Quick Hits---

- » The UConn Huskies are on the road to take on New England rival Boston College on Saturday afternoon at Alumni Stadium. Kick-off is scheduled for 12 noon on the ACC Network
- » This will be the 16th match-up between the Huskies and Eagles on the gridiron and first at Alumni Stadium since the 2016 season. UConn ended a 15-game winless streak against BC last season by beating the Eagles at home, 13-3. Saturday's game also marks UConn's third game against an ACC opponent this season, having lost at home to NC State and Duke earlier on the year.
- » The Huskies got a road win at Rice, 38-31, before their bye week on October 7 but saw a 21-10 fourth quarter lead slip away last week against USF at home. The Bulls scored twice in the final 10 minutes with running back Nay'Quan Wright capping the comeback with his second TD of the day with 4:02 left.
- » UConn sophomore running back Cam Edwards had a career-best 149 yards rushing to lead a UConn rushing attack that totalled 193 yards in the loss. Edwards carried the football 22 times on his way to his first ever 100-yard game. Edward ran for a 33-yard touchdown, and also caught four passes for 15 yards including a touchdown. He was the first Husky to rush for a touchdown and catch a touchdown since Arkeel Newsome did it against ECU in 2017.
- » UConn r-senior Christian Haynes was named to the Associated Press Mid-season All-American team last week. Haynes was named to the second team offense. Since the 2019 season he has started 44 straight games at guard and helps anchor an offensive line that ranks 24th in the nation this season in sacks allowed, giving up just nine in seven games (1.29 per game).
- » UConn Head Coach Mora returns for his second season leading the Huskies. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.

Last Meeting vs. Boston College

Oct. 29, 2022 - UConn 13 - BC 3 - Pratt & Whitney Stadium

The Huskies posted the program's first-ever win over Boston College, 13-3, at home ending an 0-12-2 drought against the Eagles in a series that dates back to 1908. The 13-3 win also ended an eight-game losing skid against teams from the ACC that dated back to the 2016 season (vs. Virginia - W, 13-10). It was also the first win over a Power Five school since that season as well. UConn linebacker Jackson Mitchell turned in a dominant defensive performance, finishing the game with 12 tackles, a sack and an interception while also forcing a fumble and recovering a fumble to lead a UConn defense that held BC to just three points and 76 yards rushing. The Huskies posted five sacks and turned the Eagles over five times in the win. Freshman quarterback Zion Turner hit classmate Justin Joly on a 62-yard catch and run for the game's only touchdown and a pair of Noe Ruelas field goals wrapped the UConn scoring. With the Huskies up 10-3 in the fourth, Mitchell and the UConn defense took over and sealed the win. Mitchell forced a fumble to set the Huskies up for a 43-yard Ruelas field goal with 6:26 left. On BC's next drive, Mitchell picked-off quarterback Emmett Morehead to halt an Eagle drive at the UConn 28. The Huskies were forced to punt on the next drive, but Mitchell came up big again, recovering a fumble by Zay Flowers with 4:06 left to put the stamp on a dominant defensive day.

Scouting the Eagles...

The Boston College Eagles come into Saturday's game having won three-straight and fresh off a 38-23 win at Georgia Tech last weekend. Offensively, the Eagles have one of the top rushing attacks in the nation, averaging 211.3 yards per game to rank 13th among national leaders. Sophomore Thomas Castellanos leads the way with 628 yards on 111 carries, 28th nationally in yards. He is averaging 5.7 yards per carry and has scored nine touchdowns on the ground, ranked eighth in the nation. Through the air, Castellanos has thrown for 1398 yards and 10 touchdowns. He ranks 26th nationally in total offense per game, averaging 289.4 yards, and 17th in points responsible per game at 16.3. On defense, grad student linebacker Vinny DePalma leads the team with 53 tackles on the year. Defensive back Elijah Jones has a team best three interceptions.

UConn vs. The ACC...

