#### WOLVERINES TOO PESKY FOR TRITONS IN HOME FINALE

UCSD took an early lead against No.6 Michigan at home on Saturday on Sarah Lizotte's goal just 1:20 in, but three consecutive goals from the Wolverines would force the Tritons to play from behind most of the afternoon. Melissa Bartow and Kirsten Bates scored consecutive goals to bring the score to 3-3 heading into the second quarter. UCSD added another goal with a man-advantage, but Michigan would out-score the host 3-1 in the second to take a 6-4 lead into halftime. Orozco opened the scoring in the second half with UCSD's third 6-on-5 score, but Lauren Orth matched her to keep a two-goal lead heading into the final stanza. Down by four, consecutive goals within 35 seconds by Bates and Lizotte brought the Tritons to back with two with just over five minutes remaining. However, Cara Reitz scored back-to-back goals to put the game out of reach, 11-7. The loss marked the second time UCSD had fell to Michigan in 2011. The Wolverines defeated the Tritons, 11-8, in UCSD's first match of the season at the UCSB Winter Invite. UCSD set a new team-high in 2011 with 15 ejections drawn.

#### MAKE IT TWO!

UCSD will own the WWPA's second seed when it heads of for the WWPA Championships Apr. 29-May 1, hosted by Cal State East Bay at Chabot Community College, it was announced Tuesday morning. The Tritons went 9-1 against WWPA opponents this season, trailing only No. 8 Loyola Marymount, who was 11-0 and earned the No. 1 seed. Santa Clara earned the third seed while Colorado State was named the fourth seed. The rest of the 2011 seedings are No. 5 CSUEB, No. 6 Sonoma State, No. 7 Cal State Bakersfield, No. 8 Cal State Monterey Bay and No. 9 Cal State San Bernardino. UCSD will open WWPA Championships play on Friday at 1:30 p.m. against Cal State Bakersfield. UCSD defeated CSUB twice this year, 13-10 and 14-11 on February 27 and March 11, respectively. The UCSD-CSUB winner will face the winner of Santa Clara-Sonoma State at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday. This is the second consecutive year the Tritons have earned the No. 2 seed for the WWPA Championships. In 2010, UCSD rode the two-seed for wins over Sonoma State and Colorado State before falling to LMU, 13-10, in the title match.

#### HARPER CUP

UCSD plays its final regular season game Friday afternoon at No. 9 San Diego State (19-12) in the annual Harper Cup. The rivalry, recognizing the influence of current UCSD Men's Coach Denny Harper on the development of both programs, has been decidedly one-sided with the Aztecs winning each of the 10 previous encounters. In the only match between the squads this season on March 25 in Hawaii, Melissa Bartow and Felicia Orozco scored a pair of goals and Kirsten Bates and Hanalei Crowell dished-out three assists, respectively, but the Tritons fell short, 10-6. UCSD was 4-for-12 in 6-on-5 situations, while SDSU converted two of its three situations with a man-advantage. The Aztecs are coming off consecutive losses to No. 2 UCLA and No. 3 Cal and have not won a match since taking three matches in a row from Arizona State, Fresno Pacific and Brown on Apr. 1-2. Leanne Ford and Meaghan Poland lead SDSU with 52 and 43 goals, respectively. SDSU went 3-1 at February 12-13's Triton Invitational, defeating Michigan 14-12 in the third-place match at Canyonview West.

#### THIEVERY

With five steals in Saturday's match with Michigan, Hanalei Crowell moved within two steals of entering UCSD's all-time top-ten in terms of career thefts. Crowell has logged 143 steals for her career, including four or more steals in six contests so far this year. She has tallied 14 steals over her past four matches, throwing-in nine assists to boot. Her 58 steals in 2011 are tied for 10th-most in a single season in Triton history while her 49 assists are sixth-best. Combined with her 15 field blocks in 2011, Crowell has accounted for at least 73 changes in possession during her senior campaign.

