TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

After suffering a narrow 66-63 double overtime loss to Cal State San Bernardino in its California Collegiate Athletic Association opener last Tuesday, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will look to bounce back against Cal State Dominguez Hills and Cal State L.A. on the road this weekend. The Tritons will take on the Toros on Friday in Carson, before traveling to Los Angeles to face the Golden Eagle on Saturday. Both contests will tip-off at approximately 7:30 p.m. and air of ESPN Radio 1700 in San Diego. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton Basketball, will have the call.

ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Friday's clash with Cal State Dominguez Hills with an overall record of 3-2 and an 0-1 mark in CCAA play following the narrow defeat to Cal State San Bernardino last week. The Tritons entered conference play with a head of steam after winning three of their first four games to open the season, but came up short against the rival Coyotes, losing their CCAA opener for the third year in a row. After dropping three of its first four league games in 2010-11, UCSD will look to pick up a pair of critical road wins this weekend.

LATE RUN DOOMS TRITONS AGAINST CSUSB

UCSD gave Cal State San Bernardino all it could handle in both team's CCAA opener last week, but the Coyotes made enough plays down the stretch to escape with a 66-63 double overtime win. UCSD led 63-59 with 2:20 left in the second OT, but CSUSB scored five points at the free throw line and Kwame Alexander converted the winning bucket with 18 seconds remaining to make the difference. The Tritons held a 30-22 halftime lead, but the Coyotes opened the second half on a 17-4 run to take a 39-34 advantage and neither team led by more than four points the rest of the way. CSUSB shot 41% (26-64) from the field, while UCSD finished at a 35% (24-69) clip. The Coyotes held a slim 45-42 rebounding advantage and outscored the Tritons 34-28 in the paint. The loss marked UCSD's fifth consecutive defeat at the hands of Cal State San Bernardino.

FRONT AND CENTER

Senior center Christian Hatch has been outstanding so far this season, averaging team-highs of 18.8 points and 9.6 rebounds through five games. The Henderson, Nev. native is shooting 48.5% from the field, having converted 32 of his 66 shots from the floor, and 75% at the free throw line, dropping 30-of-40 attempts at the stripe. He had an outstanding performance in the loss to Cal State San Bernardino last week, tallying his second straight double-double with 11 points and a career-high 15 boards in 43 minutes. That came after a 23-point, 11-rebound effort in UCSD's 80-66 win at Academy of Art on Nov. 19. An All-CCAA Second Team selection last season, Hatch has led the Tritons in scoring in four out of five games thus far. He has a total of 15 double-doubles for his career.

YOU MIGHT WANT TO GUARD ME

Junior guard Tyler McGrath had his best game of the season against Cal State San Bernardino last week, finishing with season-highs of 15 points and seven rebounds in a game-high 44 minutes. The Camarillo, Calif. native converted 5-of-11 shots from the field and sank 3-of-8 from behind the three-point line to lead four players in double figures for the Tritons. He currently ranks second on the team in scoring and third in rebounding, averaging 11.4 points and 5.2 boards, respectively, while shooting an even 50% (18-36) from the floor through UCSD's first five games. With 12 threes made on the year, McGrath is also the Tritons' primary outside threat. He is shooting 44% from downtown.

SCOUTING THE TOROS

• Cal State Dominguez Hills enters Friday's matchup with an 0-2 record and an 0-1 mark in CCAA play after dropping a 74-68 decision at Division I University of the Pacific on Nov. 21... The Toros faced Cal State L.A. in their season-opener on Nov. 16 and suffered a 73-58 defeat at the hands of the Golden Eagles in Los Angeles... Senior guard Cornell Jenkins is leading the team in scoring through two games, averaging 16.0 points on 44% shooting, while backcourt mate Van Girard II is averaging 10.5 points and a team-high 7.5 rebounds... Offensively, CSUDH is putting up 63.0 points per game, while the Toro defense is surrendering 73.5 on the other end... The Toros were tabbed to finish third in the CCAA standings by the league's coaches after posting an overall record of 16-12 and finishing second in the conference at 16-6 in 2010-11.

• UCSD holds a slim 17-15 advantage in the all-time series with Cal State Dominguez Hills after splitting two games with CSUDH in 2010-11... The Toros won the first meeting, 57-49, on Jan. 15 in La Jolla, but the Tritons came out on top in the rematch, claiming a 61-59 victory on Feb. 18 in Carson.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES

• Cal State L.A. begins the week with an overall record of 4-0 and a 1-0 tally in CCAA play following a 75-56 victory over Cal Baptist on Saturday... Junior center Carl Hoffman is averaging team-highs of 14.8 points and 8.3 rebounds through the Golden Eagles' first four games, while senior guard Ryan Wetherell is putting 11.0 points and 3.5 assists... As a team, CSULA is scoring 82.8 points per game, while the defense is holding the opposition to just 52.8... Cal State L.A. defeated Cal State Dominguez Hills 73-58 in both team's CCAA opener on Nov. 16... The Golden Eagles outscored the Toros 45-28 in the second half of that contest to pull away... CSULA was picked to finish fifth in the CCAA regular season standings after going 15-13 overall and placing sixth in the conference at 10-12 a year ago... The Golden Eagles will host Cal State San Bernardino on Friday, before UCSD comes to town on Saturday.

• UCSD leads the all-time series with Cal State L.A. by a narrow 13-11 margin after splitting two games with the Golden Eagles last season... The Tritons won the first meeting, 76-73, in double overtime on Jan. 13 at RIMAC, but the Golden Eagles claimed the rematch, recording a 64-62 victory five weeks later in L.A.

QUICK HITS

• UCSD is currently averaging 78.2 points per game offensively, a figure that ranks sixth in the CCAA... The Tritons averaged 82.0 points in their first four games of the season before scoring a season-low 63 in the loss to Cal State San Bernardino... UCSD is shooting 47.5% from the field in 2011-12, which also ranks sixth in the conference... The Tritons have shot better than 52% from the field in all three of their victories this season... Last week's setback to CSUSB marked the first time UCSD has been out-rebounded this season... The Tritons enter Friday's contest with a rebounding margin of +11.2... The Tritons will take seven days off for final exams following this weekend's contests... UCSD will return to the court on Sunday, Dec. 11 for a nonconference matchup with Dixie State at 1:00 p.m. at RIMAC Arena.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



Chris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote.

UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department last month announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.
