TRITON UPDATES

WHAT'S ON TAP

After taking care of business against Sonoma State and Humboldt State to wrap up a four-game home stand, the undefeated UC San Diego women's basketball team will hit the road to begin the second half of its California Collegiate Athletic Association slate this week. The Tritons will travel to Cal Poly Pomona for a battle with the 22nd-ranked Broncos on Thursday, before heading to San Francisco State to take on the Gators on Saturday. Both games are scheduled to tip-off at 5:30 p.m.

FOR THE RECORD

UCSD heads to Pomona with a perfect overall record of 18-0 and a 12-0 mark in CCAA play after dispatching Sonoma State and Humboldt State last week. The Tritons shook off a slow start to take down the Seawolves, 73-57, on Friday and then blew by the Lumberjacks by a final margin of 74-49 on Saturday. Head coach Charity Elliott's squad currently sits at the top of the CCAA standings, holding a 2.5 game lead over second place Cal State Monterey Bay with 10 games remaining. UCSD is 9-0 away from home this season, going 6-0 in true road games and 3-0 in neutral site contests.

QUITE A WEEK

While the 2011-12 season has been full of great moments thus far, last week was extra special for the Tritons because it featured a couple of impressive program firsts. The week got off to a great start on Tuesday when the *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll came out and UCSD was ranked No. 1 -- something the Tritons had never accomplished at either the Division II or III level. Another major milestone followed on Friday as the Tritons became the first team in program history to win 17 consecutive games, breaking the old mark of 16 straight set from Jan. 2 through Mar. 4 during the 1997-98 campaign. No matter what happens from here on out, this year's team has already gone where no other UCSD team has gone before it.

DON'T SLEEP ON OUR DEFENSE

While the Triton offense has carried the load for much of the season, it was UCSD's defense that shone through in its wins over Sonoma State and Humboldt State last week. After limiting the Seawolves to just 57 points on 39% (22-57) shooting on Friday, the Tritons were even better the following night, holding the Lumberjacks to a season-low 49 points and a measly 28% (29-64) shooting. This was quite a feat considering that Humboldt State entered the game with the CCAA's fourth-ranked offense at over 67 points per night. The Tritons also forced 19 turnovers against both SSU and HSU, leading to a combined 46 points on the other end. UCSD currently ranks fifth in the CCAA in scoring defense, allowing 60.0 points per game for the season, and sixth in field goal percentage defense at just over 38%.

RAINING THREES

UCSD shot the ball extremely well from the three-point line last week, converting 18-of-42 against Sonoma State and Humboldt State, 43%. After sinking 10-of-24 in the win over the Seawolves on Friday, the Tritons had another big night from behind the arc against the Lumberjacks, connecting on 8-of-18, a season-high 44%. UCSD currently leads the CCAA with a total of 119 threes through 18 games and ranks fourth in terms of three-point field goal percentage at .332.

NEWS AND NOTES

CHELSEA LATELY

Senior point guard Chelsea Carlisle is in the midst of another tremendous season in 2011-12, averaging 16.3 points, 4.9 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 2.8 steals entering Thursday's clash with Cal Poly Pomona. She is shooting 50.4% from the field and has hit just under 40% of her three-point tries. A two-time All-American, Carlisle currently leads the team in several categories, including scoring, assists, steals, field goals made, three-pointers made and minutes per game. She has scored in double figures in every game this season and has reached the 20-point mark on four occasions. The Agoura Hills, Calif. native had a big hand in UCSD's 73-57 win over Sonoma State on Friday night, tallying 17 points, five rebounds, 12 assists, three blocks and two steals. She finished 7-of-14 from the floor 3-of-8 from downtown. Her 12 assists tied her career mark in that category.

COMING UP DAISY

Senior guard Daisy Feder was named the Wilson/CCAA Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals in UCSD's wins over Sonoma State and Humboldt State. She shot 43% (13-30) from the field and dropped 7-of-14 from the three-point line, 50%. In Friday's victory over the Seawolves, Feder scored a career-high 23 points, while also tallying six rebounds, three assists and two steals. She followed that effort with 20 points, nine rebounds and four assists in the win over the Lumberjacks. For the season, Feder is averaging 12.0 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.1 steals. She has scored in double figures a total of 13 times this season, including each of the last nine games.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS

Cal Poly Pomona enters Thursday's matchup with an overall record of 12-4 and an 8-4 tally in the CCAA after going 1-1 against Cal State Dominguez Hills and Cal State L.A. on the road last week... The Broncos defeated the Toros, 65-50, on Friday, before suffering a 75-65 loss to the Golden Eagles on Saturday... Senior center Megan Ford is averaging team-highs of 13.6 points and 8.9 rebounds through 16 games, while senior guard Sarah Semenero is not far behind, putting up 12.3 points and grabbing 5.5 boards... The Broncos currently rank fifth in the CCAA in scoring offense at 65.1 points per game, while the defense is holding the opposition to just 57.4, a figure that ranks second... The all-time series between UCSD and Cal Poly Pomona is tied at 12 games apiece after the Tritons won the first meeting of the year, 78-64, on Dec. 30 at RIMAC Arena... Chelsea Carlisle scored 20 points to lead four players in double figures for the Tritons, who shot 48% from the field in the win.

