QUICK HITS---

- UConn kicks-off the 2025 season on Saturday afternoon at home in Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field as the Huskies take on in-state foe Central Connecticut. Saturday marks the home opener for the Huskies Saturday's game will be available throughout the state on WFSB-3 sister station WWAX and can be streamed on UConn+
- The Huskies and Blue Devils match-up for the fifth time with UConn winning all four previous meetings, the last a 23-8 win in 2022, marking the first win for head coach Jim Mora in his tenure in Storrs.
- UConn has played at least one Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) school in each season since moving up to Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in 2002. UConn is 21-2 overall against FCS opponents. UConn logged victories against: Florida Atlantic (2002), Lehigh (2003), Murray State (2004), Liberty (2005), Rhode Island (2006, 2009, 2018), Maine (2007, 2016), Hofstra (2008), Texas Southern (2010), Fordham (2011), UMass (2012), Stony Brook (2014), Villanova (2015), Holy Cross (2017), Wagner (2019), Yale (2021), Central Connecticut (2022), Sacred Heart (2023) and Merrimack (2024) with losses to Holy Cross (2021) and Towson (2013).
- The 2025 campaign will mark the fifth season the Huskies will compete as an independent. UConn has three match-ups with teams from the ACC this season, starting next week at Syracuse, in October at Boston College and in November at home against Duke. The Huskies face three teams from their former conference, The American (FAU, Rice, UAB), a pair of Conference-USA (FIU, Delaware) and MAC schools (Ball State, Buffalo) and a match-up against the Mountain West (Air Force).
- UConn Head Coach Mora is in his fourth season leading the Huskies and led the Huskies to one of the best seasons in program history in 2024. UConn finished 9-4, the program's first winning season since 2010. Mora got the Huskies to a bowl game for the second time in three seasons, leading UConn to their first bowl win since 2009, a 27-14 win over UNC in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl. He is 18-20 in his time in Storrs and is four wins away from his 100th career head coaching victory. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 22nd season of play at their off-campus home in 2025. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 77-58 at Rentschler Field and posted a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Last Meeting vs. CCSU...

Sept. 3, 2022 -- UConn 28 - CCSU 3 -- E. Hartford, CT UConn running back Nate Carter topped 100-yards rushing as the Huskies piled up-274 yards on the ground en route to a 28-3 win over in-state foe Central Connecticut at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Huskies notched their first victory of the 2022 season and the first for first-year head coach Jim Mora at UConn. The UConn defense allowed just three points, the fewest points allowed since a 2015 win at Tulane (7-3). CCSU finished with just 242 total yards of offense with just 78 yards rushing. Carter paced the offense with 123 yards coming on 23 carries and a third quarter touchdown, his first of the season. Fellow back Brian Brewton carried 10 times for 62 yards. In the air, true freshman Zion Turner made his first career start and completed 14-of-22 passes for 172 yards and a pair of touchdowns with an interception. Sophomore tight end Brandon Nemenski and r-sophomore Jacob Flynn each caught touchdowns in the win. Junior Jackson Mitchell led the defense with seven tackles, five solo while grad student Brandon Bouyer-Randal recorded his first career

interception in the win.

The Central Connecticut Blue Devils are the defending Northeast Conference champions, coming off a 7-6 season and 5-1 in conference, and trip to the FCS playoffs. CCSU was tabbed to repeat, sitting atop the 2025 NEC Preseason Coaches Poll. Eight Blue Devils were tabbed for the All-NEC Preseason squad led by the league's last two Offensive Players of the Year. Senior running back Elijah Howard was the 2024 NEC Player of the Year and a Walter Payton Award Finalist. He averaged 110.9 all-purpose yards per game and ran for 934 yards and nine touchdowns a year ago. Wideout Donovan Wadley, a transfer from Merrimack, was the 2023 NEC Offensive Player of the year after posting 1,332 all-purpose yards, ranking 17th nationally at 121.09 APY per game. Defensively, the Blue Devils return last year's NEC Rookie of the Year in defensive back Christopher Jean. Also a Jerry Rice Award Finalist, Jean had 34 tackles and four interceptions. including three in a win over Duquesne to tie a CCSU school record. Saturday's match-up with UConn is Central's only match-up against a FBS school this season and next week they host AIC in the first of seven home games set for 2025.

