TRITON UPDATES

THE WEEK AHEAD

After extending its winning streak to 12 games with a pair of home wins over San Francisco State and previously undefeated Cal Poly Pomona, the UC San Diego women's basketball team will look to keep rolling on the road this week. The Tritons will travel to Northern California to take on Cal State Stanislaus on Friday evening, before squaring off with Chico State on Saturday. Both contests will tip-off at 5:30 p.m.

FOR THE RECORD

UCSD heads to Turlock with a flawless overall record 12-0 and a perfect 6-0 tally in California Collegiate Athletic Association play after knocking off San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona last week. The Tritons rolled to a 79-44 triumph over the Gators on Thursday and then handed the 11th-ranked Broncos their first loss of the season, 78-64, on Friday. Head coach Charity Elliott's squad is 7-0 away from home so far in 2011-12, going 4-0 in true road games and 3-0 in neutral site contests. UCSD currently sits at the top of the CCAA standings, holding a half-game lead over Cal State Monterey Bay (5-0).

POLL POSITION

UC San Diego is ranked No. 3 in this week's *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 Coaches Poll. The Tritons, who began the season at No. 13, moved up one spot this week after coming in at No. 4 in the previous poll that was released on Dec. 13. The last time UCSD was ranked this high was in 2007-08, when the squad also garnered a No. 3 national ranking after winning its first eight games of the season. The Tritons were ranked as high as No. 11 in 2010-11.

GOING STREAKING

After an extremely impressive start to the 2011-12 campaign, the Tritons are quickly closing in on two of the program's major milestones. At 12-0, UCSD is just two wins shy of matching the program record for consecutive victories to open a season. That mark was established two years ago when the 2009-10 squad won its first 14 games of the year. The Tritons are also four wins shy of tying the program's all-time mark of 16 straight victories, which was set during the 1997-98 campaign. If Coach Elliott and the Tritons can continue to string wins together, they have a chance to accomplish something special this season and breaking both records would certainly qualify.

TRITON OFFENSE SECOND TO NONE

UCSD boasts the top offense in the CCAA and enters Friday's clash with Cal State Stanislaus leading the conference in four major offensive categories. The Tritons are currently averaging 78.2 points per game, a figure that easily leads the league as Cal State L.A. is second putting up 72.9. UCSD is also leading the conference in team field goal percentage at 45.5%, assists at 18.1 per game and scoring margin at +21.0. On the national level, the Tritons rank 14th in scoring offense, 14th in field goal percentage, 13th in assists and ninth in scoring margin. UCSD has scored 70 points or more 10 times this season and reached the 80-point mark on four occasions.

NEWS AND NOTES

CHelsea LATELY

Senior point guard Chelsea Carlisle is putting together another tremendous season in 2011-12, averaging 17.0 points, 4.8 rebounds, 5.5 assists and 2.9 steals through 12 games. She is shooting 53% from the field and has hit 42% of her three-point tries. A two-time All-American, Carlisle currently leads the team in several categories, including scoring, assists, steals, field goals made, three-pointers made and minutes per game. She has scored in double figures in every game this season and has reached the 20-point mark on three occasions. The Agoura Hills, Calif. native had a big week for the Tritons against San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona, averaging 17.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals in the two wins. She finished with 20 points in the triumph over the Broncos, connecting on 4-of-7 from the three-point line.

GET THE BALL DOWN LO

Center Lauren Freidenberg is also having a fine senior campaign thus far, averaging 13.8 points and a team-high 7.7 rebounds heading into Thursday's matchup with Cal State Stanislaus. She is shooting a blistering 58% from the field, which also leads the squad, and ranks second on the team in free throw percentage at 81%. The Seattle native has scored in double figures 10 times this season, including each of UCSD's last six games. Freidenberg had a huge hand in the Tritons' 78-64 victory over No. 11 Cal Poly Pomona last week, finishing with 16 points and eight boards in 31 minutes. She was 4-of-7 from the floor and sank 8-of-10 at the free throw line to help the Tritons end a three-game losing streak at the hands of the Broncos.