#### ETCETERA

Sarah Lizotte recorded her fifth consecutive hat-trick against Michigan while leading her team in scoring for the seventh straight contest... Lizotte and Kirsten Bates shared a team-high with eight shot attempts against the Wolverines... Lizotte has scored in every match in which she has appeared... Four of Michigan's 15 ejections were drawn by Natalie Peng... UCSD has out-scored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 2011, 61-59... UCSD last defeated SDSU on February 10, 2002, 5-4... With one assist vs. Michigan, Hanalei Crowell moved into third place all-time in school history with 113 career assists.

## 'THE BRONCO' FLASHBACK

After opening April 9-10's The Bronco with a 12-5 loss to No. 7 San Jose State, UCSD recovered with three consecutive victories over WWPAA opponents to improve its conference record to 9-1 and tighten its stranglehold on the WWPAA's No. 2 seed. Down by a goal at halftime in their Saturday afternoon match with host Santa Clara, Sarah Lizotte scored her third goal with 44 seconds left in regulation to force the match into overtime. The Broncos took a quick lead in the overtime period, but Melissa Bartow responded with 43 seconds remaining to force the game into sudden death. Felicia Orozco, who will be playing in her last home match this Saturday, was the first player to rip the back of the net in sudden death, providing UCSD with its second win over SCU this season. Hanalei Crowell also added five steals in the win.

UCSD would crawl back from another halftime deficit against Colorado State in Sunday's opening match, once again using a hat trick from Lizotte and a season-high six assists from Crowell. The Tritons would outscore the Rams, 8-2, in the second half, finally taking a 10-6 victory. Crowell and Lizotte would both score three goals in Sunday's second match against Cal State San Bernardino, adding four assists and two assists in the process, respectively. Natalie Peng tallied two goals and three steals in the Tritons' 11-6 win over the Coyotes. UCSD improves to 16-0 all-time against CSUSB. WWPAA-foe No. 8 Loyola Marymount, who went 3-0 against Sonoma State, CSU and CSUSB over the weekend to improve to 11-0 in the WWPAA.

## HEAD COACH BRAD KREUTZKAMP



**B**rad Kreutzkamp enters his second season as head coach of the UCSD women's water polo program in 2011. Kreutzkamp was named the head coach of the women's program in September 2009, taking over for former coach Larry Sanders who retired in June 2009 after 10 years of service to the program. Kreutzkamp has also served as associate head coach with the UC San Diego men's water polo team for the past four years.

Kreutzkamp guided the Tritons to an 18-19 overall record in his first season as coach in 2010, finishing fourth in the Western Water Polo Association (WWPA) at the end of the regular season after posting a 10-3 mark in WWPA competition. UCSD would advance to its first WWPA championship match since 2004 after beating Sonoma State and Colorado State in the first two rounds of the conference tournament; however, the squad would fall to No. 8 Loyola Marymount, 13-10, in the championship. Four players earned All-CCAA accolades while two Tritons were named All-Americans in 2010.

Kreutzkamp came to UCSD as an assistant coach with the women's team in 1999 before joining long-time head coach Denny Harper on the men's staff the following season. He served as an assistant under Harper until 2006, when he was promoted to associate head coach.

The Triton men have gone 181-93 (.661) during Kreutzkamp's tenure, winning WWPA Championships in 2000, 2002, and 2006. In his first year with the program, Kreutzkamp helped guide UCSD to 9-8 victory over USC in the NCAA Tournament Semifinals, as the Tritons became the first non-Division I program to play for a national championship.

Prior to his arrival on the La Jolla campus, Kreutzkamp was the head coach of both the boys and girls varsity programs at Grossmont High School from 1996-99 and held both positions at Patrick Henry High School for two seasons prior to that. While at Patrick Henry, he led the girls squad to the inaugural San Diego CIF Division I Championship in 1995 and was named both the Girls Eastern League and CIF D-I Coach of the Year. He also served as the head girls coach with the highly-successful Sunset Water Polo Club, winning a pair of silver medals at the 18-U Junior Olympics.
