QUICK HITS---

- » UConn returns home to Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field on Saturday afternoon to play host to the FIU Panthers of Conference-USA on Homecoming Weekend. Kick-off is scheduled for 3:30 pm on CBS Sports Network.
- » Saturday is also the Huskies annual Crucial Catch game, dedicated to recognizing those who have been impacted by cancer. Members of the program will highlight a specific form of cancer that has affected their family through the addition of cancer awareness helmet decals.
- » UConn takes on their second Conference-USA opponent this season in FIU. The Huskies and Panthers last faced-off during the 2023 season in East Hartford, a 24-17 FIU win. The Huskies won the first-ever meeting between the two schools back in 2022, a 33-12 win on the road in Miami.
- » The Huskies are back at home where they are 2-0 this season after earning their first road win of 2025, 20-17 at Buffalo last Saturday. The Huskies used some late-game magic to come away with their third victory on the season. The Bulls tied the game at 17-17 with :59 seconds left but UConn orchestrated a 10-play drive capped by a 44-yard Chris Freeman field goal with :06 seconds left to go home with the win. It marked the first field goal to win a game in the closing seconds since the 2016 season when a Bobby Puyol 37-yard make with :11 seconds left led UConn over Maine at home, 24-21.
- » UConn Head Coach Mora is in his fourth season leading the Huskies and led the Huskies to one of the best seasons in program history in 2024. UConn finished 9-4, the program's first winning season since 2010. Mora got the Huskies to a bowl game for the second time in three seasons, leading UConn to their first bowl win since 2009, 27-14 over UNC in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl. He is 21-22 in his time in Storrs and is one win away from his 100th career head coaching victory. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- » THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and are in their 22nd season of play at their off-campus home in 2025. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 79-58 at Rentschler Field and posted a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Last Meeting vs. FIU...

September 16, 2023 - FIU 24 UConn 17 - East Hartford, CT

The Huskies fell to 0-3 to start the 2023 season after a 24-17 home loss to FIU. The Huskies fell behind 24-3 at the half but defensively held FIU scoreless in the second half to set up a late game comeback that fell short of tying the game with under a minute to play. Junior running back Devontae Houston finished with 126 yards on 19 carries in the loss. He also hauled in a catch-and-run 37-yard score out of the backfield in the fourth quarter. R-Junior Ta'Quan Roberson made his first start of the season at quarterback and finished 15-of-32 for 170 yards and a score. UConn got their running game untracked, finishing with 173 yards on the ground on 40 carries. FIU freshman quarterback Keyone Jenkins threw for 284 yards and pair of scores to lead the Panthers. The UConn defense kept FIU in check in the second half and gave the offense the ball back with 2:41 left on the FIU 48-yard line down 24-17 with a chance to pull even. Roberson took the team to the FIU 11-yard line but a holding penalty put the Huskies in a 4th and 14. Roberson's pass to Cam Ross fell two yards short, ending the game.

Scouting the Panthers...

The FIU Panthers are coming off their bye week coming to Connecticut to face the Huskies. The Panthers are 2-2 on the year but lost their last time out in their Conference-USA opener at home to Delaware, 38-16. The Panthers have run the ball well this season, averaging 187.0 yards per game. Running back Kejon Owens leads the way with 396 yards and four touchdowns while averaging 6.6 yards per carry. Fellow back Anthony Carrie has 143 yards on 29 carries and a pair of scores. Quarterback Keyone Jenkins is a dual threat throwing and running the football. Jenkins has thrown for 701 yards and two scores and ran for four touchdowns as well. On defense, FIU is led by line-backer Johnny Chaney Jr. who has 36 tackles, 22 solo, 2.5 for a loss, a sack and forced fumble on the season. Defensive back Mister Clark has 22 tackles and one of the team's four interceptions. Clark leads the team with four pass break-ups.

UConn vs. Conference-USA...

The Huskies are 1-5 against teams currently in Conference-USA. UConn is 1-1 against FIU, 0-1 against Delaware and is 0-3 against Middle Tennessee. UConn has future games against the league in 2027, at FIU and Liberty and home against Delaware. The Huskies faced past members of the league during their stints in Conference-USA. The Huskies faced Cincinnati (0-1), FAU (1-0), Louisville (0-1), Marshall (0-1) and USF (0-2) when they were members of the league.

Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora has transformed the UConn football program since taking the reins after the 2021 season. Mora enters his fourth season on the Huskies' sidelines in 2025 after leading the Huskies to one of the most successful seasons in UConn football history.

