TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

After picking up a much-needed win over Cal State Monterey Bay on Saturday, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will look to build on that performance as California Collegiate Athletic Association play continues this week. UCSD will host Sonoma State on Friday evening at 7:30 p.m., before entertaining Humboldt State at the same time on Saturday. The SSU and HSU tilts will be broadcast live on ESPN Radio 1700 in San Diego, with Craig Elsten calling the action on Friday and Jack Cronin filling on Saturday.

ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Friday's clash with Sonoma State with an overall record of 6-9 and a 2-8 mark in CCAA play after going 1-1 against Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay last week. The Tritons lost a heartbreaking 80-79 overtime decision to the Pioneers on Friday, but bounced back with a gritty 71-67 win over the Otters on Saturday. UCSD, which snapped a four-game losing streak with the victory, currently sits in 10th place in the conference standings with 12 games remaining. The Tritons are currently three games behind Sonoma State and Cal State Stanislaus, which enter play this week tied for eighth place at 5-5 in CCAA play. Head coach Chris Carlson's squad is 3-3 through six games at RIMAC Arena this season.

TRITONS MAKE KEY PLAYS LATE TO TOPPLE MONTEREY BAY

UCSD held off a furious comeback attempt to take down visiting Cal State Monterey Bay, 71-67, on Saturday evening at RIMAC Arena. The Tritons held a 12-point lead early in the second half, but saw the visitors come all the way back to tie it at 66 with 1:42 remaining. UCSD was able to answer though, outscoring CSUMB 5-1 from there, as James McCann converted a three-point play to break the tie with eight seconds left and Tyler McGrath sank two free throws on the Tritons' final possession to wrap it up. UCSD shot just 42% from the field, but hit 7-of-16 from downtown and finished +11 at the free throw line to pick up its first win since Dec. 29. McCann finished with 19 points on 5-of-7 shooting to lead the way for the Tritons, while Justin Brue also scored 19 and added a game-high six rebounds.

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT

After shooting a combined 37% from the field in losses to Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State Stanislaus and Chico State from Dec. 30 to Jan. 7, UCSD shot the ball much better against Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay last week. The Tritons shot an even 50% (29-58) in their loss to the Pioneers on Friday and then finished at a 42% (18-43) clip in the win over the Otters on Saturday. The loss to East Bay marked the first time the Tritons have lost when shooting at least 50% from the field this season after winning their first five games when reaching that mark. Conversely, Saturday's game marked the first time UCSD has won when making less than half of its shots from the field after going 0-8 the first eight games under those circumstances. UC San Diego currently ranks sixth in the CCAA in field goal percentage, shooting 44.3% from the floor this season.

NEWS AND NOTES

ON POINT

Sophomore point guard James McCann had his best two games of the season last week, averaging a team-high 20.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists against Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay. He converted 54% (13-24) of his shots for the week and drained 5-of-10 from the three-point line, 50%. The Carlsbad native was brilliant in the Tritons' 80-79 loss to the Pioneers, scoring a career-high 22 points on 8-of-17 shooting, while also tallying four rebounds and seven assists. He had a strong effort in the win over the Otters the following evening as well, finishing with a game-high 19 points on 5-of-7 shooting. For the season, McCann is averaging 9.9 points and a team-high 3.8 assists. He has scored in double figures in three of the last four games.

JUST BRUE IT

Junior forward Justin Brue had a big week for the Tritons as well, averaging 17.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists in UCSD's two games. He shot a blistering 75% for the week, sinking 12-of-16 attempts from the field. After finishing with a stat line of 15 points, six rebounds, four assists, three blocks and two steals in the loss to Cal State East Bay on Friday, he came back with impressive performance against Cal State Monterey Bay on Saturday, scoring a season-high 19 points on 6-of-8 shooting. A native of Hayward, Calif., Brue enters Friday's contest averaging 9.7 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. He is shooting just under 49% from the floor.

SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES

Sonoma State enters Friday's matchup with an overall record of 7-7 and a 5-5 mark in CCAA play after knocking off both San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona last week... The Seawolves posted an 81-69 triumph over the Gators on Thursday, before dispatching the Broncos by a final margin of 70-64 two nights later... Freshman forward Justin Herold is averaging team-highs of 12.9 and 6.1 points per game, while senior guard Steven Pratt is putting up 11.9 points and dishing out 5.4 assists... The Seawolves currently rank fourth in the CCAA averaging 72.7 points per game offensively, while the defense is allowing 73.2, a figure that ranks ninth... UCSD trails the all-time series with Sonoma State 17-10 after splitting the season series with the Seawolves in 2010-11.

SCOUTING THE LUMBERJACKS

Humboldt State currently has an overall record of 10-4 and a 6-4 tally in conference play after taking down Cal Poly Pomona (74-64) and San Francisco State (87-70) at home last week... The Lumberjacks have won three straight after losing three of four from Dec. 17 through Jan. 6... Senior guard Brandon Sperling is leading four players in double figures for the Lumberjacks at 14.0 points per game on 45% shooting, while senior forward Randy Hunter is averaging 13.6 points and a team-high 6.7 boards... HSU leads the CCAA in scoring offense at 77.6 points per game, while the defense ranks seventh, allowing 69.6... UCSD has won just three of 14 previous meetings with Humboldt State after losing both matchups with the Lumberjacks a year ago.

QUICK HITS

UCSD currently ranks sixth in the CCAA in scoring offense, averaging 68.7 points per game... Defensively, the Tritons also rank sixth, allowing 67.6... UCSD leads the league in free throw percentage at .751 and ranks second in three-point percentage at .377... The Tritons missed 12 free throws (18-30) in their one-point loss to Cal State East Bay on Friday... UCSD had missed a total of 13 foul shots in the previous five games combined... The Triton defense gave up a season-high 80 points in the loss to the Pioneers after allowing 78 in a loss at Cal State Stanislaus on Jan. 6... Christian Hatch recorded his fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 14 rebounds against East Bay... After taking on Sonoma State and Humboldt State this week, UCSD will travel to Cal Poly Pomona and San Francisco State Jan. 26 and 28.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



Chris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote.

UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department in November announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.

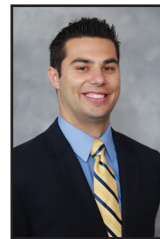
