury. Jordan Marsh missed three games with a turf toe injury but returned against Indiana on Feb. 3. Chad Baker-Mazara also missed three games due to a knee strain. Alijah Arenas is back on the court after missing the first 18 games due to a knee injury.

According to EvanMiya.com, USC is the most injured team in the nation in production lost to injury.

SHARING THE WEALTH

Over the course of 27 games, USC has had nine different players lead the team in scoring. Chad Baker-Mazara leads the charge, leading the team on 10 different occasions. Ausar comes in second in this category, leading the scoring five times.

UNDER PRESSURE

USC is 7-2 in one-possession games and 2-0 in overtime games. The Trojans' seven one-possession wins lead the Big Ten over Nebraska, which has four, and Rutgers, which has three.

THE GALEN ADVANTAGE

USC is 232-96 at the Galen Center since it opened on Nov. 16, 2006. USC is also 115-26 in non-conference games at the Galen Center.

AUSAR IS BORN

Ezra Ausar has been a staple on offense for USC this season and has made his mark at the charity stripe. His 221 free-throw attempts rank ninth in the nation, plus he ranks seventh with 7.5 fouls drawn per 40 minutes and fourth in free-throw rate. So far, his 221 free throw attempts and 147 made free throws rank tied for sixth and eighth, respectively, for a single season in USC history.

Additionally, he is currently 22nd in the NCAA and second in the Big Ten behind Michigan's Morez Johnson Jr. by making 59.7% of his field goals. Of those shots, 91.9% of them are taken either around the rim or in the paint. He also ranks in the 92nd percentile or better in fast break points per 40 minutes (3.5), paint points per 40 minutes (13.0), personal fouls drawn per 40 minutes (7.9), and points per 40 minutes (20.9) according to CBB Analytics.

COFIE TIME

Jacob Cofie is one of two Trojans who have started all 27 games. His five double-doubles lead the team, plus they rank 12th in the Big Ten and 131st in the NCAA.

Over the last five games, Cofie has averaged 10.8 points and 5.8 rebounds — including 2.6 offensive rebounds per game — and 1.8 blocks per game.

During a three-game stretch from Jan. 17-25, Cofie became the first Trojan to have 10 or more rebounds in three consecutive games since Isaiah Mobley did so from Dec. 7-15.

CHAD'S CORNER

Chad Baker-Mazara has always dreamed of playing for USC since he visited his aunt on campus when he was in high school. Now, that dream is coming true, and it might be his best year yet. Baker-Mazara is currently averaging 18.4 points per game, which ranks eighth in the Big Ten. He also has a usage percentage of 29.0% and has an assist percentage of 19.9%, both of which are in the 97th percentile or better according to CBB Analytics.

He broke his career-high in points twice this season, most recently doing that with 34 points in triple overtime against Troy. He added another 31 points and three blocks against San Diego, being the only USC player to hit 30+ points and 3+ blocks in two games.

OUT OF THE WOODS

Graduate transfer guard Kam Woods signed with USC on Dec. 18, 2025, giving the Trojans much-needed backcourt depth. The journeyman point guard comes to USC from Robert Morris, where he and Amarion Dickerson helped the Colonels reach the NCAA Tournament. Prior to that, he played for NC State, North Carolina A&T, Northwest Florida State College and Troy.

Woods had his finest game as a Trojan against Iowa, where he scored a career-high 33 points — including a stretch in the second half where he scored 19-straight points for USC — with three rebounds, three assists and a career-high-tying four steals. His 33 points are the second-most by a Trojan in a game this year, trailing Chad Baker-Mazara's 34-point effort against Troy. Over the last five games, Woods has averaged 11.0 points, 5.2 rebounds, 5.2 assists and 2.2 steals per game.

JUMP JUMP JUMP

USC has been in charge of the jump ball this season. The Trojans are currently 21-6 in winning the jump ball.

USC has made a name for itself by putting up shots in the paint. The Trojans have shot 51.4% of their shots from the paint or around the rim, accounting for 64.1% of the team's made baskets.

DISHING IT OUT

USC has done well sharing the basketball this season. They boast a two-point assist percentage of 48.9%, which ranks in the 93rd percentile according to CBB Analytics. They also dish the ball out at the rim, assisting on 56.8% of those shots, which is in the 96th percentile according to CBB Analytics.

DEFENDING THE ARC

USC is one of the best teams at defending from beyond the arc. They are 20th in the BartTorvik.com rankings in this category, holding their opponents to 30.1% from that range. This stat ranks in the 95th percentile on CBB Analytics.