Mora led the Huskies to a 9-4 record in 2024, capped by beating UNC in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl, UConn's second trip to a post season bowl game in his three seasons. UConn's nine wins is the most for the program since 2010, also securing the first winning season since that campaign. It marked the third time in program history a UConn team has won nine games or more (2024, 2010, 2007, 2003).

The Huskies enjoyed a six-win turnaround last season while also returning to their winning ways at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field, posting a 6-1 record on their home turf last fall.

For his efforts Mora, was named The Gridiron Club of Greater Boston 2024 Head Coach of the Year. The 2024 season marked the fifth winning campaign for Coach Mora during his collegiate coaching tenure. It was also the sixth post season bowl appearance for a Mora coached team during his nine seasons at UConn and UCLA combined.

Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896. In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first two-time All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

Mora, 63, brings 35 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 13 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time. A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego; Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota. Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

Coach Mora One Win From 100... Head coach Jim Mora one win away from 100 career victories as a head coach after last week's win at Buffalo. Mora is in his fourth season at UConn where he has posted 21 wins. During his six seasons as head coach at UCLA, Mora led the Bruins to 46 wins and owns a 67-52 overall record in college. During his time in the NFL, Mora was the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons for three seasons and the Seattle Seahawks for a season, posting 32 regular season and playoff wins.

Dominant at The Rent... UConn was 6-1 in 2024 and are off to a 2-0 start this season at their East Hartford home, Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. This year, the Huskies have put up 90 points in their two wins. The Huskies dominated opponents on the offensive side of the ball on their home turf last season, averaging 36.9 ppg while outscoring opponents 258-114 last fall. The 36.9 ppg is the second highest total (2010, 38.5 PPG) in their history of Rentschler Field, which opened in 2003. Their six wins on their home turf marked the fourth time in their time at The Rent winning six (2004, 2007, 2010, 2024).

Taking Care of the Football... The UConn offense is one of three teams in the country without a turnover through the five games this season. The Huskies along with Alabama and Temple have all kept the turnover column clean this season. The Huskies are ranked 35th nationally in turnover ratio (0.60), with two interceptions and a fumble recovery on the season.

Penalty Free... The Huskies went without a penalty in last Saturday's win over Buffalo. It marked just the third time in the FBS era a UConn team played a penalty-free game. The last time the Huskies went without a flag was their win over South Carolina in the Papa John's Bowl in 2010, and before that a 2005 win over Liberty. On the season, UConn ranked 16th in the country in fewest penalties per game (4.20), 30th in total penalties (21), and 21st in fewest penalty yards per game (39.4).

Freeman on the Mark... Placekicker Chris Freeman buried both of his field goal attempts at Buffalo last weekend including a season-long 44-yard make with :06 seconds left to lift UConn over the Bulls. Since a miss in the CCSU game, Freeman has made seven-straight heading into this Saturday's game. Freeman had a streak of 11-straight makes last season, tying a UConn school record. He ranks 18th in the NCAA in total points (45), 27th in FG per game (1.60), 28th in scoring (9.0 pg) and 34th in FG percentage (.889 - 8/9).

UConn Offense Shining... The UConn offense is ranked among the best in the country through five games this season. The Huskies are ranked 25th in total offense (459.0), 30th in first downs (109), 34th in passing offense (268.8), 42nd in rushing offense (190.2) and 49th in scoring offense (34.2).

Protect the Quarterback... The UConn offensive line historically have been one of the best teams in the country protecting the quarterback during the Jim Mora era and this year is no different. The Huskies are 18th in the country in sacks allowed this season, giving up just 4.0 sacks in five games (0.80 pg). In 2024, UConn finished 13th in the nation allowing just 1.08 sacks per game and in 2023, UConn was ninth at 1.00 sacks per game allowed. UConn also ranks 24th this year in tackles for loss allowed (3.80 pg).

Cam Fuels the Running Game... Running back Cam Edwards has three 100-yard rushing efforts through five games this season and is among the top running backs in the national rankings. Edwards posted 194 yards on 24 carries, both career-highs, and had two fourth quarter touchdown runs to help seal a win over Ball State. Edwards ranks fifth in the nation in rushing yards (557), seventh in yards per game (111.4), 13th in rushing TDs (6), 22nd in all-purpose yards (122.6), 21st in total TDs (6), and 31st in yards per carry (6.26). Four of his six touchdowns this season have been on runs of 30-yards or more including a career-long 73-yard touchdown in the season opener vs. CCSU.

