TRITON UPDATES

THE WEEK AHEAD

On the heels of a rousing 28-point triumph over No. 24 Cal State Monterey Bay, the undefeated UC San Diego women's basketball team welcomes Sonoma State and Humboldt State to town this weekend to wrap up a four-game homestand. The Tritons will host the Seawolves on Friday evening, before welcoming the fourth place Lumberjacks to town on Saturday. As always, both contests are scheduled to tip-off at 5:30 p.m. at RIMAC Arena on campus.

FOR THE RECORD

UCSD enters Friday's tilt with Sonoma State boasting a flawless overall record of 16-0 and a perfect 10-0 mark in California Collegiate Athletic Association play after posting a pair of home wins last week. The Tritons recorded an 84-73 victory over Cal State East Bay on Friday and then pounded budding rival Cal State Monterey Bay by a final margin of 91-63 on Saturday. The Tritons became the first team in program history to win their first 15 games with the victory over the Pioneers and then matched the program's longest winning streak overall with Saturday's impressive showing against the Otters. Head coach Charity Elliott's squad currently sits at the top of the CCAA standings, holding a 1.5 game lead over now second place CSUMB.

VIEW FROM THE TOP

After collecting its 15th and 16th victories of the season over the weekend, UCSD rose to No. 1 in the USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll that was released on Tuesday. The Tritons received 26 out of a possible 31 first place votes and a total of 770 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the first time in program history. After beginning the season at No. 13, UCSD has climbed to the top of poll -- moving up one spot each of the last three weeks -- thanks to its historic run to begin the season. The Tritons have never been ranked No. 1 at either the Division II or III level.

THAT'S JUST OFFENSIVE

The Triton offense has been a thing of beauty all season, but it has been especially impressive of late as UCSD has averaged 88.8 points on 49.5% shooting over its last four games. The Tritons have topped the 90-point mark twice during that span, erupting for a season-high 97 points in a double overtime win at Chico State on Jan. 7 and then scoring 91 in Saturday's resounding victory over No. 24 Cal State Monterey Bay. UCSD currently leads the CCAA in several offensive categories, including scoring offense (80.8), scoring margin (+19.9), field goal percentage (.466), assists (18.4) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.2). The Tritons rank second in free throw percentage at .727. UCSD has been incredibly balanced on the offensive end this season, with all five starters scoring in double figures.

HOME, SWEET HOME

UCSD has been absolutely dominant at RIMAC Arena this season, winning its first seven home games by an average of over 22 points. The Tritons are currently putting up 81.0 points on their home floor, while holding their opponents to a healthy 58.4. UCSD has won all seven games comfortably, with only Friday's victory over Cal State East Bay coming by a final margin of less than 14 points. The Tritons have won 12 straight at home dating back to last season, with their last loss coming on Jan. 22, 2010 (an 82-75 setback to Cal Poly Pomona).

NEWS AND NOTES

CARLISLE NAMED CCAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior point guard Chelsea Carlisle was named the Wilson/CCAA Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 18.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 11.0 assists and 3.0 steals in UCSD's wins over Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay last week. She shot 56% (15-27) from the field and connected on 44% (4-9) from the three-point line to take home the conference's weekly honor for the third time in 2011-12. For the season, Carlisle is averaging 16.5 points, 4.9 rebounds, 6.3 assists and 2.8 steals. She is shooting 51% from the field and has hit just under 40% of her three-point tries. A two-time All-American, Carlisle currently leads the team in several categories, including scoring, assists, steals, field goals made, three-pointers made and minutes per game. She has scored in double figures in every game this season and has reached the 20-point mark on four occasions.

FRONT AND CENTER

Senior center Lauren Freidenberg is also having a tremendous season thus far, averaging 14.1 points and a team-high 8.1 rebounds through 16 games. She is shooting a career-high 55% from the field, a figure that also leads the squad, and has scored in double figures a total of 13 times this season. After finishing with a game-high 20 points and grabbing eight rebounds in the Tritons' victory over Cal State East Bay on Friday, Freidenberg recorded her third double-double of the year with an 18-point, 15-rebound effort in the win over No. 24 Cal State Monterey Bay the following evening. She finished 6-of-12 from the field and 6-of-7 at the free throw line to help the Tritons stay perfect on the season.

SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES

Sonoma State enters Friday's matchup with an overall record of 5-9 and a 3-7 mark in the CCAA after falling to San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona by a combined three points last week. The Seawolves dropped a narrow 51-49 home decision to the Gators on Thursday, before suffering a 52-50 setback at the hands of the Broncos two nights later... Senior guard Jaclyn Bisordi is averaging a team-high 9.6 points to go with 3.3 rebounds and 1.6 assists, while senior center Aly Conway is scoring 5.9 points on 55% shooting and grabbing a team-high 5.4 rebounds per night... The Seawolves own the CCAA's top-ranked defense, holding their opponents to just 53.9 points per game, while the offense ranks 10th, averaging just 56.5 on the other end... UCSD holds a 16-10 advantage in the all-time series with Sonoma State after sweeping the Seawolves in 2010-11.

