UCLA last faced UConn in the Elite Eight at the 1995 NCAA Tournament (in Oakland). UCLA won, 102-96.

MOST RECENTLY, AS A TEAM

- The Bruins have won seven of their last nine games, heading into this Sunday evening's contest against UConn.
- UCLA outlasted No. 10-seed UCF, 75-71, in a first-round matchup on Friday night in Philadelphia.
- UCLA led by as many as 14 points in the second half of the win over UCF on Friday evening.
- UCLA has won 22 or more games for the fifth time in seven seasons under head coach Mick Cronin.
- The Bruins have gone 5-0 in their first game of the NCAA Tournament under head coach Mick Cronin.
- The Bruins concluded the regular season with a 13-7 record in Big Ten play for the second consecutive season.
- The Bruins logged a 17-1 home record and compiled a 7-10 mark in road and neutral-site games.
- UCLA has posted a 10-4 record through nine games in February and March (4-3 in February, and 5-1 in March).
- The Bruins rank No. 1 in the Big Ten in 3-point shooting and No. 6 in free throw percentage.
- UCLA's assist-turnover ratio (1.83-to-1) as a team ranked No. 4 in the Big Ten.

INDIVIDUAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Eric Dailey Jr. led UCLA with 20 points (including eight of the Bruins' first 10 points) in the win on Friday night.
- For the second straight season, Tyler Bilodeau has earned third-team All-Big Ten Conference acclaim.
- Bilodeau has scored in double figures in 27 of 31 games played, including 10 games with 20 or more points.
- Donovan Dent has registered 10 or more assists in 10 games (and in four of the Bruins' last nine contests).
- Dent ranked No. 4 in the nation (third in the Big Ten) in assists per game (7.7) through Tuesday, March 17.
- Through the last nine games, Dent has totaled 83 assists and six turnovers, averaging 13.7 points in that span.
- Through Tuesday, March 17, Tyler Bilodeau led all Big Ten players in 3-point percentage (46.4%, 64-for-138).
- Trent Perry has averaged 14.3 points and 3.5 rebounds, shooting 42.1 percent in the Bruins' last 15 contests.
- Eric Dailey Jr. (11.6 ppg, 5.8 rpg) has scored 10 or more points in eight of UCLA's last nine games.
- Five Bruins have averaged at least 11 points per game this season, led by senior Tyler Bilodeau (17.6 ppg).

NCAA TOURNAMENT AT A GLANCE

- The Bruins have advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 16 of the last 22 seasons (no tournament took place in 2020).
- Under Coach Cronin, the Bruins have gone 11-4 in five trips to the NCAA Tournament (no tournament in 2020).
- Last season, UCLA defeated No. 10-seed Utah State (72-47) and lost to No. 2-seed Tennessee (67-58).
- UCLA last advanced to the tournament's "Sweet 16" in March 2023 as a No. 2 seed in the West Region.
- The Bruins last played at Xfinity Mobile Arena against Villanova on Dec. 9, 2023 (UCLA lost, 65-56).

EYEING THE OPPOSITION

- This Sunday's showdown in Philadelphia will mark the second-ever meeting between UCLA and UConn.
- UCLA defeated UConn, 102-96, at Oakland Arena (in Oakland) on March 25, 1995, in an Elite Eight contest.
- UConn has gone 30-5 overall this season, posting a 17-3 record in the Big East Conference.
- Bruins' head coach Mick Cronin has registered an all-time record of 15-11 against UConn (all while at Cincinnati).
- UConn advanced into the tournament's second round with an 82-71 win over No. 15-seed Furman on Friday.

THANKS FOR THE ASSIST

- Donovan Dent ranks No. 3 in the Big Ten and No. 4, nationally, with 7.5 assists per game (through Friday, March 20).
- Dent (12 pts, 10 rebs, 12 assists) recorded the fifth double-double on record at UCLA last Friday against Rutgers.
- Dent's 15 assists against Illinois and Minnesota stand one shy of Earl Watson's record (16, on March 18, 2000).
- Dent currently is tied for the No. 2 spot, with 256 assists, on UCLA's single-season assists record list.
- Over UCLA's last 15 games, Dent has averaged 13.9 points, 3.7 rebounds and 8.5 assists per game.

