TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

After taking nine days off from competition over the holidays, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will return to the court this week when San Francisco State and undefeated Cal Poly Poly invade RIMAC Arena. The Tritons will host the Gators on Thursday evening before welcoming the Broncos to town on Friday. Both contests will follow the women's games, with tip-off slated for approximately 7:30 p.m. The SFSU and CPP clashes will be broadcast live on ESPN Radio 1700 in San Diego with Craig Elsten calling the action and Jack Cronin handling the color commentary duties.

ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Thursday's tilt with San Francisco State with an overall record of 4-5 and an 0-4 mark in CCAA play after dropping a 71-63 decision at Cal State San Bernardino in its last game on Dec. 19. The Tritons suffered their second loss to the Coyotes in the last five games, having also fallen to CSUSB, 66-63, in double overtime on Nov. 22 in La Jolla. UCSD, which currently finds itself at the bottom of the CCAA standings, will look to capture its first league win against SFSU, the only other team without a victory in conference play so far this season. Head coach Chris Carlson's squad has gone 1-1 in two home games so far in 2011-12, defeating Dixie State in a nonconference matchup on Dec. 11 after losing its CCAA opener to San Bernardino last month.

BIG SECOND HALF RUN DOOMS UCSD AGAINST CSUSB

UCSD held the lead for much of the first half against Cal State San Bernardino last week, taking a 27-21 advantage with just under five minutes to play in the period and then leading 31-28 at the half. Things turned quickly in the second half, however, as the Coyotes outscored the Tritons 18-3 over the first nine minutes to take a 46-34 lead. UCSD scored eight straight points to pull within five at 53-48 with 5:46 left to play, but CSUSB answered with a 10-0 run to take its biggest lead of the night and put the game away. Nate Roth scored 20 points and dished out eight assists to lead the Coyotes, while Christian Hatch finished with 20 points and 10 boards in a losing effort for the Tritons. Cal State San Bernardino shot 46% (24-52) from the field, while UCSD shot at a 43% (22-51) clip. The loss marked the Tritons' sixth consecutive defeat at the hands of the Coyotes.

SHOOT TO WIN

As mentioned in the previous paragraph, UCSD shot just 43% in the 71-63 setback to Cal State San Bernardino on Dec. 19. That's worth bringing up a second time because the loss dropped the Tritons' record to 0-5 when they shoot less than 50% from the field this season. UCSD has shot the ball extremely well in its four wins this year, finishing better than 51% from the floor in each game. The Tritons -- who have shot better than 50% from the floor just once in their previous five games, going 1-4 in that span -- are currently shooting 45.6% from the field overall this season, a figure that ranks sixth in the CCAA. Nine games in, it's clear that UCSD has to shoot the ball well to be successful.

NEWS AND NOTES

LEADING MAN

Senior center Christian Hatch has put together a great start to the season, averaging team-highs of 15.9 points and 8.2 rebounds through nine games. The Henderson, Nev. native is shooting 53% (52-98) from the field and has scored in double figures seven times in 2011-12. Hatch was outstanding in UCSD's loss to Cal State San Bernardino on Dec. 19, finishing with game-highs of 20 points and 10 rebounds for his third double-double of 2011-12. He converted nine of his 13 attempts from the field and went 2-of-4 at the free throw line to reach the 20-point mark for the third time this season. Hatch has now led the Tritons in scoring in six of the team's nine games. He was named the ucsdtritons.com Male Athlete of the Week on Monday for his performance.

SHARP SHOOTER

Junior guard Tyler McGrath had one of his best outings of the year against Cal State San Bernardino last week, finishing with a season-high 17 points, while also tallying three rebounds and two steals in 31 minutes. The Camarillo, Calif. native finished 4-of-9 from the field, including 3-of-5 from behind the three-point line, and sank all six of his free throws to reach double figures for the fifth time in 2011-12. That performance came on the heels of a 16-point, seven-rebound, three-assist effort in UCSD's 81-67 win over Dixie State on Dec. 11. For the season, McGrath is averaging 11.6 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.4 assists in 31.0 minutes per game. He is shooting 44% from the field and 42% from behind the arc and leads the Tritons with 18 three pointers made.

SCOUTING THE GATORS

San Francisco State enters Thursday's contest with an overall record of 2-7 and an 0-3 mark in CCAA play... The Gators haven't played since Dec. 3 when they dropped an 82-65 home decision to Cal State Stanislaus... Junior guard Nefi Perdomo and junior forward James Albright are both averaging 14.9 points through nine games... Perdomo is also dishing out a team-high 5.2 assists, while Albright is shooting 53% from the field and hauling down 4.7 rebounds... SFSU ranks seventh in the CCAA, averaging 70.6 points per game offensively, while the defense is surrendering 77.9, a figure that ranks last... UCSD holds a 13-10 advantage in the all-time series with San Francisco State after splitting two games with the Gators in 2011-12.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS

Cal Poly Pomona begins the week with a flawless overall record of 6-0 and a 3-0 tally in conference play... The Broncos' last game was on Dec. 15, a resounding 96-48 triumph over Pacifica College in Pomona... Junior guard Mitchel Anderson leads three players scoring in double figures for the Coyotes at 13.3 points per game... Sophomore guard Terrence Drisdorn is putting up 10.3... Cal Poly Pomona is averaging 69.0 points per game offensively, a figure that ranks ninth in the CCAA, while the Bronco defense has been much better, allowing just 54.3, second best in the league... The Tritons trail the all-time series with the Broncos 19-8 after dropping both meetings with CPP last season... The Broncos will square off with Cal State San Bernardino on Thursday before traveling to La Jolla to face UCSD on Friday.

QUICK HITS

UCSD currently ranks eighth in the CCAA in scoring offense, averaging 69.9 points per game... Defensively, the Tritons rank sixth, holding their opponents to 67.4... UCSD is the fourth-ranked rebounding squad in the conference, bringing down 35.4 boards per night... The Tritons have averaged 85.2 points in their four wins this season and just 57.6 in their five losses... UCSD has lost 10 of its last 11 CCAA games dating back to last season... The Tritons will play six of their next eight games at home beginning with this weekend's matchups against San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona... Following the games this week, UCSD will travel to Cal State Stanislaus and Chico State Jan. 6-7.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



Chris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote.

UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department last month announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.