The Huskies are 7-24 all-time against the ACC. UConn is 0-2 against the conference this season, falling to NC State in the opener 24-14, and at home to nationally ranked Duke, 41-7. The Huskies went 1-2 against the league last season, earning a 13-3 win at home over Boston College but falling at home to Syracuse, 48-14, and on the road at No. 12 ranked NC State, 41-10. UConn is 2-1 against Duke, 2-2 against Virginia and 1-2 against Wake Forest. The Huskies are 1-3 against Boston College since the Eagles joined the league in 2005 and 0-3 vs. Syracuse since the Orange jumped to the ACC in 2013. UConn has also faced Clemson (0-1), Georgia Tech (0-3), North Carolina (0-3) and NC State (0-4). The Huskies were 1-3 against Maryland when the Terrapins were a member of the conference through 2014. The Huskies have also faced Louisville, Miami, Pitt and Virginia Tech in their history but prior to those teams joining the ACC. The Huskies have never faced Florida State.

Head Coach Jim Mora

James L. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success,"

said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego; Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

NEWS & NOTES ---

Mitchell in the Middle... Senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell is at the top of the Huskies defensive stat sheet with a team best 70 tackles, averaging 10.0 per game to rank 16th nationally. Mitchell is coming off a 15 tackle game against USF last Saturday, his second 15 tackle effort this season (Utah State). Over his career, he has had 17 double digit tackle games. In the win at Rice, Mitchell had a 50-yard fumble return for a touchdown, his second career score.

Jackson is climbing up the UConn record book for career tackles and now has 395 stops over four seasons, moving him up to fifth on the all-time list. Next on the list in fourth all-time is Maurice Lloyd who made 412 tackles from 2001-2004.

Mitchell, a 2022 Butkus Award semifinalist, started all 13 games last fall, leading the team with 140 tackles (50 solo), 9.5 tackles for loss and 4.5 sacks. Mitchell was seventh among NCAA leaders in tackles, averaging 10.8 stops per game on the season.

Roberson Back to Leading the Offense... R-Junior Ta'Quan Roberson made his first start of the 2023 season, and first career start at home, in the loss to FIU. Roberson stepped in for injured starter Joe Fagnano in the second quarter at Georgia State. On the season, he is completing 59.4 % (104-175) of his passes for 1145 yards. He has thrown eight touchdowns against three interceptions.

Roberson has settled in over the last three games (Rice/Utah State/USF), completing 57-of-85 passes (.671) for 645 yards and five touchdowns. In leading the Huskies to a win at Rice, Roberson stretched the field for big plays, hitting on touchdown throws of 41 yards (Cam Ross) and 59 yards (Justin Joly) against the Owls.

Husky Receiving Corps... UConn's Roberson has spread the ball evenly to three targets in tight end Justin Joly and wideouts Cam Ross and Brett Buckman. Joly has 26 catches for a team-best 319 yards, also leading the team averaging 12.3 yards per catch. Joly had his best game as a Husky with seven catches for 96 yards and a touchdown at Rice.

Ross has 28 grabs totalling 317 yards and he had his first touchdown of the season in the win at Rice. Buckman, a grad transfer from Delaware, has 29 catches for 313 yards and a score. Eight different players have caught a touchdown this season.

Stafford Two-Way Threat... R-junior Jelani Stafford has been a force on the Husky defensive line and a threat in the UConn short yardage running game. Stafford has 27 tackles to lead all defensive linemen and also has 8.0 tackles for a loss, a half sack, and as well as a fumble recovery.

In the win at Rice, Stafford recovered a fumble on the Owls two-yard line and then two plays later, ran in from a yard out to get the Huskies on the board. In the win, he carried the ball twice for a pair of one-yard touchdowns. On the season, he has 11 carries (20 yards) and has scored five times, a team-high mark. He also caught a pass in the loss to Utah State.