SCOUTING THE WARRIORS

Cal State Stanislaus enters Friday's contest with an overall record of 4-6 and a 1-5 mark in CCAA play after defeating Chico State, 69-68, on Monday for its first conference win... Senior guard Theresa Henderson has been a force for the Warriors, averaging 19.6 points and 9.4 rebounds through 10 games... She leads the CCAA in scoring and ranks second in rebounding behind teammate Lauren Godde, who is hauling down 9.8 boards per night... Stanislaus is currently averaging 62.6 points per game offensively, while the defense is surrendering 69.8 on the other end... UCSD holds a 20-8 advantage in the all-time series with Cal State Stanislaus after sweeping the Warriors in 2010-11...The Tritons have won the previous 16 meetings with the Warriors dating back to the 2003-04 season.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Chico State enters the weekend with an overall record of 6-4 and a 3-3 tally in conference play following Monday's home loss to Stanislaus... The Wildcats have dropped two of their last three overall... Junior guard Synchro Bull leads the team in scoring at 13.1 points per game, while also dishing out a team-high 2.3 assists... Chico State ranks sixth in the CCAA averaging 62.3 points per game offensively, while the defense is giving up 62.7, a figure that ranks ninth... UCSD holds a 15-11 edge in the all-time series with Chico State after winning all three meetings with the Wildcats a year ago, including a 76-71 decision in the first round of the CCAA Tournament... Chico State will square off with Cal State San Bernardino on Friday before hosting UCSD on Saturday.

QUICK HITS

UCSD improved to 2-0 against ranked opponents this season with last week's victory over No. 11 Cal Poly Pomona... The Tritons also defeated then-No. 4 Fort Lewis College, 80-65, on Nov. 26... UCSD is the only team in the CCAA that has yet to lose this season... Cal State Monterey Bay, Humboldt State and Cal Poly Pomona all have one loss... In addition to leading the league in multiple offensive categories, the Tritons also rank first in the CCAA in rebounding (34.8) and rebounding margin (+8.0)... After taking on Cal State Stanislaus and Chico State, UCSD will come home for four straight beginning with matchups against Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay Jan. 13-14... The Tritons have won 15 of their last 16 CCAA games dating back to last season.

HEAD COACH CHARITY ELLIOTT



Charity Elliott enters her fifth season as head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to NCAA Division II West Regional appearances three out of her first four seasons at the helm. The fifth coach in program history, Elliott begins the 2011-12 campaign with a career coaching mark of 152-122 (.555) and an impressive record of 97-31 (.758) at UCSD.

Elliott has been one of the most successful coaches in program history, leading the Tritons to four consecutive 20 win seasons and two California Collegiate Athletic Association Championships. 2008-09 was arguably Elliott's most successful campaign in La Jolla, as the Tritons tied the program's all-time mark for victories, posted a near-flawless record in conference play and advanced to the NCAA West Regional Semifinals.

Ranked as high as No. 7 nationally, UCSD finished with an overall record of 27-5 that year, tying the 2006-07 squad's record for victories in a season. The Tritons were absolutely dominant in CCAA play, going 19-1 to capture the regular season championship and earn a No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. That mark was UCSD's best since joining the CCAA in 2000-01

and was the top finish by any team in the league since the 2002-03 season. The Tritons won 15 games in a row at one point -- one shy of the program's longest streak -- and Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year at the end of the season.

The Tritons earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA D-II West Regional in Seattle, where they knocked off league rival Cal State Dominguez Hills, 66-65, in the first round. UCSD's season came to an end the following day with a narrow 52-49 defeat to eventual national semifinalist Alaska Anchorage.

Under Elliott's guidance, senior forward Michelle Osier was named the CCAA Most Valuable Player in 2008-09 and went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades, as well. Osier also set both the UCSD career rebounding (1,185) and steals (318) marks during that season.