Edwards Creeping Up the UConn Rushing Charts... Through five games this season, Edwards has rushed for 557 yards on 89 carries for six touchdowns. Edwards is more than halfway to a 1,000 yards and would be the first UConn player to hit the century mark since the 2019 season when Kevin Mensah totalled 1,013 yards on 226 carries. Over his career, Edwards has piled up 2,007 yards on 359 carries with 18 touchdowns. He is now 10th all-time at UConn on the career rushing list.

Skyler Bell Among College Football's Best... Husky wideout Skyler Bell earned a spot on the Biletnikoff Award watch list this summer and through five games, he's shown why he belongs in the conversation as one of the top receivers in the nation. He caught a career-best 14 passes, one off the UConn school record, for 113 yards and a score against Ball State. He is already more than halfway to 2024 season totals through five games this season. Bell has pulled down 42 passes for 499 yards and four scores. He now has seven 100-yard games in his

18 games at UConn and eight total for his career. His 80-yard catch and run TD against CCSU marked the longest reception of his career.

Among the NCAA leaders this season, Bell ranks first in the country in catches (42), third in receptions per game (8.40), fourth in receiving yards (499), seventh in yards per game (99.8) and 15th in receiving TDs (4).

Signal Caller Stats... Joe Fagnano ranks among the top-quarterbacks in the country this season. Fagnano is 22nd in completing per game (21.8), 24th in passing yards (1201), 45th in passing yards per game (240.2), 54th in total offense (253.2) and 57th in completion percentage (.653). Fagnano threw for 346 yards, his highest total as a Husky, and two scores in the loss at Delaware and his 28 completions tied his career high. Fagnano is in his third season with the Huskies after being granted a seventh-year of eligibility by the NCAA after last season. In his 17 career games at UConn, he has thrown for 3,005 yards, completed 61.0 percent of his passes (247-408) and thrown for 27 touchdown against four picks. His 27 TD throws ranks him seventh all-time in the UConn record book.

UConn Sack Masters... The UConn defense comes into this weekend's game ranked 23rd in the nation in sacking the quarterback. The Huskies have 14.0 sacks on the season, averaging 2.80 per game with linebackers Bryun Parham and Tyquan King leading the way. Parham had a career-high three sacks against Delaware and leads the team with 5.5 sacks and ranks second in total sacks and fifth in sacks per game (1.10). King has 3.0 sacks on the year. Parham is also the Huskies leading tackler on the year along with fellow linebacker Oumar Diomande, both ranking 41st in the country in total tackles (38) and 75th in tackles per game (7.6).

Career Day for John Neider... R-sophomore John Neider had his best game as a wide receiver in the loss at Delaware. Neider caught four passes for 60 yards against the Blue Hens, both new career-highs. Against Syracuse, he threw his first career pass, finding tight end Alex Honig on a trick play for a touchdown. Last season, Neider was a special teams standout for the Huskies over 13 games, totalling 12 tackles. He also had a 20-yard punt return off a blocked punt. Neider, a converted quarterback, came to UConn as a preferred walk-on and has since earned a scholarship, had a standout high school career at Jonathan Law HS in Milford where he was named the Connecticut Gatorade Player of the Year.

Record Setting Day vs. CCSU... The Huskies piled up 638 total yards, 250 on the ground and 388 through the air, in a 59-13 over Central Connecticut, setting a new school record for total yards. The Huskies have eclipsed 600 total yards of offense five times in program history and last Saturday's mark breaks the mark of 624 set last fall vs. Merrimack. The 59 points scored tied for the 12th highest point total in school history.

Huskies in the NFL... The NFL season is underway with nine former Huskies represented in the league. Last year's draft pick, tackle Chase Lundt (2021-24) joins former UConn offensive lineman Ryan Van Denmark (2017-21) with the Buffalo Bills. Also on opening day rosters was defensive tackle Folorunso Fatukasi (2014-17) with the Houston Texans, defensive tackle Travis Jones (2018-21) with the Baltimore Ravens, offensive lineman Matt Peart (2016-19) with the Denver Broncos, and running back Nate Carter (2021-22) with the Atlanta Falcons. Former offensive linemen Christian Haynes (2018-23), Seattle Seahawks, and Valentin Senn (2021-24), Arizona Cardinals, open the year on the IR. Former defensive end Eric Watts (2019-23) is a member of the New York Jets practice squad.