Rosa - Edwards Running Attack.. Sophomore back Victor Rosa is the leading rusher with 78 carries and 405 yards and is averaging 5.2 yards per carry, a stat that ranks him 60th nationally. In the win at Rice, Rosa had a career-best 18 carries, finishing with 89 yards. He ripped off the longest run of the season, a 71-yard touchdown in the season opener against NC State. Rosa led the Huskies in rushing as a freshman, finishing with 636 yards on 140 carries with a team-best 11 touchdowns.

Rosa was forced out of the game in the first quarter against USF with injury and sophomore Cam Edwards answered with a career-best day running the football. Edwards finished with 149 yards on 22 carries while rushing for a score and catching one as well. In four games this season, Edwards has 273 yards on 55 carries, averaging 5.0 yards per carry.

Strong Start for Caratan... R-Junior punter George Caratan is among the top-punters in the nation this season. Caratan has punted 41 times in 2023 and is averaging 45.2 yards per kick. He has a career-long punt of 69 yards under his belt this year and has 12 punts of 50+ yards. He has pinned opponents inside the 20-yard line nine times. He ranks 25th in the NCAA in punting average.

NEWS & NOTES ---

Fagnano Out for 2023... After winning the starting quarterback battle in camp, senior Joe Fagnano made his UConn starting quarterback debut in the season opening loss to NC State. Fagnano got the Husky offense to a fast start, engineering a 12-play, 75 yard scoring drive to open the game, hitting his first three passes along the way. Fagnano finished the game 14-of-26 for 113 yards with an interception. In game two, Fagnano was 4-of-9 for 60 yards and ran nine times for 14 yards, getting sacked once against Georgia State. Fagnano was removed from the game in the second quarter due to an injury and it was announced that the senior quarterback will miss the remainder of the season after having shoulder surgery. Fagnano transferred to UConn from the University of Maine last spring and will have two years of eligibility remaining. Fagnano played three seasons for the Black Bears, playing under UConn offensive coordinate Nick Charlton who was Maine's head coach prior to his move to UConn.

Returning All-American... UConn r-senior offensive lineman Christian Haynes returns to the Husky offensive line after an All-American season in 2022. Haynes leads four returning starters on the offensive line and last season became just the third Husky in the FBS era to earn All-American honors after being named to the Sporting News and Associated Press All-American teams. Haynes helped lead an offensive line that fueled a rushing attack that averaged 191.0 yards per game and allowed just 17 sacks on the season, just 1.42 per game. In his UConn career, he has started 37-straight games over three seasons. During the 2023 preseason, Haynes has found his name listed on the 2023 Sporting News Preseason All-American Team (1st team), the 2023 Athlon Sports College Football Preseason All-America Team (2nd team offense), the 2023 Walter Camp Preseason FBS All-American team, presented by 777 (2nd team offense), and the 2023 Phil Steele Preseason All-American team (3rd team offense)

UConn and Duke Announce Four Future Games... The UConn football program has entered into an agreement to play four future games against Duke University. The Huskies will host the Blue Devils at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field on November 8, 2025 and September 29, 2029 and will make the trip to Duke on November 7, 2026 and August 31, 2030. UConn and Duke met earlier this season, a 41-7 win by the Blue Devils in East Hartford. The Huskies own a 2-1 edge in the all-time series between the two schools, with wins coming in the 2004 and 2007 seasons.

Huskies Announce Series with Pitt... UConn announced an agreement to play two games against the University of Pittsburgh during the 2027 and 2028 seasons this week. The Huskies will make the trip to Pittsburgh on October 30, 2027 and then host the Panthers on November 4, 2028. UConn and Pitt last met on the field during the 2012 season and the Huskies own a 5-4 edge in the all-time series between the two schools. All nine previous meetings took place during both schools time in the BIG EAST (2004-2012).