VERSUS RANKED FOES

UCLA has gone 4-6 against top-25 ranked opponents this season (as ranked in the AP poll), including a trio of home victories over top-10 teams. UCLA defeated No. 4 Purdue on Tuesday, Jan. 20, before recording a 95-94 overtime win against No. 10 Illinois on Saturday, Feb. 21, and logging the 20-point win at home on Tuesday, March 3, over No. 9 Nebraska. This marks the first season in which the Bruins have tallied three or more wins at home against top-10 ranked teams. UCLA's 72-52 win over No. 9-ranked Nebraska marked the Bruins' first 20-point win over a top-10 program since taking down No. 10-ranked Arizona in the final home contest of the 2010-11 season (Feb. 26, 2011).

TWENTY VICTORIES: The Bruins have won 20 or more contests in seven of the past 10 seasons. Stretching back through the decades, UCLA has won 20 or more games in 55 seasons (including 48 times in the last 60 years, 1967 through 2026). The Bruins won at least 20 games in 17 consecutive seasons from 1966-67 through 1982-83. UCLA had an impressive 205-5 overall record during a seven-season stretch from 1966-67 through 1972-73.

UCLA'S NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Bruins' program is making its 54th appearance at the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. UCLA has won 11 NCAA championships (most recently in 1995) and has advanced to 19 Final Fours (most recently in 2021). The Bruins have totaled 23 appearances at the Elite Eight (Regional Finals) and 38 trips to the Sweet 16 (Regional Semifinals). UCLA has compiled an all-time tournament record of 117-46. The Bruins have posted a 57-29 record and have secured 17 trips to the tournament's Sweet 16 since the field expanded to include 64 teams in 1985.

OF NOTE: UCLA's six contests in the 1980 NCAA Tournament and one game in the 1999 NCAA Tournament were later vacated by NCAA action. Those contests and NCAA Tournament appearances are not recognized by the NCAA. The numbers listed above do include those contests and tournament appearances.

THE OPENING WEEKEND

Since the NCAA Tournament expanded to include at least 64 teams in 1985, the Bruins have played 53 games during the opening week/weekend (first/second round contests). UCLA has gone 42-11 in those 53 games, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 17 tournaments. The Bruins have gone 24-6 in the first round (this doesn't include any First Four contests). The Bruins lost in the First Four in 2018 and won a First Four matchup in 2021. Most recently, UCLA went 1-1 during the tournament's opening week last season (2025, in Lexington, Ky.). The Bruins defeated 10-seed Utah State and lost to 2-seed Tennessee.

COACH CRONIN, MARCH MADNESS

In seven seasons as UCLA's head coach, Mick Cronin has guided the Bruins to five NCAA Tournaments. At the conclusion of his first season (2019-20), the NCAA Tournament was canceled as UCLA had compiled a 19-12 record heading into the Pac-12 Tournament as the No. 2-seeded team. Coach Cronin's teams have gone 11-4 in five NCAA Tournament appearances at UCLA, with one Final Four appearance (2021) and three Sweet 16 berths (2021, 2022 and 2023). UCLA's NCAA Tournament run in 2021 took place in Indianapolis, with the Bruins advancing from the First Four to the Final Four.

THE 2025-26 BRUINS

UCLA's 15-man roster includes seven players who have competed at the NCAA Tournament in previous seasons, with Tyler Bilodeau, Skyy Clark, Eric Dailey Jr., Trent Perry and Jack Seidler having seen action in last year's tournament (at Kentucky's Rupp Arena). Xavier Booker (previously at Michigan State) and Donovan Dent (previously at New Mexico) competed in the NCAA Tournament prior to transferring into UCLA. Last season, Skyy Clark shot 8-for-15 from 3-point distance (53.3) in games against Utah State (win, 72-47) and Tennessee (loss, 67-58) in the first weekend of the NCAA Tournament.