UConn vs. the Northeast Conference...

The Huskies are a perfect 6-0 all-time against teams from the FCS Northeast Conference. UConn is 4-0 against CCSU and have also beaten Wagner at home in the 2019 home opener, 24-21. The Huskies beat former NEC school Sacred Heart at home in 2023, 31-3.





Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora has transformed the UConn football program since taking the reins after the 2021 season. Mora enters his fourth season on the Huskies' sidelines in 2025 after leading the Huskies to one of the most successful seasons in UConn football history.

Mora led the Huskies to a 9-4 record in 2024, capped by beating UNC in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl, UConn's second trip to a post season bowl game in his three seasons. UConn's nine wins is the most for the program since 2010, also securing the first winning season since that campaign. It marked the third time in program history a UConn team has won nine games or more (2024, 2010, 2007, 2003).

The Huskies enjoyed a six-win turnaround last season while also returning to their winning ways at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field, posting a 6-1 record on their home turf last fall.

For his efforts Mora, was named The Gridiron Club of Greater Boston 2024 Head Coach of the Year. The 2024 season marked the fifth winning campaign for Coach Mora during his collegiate coaching tenure. It was also the sixth post season bowl appearance for a Mora coached team during his nine seasons at UConn and UCLA combined.

Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896. In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschlar Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first two-time All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

Mora, 63, brings 35 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 13 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time. A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego, Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota. Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

NEWS & NOTES ---

Turning the Page on 2024... The Huskies put together a season to remember in 2024, battling their way to a 9-4 record and a win in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl over North Carolina. UConn notched the program's first winning campaign since the 2010 season and their first bowl win since the 2009 season. The Huskies nine wins ties for the second most in a season (3x - 2024, 2007, 2003) and marks just the fourth time a UConn team has won nine-plus games (10 - 1998, 9 - 2024, 2007, 2003). UConn head coach Jim Mora was named The Gridiron Club of Greater Boston Head Coach of the Year while Chase Lundt and Jayden McDonald were name HERO Sports G5 All-Americans, three Huskies (Lundt, Tui Faumuina-Brown, Chris Freeman) were named All-New England, and two Huskies (McDonald, Mel Brown) were named FBS All-ECAC.

The Huskies put together one of their best statistical seasons in 2024, in both the UConn record book and the final NCAA rankings. The Huskies ran 912 total plays for 5169 total yards, both are ranked as the third most all-time. The UConn offense rushed for 2590 yards, the second highest total all-time, and put up 415 points, the second highest total of all-time. In the final NCAA Rankings, the UConn posted 397.6 yards per game in total offense, ranked 56th, their best finish since 2017 and the fourth best during the FBS era (2003, 2004, 2017). The rushing attack finished ranked 21st at 119.2 ypg, the highest in the Jim Mora era. It marked the third-straight season ranked in top-100 nationally. It was also the highest ranking since the 2008 season (13th-216.38) and the most yards per game since 2018 (199.5). It was the third highest ranking in FBS era (2006, 2013). The offense was 35th at 31.9 ppg, the highest ranking since 2009 (27th- 31.15) and the first time averaging more than 30.0+ ppg since 2009.

On defense, UConn ranked 46th in total defense at 357.3 yards per game, the highest ranking since the 2015 season. The defense allowed 23.1 ppg, ranked 43rd, the Huskies best ranking since 2015.

Dominant at The Rent... UConn was 6-1 in 2024 at their East Hartford home, Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field and the Huskies dominated opponents on the offensive side of the ball doing it. UConn averaged 36.9 ppg at home, outscoring opponents 258-114. The 36.9 ppg is the second highest total (2010, 38.5 PPG) in their history of Rentschler Field, which opened in 2003. Their six wins on their home turf marked the fourth time in their time at The Rent winning six (2004, 2007, 2010, 2024).