SCOUTING THE GATORS

San Francisco State starts the week with an overall record of 5-13 and a 4-8 mark in conference play after going 1-1 against Cal State L.A. and Cal State Dominguez Hills last week... The Gators have won three of their last five after starting the season 2-11... Junior guard Nicole Hicks is the only player averaging double figures for SFSU at 12.9 points per game... She's also hauling down 4.4 rebounds per night... As a team, San Francisco State is averaging just 51.6 points per game offensively, which ranks 11th in the CCAA, while the Gator defense ranks eighth, allowing 61.2... UCSD holds a 22-9 advantage in the all-time series with San Francisco State after defeating the Gators by a final margin of 79-44 on Dec. 29 in La Jolla.

QUICK HITS

UCSD is ranked No. 1 in the current *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches Poll for the second consecutive week... The Tritons are one of only two remaining undefeated teams in the country along with No. 3 Edinboro University (16-0)... UCSD boasts the top offense in the CCAA, averaging 80.0 points per game... That figure ranks sixth nationally... The Tritons also lead the league in field goal percentage (.463), scoring margin (+20.0) and assists (18.4)... Coach Elliott has used the same starting lineup in all 18 games this season... The Tritons have won 21 of their last 22 CCAA games dating back to last season... After facing Cal Poly Pomona and San Francisco State on the road this week, UCSD will come home for four straight from Feb. 3-11.

HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT



Charity Elliott enters her fifth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to NCAA Division II West Regional appearances three out of her first four seasons at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2011-12 campaign with a career coaching mark of 152-122 (.555) and an impressive record of 97-31 (.758) at UCSD.

Elliott has been one of the most successful coaches in program history, leading the Tritons to four consecutive 20 win seasons and two California Collegiate Athletic Association Championships. 2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. That mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01

and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point -- one shy of the program's longest streak -- and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year at the end of the season.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA D-II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage.

Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades, as well. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a second consecutive CCAA regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons advanced to postseason play for the fifth straight season, earning a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional. UCSD drew Humboldt State once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row in 2009-10 and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a WBCA State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

The Tritons got off to a rocky start in 2010-11, losing their first five games of the season, but Elliott's squad quickly got things turned around and finished with an overall record of 20-11 and league tally of 17-5. UCSD was awarded the No. 3 seed in the CCAA Tournament and, after knocking off Chico State in the opening round, saw its season come to a close with a narrow 78-75 loss to rival Cal Poly Pomona. Carlisle was again selected as an All-American, earning honorable mention honors from the WBCA.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure.

After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time in three years.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

She has also served in an assistant capacity with Southwest Baptist, Southwest Missouri State (her alma mater) and San Diego State (under head coach Beth Burns in 1993-94).

Elliott began her collegiate basketball career at Rice University, where she played for two seasons. She averaged 16 points per game as a sophomore before transferring to Southwest Missouri State (now Missouri State). While at SMS, Elliott guided the Bears to a 31-3 record and the program's first-ever Final Four appearance as a senior in 1992. An integral part of one of the most successful teams in program history, she ranked in the top 10 nationally in free throw percentage and was named SMS' Woman of the Year at the end of the 1991-92 season. The Bears posted a 57-8 record during her two-year career with the program.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott, who also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist, resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

UCSD INKS TWO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

UCSD signed two high school seniors to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. Coach Elliott announced on Monday, November 21. Leeann Alferness, a 6-0 center from Novato, and Taylor Hirz, a 6-2 center from Santa Ana, will join the Tritons as true freshmen in 2012-13. A standout at San Marin High School in Novato, Alferness led the Marin County Athletic League in scoring and rebounding as a junior, while Hirz led Foothill High School to the second round of the CIF-SS playoffs and is a standout with Cal Swish.

TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

With all five starters returning in 2011-12, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the CCAA standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished third in the conference with a 17-5 record last season, received eight first place votes and a total of 116 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the third year in a row. Cal Poly Pomona garnered one first place vote and 98 points to finish second, while Chico State came in third with 97 points and defending CCAA regular season champion Cal State Monterey Bay was fourth with two first place votes and 94 points. Humboldt State earned the remaining first place vote and a total of 85 points to finish fifth.
