TRITON UPDATES

HORSE WITH NO NAME

It'll feel good to get out of the rain...the San Diego rain that is. The UC San Diego women's water polo team is slated for four matches in Santa Clara at The Bronco, including three against Western Water Polo Association squads. Four of the tournament's nine teams are ranked in the Collegiate Water Polo Association Top 20, including top 10 programs No. 5 Hawaii, No. 8 Loyola Marymount and UCSD's first opponent, No. 7 San Jose State (April 9, 8:00 a.m.). Additionally, seven of nine WWPA teams in attendance combine for 11 games, making it a crucial weekend of play leading up to the WWPA Championships at the end of April. UCSD's first WWPA clash will be against fourth-place Santa Clara at 2:40 p.m. on Saturday. The Tritons previously beat SCU 12-10 on February 12 and hold an 8-6 all-time advantage over the Broncos. UCSD faces Colorado State on Sunday at 8:00 a.m. and follows with another conference tilt against Cal State San Bernardino at 2:40 p.m. The Tritons have dropped only a single match in program history to their Sunday opponents; UCSD is 7-1 all-time against CSU and 15-0 versus CSUSB. SENIOR DAY, APRIL 16th at CANYONVIEW WEST

UCSD will return home on Saturday, April 16, for its final home contest of the season against No. 6 Michigan at 12:00 p.m. Prior to the match, UCSD seniors Hanalei Crowell, Felicia Orozco and Stephanie Sasaki will be honored for their years of service to the water polo program. Be sure to arrive early and catch the Tritons' final home match before they head off to the WWPA Championships Apr.29-30 at Cal State East Bay. Admission to any Triton home match is \$5 for adults and children. As always, admission is free for UCSD students with valid student I.D. For more ticket information, log-on to ucسدtritos.com.

TRITONS TAKE TWO OF THREE IN WEEKEND HOMESTAND

The Tritons have won three of their last four contests since March 26 while outscoring its opponents 38-33 in the process. UCSD started last weekend with an 11-9 win over Brown; Kirsten Bates scored four goals and Katherine Biehle scored three times. Down by five heading into the final quarter, the Bears would score three unanswered goals, but Allie Taylor's five saves in the fourth preserved the Triton two-goal victory. UCSD followed the win with a doubleheader on Sunday against Fresno Pacific and No. 11 Arizona State. UCSD head coach Brad Kreutzkamp chose to start the FPU match with a younger lineup, but was forced to throw-in the usual starters after the team fell behind early, 3-1. Goals from Hanalei Crowell, Sarah Lizotte and Jessica Tran would help the Tritons even the match at 4-4 heading into the halftime break. UCSD led by as much as three in the second half, but the Sunbirds battled back to tie it 8-8 with 5:47 remaining. UCSD drew an FPU ejection just 15 seconds later, allowing Bates to convert from five meters to give the Tritons a 9-8 advantage. A minute later, Melissa Bartow added an insurance goal out of a timeout to give UCSD its final 10-8 lead and the team's first three-match winning streak of 2011. However, momentum wouldn't last long as the Tritons got off to a slow start against ASU, falling behind 3-0 just six minutes in. Lizotte, Biehle and Bartow netted first half goals, but UCSD trailed 5-3 at the break. The Sun Devils opened the second half by scoring four of the next five goals, digging the Tritons a four-goal deficit after the third period. Although UCSD would outscore ASU 2-1 in the final period, the Tritons dropped to 0-14 against ranked teams this season. Said Kreutzkamp, "We didn't back down anywhere against ASU and I'm really happy with the way we played."

NEWS AND NOTES

RENAISSANCE WOMAN

Although senior Hanalei Crowell's 44 goals this season are 12th-best in the country and most on the squad (ahead of Kirsten Bates' 43), Crowell is finding more ways to contribute to the team as opponents zero-in on her on the offensive side of the ball. While only scoring a pair of goals, Crowell dished-out seven assists and tallied seven steals over the three games this past weekend, setting a new team-high for assists in a game this season with five against Brown on Friday evening. She reached 100 career assists with her second dish on Sunday, moving her into sixth-place in school history.

IN CASE YOU WERE WONDERING...

Kirsten Bates scored four goals in a single game for a team-high third time this season against Brown... Her seven drawn penalty shots this season are the eighth-most in a single season in program history and her 17 career penalties drawn are sixth-best in UCSD annals... Freshman Melissa Bartow has drawn eight penalties this season, seventh-most in a single season... Sydney Fitzpatrick received her first action of the year in the cage against Fresno Pacific recorded seven saves... Bartow and Sarah Lizotte were the only Tritons other than Bates to score in all three games against Brown, FPU and ASU... All three matches this weekend were decided by three goals or less; the Tritons are 7-7 in those contests... Lizotte has 10 goals, nine assists and seven steals in just six games this year.

HEAD COACH BRAD KREUTZKAMP



Brad Kreutzkamp enters his second season as head coach of the UCSD women's water polo program in 2011. Kreutzkamp was named the head coach of the women's program in September 2009, taking over for former coach Larry Sanders who retired in June 2009 after 10 years of service to the program. Kreutzkamp has also served as associate head coach with the UC San Diego men's water polo team for the past four years.

Kreutzkamp guided the Tritons to an 18-19 overall record in his first season as coach in 2010, finishing fourth in the Western Water Polo Association (WWPA) at the end of the regular season after posting a 10-3 mark in WWPA competition. UCSD would advance to its first WWPA championship match since 2004 after beating Sonoma State and Colorado State in the first two rounds of the conference tournament; however, the squad would fall to No. 8 Loyola Marymount, 13-10, in the championship. Four players earned All-CCAA accolades while two Tritons were named All-Americans in 2010.

Kreutzkamp came to UCSD as an assistant coach with the women's team in 1999 before joining long-time head coach Denny Harper on the men's staff the following season. He served as an assistant under Harper until 2006, when he was promoted to associate head coach.

The Triton men have gone 181-93 (.661) during Kreutzkamp's tenure, winning WWPA Championships in 2000, 2002, and 2006. In his first year with the program, Kreutzkamp helped guide UCSD to 9-8 victory over USC in the NCAA Tournament Semifinals, as the Tritons became the first non-Division I program to play for a national championship.

Prior to his arrival on the La Jolla campus, Kreutzkamp was the head coach of both the boys and girls varsity programs at Grossmont High School from 1996-99 and held both positions at Patrick Henry High School for two seasons prior to that. While at Patrick Henry, he led the girls squad to the inaugural San Diego CIF Division I Championship in 1995 and was named both the Girls Eastern League and CIF D-I Coach of the Year. He also served as the head girls coach with the highly-successful Sunset Water Polo Club, winning a pair of silver medals at the 18-U Junior Olympics.
