## TRITON UPDATES

### WHAT'S ON TAP

After cruising to a resounding 70-45 triumph over Cal State San Bernardino at home earlier this week, the UC San Diego women's basketball team will travel to San Bernardino to wrap up its home-and-home series with the Coyotes on Monday. The Tritons will be looking to sweep the season series with CSUSB, while also trying to build on their current nine-game winning streak before taking nine days off over the holidays. Tip-off is slated for 5:30 p.m. at Coussoulis Arena on the Cal State San Bernardino campus.

### FOR THE RECORD

UCSD enters Monday's rematch with Cal State San Bernardino sporting a flawless 9-0 overall record and a 3-0 mark in California Collegiate Athletic Association play after routing the Coyotes on Monday at RIMAC. The Tritons scored the first 10 points of the game and never looked back, rolling to yet another comfortable victory, this one by 25 points. UCSD has started the season 9-0 for the second time in three years, having also accomplished the feat in 2009-10. Head coach Charity Elliott's squad won its first 14 games that year, suffering its first defeat on Jan. 21 at Humboldt State. The Tritons are 6-0 away from home so far in 2011-12, going 3-0 in true road games and 3-0 in neutral site contests.

### POLL POSITION

UCSD is ranked No. 4 in the current *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll, moving up one spot this week after coming in at No. 5 the previous two weeks. The Tritons began the season at No. 13 in the poll and have climbed a total of nine spots after winning nine straight to begin the year. UC San Diego hasn't been ranked this high since December of the 2007-08 campaign (Charity Elliott's first season), when the squad earned a No. 3 ranking with a record of 8-0. The Tritons were ranked as high as No. 11 nationally in 2010-11.

### DON'T FORGET ABOUT THE D

While the Triton offense has been a thing of beauty this season, putting up 78.1 points on 46% shooting through nine games, it was UCSD's defense that really got after it in the win over Cal State San Bernardino on Monday. The Tritons held the Coyotes to just 45 points on 29% (16-56) shooting, which were both low marks for a UCSD opponent this season. The Tritons also hauled down a season-best 51 rebounds in the game, finishing +22 on the boards, and forced the Coyotes into a total of 20 turnovers, leading to 19 points on the other end. UCSD currently leads the CCAA in several offensive categories, including scoring offense, field goal percentage and assists per game, but the defense has definitely played a role in the team's early success as well.

### OUT IN FRONT

UCSD has been absolutely dominant so far in 2011-12, winning its first nine games by an average over 21.0 points per game. The Tritons currently lead the CCAA and rank 13th in the nation in scoring margin, having outscored the opposition 78.1 to 56.7 to this point. As those numbers suggest, UCSD has won all nine of its games comfortably, with its lowest margin of victory coming in the 80-65 win over then-No. 4 Fort Lewis on Nov. 26. That's right, a 15-point win over the fourth-ranked team in the country! The Tritons, who have still yet to trail in the second half of any game this season, have won five contests by over 20 points, including their first three games in CCAA play. UCSD led by as many as 31 points in its 70-45 triumph over Cal State San Bernardino on Monday.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### CHELSEA LATELY

Senior point guard Chelsea Carlisle is off to a brilliant start to the season, averaging 16.8 points, 4.6 rebounds, 5.6 assists and 2.8 steals through UCSD's first nine games. She is shooting 56% (60-108) from the field overall and has hit 38% (13-34) of her three-point tries. A two-time All-American, Carlisle currently leads the team in several categories, including scoring, assists, steals, field goals made, three-pointers made and minutes per game. She has scored in double figures in every game this season and has reached the 20-point mark on two occasions. The Agoura Hills, Calif. native had another strong effort in UCSD's win over Cal State San Bernardino on Monday, finishing with 13 points, three boards, four assists, a blocked shot and a steal. She finished 5-of-7 from the field and connected on her only attempt from behind the arc.

### GIMME THE ROCK

Senior center Lauren Freidenberg had her best game of the season to lead the Tritons to a convincing 70-45 win over Cal State San Bernardino. The Seattle native recorded her first double-double of the year, finishing with game-highs of 19 points and 12 rebounds in just 26 minutes. She finished 7-of-8 from the field and sank all five of her free throws to reach double figures for the seventh time in nine games. For the season, Freidenberg is averaging 14.1 points and hauling down 6.9 rebounds per game, which both rank second on the squad. She is shooting a team-high 59.6% (53-89) from the field. Freidenberg was named the ucstdtritons.com Female Athlete of the Week for her performance.