SCOUTING THE LUMBERJACKS

Humboldt State begins the week with an overall record of 11-3 and a 6-3 tally in conference play after going 1-1 against Cal Poly Pomona (79-83) and San Francisco State (66-61) at home last week... Despite the loss to the Broncos, the Lumberjacks have won seven of their last nine overall... Junior guard Lisa Petty leads four players averaging double figures for HSU at 13.8 points per game... She is also hauling down 7.3 rebounds per night... Backcourt mate Kayla Williams is having a fine season as well, averaging 10.6 points and a team-high 4.3 assists... Humboldt State ranks fourth in the CCAA averaging 67.4 points per game offensively, while the defense is giving up 59.4, a figure that ranks third... UCSD has won eight out of 15 previous matchups with Humboldt State after splitting two meetings with the Lumberjacks a year ago.

QUICK HITS

After knocking off No. 24 Cal State Monterey Bay on Saturday, UCSD is now 3-0 against ranked opponents this season... The Tritons defeated then-No. 4 Fort Lewis, 80-65, on Nov. 26 and took down No. 11 Cal Poly Pomona, 78-64, on Dec. 30... All three wins have come at RIMAC Arena... UCSD is one of only two remaining undefeated teams in the country along with No. 3 Edinboro, which has a record of 14-0... The Tritons' currently rank fifth in the nation in scoring offense, averaging 80.8 points per game... UCSD has won 19 of its last 20 CCAA games dating back to last season... After facing Sonoma State and Humboldt State this weekend, UCSD will travel to Cal Poly Pomona and San Francisco State on Jan. 26 and 28.

HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT



Charity Elliott enters her fifth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to NCAA Division II West Regional appearances three out of her first four seasons at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2011-12 campaign with a career coaching mark of 152-122 (.555) and an impressive record of 97-31 (.758) at UCSD.

Elliott has been one of the most successful coaches in program history, leading the Tritons to four consecutive 20 win seasons and two California Collegiate Athletic Association Championships. 2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. That mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01

and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point -- one shy of the program's longest streak -- and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year at the end of the season.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA D-II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage.

Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades, as well. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a second consecutive CCAA regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons advanced to postseason play for the fifth straight season, earning a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional. UCSD drew Humboldt State once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row in 2009-10 and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a WBCA State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

The Tritons got off to a rocky start in 2010-11, losing their first five games of the season, but Elliott's squad quickly got things turned around and finished with an overall record of 20-11 and league tally of 17-5. UCSD was awarded the No. 3 seed in the CCAA Tournament and, after knocking off Chico State in the opening round, saw its season come to a close with a narrow 78-75 loss to rival Cal Poly Pomona. Carlisle was again selected as an All-American, earning honorable mention honors from the WBCA.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure.

After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time in three years.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

She has also served in an assistant capacity with Southwest Baptist, Southwest Missouri State (her alma mater) and San Diego State (under head coach Beth Burns in 1993-94).

Elliott began her collegiate basketball career at Rice University, where she played for two seasons. She averaged 16 points per game as a sophomore before transferring to Southwest Missouri State (now Missouri State). While at SMS, Elliott guided the Bears to a 31-3 record and the program's first-ever Final Four appearance as a senior in 1992. An integral part of one of the most successful teams in program history, she ranked in the top 10 nationally in free throw percentage and was named SMS' Woman of the Year at the end of the 1991-92 season. The Bears posted a 57-8 record during her two-year career with the program.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott, who also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist, resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

UCSD INKS TWO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

UCSD signed two high school seniors to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. Coach Elliott announced on Monday, November 21. Leeann Alferness, a 6-0 center from Novato, and Taylor Hirz, a 6-2 center from Santa Ana, will join the Tritons as true freshmen in 2012-13. A standout at San Marin High School in Novato, Alferness led the Marin County Athletic League in scoring and rebounding as a junior, while Hirz led Foothill High School to the second round of the CIF-SS playoffs and is a standout with Cal Swish.

TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

With all five starters returning in 2011-12, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the CCAA standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished third in the conference with a 17-5 record last season, received eight first place votes and a total of 116 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the third year in a row. Cal Poly Pomona garnered one first place vote and 98 points to finish second, while Chico State came in third with 97 points and defending CCAA regular season champion Cal State Monterey Bay was fourth with two first place votes and 94 points. Humboldt State earned the remaining first place vote and a total of 85 points to finish fifth.