Senior Bowl Top 300... Wide receiver Skyler Bell and running back Mel Brown have been named to the 2026 Senior Bowl Top 300 list. The 2026 Panini Senior Bowl will be played on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. CT at South Alabama's Hancock Whitney Stadium in Mobile, Ala. The Senior Bowl scouting department, comprised entirely of former NFL scouts, evaluated over 2,000 prospects from all levels of college football to compile the Senior Bowl Top 300. A total of 86 schools are represented on this year's list. Bell and Brown are two of 19 players selected from the "Group of 5" schools. The participants in this year's game will be announced at the conclusion of the season.

Bell for Biletnikoff... Wide receiver Skyler Bell was one of 47 players nationally named to the 2025 Biletnikoff Award watchlist. Bell came to UConn for the 2024 season, transferring in from Wisconsin. The r-senior wideout made an immediate impact for the Huskies, hauling in 50 passes for 860 yards and five touchdowns. He averaged 17.2 yards per catch on the season, ranking 37th among the nation's top-receivers. In his two seasons at Wisconsin Bell had 68 catches for 740 yards and six scores for the Badgers. The Biletnikoff Award recognizes the college football season's outstanding FBS receiver, regardless of position. Any player, regardless of position (wide receiver, tight end, split end, inside receiver, slot back or running back) who catches a pass is eligible for the award.

Cam Edwards a Doak Walker Preseason Candidate... Running back Cam Edwards was named a preseason candidate for the 2025 Doak Walker Award. The PwC SMU Athletic Forum annually presents the award to the nation's most outstanding col-

lege running back. Edwards is one of 103 running backs across the country named to this year's watch list.

Wes Hoeh on Rimington Watch List... Senior center Wes Hoeh has been named to the 2025 Rimington Trophy preseason watchlist ahead of the season. The Rimington Trophy is presented annually to the most outstanding center in NCAA Division I College Football. Hoeh, who transferred in to UConn last fall from Syracuse, helped anchor an offensive line that fueled the way to an explosive offense attack. The UConn offense continued lean on their rushing attack and in 2024 averaged 199.2 yards per game to rank 21st nationally.

PK Freeman a Lou Groza Candidate... Graduate place kicker Chris Freeman was one of 30 kickers nationally to be named to the 2024 Lou Groza Award watch list this summer. Freeman took over the kicking duties for the Huskies last season after transferring in from Indiana. Freeman had a slow start to the season, missing on his first three field goal attempts. From there, he rattled off 11-straight makes over a four-game stretch that included a 4-of-4 effort against Buffalo at home, both tying UConn school records. On the season, Freeman finished 20-of-26 on field goal attempts and made all 49 of his extra points. He finished the season with 109 points, the third-highest total in school history.

TE Alex Honig a College Football "Freak"... R-Senior Alex Honig was named to the 2025 College Football Freaks List published by The Athletic's Bruce Feldman. Feldman and The Athletic annually put together the Freak List series, which chronicles the strongest, fastest and most physical players in college football. Honig came in at number 39 out of 101 college football players for 2025. At 6-7, 270 pounds with just 14 percent body fat. He's cleaned 395 pounds - the most UConn strength coach Tyson Brown's ever seen in his 16 years in the business. Honig, who has 11-inch hands, also benched 225 for 30 reps. He vertical jumped 36 inches and broad jumped 10-5.

Mel Brown on Jet Award Preseason List... Running back and return specialist Mel Brown has been named to the 2025 Jet Award Preseason Watchlist, recognizing him as one of the nation's top return specialists. Last season, Brown was second in the nation in kickoff returns, averaging an impressive 29.1 yards per return on 17 attempts. His explosive ability was on full display with a spectacular 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the regular season finale at UMass.

Shrine Bowl 1000... The UConn Huskies placed three players on the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 watchlist, which consists of the best 1,000 players throughout all of college football who are currently all-star game eligible for the 2026 East-West Shrine Bowl and the 2026 NFL Draft class. Receiver Skyler Bell and running backs Cam Edwards and Mel Brown have been selected to this year's list. The East-West Shrine Bowl will be held at Ford Center at The Star in Frisco, TX on January 27, 2026.

