QUICK HITS---

- » The UConn Huskies return to action off a bye week to travel up to Syracuse University to face the Orange at the JMA Wireless Dome on Saturday afternoon. Kick-off is slated for 12 noon on the ACC Network.
- » Saturday's match-up is the 13th in the all-time series between the Orange and the Huskies. The series is tied at 6-6 with Syracuse winning the last four meetings. UConn won six of the first eight meetings including a stretch of five-straight. UConn is 2-4 at Syracuse with the last win coming in 2010 (23-6). The Huskies are 0-2 against teams from the ACC this season with a loss at Duke and a home loss to Wake Forest. UConn's last win against the ACC came over Boston College in the 2022 season.
- » Prior to the bye week, the Huskies went on the road for the first time since September 14 and came away with a 31-23 comeback win at UAB. UConn found themselves down 20-3 at the half and outscored the Blazers 28-3 in the second half including 21 fourth quarter points. The 17-point comeback tied the biggest comeback in school history, matching a 2003 win over Western Michigan where the Huskies trailed 17-0 in the second quarter only to go on and win 41-27.
- » The Huskies earned their seventh win of the season with the victory at UAB and improved to 7-3 on the season, guaranteeing the program's first winning season since the 2010 campaign. Seven wins is also the most since the 2010 season when UConn finished 8-5. It is also marks the fastest to seven wins since the 2008 season. If the Huskies can grab win number eight, it would tie for the fourth most wins in program history, accomplished 10 times. During the program's FBS era (2002), UConn has won eight games six times and nine games twice.
- » UConn Head Coach Mora is in his third season leading the Huskies and has the team bowl eligible for the second time during his tenure. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- » THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 21st season of play at their off-campus home in 2024. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 77-58 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Last Meeting vs. Syracuse...

Sept. 10, 2022 -- Syracuse 48 - UConn 14 -- East Hartford, CT
Syracuse junior quarterback Garrett Shrader threw for 287 yards and three touchdowns and ran two more in to lead the Orange past the UConn Huskies, 48-14, at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Syracuse signal caller finished the night completing 20-of-23 passes with touchdown throws of 47, 18 and 39 yards in the win. SU running back Sean Tucker carried it 27 times for 112 yards and a score. UConn was held to 187 of total offense in the loss, just 92 through the air and 10 first downs. Sophomore running back Nathan Carter led the Huskies with 71 yards rushing on 16 carries. Freshman quarterback Zion Turner completed 14-of-17 throws for 92 yards and a score, a 56-yard hook-up with sophomore Aaron Turner in the third quarter, his first career touchdown catch. Syracuse scored on all five of their possessions in the first half, held the ball for 20:05 and outgained the Huskies 309-105 in building a 27-7 lead at the half. Syracuse finished with 465 total yards of offense and 29 first downs.

Scouting the Orange...

The Syracuse Orange come into Saturday's game at 7-3 and fresh off a trip to the west coast where they came away with a 33-25 win at Cal last weekend. The Orange are 4-1 at home in the JMA Wireless Dome this season as they play their final two games of the season on their home turf. The Syracuse offense boasts the third-best passing attack in the nation led by quarterback Kyle McCord. The Orange average 350.7 yards while averaging 31.8 points per game. Offensively, the Orange hold the ball an average of 33:49 per game, fourth in the country. McCord is ranked second in passing yards (3,476), passing yards per game (347.8) and seventh in passing TDs (24). Trebor Pena leads the receiving corps with 71 catches for 736 yards and five scores. He is averaging 10.4 yards per catch. Defensively, linebacker Justin Barron is the team's top-tackler with 75 stops, 7.0 for a loss including 2.0 sacks. Defensive lineman Fadil Diggs leads the team with 5.5 sacks on the year.

UConn vs. the ACC...

The Huskies are 7-27 all-time against the ACC. UConn has three games against teams from the conference this season with losses at Duke and at home to Wake Forest. The Huskies went 0-3 against the league last season with home loses to NC State and Duke and a loss at Boston College. Their last win against the conference came in 2022, a home win over BC. UConn is 2-2 against Duke, 2-2 against Virginia and 1-3 against Wake Forrester. The Huskies are 1-4 against Boston College since the Eagles joined the league in 2005 and 0-3 vs. Syracuse since the Orange jumped to the ACC in 2013. UConn has also faced Clemson (0-1), Georgia Tech (0-3), North Carolina (0-3) and NC State (0-4). The Huskies were 1-3 against Maryland when the Terrapins were a member of the conference through 2014. The Huskies have also faced Louisville, Miami, Pitt, SMU and Virginia Tech in their history but prior to those teams joining the ACC. The Huskies have never faced Cal, Florida State or Stanford.

Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora will begin his third season on the UConn sidelines in 2024. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first two-time All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian

Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success," said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics, upon Mora's hiring. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego; Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

NEWS & NOTES ---

Offensive Notes from UAB... The Huskies outscored UAB 28-3 in the second half to complete a 17-point comeback for the win. UConn scored 21 fourth quarter points, their highest offensive output in the fourth since scoring 21 in the win over Florida Atlantic...Quarterback Joe Fagnano came in for injured started Nick Evers in the second half and completed five passes but two went for touchdowns in the fourth quarter. Fagnano hit Shamar Porter on a fourth-and-goal try for a six-yard score, pulling UConn within 23-17 with 8:45 left. After a UAB turnover on the next series, Fagnano threw a 21-yard scoring strike to Jasaiah Gathings just 17 seconds later to give the Huskies their first lead of the game and one they wouldn't relinquish...Running back Cam Edwards ran for a team-high 82 yards on 11 carries including a 48-yard fourth quarter touchdown run that put UConn up 31-23 with 2:39 left. It was the longest run of Edwards career. He has five rushing touchdowns this season, six overall...Fellow back Durrell Robinson had 59 yards rushing and his team leading seventh touchdown of the season...UConn converted seven-of-15 on third down (46.7), their second best percentage this season and best since converting 50.0 percent (5-10) against FAU.

