HOW DID WE GET HERE?

UCSD earned an automatic bid to the 2011 National Collegiate Women's Water Polo Championship by virtue of its first Western Water Polo Association championship since 2000. UCSD upset eighth-ranked Loyola Marymount in the conference title game, 13-11, on May 1. The winner of the WWPA is one of four teams to receive an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament every year- the others being the conference winners of the College Water Polo Association, the Big West and the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. UCSD earned the No. 7 seed at this year's tournament, where they will match-up with MPSF champ, No. 2 California. Stanford (At-large) earned the tournament's No. 1 seed and will face Iona (MAAC Champion) after the Gaels beat Redlands (SCIAAC), 13-7, on May 7 in a play-in game to determine the No. 8 seed. No. 3 UCLA (At-large) is slated to face No. 6 Indiana (CWPA Champion) while No. 4 USC (At-large) will clash with No. 5 UC Irvine (Big West Champion). The Championship is a single-elimination tournament with a losers' bracket to determine places three through eight.

LION TAMERS

UCSD took down No. 8 Loyola Marymount for the first time since 2008 with a 13-11 win over the Lions in the WWPA Championship on May 1. LMU, who spanked the Tritons 13-7 on February 18, had won back-to-back league titles and earned the No. 1 seed for the WWPA Championships due to its perfect 11-0 conference record. The second-seeded Tritons, who fell to the Lions in the 2010 WWPA championship match, came back from a two-goal deficit, capping the match with six goals in the final stanza. Sarah Lizotte scored four goals while Hanalei Crowell and Jessica Tran notched a hat trick of their own. Crowell scored the game-winner with 1:59 to play and Katherine Biehle followed with an insurance goal with 1:06 remaining. The Tritons' victory was their first against a ranked team this season; UCSD had been 0-17 in 2011 against top-20 teams.

SO... IS THIS YOUR FIRST TIME?

UCSD has never appeared at the National Collegiate Women's Water Polo Championship since the NCAA officially made women's water polo an official championship sport in 2001. UCSD had performed well on the national level in the postseason prior to the NCAA's official takeover of women's water polo. Between 1985-2000, UCSD logged nine appearances in the Collegiate National Championship, governed by USA Water Polo, including five national championships (1986, 1990-92, 1994). UCSD finished in one of the top three spots in the tournament eight times.

'TIS THE SEASON

Three UCSD players have entered the single-season record book this year. Hanalei Crowell has 54 assists on the year, third-best in program history, and 73 steals, fourth-most in school history. Crowell needs just seven more assists to break the single-season record of 60 assists, set by Danielle Boyle in 2003. Melissa Bartow has drawn nine penalties in 2011, which is tied for sixth-best in a single season at UCSD. She also needs to draw just seven more ejections to give her 67 and move her into the top-10. Kirsten Bates has eight penalties-drawn, tied for eighth-best in a single season. She also has 54 steals in 2011, 11th-best in a season all-time.

ALL-WWPA

UCSD placed four players on the WWPA All-Conference Team for the second consecutive season, it was announced last week. Hanalei Crowell earned WWPA First Team honors while Kirsten Bates earned WWPA Second Team accolades. Felicia Orozco was named WWPA All-Honorable Mention and Melissa Bartow was placed on the WWPA All-Freshman Team. The honors mark the first time to be elected to an all-conference squad for Orozco and Bartow, but is the second consecutive year that Bates has garnered a Second Team selection. Crowell also earned WWPA All-Freshman Team honors in 2008.