Turning the Page on 2024... The Huskies put together a season to remember in 2024, battling their way to a 9-4 record and a win in the Wasabi Fenway Bowl over North Carolina. UConn notched the program's first winning campaign since the 2010 season and their first bowl win since the 2009 season. The Huskies nine wins ties for the second most in a season (3x - 2024, 2007, 2003) and marks just the fourth time a UConn team has won nine-plus games (10 - 1998, 9 - 2024, 2007, 2003). UConn head coach Jim Mora was named The Gridiron Club of Greater Boston Head Coach of the Year while Chase Lundt and Jayden McDonald were name HERO Sports G5 All-Americans, three Huskies (Lundt, Tui Faumuina-Brown, Chris Freeman) were named All-New England, and two Huskies (McDonald, Mel Brown) were named FBS All-ECAC.

The Huskies put together one of their best statistical seasons in 2024, in both the UConn record book and the final NCAA rankings. The Huskies ran 912 total plays for 5169 total yards, both are ranked as the third most all-time. The UConn offense rushed for 2590 yards, the second highest total all-time, and put up 415 points, the second highest total of all-time. In the final NCAA Rankings, the UConn posted 397.6 yards per game in total offense, ranked 56th, their best finish since 2017 and the fourth best during the FBS era (2003, 2004, 2017). The rushing attack finished ranked 21st at 199.2 ypg, the highest in the Jim Mora era. It marked the third-straight season ranked in top-100 nationally. It was also the highest ranking since the 2008 season (13th-216.38) and the most yards per game since 2018 (199.5). It was the third highest ranking in FBS era (2006, 2013). The offense was 35th at 31.9 ppg, the highest ranking since 2009 (27th- 31.15) and the first time averaging more than 30.0+ ppg since 2009. On defense, UConn ranked 46th in total defense at 357.3 yards per game, the highest ranking since the 2015 season. The defense allowed 23.1 ppg, ranked 43rd, the Huskies best ranking since 2015.

The UConn Huskies kicked-off the 2025 season with a 59-13 win over in-state foe Central Connecticut in front of 37, 594 on Saturday at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Huskies controlled the game offensively, setting a new school record with 638 total yards, including 388 passing yards and four touchdowns through the air.

The first quarter got off to a slow start for the Huskies as CCSU took an early lead after a bad snap on a UConn punt gave the Blue Devils the ball on the five-yard line. The drive culminated in a touchdown by Elijah Howard and a 7-0 lead at 12:54. The Huskies responded effectively scoring on four-straight drives starting with Joe Fagnano's 80-yard touchdown pass to Skyler Bell at 10:15, tying the game. Mel Brown's 49-yard rush set up another Fagnano-to-Bell connection for a 12-yard touchdown, giving UConn a 14-7 lead with 1:05 remaining in the quarter.

The second quarter began with a Cam Edwards 73-yard touchdown run at 11:24 and Fagnano added to the momentum with a 4-yard rushing touchdown and a 3-yard touchdown pass to Reymello Murphy put UConn up 35-10.

The Huskies made it 42-10 in the third quarter as a 30-yard pass from Fagnano to Juice Vereen, set up a 20-yard touchdown run by Victor Rosa at 12:33. The momentum continued with a 29-yard field goal by Chris Freeman, extending the lead to 45-13.

UConn went to their reserves in the fourth quarter and quarterback Nick Evers connected with Jackson Harper on a 19-yard touchdown pass at 13:02, increasing the score to 51-13. Evers completed a crucial 18-yard pass to Jackson Harper, and MJ Flowers added a 16-yard rushing touchdown at 2:38, finalizing the scoring at 59-13.

Edwards finished with 115 rushing yards on six attempts and one touchdown. Fagnano led the passing game, completing 18 of 25 passes for 260 yards and three touchdowns, while also contributing a rushing touchdown. Bell was a top target, catching four passes for 135 yards and two touchdowns. On defense, Parham led with seven tackles, including one sack.

Elijah Howard led Central's offense with 59 rushing yards on 11 carries, including one touchdown. Brady Olson contributed from the quarterback position, completing 8 of 19 passes for 118 yards and adding 20 rushing yards on three attempts. David Pardo was the top receiver with two catches for 64 yards. On defense, Eric Jackson stood out with seven tackles, while Christopher Jean added six tackles to the effort.

With the win, the Huskies improved to 1-0 overall. The Huskies are on the road next weekend as they head to Syracuse for a 12 noon match-up on ESPN+.