AGAINST THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

The Bruins have compiled a 4-8 record against 10 teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Looking at the breakdown of teams within the Big Ten Conference, UCLA went 4-6 – that includes Iowa (0-1), Illinois (1-0), Michigan (0-1), Michigan State (1-1), Nebraska (1-0), Ohio State (0-1), Purdue (1-1), Wisconsin (0-1). Non-conference opponents headed to the Big Dance, who UCLA faced, include Arizona (0-1) and Gonzaga (0-1). Of the teams that UCLA faced this season, Arizona (32-2) and Michigan (31-3) earned the highest seeds in the year's tournament field (No. 1 seeds).

BIG TEN CONFERENCE PROGRAMS

UCLA is one of nine programs from the 18-team Big Ten Conference to have advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Joining the No. 7-seed Bruins are No. 1-seed Michigan (31-3), No. 2-seed Purdue (27-8), No. 3-seed Illinois (24-8), No. 3-seed Michigan State (25-7), No. 4-seed Nebraska (26-6), No. 5-seed Wisconsin (24-10), No. 8-seed Ohio State (21-12) and No. 9-seed Iowa (21-12). Should UCLA advance, the earliest in which the Bruins could face a Big Ten team would be in the Sweet 16 (Michigan State). Both Michigan State and Ohio State joined UCLA in the bracket's East Region.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT WINNER: Purdue defeated Michigan, 80-72, to capture the Big Ten Tournament title on Sunday, March 15. Purdue defeated UCLA, 73-66, in the semifinals on the afternoon of Saturday, March 14, to move into this year's tournament championship game. The Boilermakers knocked off Northwestern and Nebraska on consecutive days to move into the semifinal showdown against UCLA last weekend.

GLANCING AT THE EAST REGION

UCLA has faced two of the other 15 teams in this year's East Region – No. 3-seed Michigan State and No. 8-seed Ohio State. The Bruins went 1-1 against Michigan State, losing to the Spartans in mid-February (road game on Tuesday, Feb. 17) before taking down Michigan State last week (88-84) at the Big Ten Tournament. UCLA lost to Ohio State in a road contest, 86-74, on Saturday, Jan. 17. UCLA and No. 13-seed Cal Baptist are the only West Coast teams in the East Region.

NOTES ON UCLA VERSUS UCONN

- The Bruins have won the only previous meeting against UConn, recording an 102-96 win under head coach Jim Harrick in the 1995 NCAA Tournament's Elite Eight. Toby Bailey had 26 points and Tyus Edney totaled 22 points and 10 assists.
- UCLA's win in 1995 over UConn propelled the Bruins to the Final Four. The Bruins defeated Oklahoma State (74-61) in the national semifinals, before taking down Arkansas (89-78) to secure their 11th all-time NCAA men's basketball title.
- The Bruins shot 36-for-66 in the win against UConn in 1995, making just two of 11 attempts from 3-point distance. UConn outrebounded UCLA by a 45-34 margin in the Elite Eight contest.

ASSISTS PER GAME

Through 34 games, senior Donovan Dent has averaged 13.4 points and 7.5 assists per game. Dent, a 6-foot-2 guard from Riverside, Calif., could be on track to join a rare group of UCLA guards who averaged at least 10 points and six assists per game over the course of a full season. In fact, Dent could become UCLA's first player to average 10 points and seven or more assists in one season since then-freshman Lonzo Ball registered 14.6 points and 7.6 assists per game in 2016-17. Ball helped guide UCLA to a 31-5 overall record that season and a finish in the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16.

FACTS AND FIGURES

- Tyler Bilodeau entered this week ranking No. 12 in scoring in the Big Ten Conference (17.6 ppg).
- Bilodeau has scored in double figures in 27 of 31 games played, totaling 20 points or more in 10 games.
- Bilodeau has totaled 993 points in two seasons at UCLA, averaging 15.5 points in 66 games in the Bruins' uniform.
- Skyy Clark and Eric Dailey Jr. have each reached the 1,000 career point benchmark in the past month.
- Donovan Dent has totaled 83 assists and six turnovers in UCLA's last nine games.
- UCLA has posted a 20-3 record when leading at halftime and has gone 21-1 when building a lead of 10 or more points.
- UCLA ranked No. 1 in the Big Ten among all 18 teams, in 3-point percentage through Tuesday, March 17 (38.2%).
- The Bruins have not shot 37.0% or better (from three) since the 2020-21 season (37.2 percent from three, that year).
- The Bruins are currently shooting 76.6 percent at the free throw stripe, ranking sixth in the Big Ten.
- The school single-season record for best free throw percentage is 75.6 percent, back in the 1978-79 season.

