TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

The UC San Diego men's basketball team will open the 2011-12 regular season this weekend at the Disney West Coast Tip-Off Classic in Anaheim. The Tritons will begin the four-team event against Chestnut Hill (PA) on Friday at 5:00 p.m., before squaring off with Western Washington on Saturday and Dominican on Sunday at 2:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m., respectively. All three games will be played at the Anaheim Convention Center, which is located near Disneyland at 800 West Katella Avenue in Anaheim. After this weekend's tournament, the Tritons will face CalTech in a scrimmage on Nov. 13 at 1:00 p.m. at RIMAC Arena, before resuming non-conference play at Academy of Art University on Nov. 19.

TRITONS EYE SECOND CONSECUTIVE DISNEY CLASSIC CROWN

UCSD will be looking to capture a second consecutive Disney West Coast Tip-Off Classic title when it heads to Anaheim this weekend. The Tritons went 2-1 at the Disney Classic to begin the 2010-11 season, defeating Lewis University 70-59 and Dixie State 65-57, before dropping a 67-52 decision to Alaska Anchorage on the final day of the event. Despite the loss to the Seawolves, UCSD was crowned the champion by virtue of its victory over Lewis, which also went 2-1 in three games in Anaheim. The Tritons shot the ball extremely well in the tournament, converting 45% (61-137) of their attempts from the field overall.

UCSD FACES PAIR OF TOUGH PRESEASON TESTS

The Tritons enter the regular season after facing a pair of Division I opponents in exhibition play over the past week. UCSD opened its preseason slate against defending WAC Champion Utah State on Oct. 28 and then traveled to Berkeley for a matchup with Pac-12 power California on Nov. 2. The Tritons had their hands full in both contests, falling 74-42 to the Aggies and 88-53 to the Golden Bears, but the experience should prove to be beneficial for UCSD going forward. The Tritons didn't shoot particularly well in either contest, converting just 30.6% of their shots against Utah State and 31.3% against Cal, but they held their own on the glass, finishing with a combined 67 boards in the two games. Sophomore guard MacKenzie McCullough averaged 10.5 points and 4.0 rebounds off the bench for the Tritons, while senior center Christian Hatch averaged 10 points and six boards. UCSD was without two of its starters in both games as Justin Brue and James McCann sat out with injuries.

2010-11 AT A GLANCE

Despite an impressive start, UCSD finished with an overall record of 11-17 in 2010-11, missing the postseason for the third consecutive year. The Tritons won five of their first six games to open the season -- the program's best start at the NCAA Division II level -- and stood at 8-4 on January 3 after going 3-3 in its first six games in California Collegiate Athletic Association play. UCSD hit a rough patch after that, dropping seven out of its next eight, and recorded just three more wins in the ultra-competitive CCAA. UCSD wrapped up the year with a 6-16 conference record, finishing 11th in the league standings.

WELCOME BACK!

The Triton coaching staff has high expectations in 2011-12 as UCSD welcomes back four starters and 10 letterwinners this season. Highlighting the list of returnees is senior center Christian Hatch, who was the Tritons' leading scorer at 14.5 points per game a year ago, while ranking second in rebounding at 6.7. The Henderson, Nev. native also shot a team-high 50% (143-286) from the field. Also returning is junior forward Justin Brue, who had a breakout season as a sophomore last year. A native of Hayward, Calif., Brue averaged 9.2 points and 4.9 rebounds in 28 games, while leading the squad in blocked shots with 24. Sophomore point guard James McCann will look to build off a stellar rookie campaign in which he was named the CCAA Freshman of the Year after averaging 9.7 points and a team-high 2.9 assists. The Tritons will also have the services of guard/forward Dylan Bohanan after he missed last season with a hip injury. Bohanan averaged 4.3 points and 1.5 rebounds in 25 games as a freshman in 2009-10.

SCOUTING THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

Chestnut Hill College of Philadelphia went 12-16 overall and finished with an 8-9 mark in the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference (CACC) in 2010-11. Among the Griffins' top returners is senior guard Dan Comas, who averaged team-highs of 16.2 points and 10.0 rebounds last season. Backcourt mate Brandon Williams is also back after putting up 11.8 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.4 assists in 2010-11... Western Washington lost just one starter from last year's team that went 16-11 and placed fourth in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference (GNAC) at 11-7. Junior guard John Allen is the Vikings' player to watch, returning after averaging team-highs of 14.3 points, 4.1 assists and 1.7 steals last season. He was an All-GNAC Second Team honoree. WWU, which heads to Anaheim on the heels of an 81-68 exhibition victory over Victoria, B.C. on Oct. 29, was picked to finish third in the GNAC standings this season... Dominican University went 4-22 in 2010-11 and finished with a 4-12 mark in the Pacific West Conference. Junior center Killian Larson is the Penguins' top returner in 2011-12 after averaging a team-highs of 12.9 points and 6.7 rebounds a year ago. Dominican, which previously competed in the NAIA before joining the PacWest three years ago, was granted full Division II status for this season.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

Friday's contest will mark the first ever meeting between UCSD and Chestnut Hill. The Tritons are 0-1 all-time against Western Washington after dropping a 78-76 decision way back on Dec. 29, 1981, and lost their only previous meeting with Dominican as well, suffering a narrow 75-73 defeat on Jan. 8, 2000.

HATCH AMONG LEAGUE'S BEST

Christian Hatch was one of the elite centers in the conference last season and he earned a spot on the All-CCAA Second Team to back it up. In addition to leading the Tritons in scoring and field goal percentage, he recorded a team-high nine double-doubles and scored in double figures a total of 22 times in 2010-11. Hatch ranked seventh in the CCAA in scoring, sixth in rebounding and 13th in field goal percentage. He racked up 26 points and 13 boards to lead the Tritons to a thrilling double-overtime victory over Cal State L.A. on January 13 and scored a career-high 28 points on 11-of-16 shooting in a losing effort against Cal State Stanislaus on February 10.

UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released last Thursday. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote. Cal Poly Pomona tallied 89 points to finish fourth, followed by Cal State L.A. (77), Cal State Stanislaus (74), Chico State (70), Sonoma State (53) and San Francisco State (47) in fifth through ninth places, respectively.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



Chris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

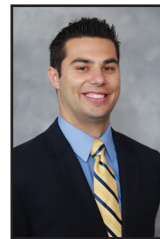
