## TRITON UPDATES

### FIRST THINGS FIRST

After earning an 80-66 road victory over Academy of Art University on Saturday, the UC San Diego men's basketball team returns to La Jolla to host Cal State San Bernardino in its 2011-12 California Collegiate Athletic Association opener on Tuesday night at 7:00 p.m. Tuesday's contest will mark UCSD's first regular season appearance at RIMAC Arena, where the Tritons went 5-7 in 2010-11.

### ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Tuesday's clash with Cal State San Bernardino with an overall record of 3-1 after defeating Academy of Art over the weekend. The Tritons opened the season with a bang, claiming a second consecutive Disney West Coast Tip-Off Classic title after winning two out of three games in Anaheim Nov. 4-6. UCSD defeated Chestnut Hill College (102-74) and Dominican University (78-73), but lost a 78-68 decision to Western Washington during the three-day event. The Tritons have now started 3-1 two years in a row, matching the program's best record through four games in 11 seasons at the Division II level. UCSD won five of its first six games in 2010-11.

### TRITONS TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS AGAINST ART U

UCSD turned in a complete performance on Saturday, cruising to an 80-66 triumph over Academy of Art at Kezar Pavilion in San Francisco. The Tritons were in control for most of the game and used a decisive 12-0 second half run to turn a 43-39 deficit into a 51-43 lead with 12 minutes left to play. UCSD's lead ballooned to 70-55 with 5:24 left on the clock and the Urban Knights got no closer than 10 the rest of the way. The Tritons shot 52% (23-44) from the field and converted 5-of-9 from the three-point line, 56%, for the game. UCSD held a decisive 34-21 advantage on the glass and finished +19 at the free throw line. Academy of Art shot 48% (25-52) for the game.

### DIALED IN

The Tritons have shot the ball very well so far in 2011-12. After shooting 52.3% from the field on Saturday, UCSD is now shooting an even 52% (102-196) overall entering Tuesday's matchup with Cal State San Bernardino. The Tritons have shot better than 52% in all three of their victories, including a season-high 59% (33-56) in the season-opening win over Chestnut Hill on Nov. 4. UCSD is also shooting well from the three-point line so far this season, draining 49% (24-49) of its attempts from behind the arc. After shooting just 41% from the field as a team in 2010-11, the Tritons are off to a much better start in that department this season.

### BOARD GAMES

UCSD is getting the job done on the boards as well, outrebounding the opposition 153-94 through four games. The Tritons have won the rebounding battle in every game so far in 2011-12, finishing +11 or better in all four contests. UCSD recorded an average rebounding margin of +15.3 in its three games at the Disney Classic and finished +13 in the win over Academy of Art on Saturday. The Tritons are going to have to be an excellent rebounding team to be successful in 2011-12, so their performance on the boards so far bodes extremely well.

### HATCH CONTINUES HOT START

Senior center Christian Hatch had another monster game on Saturday, finishing with 23 points and 11 rebounds to lead UCSD past Academy of Art. He converted 7-of-15 shots from the field and sank 9-of-13 at the free throw line en route to his second 20-point effort in four games this season. Hatch had a big opening weekend for the Tritons as well, averaging 20.0 points and 7.3 rebounds at the Disney West Coast Tip-Off Classic. He shot just under 57% (21-37) from the field and 18-of-23 at the foul line, earning tournament Most Valuable Player honors for his performance. The Henderson, Nev. native enters Tuesday's contest averaging team-highs of 20.8 points and 8.3 rebounds, while shooting 54% (28-52) from the field. Hatch has led the Tritons in scoring in all four of their games this season.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### JUST BRUE IT

Junior forward Justin Brue had a big game as well on Saturday, finishing with a season-high 18 points, three rebounds, two assists and two blocks in the win over Academy of Art. The Hayward, Calif. native hit 4-of-6 shots from the field and converted 10 of his 13 free throws to help the Tritons down the Urban Knights for the second year in a row. Brue currently ranks third on the team in scoring and second in rebounding, averaging 11.5 points and 6.5 boards per game. He is shooting 54% from the field.

### SCOUTING THE COYOTES

Cal State San Bernardino enters Tuesday's matchup with a 1-0 record after defeating Westmont College, 70-66, in its season-opener on Saturday, Nov. 12. Senior forward Theron Laudermill scored 18 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for the Coyotes, while sophomore guard Juan Martinez finished with 14 points off the bench and Tre' Brewer added 12. CSUSB shot just 40% (22-48) from the field, but held a 37-22 advantage on the glass and finished +13 at the free throw line in the win... The Coyotes were picked to finish second in the league standings this season after posting an overall record of 17-10 and placing third in the CCAA at 15-7 in 2010-11.

### HEAD-TO-HEAD

UCSD trails the all-time series with Cal State San Bernardino 25-15 after dropping both contests with the Coyotes last season. CSUSB escaped RIMAC Arena with a narrow 60-59 win in the first meeting of the year on Jan. 20, before defeating the Tritons, 76-72, in the regular season finale on Feb. 25 in San Bernardino. UCSD's last win over CSUSB came on February 14, 2009, a 69-63 victory in La Jolla.

### UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department recently announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. Beginning with Tuesday's clash with Cal State San Bernardino, ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.

### UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released last month. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote. Cal Poly Pomona tallied 89 points to finish fourth, followed by Cal State L.A. (77), Cal State Stanislaus (74), Chico State (70), Sonoma State (53) and San Francisco State (47) in fifth through ninth places, respectively.

## HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



**C**hris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.
