## TRITON UPDATES

### FIRST THINGS FIRST

After splitting a pair of home games with San Francisco State and No. 8 Cal Poly Pomona, the UC San Diego men's basketball team will look to gain ground in the California Collegiate Athletic Association standings on the road this week. The Tritons will travel to Turlock to face Cal State Stanislaus on Friday evening, before heading to Chico for a matchup with Chico State on Saturday. Both games are slated to tip-off at 7:30 p.m. or immediately following the women's contests.

### ON THE RECORD

UCSD enters Friday's clash with Cal State Stanislaus with an overall record of 5-6 and a 1-5 mark in CCAA play after going 1-1 in two games last week. The Tritons defeated San Francisco State, 72-50, to earn their first conference victory of the season on Thursday, but couldn't make it two in a row on Friday, suffering a 66-52 setback at the hands of league-leading Cal Poly Pomona. The Tritons, who have dropped five of their last seven and currently sit in 11th place in the CCAA standings, will now look to get things turned around as the conference schedule picks up in January. Head coach Chris Carlson's squad has a 3-4 record in seven games away from home in 2011-12, going 1-3 in true road games and 2-1 in neutral site contests.

### TRITONS DOMINATE GATORS FOR FIRST CCAA WIN

UCSD registered its first CCAA victory in dominating fashion last week, dispatching San Francisco State by a final margin of 72-50 on Thursday evening at RIMAC Arena. The Tritons scored the first nine points of the game and never looked back, leading by as many as 30 late in the second half. UCSD shot 51% (23-45) from the field and converted 8-of-13 from the three-point line, while holding SFSU to just 40% (18-45) shooting on the other end. Mike Meza led all scorers with 19 points off the bench for UCSD, while Christian Hatch finished with 12. The Tritons held a commanding 35-22 advantage on the glass and outscored the Gators 26-14 in the paint.

### CAUSE AND EFFECT

UCSD is having a Jekyll and Hyde type of season in one critical area: shooting percentage. With the victory over San Francisco State, the Tritons improved to 5-0 when they shoot better than 50% from the field this season. Conversely, UCSD shot just 38% in the loss to Cal Poly Pomona, dropping the team's record to 0-6 when they shoot less than 50% from the field. UCSD is averaging 82.6 points on 57% shooting in its five victories this season, but putting up just 56.7 points on 39% shooting in its six losses. If the Tritons can find a way to shoot the ball more consistently, the wins will certainly follow.

### THREE'S A CROWD

The Tritons have been shooting the ball well from the three-point line lately, averaging just under seven triples over their previous four games. UCSD was dialed in from behind the arc against San Francisco State last week, hitting 8-of-13 from downtown, a season-best 61.5%. The Tritons also hit eight threes in the 81-67 win over Dixie State on Dec. 11 and sank a season-high 11 threes in their season-opening victory over Chestnut Hill College back on Nov. 4. UCSD currently leads the CCAA in three-point field goal percentage at 39.7% and ranks fifth in threes made with 62 through 11 games.

## NEWS AND NOTES

### LEADING MAN

Senior center Christian Hatch is putting together an outstanding season for the Tritons, averaging team-highs of 14.8 points and 7.3 rebounds through 11 games. The Henderson, Nev. native is shooting 54.5% from the field and 70.5% at the free throw line. He has scored in double figures a total of eight times this season and has tallied three double-doubles on the year, including an impressive 20-point, 10-rebound performance against Cal State San Bernardino on Dec. 19. Hatch had a big hand in UCSD's win over San Francisco State last Thursday, finishing with 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting. He tallied eight points and four rebounds in the loss to Cal Poly Pomona the following evening.

### BE LIKE MIKE

Senior forward Mike Meza had another big game last week, finishing with a game-high 19 points in UCSD's 72-50 win over San Francisco State. The Simi Valley, Calif. native had a brilliant shooting performance, converting 6-of-9 shots overall and 5-of-6 from the three-point line in just 22 minutes off the bench. He tied his career scoring mark with the performance, having also put in 19 in the Tritons' season-opener against Chestnut Hill. Meza, who also finished with six points, four rebounds and two assists the Tritons' loss to Cal Poly Pomona, was named the ucsdtritons.com Male Athlete of the Week on Monday for his efforts. For the season, Meza is averaging 9.7 points and 2.3 rebounds in 18.6 minutes per game. He is shooting a team-high 57% from the field and 67% from downtown.

### SCOUTING THE WARRIORS

Cal State Stanislaus enters Friday's clash with an overall record of 7-3 and a 3-3 mark in CCAA play after dropping a 63-59 decision at Chico State on Monday night... Senior forward Reggie Jones is a hand full in the post, averaging team-highs of 19.0 points and 6.4 rebounds through the Warriors' first 10 games... He leads the CCAA in scoring and ranks ninth in rebounding... As a team, Stanislaus ranks third in the league averaging 75.8 points per game offensively, while the defense is allowing 70.0, a figure that ranks seventh... UCSD holds a narrow 16-15 advantage in the all-time series with Cal State Stanislaus after losing both matchups with the Warriors in 2010-11... The Tritons were on the wrong end of a 57-55 decision on Jan. 8 in Turlock, before falling 71-66 at RIMAC a month later.

### SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Chico State enters the weekend with an overall record of 9-3 and a 3-3 tally in conference play following its win over Cal State Stanislaus earlier this week... Sophomore guard Sean Park leads three players averaging double figures for the Wildcats at 11.3 points per game... Sophomore forward Amir Carraway is putting up 10.8 points and grabbing a team-high 6.0 rebounds per night... Chico State is averaging 70.5 points per game offensively, a number that ranks sixth in the CCAA, while the defense has surrendered just 58.1, third-best in the league... The Tritons trail the all-time series with the Wildcats 14-10 after dropping both meetings with Chico last season... The Wildcats posted a 68-55 home victory on Jan. 7 and then claimed a 60-56 win in La Jolla on Feb. 12... Chico State will square off with Cal State San Bernardino on Friday before entertaining UCSD on Saturday.

### QUICK HITS

UCSD currently ranks ninth in the CCAA in scoring offense, averaging 68.5 points per game... Defensively, the Tritons rank sixth, holding their opponents to 65.7... UCSD held San Francisco State to just 50 points in its victory last week, the second-lowest total by an opponent this season... The Tritons have shot better than 50% from the field in back-to-back games just once this season, doing so in consecutive wins over Dominican and Academy of Art in November... After facing Cal State Stanislaus and Chico State, UCSD will come home for four straight beginning with matchups against Cal State East Bay and Cal State Monterey Bay Jan. 13-14.

## HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON



**C**hris Carlson embarks on his fifth season as the head coach at UC San Diego in 2011-12. The 11th coach in program history, he enters the year with an overall record of 54-57 (.486) in four seasons at the helm.

Carlson made an immediate impact upon arriving at UCSD, leading the Tritons to an overall record of 18-12 in his first season, the program's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the Division II level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage 80-60 in the opening round of the West Regional.

The Tritons were one of the top teams in the CCAA again in 2008-09, recording an overall record of 17-11 and a 13-7 mark in league play. After earning a No. 4 seed in the CCAA Tournament, UCSD defeated No. 5 Humboldt State 79-67 in the first round before falling 76-72 to host Cal State San Bernardino in the semifinals.

UCSD finished with an overall record of 8-17 in 2009-10, missing the postseason for the first time since 2007. The Tritons went 4-2 during a six-game stretch in February to stay in contention for a conference tournament berth, but a pair of losses to Sonoma State and Humboldt State the final week of the regular season dashed the Tritons' postseason hopes.

Under Carlson's guidance, senior guard Jordan Lawley became the first Triton to win the CCAA scoring title since UCSD joined the conference in 2000-01 during the 2009-10 campaign. Lawley was named to the All-CCAA First Team and went on to earn All-West Region accolades after averaging career-highs of 20.2 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in his final season as a Triton.

UCSD won five of its first six games to kick off the 2010-11 campaign, marking the program's best start in 10 seasons at the D-II level. The Tritons claimed the 2010 Disney West Coast Tipoff Classic title after defeating Lewis and Dixie State to open the season and also posted early season victories over Notre Dame de Namur and Simon Fraser. Despite the torrid start, UCSD would ultimately finish with an 11-7 record and miss the postseason for the second consecutive season.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99, where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94 and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UC Santa Barbara, where he received his bachelors degree in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen have two sons, Nicklas and Charlie.

### UCSD PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN CCAA STANDINGS

UC San Diego was selected to finish 10th in the California Collegiate Athletic Association regular season standings, according to the league's annual preseason coaches poll that was released in October. UCSD, which finished 11th in the conference with a 6-16 record last season, received 32 points in the poll. Defending regular season champion Humboldt State was picked to win the 2011-12 CCAA title, receiving nine first place votes and a total of 119 points. Cal State San Bernardino collected 106 points and two first place votes to finish second, while Cal State Dominguez Hills was third after garnering 90 points and the remaining first place vote.

### UCSD GAMES TO AIR ON ESPN 1700 IN 2011-12

The UC San Diego Athletics Department last month announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1700 that will carry 16 Triton men's basketball games live locally during the 2011-12 season. ESPN 1700 will broadcast a total of 12 home games and four road contests this season, marking the first time UCSD basketball will air on terrestrial radio. Craig Elsten, who is in his third season as the voice of Triton basketball during UCSD's online broadcasts, will serve as play-by-play announcer, while Jack Cronin, Executive Producer at XX Sports 1090 and ESPN 1700, will handle the color commentary duties.