Third Year as an FBS Independent... The 2023 campaign will mark the third season the Huskies will compete as an independent. UConn has three match-ups with teams from the ACC this season (NC State, Duke, BC). The Huskies will take on a pair of teams from the Sun Belt (Georgia State, JMU) and their former conference, the AAC (Rice, USF). The schedule also features single match-ups against teams from the SEC (Tennessee), the Mountain West (Utah State), Conference USA (FIU) and the NEC from FCS (Sacred Heart). In addition, UConn will have first-ever meetings this season against Georgia State, Rice and Sacred Heart.

The Stadium: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 20th season of play at their off-campus home in 2023. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 69-58 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

20 Seasons at The Rent... The 2023 season marks the 20th season of UConn football at Pratt & Whitney Stadium. Each week, we will look back on a key game or moment in the history of UConn football at the East Hartford stadium. **This week's highlight:** **Nov. 21, 2015** – UConn beats No. 13 Houston 20-17 to earn bowl eligibility. Noel Thomas had two touchdown receptions and seven receptions total. UConn stopped UH on a fourth and nine with two minutes to go and CB Jamar Summers had an interception with 55 seconds left to seal the win.

NC State quarterback Brennan Armstrong threw for 155 yards and ran for 96 and a pair of touchdowns as the Wolfpack came to Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field and dealt the UConn Huskies a 24-14 loss in the 2023 season opener for both teams.

Thursday night's home opener for the Huskies was played in front of 36,526 fans, the biggest opening night at The Rent since the 2010 opener against Texas Southern which had 37,359. It was the largest home crowd since the Huskies 2013 match-up with Michigan which drew 42,704.

The Huskies (0-1) got the night off with a bang, after taking the opening kickoff then marching 75 yards in 12 plays for the season's opening score and a 7-0 lead thanks to an 18-yard scamper to the right corner of the endzone by sophomore running back Victor Rosa (Bristol, Conn.). Newly named starting quarterback Joe Fagnano (Williamsport, Pa.) hit on his first three passes of the night and picked-up a key third down conversion on the drive.

NC State (1-0) answered right back, needing nine plays to cover 66 yards on the ensuing drive with Armstrong capping it off with a four-yard run off tackle for six to knot it at 7-7. The Wolfpack defense put UConn in check the rest of the first half, limiting the Huskies to just 45 yards of offense and took a 10-7 lead into the locker room.

The Wolfpack used an 11-play drive that covered 91 yards and 6:27 in the third quarter to extend their lead to 17-7 as Delbert Mimms plunged in from a yard out.

The UConn offense sparked to life on the ensuing drive with Rosa blazing his way on the first play up the left sidelines for a 71-yard touchdown, the longest score of the young back's career. Rosa was flagged for unsportsmanlike conduct for flipping into the endzone, forcing the Huskies to kick off from their own 20. Julian Gray had a 40-yard return and an unnecessary roughness call on UConn tacked on 15 more yard to set up NC State at the UConn 27-yard line.

Armstrong need just four plays to extend the lead, running in from eight-yards out for his second score on the night and a 24-10 lead with 34 seconds left in the third.

The UConn defense got a fourth down stop at midfield early in the fourth quarter but couldn't capitalize and a late eight-play drive was cut short as Fagnano was intercepted with 2:20 left to seal the win for NC State.

NC State finished with 209 yards on the ground led by Armstrong's 96 on 19 carries. The Wolfpack held the ball for 34:00 minutes on Thursday night and defensively held UConn to 273 yards of offense and just 4-of-12 on the third down.

Rosa ran for 99 yards on nine carries and a pair of scores. Fagnano completed 14-of-26 for 113 yards and was sacked twice in the loss.

Defensively, senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, Conn.) finished with 15 total tackles, 1.5 for a loss. Junior safety Durante Jones (Atlanta, Ga.) matched his career-high with 14 tackles, 10 solo.

Georgia State quarterback Darren Grainger ran for 142 yards and a score and threw for 144 and a touchdown to lead the Panthers to a 35-14 win over the visiting UConn Huskies at Center Pac Stadium in front of 15,186 fans.

The Panthers ran for 250 yards on the night led by Grainger and running back Marcus Carroll who had 107 rushing with three touchdowns.

