TRITON UPDATES

THE WEEK AHEAD

On the heels of two runaway victories over the holiday weekend, the UC San Diego women's basketball team will begin defense of its 2009-10 California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season title against Cal State Monterey Bay and San Francisco State on the road this week. The Tritons will travel to Seaside to take on the Otters on Friday evening, before squaring off with the Gators in San Francisco on Saturday. Both contests will tipoff at 5:30 p.m.

ON THE RECORD

The Tritons enter conference play with an overall record of 2-5 after recording their first two victories of the season during the UCSD Thanksgiving Classic last week. UCSD absolutely dismantled Western New Mexico and Notre Dame de Namur in back-to-back games, winning by final margins of 90-55 and 94-54, respectively. The pair of wins put a stop to the Tritons' five-game skid to open the season, which was UCSD's worst mark through five games in Charity Elliott's four seasons as head coach.

NOW THAT'S MORE LIKE IT

After going 0-5 in five games outside of La Jolla, the Tritons found their mojo at home last weekend, defeating the Mustangs and Argonauts by an average of 37.5 points. UCSD shot the ball extremely well in the two games, finishing at a season-high 60% (34-57) from the field against Western New Mexico and 53% (36-68) in the matchup with NDNU. The Tritons were on target from three-point range all weekend as well, shooting a combined 46% (19-41) from behind the arc, while also dishing out a total of 50 assists on 70 field goals in the two games. The back-to-back 90-point performances marked the first time UCSD has accomplished the feat since scoring 90 in three straight in February of the 2005-06 campaign.

SCOUTING THE OTTERS AND GATORS

- Cal State Monterey Bay enters Friday's contest with a perfect overall record of 4-0 and a 1-0 CCAA mark after defeating San Francisco State 49-40 in a defensive struggle in both team's conference opener on November 24. The Otters, who will have had eight days off when they take the court against the Tritons, are averaging 66.8 points per game, while limiting the opposition to just 51.0. Junior guard Erika Ward is the team's leading scorer through four games at 10.5 points on 42% shooting. Senior guard Michelle Santizo has been a player to watch thus far as well, averaging 8.5 points, 2.8 rebounds and 3.5 assists. She is shooting 54% from the field. Cal State Monterey Bay was picked fifth in the CCAA coaches poll this season.

- San Francisco State begins the week in search of its first victory after falling to Monterey Bay in Seaside last week. The Gators, who currently stand at 0-3 overall and 0-1 in conference play, have struggled mightily from the floor, shooting a combined 29% through three games. SFSU's defense has done its part though, limiting all three opponents to 58 points or less on 32% shooting. Senior center Dominique Hunter is averaging team-highs of 9.3 points and 10.7 rebounds, while sophomore guard Nicole Hicks is putting up 8.0 points and 5.7 boards. SFSU was picked to finish ninth in the conference standings in 2010-11. The Gators will host Cal State East Bay on Friday night, before entertaining UCSD on Saturday.

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH CSUMB, SFSU

UCSD has won 11 of its 12 previous meetings with Cal State Monterey Bay and holds a 19-9 advantage in the all-time series with San Francisco State. The one loss to the Otters came last season, as UCSD suffered a 68-57 defeat in Seaside on February 20 after downing Monterey Bay 68-63 in the first meeting of the year on January 14 at RIMAC Arena. The Tritons swept the Gators in 2009-10, recording a 74-61 home victory on January 16 and then defeating SFSU 58-50 in San Francisco on February 19.

HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT

Charity Elliott enters her fourth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to three straight NCAA Division II West Regional appearances in her three years at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2010-11 campaign with career coaching mark of 132-111 (.543) and an impressive record of 77-20 (.794) at UCSD.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a fourth consecutive California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional, advancing to postseason play for the fifth straight season. UCSD drew Humboldt once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row last season and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Under Elliott's guidance, Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. The mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01 and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point – one shy of the program's longest streak – and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for her performance.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Division II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage. Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure. After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time since 2002-03.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist. She resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

CHELSEA LATELY

Junior point guard Chelsea Carlisle had another outstanding weekend for UCSD, leading the Tritons to their first two victories of the season. The Agoura Hills native averaged a team-high 16.5 points and 8.0 assists, while also grabbing 3.5 rebounds. Carlisle finished with a game-high 21 points in UCSD's rout of Western New Mexico, while also tallying three boards and seven assists. She had another tremendous performance the following night, finishing with 12 points, a season-high nine assists and four rebounds against Notre Dame de Namur. For the week, she shot 56.5% (13-23) from the field and converted 4-of-10 three-point tries, 40%. The 2009-10 First Team All-American enters Friday's contest averaging 18.6 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.4 assists through seven games. She is shooting a career-best 43% from the field.

THE WHITE STUFF

Freshman guard Elaina White earned the starting nod against Western New Mexico and Notre Dame de Namur last week and she came through in a big way, averaging 12.5 points on 69% shooting in the two games. She was also very effective from the three-point line, converting 5-of-7 attempts, 71%. After finishing with 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting in the win over the Mustangs on Friday, she came back to hit 5-of-6 shots -- including all three of her three-point tries -- for a season-high 15 points to help the Tritons down the Argonauts on Saturday. The Carlsbad native had scored a total of seven points in three games prior to last weekend.

CLASS OF THE CCAA

UCSD has been absolutely dominant in California Collegiate Athletic Association play since the beginning of the 2005-06 campaign, posting a stellar 88-16 (.846) record over the last five seasons. The Tritons finished with an impressive record of 19-3 on the way to a second consecutive regular season title last season, winning 19 games in CCAA play for the second year in a row. Head coach Charity Elliott has fared extremely well in conference play in her three seasons at UCSD, recording an impressive mark of 52-10 in 62 league games for a winning percentage of .839. The Tritons enter Friday's showdown with Cal State Monterey Bay having won 38 of their last 42 conference games spanning the last two seasons.

TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

After winning a fourth consecutive CCAA regular season title last season, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the league standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished with a record of 19-3 in CCAA play in 2009-10, received six first place votes and a total of 114 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the second year in a row. The Tritons narrowly beat out Chico State, which garnered four first place votes and 103 points to finish second, while Cal Poly Pomona was third with 89 points and Humboldt State finished fourth with 87. Cal State Monterey Bay totaled 82 points to claim fifth place, finishing two points in front of sixth place Cal State L.A., which received the remaining two first place votes.

QUICK HITS

UCSD enters Friday's contest averaging 78.9 points per game, a figure that leads the CCAA... The Tritons are shooting a season-best 42% from the field after last week's games... Defensively, UCSD is allowing 76.6 points per game on 47% shooting both of which rank last in the conference... The Tritons forced a total of 54 turnovers against Western New Mexico and Notre Dame de Namur last week... UCSD opponents are now averaging over 22 miscues per game... The Tritons are currently shooting a conference-best 79.6% from the free throw line... UCSD will take nine days off for final exams after this weekend's contests against Cal State Monterey Bay and San Francisco State... The Tritons will return to the court against Cal State East Bay on December 14 at RIMAC Arena.