Defensive Notes from UAB... For the second-straight week, UConn won the turnover battle, getting a pair of fumble recoveries and a pair of interceptions. The Huskies turned two fourth quarter UAB turnovers in to 14 points to fuel their comeback win. UConn held the Blazers to just three second half points as well, including a scoreless fourth quarter where they forced a pair of turnover on downs...Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown made six tackles and had a career-high 2.5 sacks in the win...Fellow linebacker Jayden McDonald turned in 12 tackles, eight solo, to mark his fourth game this season with double digit tackles...Senior safety Malik Dixon-Williams turned in seven tackles and got his team-leading third interception. It was his second-straight game with a pick and third in the last five games. He now has six career interceptions...R-freshman corner Cam Chadwick also got an interception in the win, his second of the season. He added a career-best six tackles to his game totals.

Special Teams Notes from UAB... Place kicker Chris Freeman made one-of-two field goal attempts in the win, converting on a first quarter 26-yarder. It was Freeman's 15th make of the season, the most field goals in a season by a UConn kicker since the 2015 campaign when Bobby Puyol made 16 of 18. He raised his total to 83 points on the season to continue leading the team. All six of Freeman's kick-offs went for touchbacks, raising his total to 39 on the season...Punter Conor Stutz punted five times in the win, averaging 48.6 yards per punt with a long of 51 yards, giving him 12 punts this season of 50-plus yards.

Another Match-Up with the Orange... The UConn and Syracuse football programs have amended their previous agreement to add an additional game during the 2028 season it was announced last week. The two schools have agree to add a game during the 2028 season with the Huskies heading up to Syracuse on November 11, 2028. UConn and Syracuse will face-off this Saturday and are scheduled to meet again at Syracuse next season on September 6, 2025. UConn is scheduled to host the Orange at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field on October 3, 2026 and November 6, 2027.

Lundt Earns His Reese's Senior Bowl Invite... UConn offensive tackle Chase Lundt has received an invitation to participate in this year's Reese's Senior Bowl on February, 1 in Mobile, Alabama. Lundt is the 18th Husky in program history to earn an invite to the prestigious all-star game. Last season, UConn offensive lineman Christian Haynes and defense end Eric Watts participated. Lundt, who was named to the preseason watch lists for both the Senior Bowl and the East-West Shrine Bowl, has been a fixture on the UConn offensive line during all four of his seasons in Storrs. He has made 46 starts, missing just one game during his Husky career. The UConn line has put together another strong season in 2024, helping lead a rushing attack that ranks 23rd in the nation in yards per game at 200.3 yards per game. In the passing game, the Huskies protect the quarterback to the tune of allowing just 1.10 sacks per game, ranked 17th among the nation's leaders.

The Reese's Senior Bowl is widely regarded as the preeminent college football all-star game and the first stage in the NFL Draft process. The longest continual-running all-star game has taken place in Mobile, Alabama the past 75 years. More than 900 NFL personnel, including key decision-makers from all 32 teams, and over 1100 media members from around the country were credentialed this year. This past April, the game produced 110 total picks, representing 43 percent of the entire NFL draft.

Home Cooking... The Huskies closed out a six-game home stretch beating Georgia State to finish 6-1 at home at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field this season. Their 6-1 mark is the team's most home wins since a 6-0 2010 campaign. Since playing at The Rent in 2003, this is the ninth time the Huskies have played seven home games. UConn was 7-0 in 2007 and 6-1 in 2004 and 2024. The UConn offense dominated in their seven home games, scoring 258 points, the most in their history in the stadium, while averaging 36.9 ppg, second only to the 2010 season when they averaged 38.5 ppg in six games.

Defensive Turnaround... The UConn defensive unit, under first year defensive coordinator Matt Brock, has improved over last year's performance in just about every major category heading into the final week's of the regular season. The Huskies are allowing 21.3 points per game, down from 29.8 per game last fall. UConn's defense has been among the best on third down this season, ranking ninth nationally at .297 percent. In 2023, that number stood at .429 percent. The UConn run defense

is allowing 137.2 yards per game, down from 149.7 a year ago, and against the pass, the Huskies are allowing 200.9 yards per game, down from 258.8 in 2023. UConn ranks 18th in the nation in passing efficiency defense (126.51). UConn ranks 42nd in total defense, allowing 338.1 yards per game, better than the 408.5 yards allowed last fall.

Offensive Production Trending Up... Under the direction of first year offensive coordinator Gordon Sammis, the Huskies have been equally impressive on the offensive side from a year ago. UConn is averaging 31.7 points per game, 37th nationally, up from 19.1 last season. The Huskies have scored 317 points through 10 games, marking the most points scored since the 2008 season, with two games to play. The last time a UConn offense average 30 or more points a game was in 2009 (31.2). The rushing attack is back to 2022 form (191.0) and averaging 200.3 yards per game, up from 136.6 last season. The UConn running game ranks 21st in the nation. The Huskies are averaging 402.2 yards of total offense a game, up from 326.9 last year and at pace for the most since 2017 (415.2 ypg). UConn continues to excel at protecting the quarterback, ranking 15th nationally in sacks allowed (1.10 pg).