Game Notes:

- Skyler Bell's 80-yard touchdown was the longest reception and TD of his career. Bell's second TD catch marked his 7th TD as a Husky. It was Bell's sixth career 100-yard game.
- Cam Edwards' 73-yard touchdown run was the longest run and TD of his career. Edwards scored his 16th career touchdown and recorded his 5th career 100-yard game.
- Victor Rosa scored his first touchdown since the second game of the 2024 season.
- Reymello Murphy, MJ Flowers and Jackson Harper scored their first UConn touchdowns. For Harper, it was his first career TD catch.
- Saturday's attendance was the largest crowd at a UConn home game since a 2013 match-up against South Florida. It was the 5th largest crowd in a UConn home opener at Rentschler Field.

The UConn Huskies lost an 27-20 overtime decision to the Syracuse Orange Saturday afternoon at the JMA Wireless Dome in front of 39,391.

UConn quarterback Joe Fagnano completed 24 of 43 passes for 259 yards, while wideout Skyler Bell set a new career-high with 11 receptions totaling 105 yards. Eight of Bell's 11 catches came in the second half.

On the ground, Mel Brown provided a spark with 72 rushing yards on five carries, including a touchdown. Cam Edwards carried it 21 times for 75 yards in the loss. Defensively, D'Mon Brinson had seven total tackles and an interception. Linebacker Oumar Diomande led the team with nine tackles including a sack.

UConn's defense twice stopped the Orange on downs inside their own 10-yard line in the first half, and used a strong effort all half to build a 14-3 lead. The Huskies struck first on a trick play in the second quarter as wideout John Neider took a pass behind the line of scrimmage then found tight end Alex Honig all alone in the end zone for a 7-0 second quarter lead.

After a Syracuse field goal, UConn made it 14-3 as Brown burst off right tackle and scampered 45 yards for a score late in the second.

At the start of the third quarter, UConn capitalized on an early drive beginning at their own 10-yard line. Fagnano led the offense efficiently, completing a key 34-yard pass to Cam Edwards on a third down, ultimately setting up a 35-yard field goal by Chris Freeman at 9:55, extending UConn's lead to 17-6.

Syracuse's Angeli led a pair of fourth quarter scoring drives of 90 yards and 80 yards with just over seven minutes left to take a 20-17 lead. UConn move the ball down the field in the last 1:18 and got a Chris Freeman 41 yard field goal to knot the game back up at 20-20 and send it to overtime.

In overtime, quarterback Angeli threw a 10-yard pass to Will Nixon, followed by a 7-yard completion to Johntay Cook II, setting up the decisive play. On third down, Angeli connected with Ross-Simmons for a 6-yard touchdown pass, giving SU a 27-20 lead after Woody's successful extra point. UConn's subsequent drive was thwarted by incomplete passes from Fagnano and a crucial pass breakup by Antoine Deslauriers on fourth down, sealing SU's win. This marked the first overtime game for UConn since a triple OT win at Louisville in 2012.

Syracuse's offensive effort was spearheaded by quarterback Steve Angeli, who completed 33 of 53 passes for 417 yards and two touchdowns, despite throwing one interception. Yasin Willis contributed on the ground with 48 rushing yards on 11 attempts, including a touchdown. Justus Ross-Simmons was a key target, catching five passes for 83 yards and two touchdowns.

The University of Delaware edged out UConn in overtime, prevailing 44-41 at Delaware Stadium in front of 17,862. Both teams combined for over 1,000 yards of total offense on the day.

Running back Cam Edwards led the Huskies' offense with 116 rushing yards on 23 carries and scored two touchdowns. Joe Fagnano completed 28 of 38 passes for 346 yards, a career-high as a Husky, and added two touchdowns, bolstering the team's aerial attack. On defense, Bryun Parham recorded 10 tackles and sacked the quarterback three times, a new career-high.

In the first quarter, the Blue Hens opened the scoring with a methodical drive, culminating in a 3-yard touchdown run by Nick Minicucci at 11:13, followed by Nate Reed's successful extra point. UConn responded with a 75-yard drive, highlighted by a 51-yard touchdown run from Edwards at 8:48, leveling the score after Chris Freeman's PAT. However, Delaware quickly regained the lead with a 70-yard touchdown rush by Jo Silver at 8:06, again capitalized with a Reed extra point, making it 14-7. The Huskies narrowed the gap with a 28-yard field goal by Freeman at 4:48, ending the quarter with Delaware ahead 14-10.