LAST TIME OUT

USC Men's Basketball fell 71-70 to the Oregon Ducks on Feb. 21 at the Galen Center on a late 7-0 surge from the Ducks in the final minute of the game. Although trailing 35-32 at the break, the Trojans were revived by a second-half push from Alijah Arenas and Ezra Ausar, who combined for 22 points in the last 20 minutes of action. Oregon capitalized off its own missed free throw by grabbing the offensive board and dishing it to Kwame Evans Jr., who'd sink the triple and pull within one. USC came up empty on its last possession, and Duck free throws carried Oregon to victory. Chad Baker-Mazara recorded a team-high 21-point performance, while Jacob Cofie set a career-high five blocks.

WATCH LIST ALERT

This week, Chad Baker-Mazara made the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Mid-Season Top 10 List. Currently, Baker-Mazara is averaging 18.4 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.9 assists per game. This is the second year straight he has been named to the Mid-Season Top 10 list.

Earlier in December, Baker-Mazara was also one of 30 players to make the Lute Olson Award Early Watch List. This award is given annually to the top player in Division I college basketball.

BOUNCE BACK KIDS

Heading into the 2025-26 season, Andy Katz ranked USC second on his list of teams that are most likely to have a bounce-back year following a 17-18 record last season.

NEW HEIGHTS

USC has one of the tallest teams in basketball this year. When looking at average height compared with minutes played, USC has the sixth-tallest roster according to KenPom.

FILLING THE WIN COLUMN

Both Chad Baker-Mazara and Terrance Williams II know what it's like to win games. Baker-Mazara currently has 109 career wins, while Williams currently boasts 103 wins.

1,000-POINT CLUB

This season has opportunities for more Trojans to hit 1,000 career points. Currently, four Trojans have reached that milestone: Chad Baker-Mazara, Ezra Ausar, Ryan Cornish and Kam Woods.

After scoring 603 points last season, Jordan Marsh is getting closer to accomplishing that feat, as he currently has 969. Terrance Williams II is also within 100 points of hitting that goal, as he also has 905 career points.

With 897 career points, Jaden Brownell is also getting close to the 1,000-point milestone.

BLOCK PARTY

USC is one of the best shot-blocking teams in the country. Currently, the Trojans are 10th in the nation, averaging 5.6 blocks per game. Jacob Cofie is a huge piece to that as he has registered at least one block in all but three games this season. He is averaging 1.70 blocks per game.

WHISTLE WARRIORS

USC has been great at drawing fouls so far this season. They are drawing an average of 20.9 fouls per 40 minutes, which is in the 99th percentile according to CBB Analytics. They are 10th in the NCAA and first in the Big Ten in made free throws per game (19.6) and third in attempts per game (27.5). The Trojans are also averaging 10.4 shooting fouls drawn per 40 minutes and 2.0 offensive fouls drawn per 40 minutes, both of which are in the 98th percentile or better.

STAR POWER

USC has 11 players who started in at least 20 games in their careers so far: Rodney Rice, Ezra Ausar, Amarion Dickerson, Chad Baker-Mazara, Terrance Williams II, Jordan Marsh, Jacob Cofie, Ryan Cornish, EJ Neal Jr., Kam Woods and Jaden Brownell. Combined, that group of players has 594 career starts.

WINNING WAYS

USC has compiled a record of 1,747-1,289 in its 119 years of intercollegiate basketball competition. USC has had a .500 or better record in 83 of its 119 seasons.

CAREER RANKINGS

Among active career leaders in the NCAA, USC has numerous players who are making their mark. USC has two of the top 10 players in career blocked shot average. Gabe Dynes is fourth, averaging approximately 2.23 blocks per game. He is also seventh in total blocked shots with 194. Amarion Dickerson comes in at 10th, averaging 2.07 blocked shots per game. Chad Baker-Mazara is also ranked highly in free-throw percentage. His 88.6% clip from the charity stripe ranks 14th in the NCAA. He is also 43rd with 1,600 career points.

Along with those two, Terrance Williams II and Chad Baker-Mazara rank in the top 20 in games played. Williams' 148 career games are the 12th-most, while Baker-Mazara's 14 games sit right behind Williams in a tie for 21st.

AND ONE

USC has been drawing a lot of and-one fouls this season. Currently, they are averaging 2.4 and-ones per 40 minutes, which ranks in the 96th percentile according to CBB Analytics. Additionally, 15.9% of USC's shots result in a shooting foul, which is in the 99th percentile.