After trading punts on the game's first two possessions, the Panthers struck for the game's first points as Grainger took the snap in shotgun and burst right through the middle of the Husky defense, going 65 yards untouched for a 7-0 lead at 8:40.

UConn's first chance at points came McFadden missed 48-yard field goal, wide left, with five seconds left in the first after the Huskies got a GSU turnover on the Panther's 47-yard line.

Georgia State got on the board twice in the second quarter, their first being set up by a muffed punt return on the UConn 46-yard line. Grainger need six plays to put his team up 14-0, hitting Robert Lewis at the right front pylon for a nine-yard score at 5:22. The Panthers closed out the half with a nine-play drive that covered 63 yards with Marcus Carroll scoring from two-yards out for a 21-0 lead into the locker room.

UConn starting quarterback Joe Fagnano (Williamsport, Pa.) was forced out of the game late in the second quarter with an injury and the Huskies would go to r-junior back-up Ta'Quan Roberson (Orange, NJ) the rest of the way. The Huskies struggled on offense in the first half and were outgained 247 to 88 in total yards. UConn ran it 22 times in the first 30 minutes but managed just 25 yards.

Out of the half, the Panthers forced a UConn punt on the opening possession, then Grainger engineered a 15-play drive that covered 92 yards and was capped by Carroll who scored his second of the night on a three-yard plunge to make it 28-0.

The Huskies put an end to their scoring drought with 9:16 left in the fourth quarter as Roberson hit Kevens Clercius (Montreal, Quebec) in the back of the endzone from 11-yards out for his first TD pass at UConn.

Carroll scored his third on the night with 6:26 to play, bursting through the middle for a 39-yard score, pushing him over the 100-yard mark for the night.

Roberson led a second UConn scoring drive, covering 80-yards in eight plays capped by a diving catch in the endzone by Brett Buckman (Park Ridge, NJ) for a 32-yard scored, cutting it to 35-14 with 3:57 left.

UConn finished with just 50 yards on the ground on 31 rushes on the night. Roberson finished 19-of-30 for 216 yards and a pair of touchdowns with an interception in the loss. Buckman caught nine balls for 93 yards and his first TD as a Husky.

Defensively, Noah Plack (Bridgeville, PA) posted 13 tackles, two for a loss. Linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) made seven stops and had a half a sack.

UConn junior running back Devontae Houston ran for 126 yards on 19 carries, but FIU freshman quarterback Keyone Jenkins threw for 284 yards and pair of scores to lead the Panthers past the Huskies, 24-17, in front of 20,405 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (0-3) fell behind 24-3 at the half but defensively held FIU (3-1) scoreless in the second half to set up a late game comeback that fell short of tying the game with under a minute to play.

For Houston, it was his third career 100-yard rushing game and his first this season. The junior running back also hauled in a catch-and-run 37-yard score out of the backfield in the fourth quarter. R-Junior Ta'Quan Roberson made his first start of the season at quarterback and finished 15-of-32 for 170 yards and a score.

The Panthers came out flying, taking the opening kick-off then going 75-yards in six plays with Jenkins capping it off on a one-yard plunge for a 7-0 lead at 12:27. The Huskies would try to answer and put together a 13-play, 71-yard drive that stalled out, settling for a Joe McFadden (Grapevine, Texas) 26-yard field goal.

FIU had a big second quarter, scoring 17 to take a commanding lead into the half. After a Chase Gabriel 27-yd field goal, Jenkins hit on a pair of big play passes for scores. The freshman signal caller found Jalen Bracey for a 45-yard score and then hooked-up for a 64-yard pitch-and-catch to Kris Mitchell up the left sidelines with just 47 seconds left in the half for a 24-3 lead.

The Huskies responded out of the break, taking the opening second half kick-off, and putting together an eight-play, 82-yard drive that was capped by r-junior defensive tackle Jelani Stafford plowing his way through the middle of the defense for a one-yard touchdown his first career carry and touchdown.