The second quarter began with UD extending their lead to 21-10, as Minicucci's 5-yard touchdown run capped a 12-play, 79-yard drive. The Huskies quickly responded, with Victor Rosa rushing for a 31-yard touchdown at 10:08, narrowing the deficit to 21-17. UConn then took the lead with 7:17 remaining when Edwards rushed for a 2-yard touchdown, making it 24-21. Delaware answered back with a significant 68-yard touchdown pass from Minicucci to Kyre Duplessis at 5:55, regaining the lead at 28-24.

The Huskies capitalized on their first drive of the second half, with a series of penalties against Delaware, ultimately leading to a 10-yard touchdown pass from Fagnano to Reymello Murphy, putting UConn ahead 31-28 with 5:05 left in the period. Delaware responded, culminating in an 18-yard touchdown run by Silver as time expired in the quarter, giving Delaware a 35-31 lead.

In the fourth quarter, UConn's Fagnano's hit a critical 27-yard completion to Murphy to set up a one-yard touchdown pass to Alex Honig at 9:54, giving UConn a 38-35 advantage. Delaware got a late stop on fourth down with just over two minutes to go and as time expired, Delaware's Reed successfully kicked a 43-yard field goal, tying the game at 38-38 and sending the game to OT.

In overtime, UConn took the ball first with Edwards rushing for a 4-yard gain, followed by a 19-yard pass from Fagnano to Louis Hansen, advancing to Delaware's two-yard line. However, after a failed rush and an incomplete pass, Fagnano was sacked for a 4-yard loss by Jack Hall and Ethan Saunders, forcing UConn to settle for a 24-yard field goal by Freeman. Delaware responded effectively, with Silver rushing for 9 yards and Minicucci then sealed the game with a 13-yard touchdown run, propelling Delaware to a 44-41 victory.

Murphy had three catches for 51 yards and a score while Skyler Bell hauled in seven for 92 yards.

UD quarterback Minicucci led UD, completing 23 of 34 passes for 265 yards and one touchdown. Minicucci was also a dual threat, rushing 18 times for 20 yards and securing three rushing touchdowns. Wide receiver Duplessis was a key target, capturing nine receptions for 161 yards and a touchdown. Running back Silver carried the ball 15 times for 179 yards and two touchdowns. On the defensive side, KT Seay anchored the unit with 13 total tackles.

The UConn Huskies held off Ball State University for a 31-25 victory at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in front of 25,025 fans Saturday afternoon.

Running back Cam Edwards led UConn's offense with a career-high 194 rushing yards on 24 carries, scoring two touchdowns. Wideout Skyler Bell added a career-best 14 receptions for 113 yards and a touchdown. His 14 catches was one shy of the UConn school record.

On defense, the Huskies recorded four sacks or more in their third-straight game with safety Malachi McLean making nine tackles and one sack.

Quarterback Joe Fagnano completed 20 of 30 passes for 181 yards, including a touchdown in the win as the Husky offense went without a turnover for the fourth-straight game to start the season.

In the first quarter, opened the scoring with a 30-yard field goal by Chris Freeman at 9:48, giving them an early 3-0 lead over the Cardinals. After a defensive stand, UConn capitalized on a short field, with Fagnano connecting with Bell for a touchdown pass from two-yards out at the 2:30 mark, extending their advantage to 10-0.

At the start of the second quarter, the Cardinals quickly narrowed the gap with a 19-yard touchdown pass from Qian Magwood to quarterback Kial Kelly at 14:53 on a trick play, making the score 10-7. Neither team could crack the scoreboard the rest of the first half.

UConn capitalized on their first possession of the second half, mounting a 14 play drive for a touchdown. Fagnano connected on a crucial 33-yard pass to Shamar Porter, setting up a 1-yard touchdown run by Terrence Smith with 6:04 remaining for a 17-7 lead. Ball State responded with a solid drive, highlighted by Eric Weatherly's 22-yard run and a 22-yard pass from Kelly to Hamilton, ultimately leading to a Holmer 23-yard field goal with 37 seconds left, narrowing the score to 17-10.

In the fourth quarter, UConn opened with a strong offensive drive, culminating in a 32-yard touchdown run by Edwards at 10:24, extending their lead to 24-10. Ball State quickly responded, with Qua Ashley scoring on a 1-yard rush at 3:28, narrowing the gap to 24-17. UConn's Edwards broke away for a dramatic 67-yard touchdown run with 1:50 left, pushing the lead to 31-17. Ball State's final push saw Kelly connect with Dahya Patel for an 11-yard touchdown with just 9 seconds remaining, but the Huskies held on for a 31-25 victory.

For Edwards, it was his second-straight game finding the endzone twice for the Huskies. Bell recorded his third 100-yard game of the season and his second game with 10-plus catches.

