TRITON UPDATES

THE WEEK AHEAD

With a nine-day layoff for final exams under their belts, the UC San Diego women's basketball team will return to the court to face two of the bottom three teams in the California Collegiate Athletic Association standings this week. The Tritons will host winless Cal State East Bay on Tuesday night at 5:30 p.m., before entertaining nemesis Humboldt State on Saturday in a 12:30 p.m. start. Both games will be held at RIMAC Arena on the UCSD campus.

ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Tuesday's clash with Cal State East Bay with an overall record of 3-6 and a 1-1 mark in the CCAA after splitting two road games to kick off conference play December 4-5. The Tritons were on the short end of a frustrating 92-91 double overtime decision at Cal State Monterey Bay to begin the trip, but bounced back with a gritty 66-52 triumph over San Francisco State the following night. Head coach Charity Elliott's squad has won three of its last four after dropping five straight to open the season.

DEFENSE KEYS WIN OVER SFSU

UCSD's defense has had its struggles at times this season, but the Tritons were dialed in defensively in the 14-point win over San Francisco State. UCSD held SFSU to just 52 points on 36% (18-50) shooting from the field, which were both season-lows for an opponent. The Tritons forced a total of 29 turnovers and finished with 16 steals in the game, both high marks in 2010-11, as well. UCSD didn't have its best performance offensively, shooting just 40% (23-57) against SFSU, but the Tritons were able to pick up their first win away from home and they did it playing the Gators' kind of game. If they can replicate that performance on the defensive end this week, they should be in great shape.

SCOUTING THE PIONEERS AND LUMBERJACKS

• Cal State East Bay comes to town searching for its first victory of the season at 0-6 overall following a pair of losses to Dominican (53-46) and Academy of Art (66-56) at the CCAA/PacWest Challenge over the weekend. The Pioneers are 0-2 in conference play after dropping back-to-back games at San Francisco State (46-38) and Cal State Monterey Bay (56-38) December 3-4. Senior guard Claudia Nelson is averaging a team-high 10.2 points through six games, while sophomore forward Lauren Lucchesi is putting up 7.2 points and 4.3 rebounds. Sophomore Marlene MacMillian is the squad's leading rebounder at 9.0 boards per night to go with 4.7 points. Cal State East Bay currently ranks 11th in the CCAA averaging just 46.0 points per game, while the defense ranks fifth allowing 59.8.

• Humboldt State starts the week with an overall record of 3-4 after defeating Academy of Art (76-73) and Dominican (76-52) on its home floor during the CCAA/PacWest Challenge last weekend. The Lumberjacks are also winless in CCAA play at 0-3 following narrow losses to Chico State (64-62) and Cal State Stanislaus (81-78) December 3-4. Junior forward Bree Halsey has been a beast down low so far in 2010-11, averaging team-highs of 14.4 points and 10.9 rebounds, while frontcourt mate Jeanette Dewitt enters Sunday's matchup averaging 12.7 points and 7.1 boards. HSU ranks fourth in the conference offensively at 72.6 points per game, while the Lumberjack defense is surrendering 69.4, a figure that ranks ninth. The Lumberjacks will have had a full six days off when they arrive in La Jolla to play the Tritons on Sunday.

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH CSUEB, HSU

UCSD has won four out of five previous meetings with Cal State East Bay and holds a slim 7-6 edge in the all-time series with Humboldt State. The Tritons swept the Pioneers in their first official season as a member of the CCAA in 2009-10, picking up a 78-61 victory in Hayward on December 15 and then taking the rematch in La Jolla, 96-73, on February 16. UCSD didn't have nearly as much success against HSU last season, as the Lumberjacks dealt the Tritons three of their five losses on the year. After the two teams split the regular season series, Humboldt defeated UCSD in the CCAA Tournament Semifinals, 82-78, and then handed the Tritons a season-ending 76-72 loss in the NCAA West Regional First Round a week later in Seattle.

HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT

Charity Elliott enters her fourth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to three straight NCAA Division II West Regional appearances in her three years at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2010-11 campaign with career coaching mark of 132-111 (.543) and an impressive record of 77-20 (.794) at UCSD.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a fourth consecutive California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional, advancing to postseason play for the fifth straight season. UCSD drew Humboldt once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row last season and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Under Elliott's guidance, Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. The mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01 and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point -- one shy of the program's longest streak -- and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for her performance.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Division II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage. Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure. After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time since 2002-03.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist. She resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

CHELSEA LATELY

Chelsea Carlisle continued her recent tear two weeks ago, averaging 18.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 8.0 assists and 2.5 steals against Cal State Monterey Bay and San Francisco State. The junior point guard had a huge performance against the Otters on Friday, finishing with 23 points, four rebounds and seven assists in 49 minutes and then came back with 13 points, six boards and a season-high nine assists to lead UCSD past the Gators on Saturday. The 2009-10 First Team All-American enters Tuesday's matchup averaging 18.4 points, 4.8 rebounds, 5.2 assists and 2.1 steals through nine games this season. She leads the Tritons in scoring, assists, steals, free throw percentage (87%) and minutes per game (36.8).

FRONT AND CENTER

Junior center Lauren Freidenberg put together the best performance of her career in the double overtime loss to Cal State Monterey Bay on December 4, finishing with 27 points, eight rebounds, two blocks and three steals in 43 minutes. She was a very efficient 10-of-14 from the field and converted 7-of-9 attempts at the free throw line to shatter her previous scoring mark of 17 that came in UCSD's loss to Grand Canyon on November 14. Freidenberg is currently third on the team in scoring at 12.9 points per game, while leading the the Tritons in rebounding at just under seven per night. She is also leading the squad in field goal percentage at a career-best 57%.

THE WIZARD OF OSGA

Sophomore guard Emily Osga has been outstanding so far in 2010-11, averaging 14.3 points, 6.2 rebounds, 3.8 assists and 1.8 steals through UCSD's first nine games. She is one of three Tritons to have started all nine games this season and has scored in double figures in seven of the nine. Osga had a great start to conference play two weeks ago, posting averages of 16.0 points, 5.0 boards, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals as the Tritons split two games with Cal State Monterey Bay and San Francisco State. Her best game came against the Otters, when she finished with 18 points, five boards and three assists in a career-high 47 minutes. For the week, Osga converted 11-of-21 shots from the field, 52%, and hit 4-of-8 from the three-point line, 50%.

TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

After winning a fourth consecutive CCAA regular season title last season, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the league standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished with a record of 19-3 in CCAA play in 2009-10, received six first place votes and a total of 114 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the second year in a row. The Tritons narrowly beat out Chico State, which garnered four first place votes and 103 points to finish second, while Cal Poly Pomona was third with 89 points and Humboldt State finished fourth with 87. Cal State Monterey Bay totaled 82 points to claim fifth place, finishing two points in front of sixth place Cal State L.A., which received the remaining two first place votes.

QUICK HITS

UCSD enters Tuesday's clash averaging 78.8 points per game, a figure that leads the CCAA... The Tritons are shooting 42% from the field following the matchups with CSUMB and SFSU... Defensively, UCSD is allowing 75.6 points per game on 46% shooting, both of which rank last in the conference... The Tritons are allowing 53.7 points per game in their three wins and 86.5 in their six losses... UCSD also leads the CCAA in free throw percentage at 77.3%... The Tritons shot a total of 50 free throws against the Otters and Gators, converting 35 (70%)... After squaring off with Cal State East Bay and Humboldt State this week, UCSD will return to action after the holidays when Sonoma State pays a visit to RIMAC Arena on Thursday, December 30... Tipoff is scheduled for 5:30 p.m.