Senior Bowl Top 300... Wide receiver Sklyer Bell and running back Mel Brown have been named to the 2026 Senior Bowl Top 300 list. The 2026 Panini Senior Bowl will be played on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. CT at South Alabama's Hancock Whitney Stadium in Mobile, Ala. The Senior Bowl scouting department, comprised entirely of former NFL scouts, evaluated over 2,000 prospects from all levels of college football to compile the Senior Bowl Top 300. A total of 86 schools are represented on this year's list. Bell and Brown are two of 19 players selected from the "Group of 5" schools. The participants in this year's game will be announced at the conclusion of the season.

Bell for Biletnikoff... Wide receiver Skyler Bell was one of 47 players nationally named to the 2025 Biletnikoff Award watchlist. Bell came to UConn last fall, transferring in from Wisconsin after a pair of season. The r-senior wideout made an immediate impact for the Huskies, hauling in 50 passes for 860 yards and five touchdowns. He averaged 17.2 yards per catch on the season, ranking 37th among the nation's top-receivers. Bell opened his UConn career with five catches for 141 yards at Maryland and followed that up a two-catch, 105 yards and a touchdown against Merrimack. His best game of the season saw him pull down six passes for 153 yards and three touchdowns against Buffalo, tying the UConn school record for TD catches. At Syracuse, he had his fourth 100-yard receiving game the season while catching a career-high 10 passes. In his two seasons at Wisconsin Bell had 68 catches for 740 yards and six scores for the Badgers. The Biletnikoff Award recognizes the college football season's outstanding FBS receiver, regardless of position. Any player, regardless of position (wide receiver, tight end, split end, inside receiver, slot back or running back) who catches a pass is eligible for the award.



NEWS & NOTES ---

Cam Edwards a Doak Walker Preseason Candidate...

Running back Cam Edwards was named a preseason candidate for the 2025 Doak Walker Award. The PwC SMU Athletic Forum annually presents the award to the nation's most outstanding college running back. Edwards is one of 103 running backs across the country named to this year's watch list. The r-junior running back has seen his work load and production increase in each of his seasons in Storrs and is coming off a year where he lead the Huskies in rushing. Edwards carried the load for the ground game last fall, registering 146 carries for a team-best 830 yards, averaging 5.7 yards per carry. He found the endzone eight times on the ground including scores in the final four games of the season. He also caught 13 passes out of the backfield for 148 yards and three scores. He had a pair of 100-yard games on the year including a season-high 142 yards on 18 carries with a rushing and receiving score in the regular season finale win at UMass. At Duke, he ran 21 times for 106 yards and a score. At Syracuse, he ripped off a career-long 71-vard touchdown. Over his career, he has played in 23 games, posting 1450 yards on 270 carries with 12 touchdowns. He has 28 career catches for 280 yards and three touchdowns.

Wes Hoeh on Rimington Watch List... Senior center Wes Hoeh has been named to the 2025 Rimington Trophy preseason watchlist ahead of the season. The Rimington Trophy is presented annually to the most outstanding center in NCAA Division I College Football. Hoeh, who transferred in to UConn last fall from Syracuse, helped anchor an offensive line that fueled the way to an explosive offense attack. The UConn offense continued lean on their rushing attack and in 2024 averaged 199.2 yards per game to rank 21st nationally.

PK Freeman a Lou Groza Candidate... Graduate place kicker Chris Freeman was one of 30 kickers nationally to be named to the 2024 Lou Groza Award watch list this summer. Freeman took over the kicking duties for the Huskies last season after transferring in from Indiana. Freeman had a slow start to the season, missing on his first three field goal attempts. From there, he rattled off 11-straight makes over a four-game stretch that included a 4-of-4 effort against Buffalo at home, both tying UConn school records. He also connected on a 53-yard field goal during that stretch, marking a new career high and becoming the longest field goal by a UConn kicker at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. He would match the 53-yard mark again in the regular season finale at UMass. On the season, Freeman finished 20-of-26 on field goal attempts and made all 49 of his extra points. He finished the season with 109 points, the third-highest total in school history.