Houston's 37-yard touchdown catch with 14:04 left in the fourth quarter pulled the Huskies within 24-17. The UConn defense kept FIU in check and gave the offense the ball back with 2:41 left on FIU 48-yard line with a chance to pull even. Roberson took the team to the FIU 11-yard line but a holding penalty put the Huskies in a 4th and 14. Roberson's pass to Cam Ross (Newark, Del.) fell two yards short, ending the game.

On defense, Pryce Yates finished with six tackles, 3.5 for a loss, and a sack.

The No. 18 nationally ranked Duke Blue Devils turned in a strong defensive performance as they remained unbeaten on the season thanks to a 41-7 win over the UConn Huskies in front of 29,033 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (0-4) were shut out for three quarters and finished with 203 yards of total offense including just 89 yards rushing. The Duke (4-0) defense added a score in the win as defensive lineman DeWayne Carter returned a fumble 26 yards for a touchdown in the third quarter.

Duke's Jordan Waters ran the ball just seven times for 18 yards but had a pair of touchdowns in the win, including a first quarter one-yard plunge for a 7-0 lead. The Blue Devils shut the Huskies down offensively in the first half, holding UConn to just 32 total yards and four first downs into the half. Duke put up 20 points in the second quarter with sophomore placekicker Todd Pelino opening the second with a 50-yard field goal and closing it with a 40-yarder to make it 27-0 at the break.

Carter made it 34-0 at 7:13 in the third, scooping up a Jalen Mitchell (Rockledge, Fla.) fumble and rumbling in from 26-yards out. Junior quarterback Riley Leonard finished out the Duke scoring with 3:01 left in the third as he hooked up with Jordan Moore for a 22-yard score to make it 41-0.

Riley finished 23-of-34 for 248 yards and a touchdown and finished as Duke's leading rusher with four carries for 30 yards and a touchdown in the win. Riley found Moore for eight catches and 86 yards and hit Jalon Calhoun six time for 76 yards.

UConn ended the shutout bid late in the fourth quarter as r-junior quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson (Orange, N.J.) capped off a 10-play, 83-yard drive with a two-yard score, producing the 41-7 final. Roberson was 13-of-28 for 114 yards and was sacked twice.

Sophomore Victor Rosa (Bristol, Conn.) carried the ball 14 times for 68 yards in the loss. Classmate Cam Edwards (Norwalk, Conn.) had a career-high 12 carries for 43 yards.

Defensively, the Huskies lost leading tackler senior Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, Conn.) early in the first quarter when he was called for targeting on Duke's second drive of the game.

UConn falls to 3-11 against nationally ranked opponents at Rentschler Field all-time. The Huskies are also 0-2 against teams from the ACC this season with a match-up at Boston College scheduled for October.

UConn r-junior Jelani Stafford plunged into the end zone from a yard out with 40 seconds remaining, but Utah State's Ike Larson came up with a block on the game-tying extra point attempt to deliver the Aggies a 34-33 win in front of 21,227 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentscher Field.

The Huskies (0-5) had their best offensive outing of the season, totaling 473 yards of offense with 218 coming on the ground and 255 through the air. UConn built a 17-0 lead late in to the first half and were dominating with 254 total yards to 22 for Utah State while holding the ball for 24:06. The Huskies looked headed to the locker room pitching a shutout, but the Aggies had other ideas, striking for a 63-yard score on a McCae Hillstead to Colby Bowman pitch-and-catch up the middle of the field to make it 17-7 at the break.

The Aggies (2-3) touchdown right before the half ignited their offense who scored on six-straight drives into the fourth quarter. Hillstead was forced to leave the game on the first possession of the second half and back-up quarterback senior Cooper Legas came in and finished 11-of-13 for 204 yards and three touchdowns to lead the way to a win. Junior wideout Jalen Royals, who had two catches for seven yards in the first half, was Legas go-to man in the second half as the duo hooked-up five times for 176 yards and three scores. He finished with seven catches on seven targets for 185 yards and touchdowns.

