Event Information

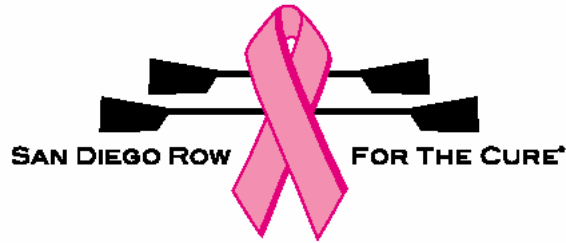

Event Directions:

- Coming from the north or south on Interstate 5, exit Sea World Drive and go west
- Follow the signs to the West Mission Bay Drive exit
- After you take the West Mission Bay Drive exit off of Sea World Drive, you will be on Ingraham Street
- Stay on Ingraham Street until you get to the signal at Vacation Road (if you get to the signal at Crown Point Drive/Rivera Street, you went too far)
- The entrance for the Paradise Point Resort will be on your left and the parking area for North Ski Beach will be on your right
- Turn right at Vacation Road, make an *immediate* left and follow the road around to the right to the parking area
- Look for a small shade structure, rowing shells, a crowd of people, tents, etc.