Husky Rankings... Defensively, linebackers Tui Faumuina-Brown and Jayden McDonald rank 27th (8.7) and 43rd (8.2) in tackles per game. Safety Malik Dixon-Williams is 29th with three interceptions.... The rushing game with back Durrell Robinson ranking 79th in rush yards (645) and 84th in yards per game (64.5). Fellow back Cam Edwards is 77th averaging 5.12 yards per carry...On special teams, the Huskies are 8th in kick-off returns at 25.91 per return. Kicker Chris Freeman ranks 24th in field goals per game (1.50), 29th in total points (83), and 31st in scoring (8.3). Punter Connor Stutz is 34th with a 43.3 punting average.

Red Zone Success... The UConn offense ranks 20th in the NCAA in red zone success converting at .912 percent. The Huskies have scored on 31 of 34 trips into the red zone this season and have 20 touchdowns on their 34 trips. The Huskies last season were 25 of 32 in the red zone with 17 touchdowns, a .781 percentage.

Bell Among NCAA Leading WRs... R-Junior wideout Skyler Bell has hauled in 36 passes for 646 yards and four touchdowns and has three 100-yard games to his credit. Bell is averaging 18.5 yards per catch and 64.6 yards per game. He currently ranks 31st in the NCAA in yards per catch, 75th in receiving yards, and 71st in receiving yards per game. In the season opener, Bell hauled in five passes for 141 yards at Maryland, marking the first 100-yard game by a UConn receiver since the 2021 season when Keelan Marion had 102 yards at Vanderbilt. Against Merrimack, Bell caught two passes for 105 yards including his first UConn touchdown, and became the first UConn receiver to go over 100 yards in back-to-back games since Hergy Mayala did during the 2017 season. For Bell, he now has four career 100-yard games, his first coming in 2022 at Wisconsin when he had four catches for 108 yards and two scores against New Mexico State

Three-Headed Backfield Monster... The Huskies have been able to utilize three running backs to lead the ground game this season. R-junior Durrell Robinson leads the team with 645 yards on 93 carries, and is averaging 6.9 yards per carry. Mel Brown has 510 yards on 94 carries, averaging 5.4 yards per carry. Cam Edwards has 527 yards on 103 carries and averages 5.1 yards per rush. Robinson has seven rushing touchdowns, Edwards five with a receiving TD as well, and Brown with two. Robinson and Brown both went for 156 yards each in the win over Florida Atlantic. Brown had a second 100-yard effort with 138 yards against Georgia State. Edwards went for a 106 yards and a score at Duke.

UConn in ESPN FPI... After UConn's win over UAB, the Huskies moved up to 81st (-3.6) in the ESPN's College Football Power Index (FPI) this week. The Football Power Index (FPI) is a measure of team strength that is meant to be the best predictor of a team's performance going forward for the rest of the season. FPI represents how many points above or below average a team is. Projected results are based on 20,000 simulations of the rest of the season using FPI, results to date, and the remaining schedule. Ratings and projections update daily. FPI data from seasons prior to 2019 may not be complete.

Evers Back and Posts Career #s... Starting quarterback Nick Evers was back under center in the win over Wake Forest after injury forced him to miss his second game of the season in the Temple win. Evers returned and had a career day passing the football, completing 26 of 43 for 264 yards and

touchdown throws to Jasaiah Gathings and Louis Hansen.

Fagnano Great in Relief... Quarterback Joe Fagnano made his second start of the season in the win over Temple. Fagnano has thrown for 999 yards and 11 touchdowns this season, completing 58.2 percent (57-98) of his passes. His 11 touchdown throws ranks 42nd in the nation. His 174.7 passing efficiency is seventh and his 17.53 yards per completion ranks second. Fagnano won the starting quarterback job out of camp last season but saw his season come to an end in game two with a shoulder injury. Fagnano transferred in to UConn at the start of last season from Maine, where he was coming off a season in which he threw for 2,231 yards and 15 touchdowns. Fagnano was named to the 2024 Comeback Player of the Year watch list this preseason.

More Records Fall against Buffalo... R-Junior wide receiver Skyler Bell set a new school FBS record with three touchdown catches in the win. Grad student Chris Freeman tied the school record and UConn FBS record with four field goal makes on Saturday. The offense posted 95 points over the last two games, the most in program history in back-to-back games against FBS opponents

Record Running Day at the Rent... UConn's rushing attack ran wild in a 48-14 win over Florida Atlantic. The Huskies plowed their way to a school FBS record 421 yards, which also marked the second most rushing total in program history (437 - vs UMass, 1956). The Huskies ran the ball 66 times in the, also setting a new FBS record for rushing attempts in a game. It tied for the fourth most attempts in a game all-time.

Record Setting Day vs. Merrimack... The UConn Huskies improved to 21-2 against FCS opponents thanks to their record setting performance in a 63-17 win over Merrimack. The Huskies scored 35 points on just 16 plays in the first quarter of Saturday's win, and finished the first half with 56 points, both new FBS school records. The 63 total points tied the school FBS mark for points in a game (vs. Kent State - 2002). UConn's offense piled up 624 yards to set a new school record for total offense.

QB Fagnano Sets New Record as Well... Back-up quarterback Joe Fagnano got the starting nod against Merrimack with injured started Nick Evers out of action. Fagnano answered by leading the offense to the tune of 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws. Fagnano completed 13-of-19 passes had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win. Fagnano also ran for 38 yards and a touchdown. His five TD throws tied the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career.