Royals caught his first touchdown to on the first drive of the third quarter, pulling the Aggies within 17-14. After a Utah State field goal tied the game at 17-17 at 6:56, Royal hauled in a 71-yard pass from Legas to give the Aggies their first lead of the day, 24-17, with 3:52 left in the third.

The Huskies tied the game at 24-24 on grad student Geordon Porter first touchdown catch at UConn, capping an eight play, 88-yard drive at 14:17 of the fourth. Legas to Royals struck again on the next drive, hooking-up on a 52-yard score to put Utah back in front, 31-24. The two teams traded field goals on their next possessions and the Husky defense held late to get the ball back with 2:41 left, down 34-27.

R-Junior quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson put together a nine-play drive to drive the Huskies down to the Utah State one-yard line, hitting r-junior Cam Ross (Newark, Del.) three times including a 35-yard strike to open the drive. A 25-yard pass up the left sideline to grad student Brett Buckman set up a first and goal at the two-yard line. After getting denied on first down, the Huskies went back to Stafford who barreled in for his second score of the day to pull the game withing 34-33. UConn elected to kick the extra point for the tie but Larsen broke through off the right end and denied the Huskies overtime by blocking the Joe McMadden attempt.

Roberson would finish the day 22-of-32 for 255 yards, two touchdowns and an interception. Ross caught seven passes for 70 yards while tight end Nick Harris (Marriottsville, Md.) caught his first career touchdown. Leading the UConn running game was sophomores Victor Rosa with 92 yards on 15 carries and Cam Edwards who totaled a career-high 73 yards on 13 touches. Stafford carried the ball five times for 11 yards and two scores in short yardage, while also catching his first career pass for 10 yards.

On defense, UConn's Jackson Mitchell made a season-high 15 tackles in the loss and grabbed an interception. R-junior Chris Shearin also had his first interception of the season. The Huskies turned both turnovers into touchdowns.

UConn r-junior quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson threw for 215 yards and a pair of touchdowns and the defense forced four turnovers as the Huskies went on the road and earned their first win of the 2023 campaign, beating Rice, 38-31, at Rice Stadium in front of 21,207.

UConn (1-5) fell behind 14-0 in the first quarter but scored 28 unanswered points into the third to take a lead they would never relinquish. Senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell had a fumble return for a 50-yard touchdown and r-junior Jelani Stafford scored twice from the one-yard line for the Huskies who scored their most points (38) since a 2019 win at UMass, 56-35.

Rice (3-3) quarterback JT Daniels threw for 362 yards and two touchdowns while Luke McCaffrey caught seven for 100 yards and both of his scores.

The Huskies forced a three-and-out one the game's first possession and got great field position on the Rice 42 but missed a chance for the game's first points when a Joe McMadden field goal missed its mark. Rice responded with a six-play drive and running back Juma Otoviano scoring on a 24-yard run through the middle for a 7-0 lead at 6:53.

Rice went up 14-0 on their next drive as Otoviano scored for the second time, capping an eight-play drive that covered 78-yards on a run from seven yards out. The UConn defense switched the momentum, creating a turnover on Rice's next drive to set up a first and goal. R-sophomore Pryce Yates got a strip-sack of Daniels at the Rice six-yard line and Stafford covered up at the two-yard line. Two plays later, the Husky defensive lineman plunged in from a yard out for his fourth score of the season. The extra point attempt was block, leaving the Huskies trailing 14-6 with 10:49 left in the half.

The UConn defense came up with another big play after a big kick return by Rice. A backward pass from Daniels to wideout Braylen Walker fell short and UConn's Mitchell was there to scoop the loose ball and return it 50-yards for his second career touchdown to make it 14-13 with 9:54 left. The Huskies would make it 20 unanswered points on their next possession as Roberson hit a streaking Cam Ross on a 41-yard pitch-and-catch in the endzone to make it 20-14 at the 3:48 mark. That's where it would stay after Rice's Tim Horn missed a field goal just before the half.