LEADING SCORER

Senior forward Tyler Bilodeau ranked No. 12 in scoring among all Big Ten players (17.6 ppg) and No. 4 in shooting percentage (51.8%), through Tuesday, March 17. The 6-foot-9 product from Kennewick, Wash., has scored at least 15 points this season in 21 of the Bruins' 35 games (he did not play in three games). Through Tuesday, March 17, he continued to lead the Big Ten in 3-point shooting percentage, having made 64 of 138 long-range attempts (46.4%). Bilodeau was honored as a first-team NABC All-Pacific District on Tuesday (March 17) along with teammate Donovan Dent.

LEADING REBOUNDER

Junior forward Eric Dailey Jr. (11.6 ppg, 5.8 rpg) enters the weekend as UCLA's leading rebounder. He has totaled four double-doubles, including a pair of double-doubles last week in a win over Michigan State (14 points, 10 rebounds and four steals) and a semifinal loss to Purdue (11 points, 10 rebounds). Now in his second season at UCLA, Dailey Jr. has averaged 11.5 points in 67 career games with the Bruins. Dailey Jr. scored a season-high 20 points in UCLA's 75-71 win over No. 10-seed UCF on Friday night, knocking down 8 of 17 shots and going 2-for-6 from 3-point range.

SOPHOMORE JUMP

Sophomore Trent Perry scored a career-best 30 points in UCLA's 71-60 win at Penn State on Jan. 14. Perry was perfect at the free throw line (12-for-12). Entering this Sunday night's game, he has averaged 12.8 points and 3.0 rebounds per game (34 contests) while shooting 44.1 percent from the field and 39.8 percent from 3-point range. He has scored at least 10 points in 23 games for UCLA, logging 96 assists and 45 turnovers for an assist-turnover ratio of 2.1-to-1. Over the Bruins' last 15 contests, Perry has averaged 14.3 points and 3.5 rebounds while shooting 40 percent from 3-point range.

RUNNING THE POINT

Senior Donovan Dent has averaged 13.4 points, 7.5 assists and 2.9 rebounds in 34 games. Dent, a 6-foot-2 guard from nearby Riverside, Calif., transferred from New Mexico to UCLA in the offseason. He has recorded nine point-assist double-doubles this season (totaling 16 in his career). Since assists were routinely tracked, starting in 1978-79, Dent has become the first UCLA player with three consecutive point-assist double-doubles (UCLA's games versus Indiana, Rutgers and Washington). He ranks No. 3 in the Big Ten in assists per game (7.5) and was fourth, nationally, through Friday, March 20.

NOTES ON PAULEY PAVILION

This marked UCLA's 60th season playing inside Pauley Pavilion and the 14th season since the arena underwent a major renovation. The Bruins went 17-1 at home this season and 15-2 last year (32-3 record through two seasons). The first game in Pauley Pavilion took place on Dec. 3, 1965, as No. 1-ranked UCLA defeated Ohio State, 92-66. UCLA spent 47 seasons in the historic arena before the venue was closed for an 18-month renovation (closed in March of 2011 and under construction until November 2012). UCLA hosted 18 home games in 2011-12 at the Los Angeles Sports Arena (14 games) near downtown L.A. and at the Honda Center in Anaheim (four games) before returning home in November of 2012. **Since taking over as UCLA's head coach prior to the 2019-20 campaign, Mick Cronin has guided UCLA to a 96-16 home record (logging a win percentage of 85.7 in 112 home contests).**

ELITE SHOOTING PERCENTAGES

Xavier Booker became UCLA's first player to shoot at least 10-for-11 (min. 11 attempts) or better in the team's 98-66 win over Rutgers on Tuesday, Feb. 3., since T.J. Cummings shot 11-for-12 at the Maui Invitational in a win over South Carolina (Nov. 21, 2001). Below is a list which shows several of the Bruins' top field goal percentage performances over the past 20-plus basketball seasons (min. 10 made shots).