Huskies Named to Joe Moore Award Mid-season Honor Roll... The Joe Moore Award for the Most Outstanding Offensive Line Unit in college football since 2015, announced the twenty-two members of its 2024 Mid-season Honor Roll with the UConn offensive line earning a spot among the programs honored. The Huskies offensive line is among a group of o-lines from Alabama, Army, Clemson, Iowa, Kansas State, Louisiana, LSU, Miami, Michigan, Navy, Ohio State, Oregon, Penn State, Rutgers, SMU, Tennessee, Texas, Texas Tech, UNLV, Western Michigan, and West Virginia to make the mid-point honor roll. The UConn offensive line, tackles Chase Lundt and Valentin Senn, guards Christopher Fortin and Ben Murawski and center Wes Hoeh, are coached by offensive coordinator Gordon Sammis, in his third season with the program.

UConn r-junior wide out Skyler Bell hauled in five passes for a career-high 141 yards in his first game for the Huskies. R-Senior receiver TJ Sheffield caught two passes for 32 yards and UConn's only touchdown in the loss.

The Huskies (0-1) were held to just 88 yards rushing and 11 first downs on Saturday while Maryland ran for 248 yards and threw for 381 to kick-off the season.

The Terps (1-0) running game was led by backs Roman Hemby and Nolan Ray led the rushing attack with 126 yards combined and two scores. Edwards finished the day 20-of-27 while his back-up Cameron Edge came in and went five-of-six for 57 yards and a score.

Maryland came out of the gates with a touchdown on their first two drives of the afternoon. The Terps took the opening kick-off and needed eight plays to cover 75 yards with Edwards Jr. finding Tai Felton for an 18-yard score. After a deep punt put the Terps back on their eight-yard line, the offense made it 14-0 seven plays later as Ray broke free for a 48-yard scoring run. Maryland's offense rang up 131 yards rushing in the first quarter.

UConn's defense held Maryland to three field goals the rest of the first half as the Terps went to the locker room up 23-0. Maryland made it 30-0 on their first possession of the second half as Hemby scored from four yards out to cap a 78-yard drive for his only score.

R-Freshman quarterback Nick Evers made his first collegiate start and finished six-of-17 for 73 yards with an interception before being forced from the game in the third quarter due to injury. Back-up Joe Fagnano came in and led the Huskies on their only scoring drive late in the third. Fagnano found Sheffield up the right sideline for a 27-yard hook-up and Sheffield's first touchdown as a Husky. Fagnano finished out the game 8-of-16 for 149 yards, a touchdown and an interception.

The Terps left no doubt as on their first play of the ensuing drive Edwards Jr. connected with Felton who broke free and flew up his own sideline for a 75-yard score. Felton finished the game with seven catches for 178 yards.

The UConn Huskies tied the school FBS record for points in a game in a 63-17 win over visiting Merrimack College in front of 32,351 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in the 2024 home opener.

Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano led the UConn offense with 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws, tying the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career. Fagnano finished the day completing 13-of-19 passes and had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win.

Fagnano and the Huskies piled up 624 total yards of offense on Saturday also setting a new UConn school record. The Huskies 63 points matches the FBS record for points in a game, set against Kent State on November 9, 2002. The 46-point win is the largest margin of victory since a 45-10 win over Memphis in 2013.

UConn (1-1) came flying out of the gates and scored 35 points in the first quarter on 16 total plays, setting a new school FBS record for points in a quarter (28 4x – last vs URI 9/15/18). The Huskies finished the first half with 56 points and 486 yards of offense with Fagnano completing 10-of-15 passes for 298 yards and four scores. UConn's 56 points at the half sets a new FBS school record for points in a half (49 vs Kent State, 11/9/02).

R-Junior Skyler Bell caught two passes and had 105 yards receiving including a 60-yard touchdown catch, his first as a Husky. Bell hit the century mark receiving for the second-straight game.

R-Junior tight end Alex Honig caught three passes, including his first career touchdown, while r-senior Ezeriah Anderson and r-freshman Shamar Porter each caught a pair of passes and scored their first touchdowns as Huskies.

On the ground, UConn piled up 278 yards rushing and were led by r-freshman Durrell Robinson who finished with 94 yards on 10 carries and a score. Junior Mel Brown ran for 87 yards on a team-high 14 carries.

Fagnano added 38 yards rushing and a score to his offensive totals for the day while junior Victor Rosa and r-sophomore Cam Edwards each found the end zone as well; Edwards twice, once through the air and another on the ground..

The UConn defense held Merrimack (0-2) to 279 yards of offense while picking up four sacks and 10.0 tackles of a loss. R-Senior linebacker Jayden McDonald finished with a team-high eight tackles.

Merrimack's Jermaine Corbett ran for 103 yards and a touchdown in the loss. Junior back-up quarterback Justin Lewis came in and was 6-of-6 for 103 yards and a touchdown.

The UConn Huskies got 106 yards rushing and a touchdown from r-sophomore Cam Edwards but saw their second half lead erased in the fourth quarter as the Duke Blue Devils came away with a 26-21 win in front of 20,174 at Brooks Field at Wallace Wade Stadium.

Duke, who moves to 3-0 with the win, erased a 21-17 UConn lead in the fourth quarter with a Todde Pelino field goal and quarterback Malik Murphy's third touchdown throw of the night en route to the win. Murphy finished the night 28-for-43 for 267 yards and three touchdowns and an interception.

For UConn (1-2), Edwards rumbled to his third career 100-yard game needing 21 carries to hit the century mark while adding a 26-yard catch to his stat line. R-Sophomore Nick Evers was back under center to lead the UConn offense and threw his first career touchdown. Evers finished the night 15-of-29 for 135 yards and also ran it 10 times for 60 yards.