2009-10 was another banner year for the Tritons, as Elliott led the team to a 25-5 overall record and a second consecutive CCAA regular season crown with a league mark of 19-3. Despite an opening round loss to host Humboldt State in the CCAA Tournament, the Tritons advanced to postseason play for the fifth straight season, earning a No. 2 seed in the NCAA West Regional. UCSD drew Humboldt State once again in the first round and lost a heartbreaking 76-72 decision to the Lumberjacks in Seattle.

Elliott was named the CCAA Coach of the Year for the second year in row in 2009-10 and sophomore guard Chelsea Carlisle was voted the conference's Most Valuable Player. Carlisle went on to earn Daktronics West Region Player of the Year accolades and was named a WBCA State Farm Coaches First Team All-American.

The Tritons got off to a rocky start in 2010-11, losing their first five games of the season, but Elliott's squad quickly got things turned around and finished with an overall record of 20-11 and league tally of 17-5. UCSD was awarded the No. 3 seed in the CCAA Tournament and, after knocking off Chico State in the opening round, saw its season come to a close with a narrow 78-75 loss to rival Cal Poly Pomona. Carlisle was again selected as an All-American, earning honorable mention honors from the WBCA.

Prior to her arrival on the La Jolla campus, Elliott spent three seasons as the head coach at Division I Portland State, where she led the Vikings to a remarkable turnaround during her tenure.

After PSU finished with an overall record of 3-23 during her first year in 2004-05, the Vikings improved to 12-16 and 6-8 in the Big Sky Conference during her second season. The nine-win improvement ranked amongst the nation's top 20 and Portland State qualified for the Big Sky Tournament for the first time in three years.

Before taking the Portland State job, Elliott served as an assistant coach for Arkansas for one season, helping the Razorbacks to a record of 16-12. Prior to that, she served as head coach at Cal Baptist for two seasons, where she guided the Lancers to a 16-16 record in 2002-03, snapping the program's run of 10 consecutive losing seasons.

She has also served in an assistant capacity with Southwest Baptist, Southwest Missouri State (her alma mater) and San Diego State (under head coach Beth Burns in 1993-94).

Elliott began her collegiate basketball career at Rice University, where she played for two seasons. She averaged 16 points per game as a sophomore before transferring to Southwest Missouri State (now Missouri State). While at SMS, Elliott guided the Bears to a 31-3 record and the program's first-ever Final Four appearance as a senior in 1992. An integral part of one of the most successful teams in program history, she ranked in the top 10 nationally in free throw percentage and was named SMS' Woman of the Year at the end of the 1991-92 season. The Bears posted a 57-8 record during her two-year career with the program.

After graduating from Southwest Missouri State with a degree in psychology, Elliott began her coaching career as an assistant at San Diego State, where she helped coach the Aztecs to a 26-5 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1993-94. Elliott then returned to Springfield, Mo. to join Cheryl Burnett's staff at her alma mater. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Missouri State, helping the Bears post a combined record of 46-17 with two Big Dance appearances.

Elliott, who also earned her masters in education while at Southwest Baptist, resides in San Diego with her husband Chris, who is also a member of the Triton coaching staff.

UCSD INKS TWO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

UCSD signed two high school seniors to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period. Coach Elliott announced on Monday, November 21. Leeann Alferness, a 6-0 center from Novato, and Taylor Hirz, a 6-2 center from Santa Ana, will join the Tritons as true freshmen in 2012-13. A standout at San Marin High School in Novato, Alferness led the Marin County Athletic League in scoring and rebounding as a junior, while Hirz led Foothill High School to the second round of the CIF-SS playoffs and is a standout with Cal Swish.

TRITONS TOP PICK IN CCAA COACHES POLL

With all five starters returning in 2011-12, UC San Diego was once again picked to finish first in the CCAA standings according to the preseason coaches poll that was released last month. UCSD, which finished third in the conference with a 17-5 record last season, received eight first place votes and a total of 116 points to earn the top spot in the poll for the third year in a row. Cal Poly Pomona garnered one first place vote and 98 points to finish second, while Chico State came in third with 97 points and defending CCAA regular season champion Cal State Monterey Bay was fourth with two first place votes and 94 points. Humboldt State earned the remaining first place vote and a total of 85 points to finish fifth.