TE Alex Honig a College Football "Freak"... R-Senior Alex Honig was named to the 2025 College Football Freaks List published by The Athletic's Bruce Feldman. Feldman and The Athletic annually put together the Freak List series, which chronicles the strongest, fastest and most physical players in college football. Honig came in at number 39 out of 101 college football players for 2025. At 6-7, 270, Honig, a former quarterback from Bavaria, Germany, began his college career at TCU. He moved to tight end after a redshirt season and played in 12 of 15 games during TCU's run to the title game. Honig won the starting job last season in large part because of his blocking ability, but he did have six catches, with three for touchdowns. At 6-7, 270 pounds with just 14 percent body fat, some scouts think he could project to offensive tackle at the next level because of his hulking frame and impressive athleticism. He's cleaned 395 pounds — the most UConn strength coach Tyson Brown's ever seen in his 16 years

in the business. Honig, who has 11-inch hands, also benched 225 for 30 reps. He vertical jumped 36 inches and broad jumped 10-5.

Mel Brown on Jet Award Preseason List... Running back and return specialist Mel Brown has been named to the 2025 Jet Award Preseason Watchlist, recognizing him as one of the nation's top return specialists heading into the college football season. Brown has established himself as a dynamic dual-threat player, excelling both as a running back in the offensive backfield and as a game-changing return specialist on special teams. Last season, Brown was second in the nation in kickoff returns, averaging an impressive 29.1 yards per return on 17 attempts. His explosive ability was on full display with a spectacular 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the regular season finale at UMass.

Shrine Bowl 1000... The UConn Huskies placed three players on the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 watchlist, which consists of the best 1,000 players throughout all of college football who are currently all-star game eligible for the 2026 East-West Shrine Bowl and the 2026 NFL Draft class.

Receiver Skyler Bell and running backs Cam Edwards and Mel Brown have been selected to this year's list. The East-West Shrine Bowl is a best-in-class all-star event that will take place at Ford Center at The Star in Frisco, TX on January 27, 2026. Our players will be coached by NFL coaches, in an NFL facility, and will have access to NFL-level resources, facilities, player-friendly schedules, and opportunities at the highest level.

Coach Mora Closing in on 100... Head coach Jim Mora is four wins away from 100 career victories as a head coach. Mora is in his fourth season at UConn where he has posted 18 wins. During his six seasons as head coach at UCLA, Mora led the Bruins to 46 wins and owns a 64-50 overall record in college. During his time in the NFL, Mora was the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons for three seasons and the Seattle Seahawks for a season, posting 32 regular season and playoff wins.

Coaching Staff Changes... Head Coach Jim Mora added a new quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator to his staff this spring in Pryce Tracy. Tracy spent the last three seasons on the staff at Georgia with coaching stops at Arkansas Tech, Alabama and Notre Dame on his journey to Storrs. Mora also elevated Cole Peterson to the Huskies new tight ends coach with Christian Pace moving over to coaching the offensive line this season.

Former Huskies Join Coaching Ranks... UConn will have three familiar faces joining the coaching staff this fall in former Huskies Jackson Mitchell, Rante Jones and Kaleb Anthony. Mitchell played two seasons for Coach Mora and was one of the greatest line-backers in program history. He was a Butkus Award semifinalist and finished his career third all-time with 438 tackles over 47 games. He will serve as a defensive assistant working with the Husky linebackers. Jones wrapped his career in Storrs last fall, finishing his career with 283 total tackles and three interceptions in 47 career games. Jones role with the team will be director of recruiting and high school relations while also working as an assistant with the defensive backs. Anthony was a defensive back for the Huskies, playing in 12 games over the 2021 and 2022 seasons before injury cut his career short. He joins the staff in the role of player personnel assistant.