The Blue Devils got on the board on their first drive on the night as Murphy led them on a nine-play, 92-yard drive he capped with a four-yard scoring strike to Jordan Moore for a 7-0 lead. An Evers fumble set up another Duke score as Pelino hit from 53-yards out for a 10-0 lead at 12:10 in the second quarter. After forcing a three-and-out, Moore capped another scoring drive with his second touchdown throw of the night, this time finding a streaking Eli Pancol up the left sidelines for a 36-yard score and a 17-0 lead with 8:27 to go in the half.

The UConn defense pulled the Huskies back into the game, forcing their first turnover of the season and turning it into six. Linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown broke up a Murphy pass and fellow linebacker Langston Hardy picked it off and rumbled 64 yards for the score.

The Huskies owned the third quarter, putting two scoring drives together while outgaining Duke 124-43 in yards to take a 21-17 lead. Forcing a three-and-out on Duke's first possession, Evers orchestrated an eight-play drive with Edwards capping it off with a one-yard plunge to pull within 17-14. Another three-and-out gave Evers and the offense the ball back and the Huskies new QB finished off a 75-yard drive finding his tight end Alex Honig in the front corner of the end zone for a 21-17 lead at 8:21 of the third.

Duke pulled within 21-20 on the first play of the fourth quarter as Pelino hit his second field goal of the night, this time from 47 yards out to cap a 10-play drive that only covered a total of 13 yards. The Blue Devils created their second turnover on the next UConn drive, an Evers interception, and Murphy took them down the field in seven plays, capping the 56-yard drive to go back in front with a 20-yard TD throw to Que'Sean Brown on a third down play. The two-point try failed putting Duke up 26-21 with 11:52 left in the fourth.

The Huskies had a chance to cut into the lead but a 48-yard field goal chance with 5:42 left went wide right and the Blue Devils would take over and never give UConn the ball back. The Duke offense put together a 12-play drive highlighted by a Star Thomas 21-yard run where he could of scored but gave himself up at the UConn three-yard line, letting the Blue Devils kneel out the clock for the win.

Thomas ran for 122 yards on 22 carries while Brown caught all 11 passes thrown his way for 87 yards and a score for Duke. The Blue Devils finished with 409 yards of total offense.

UConn was led defensively by Faumuina-Brown who had 12 tackles and a pair of pass break-ups. Fellow linebacker Jayden McDonald had 11 tackles.

The UConn offense ran for a FBS school record 421 yards as the Huskies posted a 48-14 win over Florida Atlantic in front of 20,144 fans at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (2-2) ran wild as r-freshman Durell Robinson and junior Mel Brown both went for 156 yards to pace the rushing attack. It marked the first time since the 2019 season two Huskies ran for over 100-yards (vs UMass 10/26/2019). The 421 yards was the second most rushing total in program history (437 – vs UMass, 1956).

For Robinson, it was his first career 100-yard rushing game, carrying the ball 16 times on the night and finding the end zone twice. For Brown, he topped his career-high, needing 21 carries to hit 156 yards, while marking his third career 100-yard effort

UConn r-sophomore Nick Evers finished with a career-high 78 yards rushing on 18 carries and two touchdowns. Evers completed nine-of-14 for 88 yards and a touchdown. He led the UConn offense to 542 total yards on 81 plays while picking up 32 first downs, the first time getting 30 or more first downs since the 2018 season (vs. SMU – 34). The Huskies also did not punt on Saturday night, a first since a game at Syracuse during the 2004 season.

The Huskies ran their way to a 17-0 lead at the half, pounding the ball at the FAU defense to the tune of 31 rushes for 169 yards while holding the football for 20:36. The Huskies ran 42 total plays to 20 for the Owls in the first half.

After forcing a three-and-out on the game's first possession, the UConn offense put the first points on the board as grad student kicker Chris Freeman converted on his first field goal of the season, a 34-yarder, to cap a 10-play drive. Freeman snapped a 0-for-3 streak to start the season with the make.

The Huskies orchestrated a pair of 12-play drives in the second quarter to put a pair of touchdowns on the board. Evers converted on a second-and-goal try at 11:32, finding junior Mel Brown out of the backfield for a 10-0 lead. Evers then led UConn's longest scoring drive of the season, pacing the offense 91-yards, running on 10 of the 12 plays, capped by an eight-yard burst up the middle by Robinson at 1:50 for a 17-0 lead.

The UConn running attack picked right up to open the second as Evers ran in his first career rushing touchdown, a three-yard plunge, to cap of a 14-play drive which featured 12 runs to cover the 75 yards. UConn got their first turnover of the night on the Owls next possession as linebacker Jayden McDonald picked-off a tipped pass to set up the Huskies on FAU 23-yard line. Freeman drilled home his second field goal of the night at 5:57, a 35-yard attempt, to extend the lead to 27-0.

The Owls ended UConn's bid at a shutout with 2:17 left in the third as CJ Campbell Jr. ran in from three yards out. UConn's Evers and Robinson opened the fourth quarter each posting their second scores of the night to push the UConn lead to 41-7 with just under 12 to play. Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano came on and threw a 33-yard touchdown to r-freshman Shamar Porter for the Huskies final score.

UConn's defense gave up a season-low 250 total yards in the win, just 87 yards through the air. Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown led the defense with nine tackles.