The Huskies rolled out of the locker room and took the opening second half kick-off for a seven-play drive where short-yardage specialist Stafford got his second of the day from a yard out followed by a Roberson to Justin Joly two-point try to push the UConn lead to 28-17 to start the third. Rice ended the Huskies 28-point run on the ensuing possession as Daniels put together a 14-play drive that covered 80 yards and was topped off by finding Luke McCaffrey on a third and goal from the four to pull withing 28-21 with 7:45 left in the quarter.

The fourth quarter started with UConn extending the lead to 31-21 on a McMadden 47-yard field goal, matching his career long set in 2021 against Mid Tennessee at home. Rice answered with a Daniels to McCaffrey 30-yard hook-up to pull within 31-28 with just under seven to play. The Huskies would quickly respond and Roberson hit for another big play, finding his tight end Joly for a 59-yard touchdown that helped seal away the win. After a late Horn 23-yard field goal, Joly would recover the onside kick with 40 seconds left to seal the win.

The sophomore tight end finished with seven catches for 96 yards in the win. Sophomore. Victor Rosa rushed for 89 yards on 18 carries to pace the ground game.

The South Florida Bulls scored twice in the final 10 minutes of the fourth quarter to erase a 21-10 UConn lead and come away with a 24-21 win over the Huskies in front of 21,704 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. USF running back Nay'Quan Wright scored twice, his second coming with 4:02 left to provide the winning score.

Wright piled up 186 yards rushing on 26 carries while the Bulls finished with 260 yards on the ground. Quarterback Byrum Brown ran for 61 yards and a touchdown and completed 27-of-39 for 203 yards in the win.

The Huskies ran for 193 yards on the ground and were led by sophomore Cam Edwards who had his first career 100-yard rushing game, totaling 149 on 22 carries. Edwards ran for a score and then caught four passes for 15 yards including a touchdown.

UConn got off to a slow start as a fumble on their second play from scrimmage gave the Bulls the ball on the eight-yard line and just two plays later Wright ran in from a yard out for a 7-0 lead. UConn lost starting back Victor Rosa on the first series to injury and Edwards stepped in to carry the load. The Huskies tied the game up early in the second quarter after quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson led an eight-play drive over 84 yards, running it around the right side, beating a linebacker and scoring from 24 yards out.

South Florida's final points of the first half came on a John Cannon 45-yard field goal with 6:48 left to go up 10-7. The Huskies answered on the ensuing possession as Edwards ripped off a 39-yard run on the drive and Roberson ended with find the running back in the back of the end zone for a 14-10 lead with 3:40 left in the half.

Defensively, the Huskies kept the Bulls off the scoreboard for the entire third quarter and came up with an interception. UConn cashed in early in the fourth as Edwards made it 21-10 off 33-yard run off right tackle that found the end zone at 12:45.

The USF offense reignited on their next possession as Brown led them down the field 75 yards in nine plays, capping it off with a six-yard TD run up the middle to pull within 21-17 with 9:51 left. The Bulls forced a UConn punt and took the ball back at their own 10-yard line. Brown again led the Bulls down the field, helped by a 47-yard run by Wright to set up a first and goal. The grad student plowed in from four yards out with 4:02 left to give his team the lead for good, 24-21.

Roberson and the Huskies had a chance to answer but on a third and six scramble, linebacker Mac Harris forced a fumble on the quarterback and corner Daquan Evans recovered at midfield. UConn was able to use their timeouts and force one last punt, getting the ball back with nine seconds left at their own 28-yard line but a trick play on the final snap resulted in a fumbled lateral attempt ending the game.

UConn's Roberson finished 19-of-34 for 175 yards with a touchdown and an interception. Senior Jackson Mitchell made 15 tackles, nine solo, with a tackle for loss and a half sack. R-junior Malik Dixon-Williams had a season-high 10 tackles and forced a fumble.