Kelly led the Cardinals with 209 passing yards and one touchdown on 17-of-24 completions, adding 27 rushing yards on 12 attempts. Ashley contributed significantly to the ground game with 86 rushing yards and a touchdown on 18 carries, while also catching three passes for 14 yards. Hamilton was a key target through the air, securing seven receptions for 61 yards. Defensively, Alfred Chea topped the team with eight total tackles.

The Huskies return to action next Saturday, September 27 when they travel to the University at Buffalo for a 3:30 pm match-up on ESPN+.

Game Notes:

- The Huskies earned their first win over Ball State in the all-time series, snapping an 0-4 mark that dates back to the 2000 season.

- UConn improved to 22-11 all-time against the Mid-American Conference with a match-up at Buffalo on deck next weekend.

- Bell recorded his eighth career 100-yard receiving day, and his seventh as a Husky.

- Edwards had his seventh career 100-yard rushing day and third in four games this season. His 194 yards rushing was the most by a UConn running back since the 2010 season when Jordan Todman had 222 yards against Pitt. It was the highest rushing total by a Husky since quarterback David Pindell had 197 yards rushing against USF in 2018.

- R-Freshman Terrence Smith recorded his first career touchdown in the win.

UConn's Chris Freeman buried a 44-yard field goal with six seconds left to give the Huskies a 20-17 victory over the University at Buffalo at UB Stadium on Saturday afternoon.

Running back Cam Edwards scored a touchdown while rushing for 57 yards on 15 carries for the Huskies. Skyler Bell caught six receptions for 54 yards, including one touchdown. Joe Fagnano completed 19 of 31 passes for 155 yards and added a passing touchdown. Oumar Diomande led the defense with 10 tackles.

UConn took the lead over UB with a 25-yard touchdown pass from Fagnano to Bell at 8:36 in the second quarter. The Bulls quickly responded on their ensuing drive with a 63-yard touchdown run by Lamar Sperling at 6:21, leveling the score at 7-7 going into halftime.

The Huskies extended their lead with a scoring drive to open the third quarter, capped by an 8-yard touchdown run from Edwards at 11:16 to make it 14-7. Buffalo responded with a 39-yard field goal by Jack Howes at 4:58, narrowing the gap to 14-10. UConn's Freeman then added a 40-yard field goal of his own with 1:31 remaining, bringing the score to 17-10 to end the quarter.

Buffalo mounted a crucial drive in the waning minutes of the fourth quarter, with Gunnar Gray finding AJ Henderson for a 5-yard touchdown pass on fourth down with 59 seconds left, tying the score at 17-17. Fagnano quickly moved UConn into range on a 10-play drive, setting up the 44-yard chance. Freeman delivered, securing the win with a 44-yard field goal, clinching a 20-17 victory for the Huskies.

Buffalo's offense was bolstered by the efforts of Henderson, who carried the ball 24 times for 63 yards and added a receiving touchdown on three catches for 18 yards. Junior running back Lamar Sperling made a significant impact with 106 rushing yards on just nine carries, finding the end zone once. Senior quarterback Gunnar Gray completed 17 of 29 passes for 125 yards, throwing one touchdown without an interception.

On defense, senior linebacker Red Murdock was a standout, leading the team with nine total tackles and forcing a fumble. Defensive back Solomon Brown contributed solidly with six tackles, adding to the defensive effort.

The Huskies are back at home in Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field next Saturday, October 4 when the FIU Panthers come to town. Kick-off is scheduled for 3:30 pm on CBS Sports Network.

Game Notes:

The Huskies extend their lead to 18-5 in the all-time series with Buffalo. First win at UB Stadium since 2011. UConn is now 2-0 against the Mid-American Conference this season and improve to 23-11 all-time against the league.

Huskies first scoring drive covered 93 yards and ended with Bell's 4th touchdown catch of the season. It marked the longest scoring drive of the season.

Cam Edwards third quarter touchdown run was his sixth of the season and his third-straight game with a touchdown. He has found the end zone in four of five games this season.

Running back Oliver Lundberg Coleman finished with career highs in carries, 5, and yards, 31, in the win.

Quarterback Joe Fagnano had the longest run of his career, a 38-yard jaunt in the third quarter. He finished with 64 yards on six carries, his highest total as a Husky.

Kicker Chris Freeman connected on a pair of field goals to make it seven-straight makes dating back to the Syracuse game.