UConn wideout Skyler Bell hauled in six passes for 153 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Huskies to a 47-3 win over the University at Buffalo Saturday afternoon in front of 20,347 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The UConn (3-2) offense had another big performance, running for 257 yards and passing for 280, while the defense was equally impressive, allowing a season-low three points and 198 total yards in the win. The Huskies have lit up the scoreboard to the tune of 95 points over the last two games, the most in program history in back-to-back games against FBS opponents and the most since 2009 (89 – 33 at Notre Dame; 56 vs Syracuse). UConn also improved to 3-0 at home thus far this season and have outscored opponents 158-34.

For Bell, it was a career-high for receiving yards and touchdown catches and marked his third game this season hitting the 100-yard mark. His three touchdown grabs is a new school FBS record and marks the first Husky to catch three touchdowns in a game since the 1996 season (Dak Newton 3 vs. Villanova). He has four career 100-yard receiving games.

Defensively, the Huskies recorded three sacks and grabbed an interception while holding Buffalo to just 12 first downs, 1-of-14 on third down while forcing eight three-and-outs. Linebacker Langston Hardy had a pair of sacks and fellow linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown had the other as well as six tackles. Safety Rante Jones got his first interception of the season and the third of his career.

The Huskies built a 23-0 lead late into the second quarter as kicker Chris Freeman made three of his four field goals in the first half. Running back Cam Edwards scored the game's first touchdown, a 43-yard tackle off the left end for a 10-0 lead after the first.

UConn's starter Nick Evers was forced from the game in the second quarter with an injury leaving back-up Nick Fagnano to take over play-calling duties. Fagnano finished 11-of-19 for 217 yards and three touchdowns in relief, all three to Bell.

Fagnano and Bell found pay dirt in the second quarter on a 40-yard catch-and-run to make it 23-0. Buffalo (3-2) the first half a seven-play drive that was capped by a 47-yard Upton Bellenfant field goal as time expired, their only points of the day.

Fagnano hit Bell for two third quarter scores, the first a 70-yard score, the longest-scoring play by the Huskies this season. The two finished off the trifecta on a 12-yard strike into the end-zone to make it 37-3 with 5:33 left in the third.

UConn had a balanced running game with Edwards leading the way 97 yards on 10 carries with a score. Durrell Robinson had eight rushes for 73 yards and Mel Brown had 10 carries for 53 yards and a fourth quarter touchdown.

Freeman connected on field goals of 26, 39, 22 and 27 yards, tying the UConn school and FBS record for field goals in a game. His 4-for-4 effort marks the first time a UConn kicker had four makes since Dave Teggart did it at Cincinnati in 2011.

The UConn defense came up with a fourth and goal stop with three seconds left in the game, capped by cornerback Jordan Wright scooping a fumble and returning it 96 yards for a touchdown to put the final stamp on a 29-20 win over Temple in front of 28,921 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies earn their third-straight victory and improve to 4-2 on the season heading into the bye week. UConn has won four-straight at home, five-straight dating back to last season.

R-Senior TJ Sheffield caught nine passes for 141 yards, both career-highs, with a 58-yard touchdown, the longest catch of his career. R-Fr. Running back Durell Robinson ran for a team-high 52 yards and a go-ahead fourth quarter score. Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano finished 24-of-41 for 272 yards a score and two picks.

Temple's Maddux Trujillo made a pair of field goals, including a 60-yarder, the longest field goal ever made at Rentschler Field. Running back Terrez Worthy finished with a game-high 95 yards on 12 carries.

Trujillo's back-to-back third quarter field goals gave the Owls (1-5) a 13-9 lead with 2:43 left in the quarter. Fagnano would hook-up with Sheffield for a short gain but the wideout broke free of a tackle and flew up the right sideline for a 58-yard score to put UConn in front 16-13.

Temple took the lead back early in the fourth quarter, turning a Fagnano interception into a 44-yard drive that ended with quarterback Forrest Brock scampering in from eight yards out for a 20-16 lead with 9:52 left.

Fagnano was able to put together a 10-play scoring drive, keeping the drive alive with one of the biggest plays of the night. Fighting his way out of a sack, the senior quarterback was able to find Brett Buckman all alone up the sidelines for 32 yards on a third-and-10 play that set up the Huskies on the Temple 38. From there, Robinson pounded the ball down to the one before plunging in on the next play for a 23-20 lead with 3:46 left.

Temple took over on their own 25-yard line after the touchback and drove the ball all the way to the UConn one-yard line to set up the late game drama. On second and goal, Antwain Littleton came up just short of the goal line and was then stuffed on third and goal at the one. The Owls let the clock run down to three seconds before using their final time-out on fourth and goal, setting up the final play for the win. Quarterback Tyler Douglas tried to push in over the right tackle but the ball popped loose before he could get anywhere with Wright there to scoop it at the four and fly up the field to seal the win and celebration.

Defensively, linebacker Jayden McDonald had 14 tackles, 2.5 for a loss, with a sack. Fellow linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown made 11 tackles, two for a loss. Safety Malik Dixon-Williams had nine stops and his first interception of the season.

Kicker Chris Freeman was responsible for all the UConn scoring in the first half, hitting field goals of 43, 24, and 35 yards. Since starting the season 0-for-3, Freeman has nine-straight makes.

Temple's lone score in the first half came off a blocked punt in the endzone, recovered by John Adams.

UConn r-sophomore quarterback Nick Evers threw a pair of second half touchdowns but the Huskies came up short in a comeback bid, falling to Wake Forest, 23-20, at home in front of 30,122 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field Saturday afternoon.

Evers completed 26 of 43 for 264 yards and touchdown throws to Jasaiah Gathings and Louis Hansen. Gathings finished with a season-high seven catches for 75 yards and his first score as a Husky.