### COYOTE SEASON

Cal State San Bernardino enters Monday's contest with an overall record of 2-5 after losing a 71-65 decision to San Diego Christian College at home on Wednesday... The Coyotes dropped to 1-2 in CCAA play following last week's loss to the Tritons and currently sit in a three-way tie for seventh place in the conference standings... Senior guard Eliza Dy is averaging team-highs of 11.7 points and 3.3 assists through seven games, while backcourt mate Angela Streets is putting up 11.6 points and grabbing 4.3 rebounds... Junior forward Kristen Huffman is the team's leading rebounder, hauling down 7.1 boards per night... San Bernardino is averaging 54.0 points per game offensively, while the defense is surrendering 60.9... UCSD holds a 23-8 lead in the all-time series with CSUSB following Monday's victory.

### LAST TIME VS. CSUSB

UCSD jumped all over Cal State San Bernardino in Monday's matchup, racing out to a quick 10-0 lead and extending its advantage to 19-4 with eight minutes left to play in the first half. The Tritons' lead ballooned to 42-17 at halftime and they led by as many as 31 in the waning moments of the 70-45 victory. Lauren Freidenberg finished with game-highs of 19 points and 12 rebounds and Chelsea Carlisle scored 13 to pace UCSD, which shot 48% (29-60) from the field. Eliza Dy scored 18 points on 8-of-20 shooting, but no other player finished with more than seven for the Coyotes. UCSD held CSUSB to just 29% shooting from the field.

### QUICK HITS

UCSD has won seven of the last nine regular season meetings with Cal State San Bernardino dating back to the 2007-08 season... In addition to leading the CCAA in scoring offense (79.1), field goal percentage (.464) and assists per game (17.4), the Tritons also rank first in rebounding offense (42.4), rebounding margin (+6.8), turnover margin (+6.88) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.1)... UCSD ranks sixth in the league in scoring defense, allowing 56.7 points per game... The Tritons are currently navigating the slowest part of their schedule, playing just twice in a span of 25 days... Following Monday's matchup in San Bernardino, UCSD will not return to the court until Dec. 29 when San Francisco State pays a visit to RIMAC Arena.

## HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT



Charity Elliott enters her fifth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to NCAA Division II West Regional appearances three out of her first four seasons at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2011-12 campaign with a career coaching mark of 152-122 (.555) and an impressive record of 97-31 (.758) at UCSD.

Elliott has been one of the most successful coaches in program history, leading the Tritons to four consecutive 20 win seasons and two California Collegiate Athletic Association Championships. 2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. That mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01

and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point -- one shy of the program's longest streak -- and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year at the end of the season.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA D-II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage.

Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades, as well. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a second consecutive CCAA regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons advanced to postseason play for the fifth straight season, earning a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional. UCSD drew Humboldt State once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row in 2009-10 and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a WBCA State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

The Tritons got off to a rocky start in 2010-11, losing their first five games of the season, but Elliott's squad quickly got things turned around and finished with an overall record of 20-11 and league tally of 17-5. UCSD was awarded the No. 3 seed in the CCAA Tournament and, after knocking off Chico State in the opening round, saw its season come to a close with a narrow 78-75 loss to rival Cal Poly Pomona. Carlisle was again selected as an All-American, earning honorable mention honors from the WBCA.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure.

After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time in three years.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

She has also served in an assistant capacity with Southwest Baptist, Southwest Missouri State (her alma mater) and San Diego State (under head coach Beth Burns in 1993-94).

Elliott began her collegiate basketball career at Rice University, where she played for two seasons. She averaged 16 points per game as a sophomore before transferring to Southwest Missouri State (now Missouri State). While at SMS, Elliott guided the Bears to a 31-3 record and the program's first-ever Final Four appearance as a senior in 1992. An integral part of one of the most successful teams in program history, she ranked in the top 10 nationally in free throw percentage and was named SMS' Woman of the Year at the end of the 1991-92 season. The Bears posted a 57-8 record during her two-year career with the program.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott, who also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist, resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

### UCSD INKS TWO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

UCSD signed two high school seniors to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. Coach Elliott announced on Monday, November 21. Leeann Alferness, a 6-0 center from Novato, and Taylor Hirz, a 6-2 center from Santa Ana, will join the Tritons as true freshmen in 2012-13. A standout at San Marin High School in Novato, Alferness led the Marin County Athletic League in scoring and rebounding as a junior, while Hirz led Foothill High School to the second round of the CIF-SS playoffs and is a standout with Cal Swish.

### TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

With all five starters returning in 2011-12, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the CCAA standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released last month. UCSD, which finished third in the conference with a 17-5 record last season, received eight first place votes and a total of 116 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the third year in a row. Cal Poly Pomona garnered one first place vote and 98 points to finish second, while Chico State came in third with 97 points and defending CCAA regular season champion Cal State Monterey Bay was fourth with two first place votes and 94 points. Humboldt State earned the remaining first place vote and a total of 85 points to finish fifth.