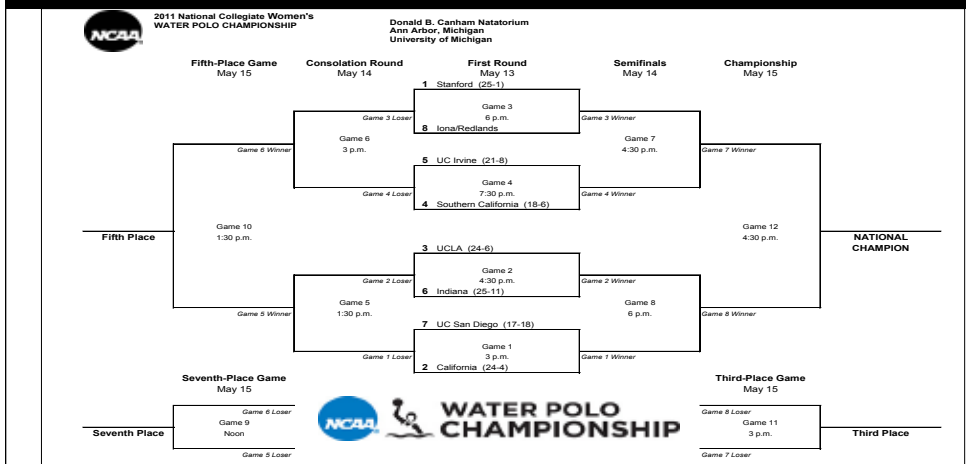
QUICK-HITTERS

UCSD is ranked the highest it has been since being No. 14 from January 23-29, 2008... The last time UCSD was ranked higher than 14th was March 29-April 4, 2006, when the team was ranked No. 13... Hanalei Crowell is tied for second in terms of career assists in program history with 118. She needs just seven more assists to equal the school record of 125... Crowell's 158 steals are fifth-best in UCSD career history... Bates' 17 career penalties drawn are sixth most in program history... Freshman Sarah Lizotte has led the team in scoring in 10 of the team's last 11 contests, including a hat trick in eight of her last nine matches... Lizotte led the team with nine goals over the WWPA championships, while Bates tossed-in seven... Crowell racked-up 10 steals at the WWPA's... Katherine Biehle scored four times at the WWPA's... Lizotte has the second-highest goals per game average (2.5) of any player in the NCAA Championship behind Iona's Maggie Wood (4.4)... Orozco had six assists at the WWPA's.

HEAD COACH BRAD KREUTZKAMP



Brad Kreutzkamp enters his second season as head coach of the UCSD women's water polo program in 2011. Kreutzkamp was named the head coach of the women's program in September 2009, taking over for former coach Larry Sanders who retired in June 2009 after 10 years of service to the program. Kreutzkamp has also served as associate head coach with the UC San Diego men's water polo team for the past four years.

Kreutzkamp guided the Tritons to an 18-19 overall record in his first season as coach in 2010, finishing fourth in the Western Water Polo Association (WWPA) at the end of the regular season after posting a 10-3 mark in WWPA competition. UCSD would advance to its first WWPA championship match since 2004 after beating Sonoma State and Colorado State in the first two rounds of the conference tournament; however, the squad would fall to No. 8 Loyola Marymount, 13-10, in the championship. Four players earned All-WWPA accolades while two Tritons were named All-Americans in 2010.

Kreutzkamp came to UCSD as an assistant coach with the women's team in 1999 before joining long-time head coach Denny Harper on the men's staff the following season. He served as an assistant under Harper until 2006, when he was promoted to associate head coach.

The Triton men have gone 181-93 (.661) during Kreutzkamp's tenure, winning WWPA Championships in 2000, 2002, and 2006. In his first year with the program, Kreutzkamp helped guide UCSD to 9-8 victory over USC in the NCAA Tournament Semifinals, as the Tritons became the first non-Division I program to play for a national championship.

Prior to his arrival on the La Jolla campus, Kreutzkamp was the head coach of both the boys and girls varsity programs at Grossmont High School from 1996-99 and held both positions at Patrick Henry High School for two seasons prior to that. While at Patrick Henry, he led the girls squad to the inaugural San Diego CIF Division I Championship in 1995 and was named both the Girls Eastern League and CIF D-I Coach of the Year. He also served as the head girls coach with the highly-successful Sunset Water Polo Club, winning a pair of silver medals at the 18-U Junior Olympics.