The UConn (4-3) offense was held to a season-low 40 yards rushing and 304 yards of total offense in the loss. Defensively, the Huskies were led by linebacker Jayden McDonald who posted a game-high 13 tackles, 2.0 for a loss and a sack. Safety Malik Dixon-Williams had a season-high 10 tackles while cornerback Cam Chadwick (Plainfield, NJ) got his first career interception.

The Demon Deacons (3-4) were led by quarterback Hank Bachmeier who completed 21 of 36 for 275 yards, with an interception, and running back Demond Claiborne who had 30 yards on 24 carries and two scores. Placekicker Matthew Dennis made three field goals and had one blocked.

The two teams played to a 3-3 tie after the first quarter with Wake Forest getting the game's first touchdown at 13:21 in the second on Claiborne's first TD of the day, a five-yard rush to cap a seven-play, 75-yard drive for a 10-3 lead. The Demon Deacons never gave up the lead the rest of the way, using a Dennis 31-yard field goal to increase their lead to 13-3 with 6:01 left.

UConn kicker Chris Freeman made both of his field goal tries, including a career-long 53 yarder with 1:50 left in the first half to pull the Huskies within 13-6. Freeman extended his streak to 11-straight makes with his career-long make. The Demon Deacons where on the march for more points before half but Chadwick put the brakes on the drive with his first career interception, picking off Bachmeier in the endzone.

Wake Forest took the opening kick-off of the second half and pushed their lead to 20-6 as Claiborne scored from a yard out for his second TD of the day. UConn answered that drive with their first TD of the day as Evers rifled one to Gathings in the end zone from 20-yards out at 7:33 in the third, pulling within 20-13.

The Huskies got a blocked field goal near the end of the third quarter but Dennis hit for his third of the day at 11:13 in the fourth, from 36 yards out, to make it 23-13. Evers got the Huskies to 23-20 with 2:27 left, hitting Hansen in the right corner for a 25-yard scoring strike, his first career touchdown catch. The Huskies kicked-off with all three time-outs and forced Wake Forest into a three-and-out and getting the ball back with 2:02 left with a chance to tie or go ahead. The Demon Deacons defense forced the Huskies into a fourth and three and got a break when a false start penalty backed UConn up to a fourth and eight from their own 43. Evers looked for Gathings toward the left sidelines with the play falling incomplete allowing Wake Forest to kneel out the clock for the win.

The UConn defense held the Rice offense to 178 total yards including just 88 yards passing on the road to a 17-10 win over the Owls in front of 23,711 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (5-3) limited the Owls (2-6) to just three points on offense while forcing eight three-and-outs and holding Rice to just two-for-16 on third down on Saturday. UConn finished with nine tackles for loss, including two sacks, and had 11 pass break-ups in a dominating defensive effort.

On the flip side, UConn's offense struggled to get going, being shutout in the first half for just the second time this season, the last being the season-opener at Maryland. UConn 18 yards rushing at the half, turning it over twice that led to a Rice field goal and 3-0 first quarter lead.

The rushing attack had 30 yards on 23 carries early in the third quarter before running back Durell Robinson kick-started the UConn attack. On the first play of the team's second drive of the second half, the r-freshman back blew through the line of scrimmage and then up the right sideline untouched for a 68-yard touchdown run to get the Huskies on the board and a lead they would never let go of. For UConn and Robinson, it was the longest run of the season and got the UConn offense moving. Robinson would go on to carry it 15 times for 132 yards in the win, his second 100-yard effort this season, and score his fifth touchdown on the year.

UConn extended their lead to 14-3 at 10:15 in the fourth quarter as a quarterback Nick Evers (Flower Mound, TX) 34-yard hook-up with Skyler Bell set up the Huskies on the Rice nine-yard line and back Cam Edwards finished off the drive with a four-yard score, his fifth TD this season.

Place kicker Chris Freeman, who saw a streak of 11-straight makes snapped when a 53-yard attempt missed in the first half, tacked on a 30-yard field goal with 3:40 left in the fourth to give UConn a 17-3 advantage. On the ensuing kick-off, Rice's Quinton Jackson ripped off a 100-yard return to pay-dirt, pulling the Owls within 17-10 with 3:28 left. It was the first time allowing a kick-off return for a touchdown since 2015 against Houston (Brandon Wilson – 94 yards).

The Owl defense was able to get the ball back to the offense but with just 22 seconds left and on their own nine-yard line. After a Pryce Yates sack, his second of the day, the Huskies forced a fumble on the final play to end the game.

The Huskies finished with 309 yards of total offense, 181 on the ground and 128 through the air. UConn also struggled on third down, finishing three-for-16 while also allowing a season-high three sacks. Both teams combined for 20 punts in the game.

Linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown made 10 tackles, 1.5 for loss, with a forced fumble and two pass break-ups. Defensive tackle Dal'Mont Gourdine had four of UConn's pass break-ups.

The UConn Huskies pounded their way to 271 yards rushing en route to a 34-27 win over Georgia State in the final home game of the season in front of 22,028 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The win gives the Huskies (6-3) bowl eligibility for the second time in the last three seasons and the eighth time in the program's FBS history. The Huskies finish out their seven-game home schedule with a 6-1 record, their best record at home since Jim Mora's first season in 2022 when they went 5-1. It is their most home wins since a 6-0 home campaign in 2010.

Running back Mel Brown finished with 138 yards on 14 carries with a touchdown while Cam Edwards had 88 yards on 13 carries to lead the ground game.

