TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Following a pair of tough home losses to Cal State San Bernardino and Cal Poly Pomona, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will hit the road looking to put an end to its current skid. The Tritons will travel to Rohnert Park to take on Sonoma State on Thursday evening, before squaring off with second place Humboldt State in Arcata on Saturday. As always, both games will follow the women's contests and tip-off at approximately 7:30 p.m.

FOR THE RECORD

UCSD heads to Northern California with an overall record of 9-9 and a 4-8 mark in California Collegiate Athletic Association play after falling to Cal State San Bernardino and Cal Poly Pomona by a combined three points last week. The Tritons lost a 60-59 heartbreaker with the Coyotes on Thursday and then came up short in a 54-52 decision with the defending national champion Broncos two nights later. Despite losing three straight and five of its last six, UCSD still sits in eighth place in the CCAA standings, entering the week in a three-way tie with Cal State Stanislaus and Sonoma State.

OH, SO CLOSE

The Tritons have played a lot of close games lately, with four of their previous five being decided by three points or less. While UCSD has gone just 1-4 over that stretch, the Tritons have been in a position to win all five. UCSD's lone victory during that period came in double overtime against Cal State L.A. on January 13 and the only game that was decided by more than three came against league-leader Cal State Dominguez Hills two nights later, when the Tritons cut a nine-point deficit down to 48-47 late in the second half, only to fall 57-49.

SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES AND LUMBERJACKS

- Sonoma State enters Thursday's matchup with an overall record of 6-10 and a 4-8 mark in the CCAA after losing at Cal State Dominguez Hills on Friday, but bouncing back with a 69-61 win at Cal State L.A. the following night. Currently tied with the Tritons for eighth place in the league standings, the Seawolves had lost four straight and six of seven before defeating the Golden Eagles on Saturday. Senior guard Ben Washington leads the team in scoring at 12.2 points per game on 49.6% shooting, while also hauling down 3.1 rebounds and dishing out 2.1 assists. Sophomore guard Will Olsem is another threat, averaging 9.6 points off the bench. He is Sonoma's top three-point shooter with 39 triples on the year. The Seawolves own the CCAA's second-ranked offense at 74.7 points per game, while the SSU defense is surrendering 74.7 as well, a figure that ranks 11th.

- After facing Sonoma on Thursday, UCSD will then face Humboldt State in Arcata on Saturday. The Lumberjacks enter the week with an overall record of 14-2 and an impressive 11-2 tally in conference play after splitting with Cal State L.A. and Cal State Dominguez Hills over the weekend. After defeating CSULA, 57-51, on Friday, Humboldt suffered a 76-59 setback at CSUDH on Saturday, falling a game behind the first place Toros in the conference standings. Senior forward Brian Morris is averaging team-highs of 18.7 points and 7.8 rebounds through 16 games this season, while also leading the Lumberjacks in field goal percentage at 58%. Morris currently ranks second in the CCAA in scoring and third in rebounding. Junior forward Randy Hunter is also having a fine season, averaging 15.3 points and 7.4 rebounds. Humboldt features the conference's top offense at 79.2 points per game, while the defense ranks eighth, holding the opposition to 67.9.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

UCSD trails the all-time series with Sonoma State, 16-10, and has won just three of 13 previous matchups with Humboldt State. The Tritons registered a 73-64 victory over the Seawolves on December 30 at RIMAC Arena earlier this season, but dropped a 67-57 decision with the Lumberjacks on December 19. Casey Ryan scored a career-high 28 points, grabbed nine rebounds and dished out five assists to lead UCSD past SSU.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON

Chris Carlson embarks on his fourth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2010-11. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 43-40 (.518) in three seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, which was the school's best mark since the 1998-1999 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the D-II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage, 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 last year, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes. Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn all-region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta, Calif. from 1991-93.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UCSB, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

CENTER OF ATTENTION

Center Christian Hatch has put together a tremendous junior campaign thus far. He enters Thursday's matchup with Sonoma State averaging a team-high 14.2 points to go with 7.0 rebounds per game. The Henderson, Nev. native is also shooting a team-high 54% from the field. He currently ranks seventh in the CCAA in scoring and sixth in rebounding. Hatch has scored in double figures nine times in the last 10 games, including both contests last week. He finished with 12 points and five boards in the loss to Cal State San Bernardino and then tallied 10 points and eight boards in a losing effort against Cal Poly Pomona.

SENIOR CITIZEN

Casey Ryan is the lone senior on the UCSD roster in 2010-11 and he is having his finest season yet, averaging career-highs of 12.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists through 18 games. He is shooting 42% from the field and has scored 10 or more in all but six games this season. The Jackson native turned in another great performance in the Tritons' one-point loss to Cal State San Bernardino last Thursday, finishing with a game-high 21 points on 6-of-11 shooting from the field. Ryan, who currently leads the CCAA in rebounding, also grabbed a team-high seven boards against the Coyotes.

SHARP SHOOTER

Sophomore guard Tyler McGrath came up big against defending national champion Cal Poly Pomona on Saturday, scoring a career-high 18 points in 26 minutes off the bench. He finished 5-of-12 from the floor, with all five of his field goals coming from behind the three-point arc, to lead all scorers. McGrath hit four triples and scored 15 points in the second half as UCSD rallied from 10 down to take 49-47 lead with four minutes to play. On the season, McGrath is averaging 8.5 points per game on 39% shooting. He leads the Tritons with a total of 26 threes.

TRITONS PICKED TO FINISH 11TH IN CCAA COACHES POLL

UCSD was selected to finish 11th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's preseason coaches poll that was released last month. The Tritons, who finished ninth in the conference last season at 7-15, received 21 points in the poll, 10 behind 10th place Cal State Monterey Bay. Defending national champion Cal Poly Pomona was picked to win the 2010-11 CCAA regular season title, receiving 10 first place votes and a total of 120 points. Cal State Dominguez Hills collected 100 points and earned one first place vote to finish second, while Cal State San Bernardino was third after garnering 98 points. Humboldt State, which earned the remaining first place vote, tallied 95 points to finish fourth, followed by Chico State (85), Sonoma State (69), Cal State Stanislaus (58), San Francisco State (52), Cal State L.A. (51), and Cal State Monterey Bay (31) coming in fifth through 10th, respectively. Cal State East Bay, which is not eligible for the conference title, finished 12th with 12 points.

QUICK HITS

UCSD was excellent defensively last week, limiting Cal State San Bernardino and Cal Poly Pomona to just 37.5% and 36% shooting from the field, respectively. The Tritons enter Thursday's contest ranked fourth in the CCAA in scoring defense (61.4) and fifth in field goal percentage defense (.403)... UCSD's struggles have come on the offensive end as the Tritons have shot below 40% from the field in six of their last seven games. The one exception was against CSUSB, when they shot 43.5%. UCSD currently ranks 10th in the conference in scoring offense (63.3) and seventh in field goal percentage (.417)... The Tritons have a record of 5-5 away from home in 2010-11, but they are just 2-4 in true road games. UCSD went 1-2 during a three-game road trip earlier this month...After squaring off with the Seawolves and Lumberjacks, the Tritons will return to La Jolla for four straight beginning with a matchup against San Francisco State on February 3.