USC's team is made up of players from all over the country. There are five players from California in Alijah Arenas, EJ Neal Jr., Patrick O'Brien, Jonah Goorin, and Brit Burden. Along with that, there are three players from Maryland in Ryan Cornish, Rodney Rice and Terrance Williams II, and two players from Ohio in Jerry Easter II and Amariion Dickerson.

There is also one player from Washington (Jacob Cofie), Georgia (Ezra Ausar), Utah (Jaden Brownell), Kentucky (Gabe Dynes), Alabama (Kam Woods) and North Carolina (Jordan Marsh). There is also one international player in Chad Baker-Mazara.

MUSSELMAN IN YEAR TWO

Coach Musselman has proven himself as a winner in his second season at his last two colleges. At both Nevada and Arkansas, Musselman has accumulated a 53-14 record, which comes out to a .791-win percentage in that time. Both teams made the NCAA Tournament in their second seasons.

PHYSICAL PLAY

Coach Musselman takes pride in recruiting physical players. This has led to him having seven former football players on his team.

SMARTIES

USC finished the fall semester with one of the best academic performances in program history. They broke the record for the highest cumulative GPA, earning a 3.319 as a team. Not only that, but all players on the roster finished with a GPA above a 3.0.

IN THE COMMUNITY

The team has done numerous community service events this summer. Most recently, the Trojans distributed toys to children at the Barack Obama Charter School in partnership with World Vision. The team also helped at Clayton Kershaw's Back-to-School Bash, playing wheelchair basketball at Angel City Sports, volunteering at the LA Food Bank, and participating in a Juneteenth event with Empowerment Congress.

FUTURE TROJANS ON THE RISE

ESPN rated USC's 2026 recruiting class ninth in the nation in early December. Five-star center and ESPN's No. 10 recruit Adonis Ratliff and his twin brother, four-star recruit Darius Ratliff highlight the Trojans' recruiting class so far. The twins are sons of Theo Ratliff, a former NBA All-Star who enjoyed a 16-year professional career.

Along with that, both Adonis and Darius have been selected for the McDonald's All-American game, becoming the 14th and 15th Trojans to be named as McDonald's All-Americans. USC was one of three schools with multiple players on the McDonald's All-American game rosters (the others were Duke and Missouri). Adonis and Darius were also selected for the Iverson Classic All-American game.

DEVELOPING THE FUTURE OF THE NBA

With the signing of Adonis Ratliff and Darius Ratliff, USC has its third-straight recruiting class where the son of a former NBA player has joined the team. This tradition includes Bronny James (son of LeBron James), Alijah Arenas (son of Gilbert Arenas), and now Adonis and Darius Ratliff (sons of Theo Ratliff). DJ Rodman is also a part of this group, as he came to USC as a graduate student and is the son of Dennis Rodman.

BIG TEN IN THE AP RANKINGS

The Big Ten is well represented in this week's AP Top 25 Men's College Basketball Poll. The highest-ranked team is Michigan, coming in at No. 3. The Big Ten also has four other teams in the top 15: No. 8 Purdue, No. 10 Illinois, No. 12 Nebraska, and No. 13 Michigan State. Wisconsin and Iowa also received votes in the latest AP poll.

SCOUTING THE BRUINS

- UCLA notched its second-ranked win of the season on Feb. 21 over No. 10 Illinois in a 95-94 overtime victory. Donovan Dent had the coast-to-coast game-winning layup on the Bruins' final possession to seal a 23-point comeback, the largest in program history.
- Dent finished with 14 points and a career-high 15 assists. Five other UCLA players hit double-digit figures, with Eric Dailey Jr. pouring in a game-high 20 points.
- Dent ranks third in the Big Ten with 7.4 assists per game, and is sixth in the conference in steals, averaging 1.8 per game.
- UCLA shoots a conference second-best .379 mark from beyond the arc. Skyy Clark is the most efficient sharpshooter. Clark has made six three-pointers on three separate occasions this season. Forward Tyler Bilodeau is also effective from downtown, sinking at least two triples in his last five outings.
- Bilodeau averages a team-best 18.1 points per game. He has scored double digits in 23 of 25 contests this season and put up a career-high 34 points against UC Riverside (Dec. 12, 2025).
- While the Bruins lead their opponent in most statistical categories, they lack strength on the boards, posting a -0.8-rebounding margin to their opponents. This season, UCLA
- UCLA is 15-1 at Pauley Pavilion this season.