UConn started fast on Friday night, forcing and three-and-out on the Panthers first possession then using a Brown 52-yard run to set-up a first-and-goal. Quarterback Nick Evers hit tight end Louis Hansen in the flat and he dove from the front pylon for a 7-0 lead just 1:24 into the game. A Chris Freeman 42-yard field goal put the Huskies up 10-0 at 3:31 of the first quarter.

Georgia State (2-6) clawed back in the second quarter and a Zach Gibson to Ted Hurst 11-yard touchdown and Liam Rickman 30-yard field goal, coming off a UConn fumble, tied the game at 10-10 with 3:29 left in the half. The Panthers had the ball and driving for late first half points but defensive back D'Mon Brinson got his first career interception with 1:00 left in the half, setting the Huskies up for a late field goal. UConn's drive stalled out on the Panther 10-yard line before Freeman knocked through a 28-yarder for a 13-10 lead at the half.

UConn opened the second half getting the ball and put together a six-play, 75-yard drive that featured a 46-yard Cam Edwards run and ended with Durrell Robinson plunging in from a yard out for his sixth touchdown on the season and a 20-10 lead.

Georgia State answered with the longest scoring drive allowed by the UConn defense this season, 16-plays, but the Panthers were forced to settle for another Rickman field goal to pull within 20-13.

The Huskies dominated the start of the fourth quarter as Evers finished off an eight-play drive with a five-yard touchdown run off-tackle to make it 27-13 at 12:54. The UConn defense got their second pick of the night on the next possession as safety Malik Dixon-Williams intercepted Christian Veilleux on the sidelines at the Panther 31-yard line. On the next play, Brown burst up the right sidelines for the touchdown, clinching his second 100-yard effort this season and making it 34-13 at 11:26.

The Panthers made it interesting down the stretch as Freddie Brock ripped off a 55-yard touchdown up the middle of the defense with 9:57 left then a late Gibson scramble for six to cap a 12-play drive to pull within 34-27 with 1:47 to go. Georgia State lined up for an onside kick but UConn recovered then converted on a fourth down to get in position to kneel out the clock on the win.

Georgia State's Gibson finished 28-of-40 for 257 yards a touchdown and a rushing touchdown in the loss.

The UConn football team scored 21 points in the fourth quarter on the way to erasing a 20-3 UAB lead to come away with a 31-23 win over the Blazers in front of 18,351 at Protective Stadium in Birmingham.

The win ties the UConn program record for largest comeback, matching a 2003 win over Western Michigan where the Huskies trailed 17-0 in the second quarter only to go on and win 41-27. UConn also notched their seventh win on the season, ensuring the program's first winning campaign since the 2010 season (8-5).

UConn quarterback Joe Fagnano came in relief of starter Nick Evers, who was forced out in the third quarter with an injury. Fagnano led three scoring drives in the fourth quarter in relief including touchdown throws to Shamar Porter and Jasaiah Gathings. Gathings finished with six catches for 52 yards.

Running back Cam Edwards led the ground game with 82 yards on 11 carries including 48-yard burst for six to push the Huskies lead to 31-23 with 2:39 left in the game. The UConn defense forced a season-high four turnovers in the win, three coming in the second half and leading to 14 points.

The Blazers and Huskies both put long together long drives on their first possessions but both managing just a field goal. The two teams then traded turnovers as UConn's Cam Chadwick got his second interception of the season, but the Huskies gave it right back with a fumble at the end of the first quarter to set up another UAB field goal at 13:07 in the second.

UAB got their second turnover on UConn's next possession, an interception by Tyjon Jones, and turned it into a touchdown and a 10-point lead. Just as the skies opened up with heavy rain falling, the Blazers ran it seven-straight times before Kitna hit Corri Milliner for a 38-yard score to make it 13-3 with 7:02 left in the half. The Blazer settled in and forced a pair of three-and-outs, giving the offense the ball back with 1:57 left in the half. UAB used five plays to get more points as Beebe Jr. burst off the left end and up the sidelines for 25-yards to make it 20-3 going in to the break.

The Huskies came out of the half and pieced together a 15-play scoring drive, their longest of the season, to find the end zone. Robinson carried it five times on the drive, the last a plunge from a yard out for six, cutting the lead to 20-10 at 7:57.

A third field goal from UAB's Delange pushed their lead to 23-10 and the Blazers were on the hunt for more on their next possession before a diving interception by safety Malik Dixon-Williams, his second of the season, ended the threat on the UConn one-yard line. The Huskies were able to pick-up a pair of first downs before being forced to punt but also lost starter Evers to an injury.

Fagnano came on in relief and put together an eight-play scoring drive with the big play coming on a 28-yard hook-up to Skyler Bell to set up first and goal on the Blazer six-yard line. The UAB defense held and forced a fourth down decision. UConn would go for it and Fagnano had a clean pocket to find Porgter all alone in the middle for six, pulling the Huskies to within 23-17 with 8:45 left in the fourth.

UConn caught a break on UAB's first play on the ensuing drive as a muffed exchange by Kitna to Kam Shanks resulted in the Huskies falling on the football and taking over on the Blazer's 21-yard line. Fagnano gave the Huskies their first lead of the game finding Gathings in the right corner of the end zone with a 21-yard strike to go up 24-23 with 8:28 left.

The Huskies got their fourth turnover of the night with 4:54 left, recovering a fumble on their 41 yard line. Four plays later, Edwards burst up the left sideline for a 48-yard score giving UConn a 31-23 lead with 2:39 left. UConn had a chance to add to that in the closing minutes but a Chris Freeman field goal try missed. The defense stood tall and forced a turnover on downs to seal the win.
